**COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON HEAD COACH BOBBY CREMINS**



Bobby Cremins, a veteran of 30 seasons as a college basketball head coach and the winningest coach in Georgia Tech history, is in his sixth season as head coach at the College of Charleston. Cremins was named coach of the Cougars on July 3, 2006 and currently ranks among the top 15 active NCAA Division I coaches in career victories (573).

There is not a coach in the country who combines experience, development and caring as much as Cremins. He has mentored 24 players who have gone on to the NBA, has coached in an NCAA Final Four and has twice been named National Coach of the Year by the media and his peers.

The Bronx, N.Y. native, who coached six seasons at Appalachian State (1976-81, 100-70) and 19 at Georgia Tech (1982-2000, 354-237), sports a 573-368 (.609) overall career record and is in his 31st season as a Division I head coach. He led Appalachian State to one NCAA Tournament berth and Georgia Tech to nine.

Cremins has led the Cougars to four 20-win campaigns in the last five years including last season's memorable run to the NIT Quarterfinals and a 26-11 overall record. CoFC would claim its first Southern Conference regular-season championship title as well as boast the program's first NBA Draft pick and All-American since 1997 in all-time leading scorer and great Andrew Goudelock.

In 2009-10, CoFC reached the quarterfinals of the College Basketball Invitational, posted a 22-11 overall record and stunned No. 9-ranked North Carolina in an 82-79 overtime-thriller on Jan. 4, 2010 at TD Arena. A year prior, the Cougars enjoyed another successful season at 27-9 overall and a 15-5 SoCon mark in 2008-09. CoFC posted a 3-1 record in the SoCon Tournament falling in the title game.

Cremins earned his 500th career win in the Cougars' 73-58 victory over Coastal Carolina on Dec. 17, 2008. The season also included a pair of wins over Davidson and an overtime upset of Cremins' alma mater South Carolina, 82-80. Jermaine Johnson, Tony White, Jr. and Goudelock all surpassed the 1,000-point plateau for their careers. Goudelock was a unanimous All-SoCon first team selection, while Johnson earned third team honors from the league's media.

Cremins led Charleston to a 22-11 record in his inaugural season in 2006-07. CoFC, which won 13 of 18 league games, finished second in the Southern Conference Tournament. The Cougars won 20 games for the first time since 2003-04 and for the 21st time in program history.

Cremins is the 21st head coach in College of Charleston men's basketball history. In 2003, Georgia Tech officially named the basketball court at Alexander Memorial Coliseum "Cremins Court."

Cremins became Georgia Tech's all-time winningest coach during the 1995-96 season. He was inducted into the Atlanta Sports Hall of Fame on June 9, 2006 and the Georgia Tech Sports Hall of Fame on October 6, 2006.

Cremins thrust the Yellow Jackets into the national basketball picture with a long line of great players, beginning with Mark Price and John Salley and continued with Duane Ferrell, Tom Hammonds, Dennis Scott, Brian Oliver, Kenny Anderson, Stephon Marbury and Matt Harpring.

Cremins guided Tech to 14 winning seasons and 14 postseason berths in his 19 years. He led the Yellow Jackets to three ACC tournament titles, two ACC regular-season titles and a Final Four appearance in 1989-90.

After graduating from South Carolina in 1970 with a bachelor's degree in marketing, Cremins played professional basketball in Ecuador before beginning his collegiate coaching career at Point Park College in Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1972. He returned to his alma mater as an assistant coach in 1973.

After a two-year stint at USC, Cremins, born on July 4, 1947, was chosen to build the Appalachian State program-becoming the youngest Division I head coach in the NCAA at the age of 27. After a first year mark of 13-14, the Mountaineers posted a five-year record of 87-56, a 60-percent winning mark, while capturing three SoCon titles. His 1978-79 team registered a 23-6 mark and an NCAA bid while his 1980-81 squad was 20-9.

Cremins received his master's degree in guidance and counseling in 1972, also from South Carolina. He was a three-year starter at point guard under legendary coach Frank McGuire, leading the Gamecocks to some of their most successful seasons and a 61-17 record. Cremins was inducted into the New York City Basketball Hall of Fame on September 20, 2007.

He and his wife, Carolyn, have three children: Liz, Suzie, and Bobby, III, and a daughter-in-law, Jennifer.

**GAME PREVIEW**

Riding a three-game winning streak, the College of Charleston men's basketball team (6-1, 1-0) continues its Southern Conference homestand with preseason North Division favorite Chattanooga (2-5, 0-1) on Saturday, Dec. 3 at TD Arena. Tipoff between the Cougars and Mocs is scheduled for 4 p.m. (ET) and the game will be carried locally on FOX 24 Charleston and online on ESPN3. Over the last couple of years, both teams have developed a healthy rivalry as CoFC looks to avenge a close 91-88 decision in a battle of previous unbeaten at Chattanooga 11 months ago as well as an 11-point loss in the SoCon Tournament finals with a trip to the Big Dance on the line in 2009. The Cougars have led the league in scoring offense the last two years and field-goal percentage in 2010-11. They currently rank No. 80 nationally averaging 74.4 points per game and No. 39 shooting 48.1 percent from the field. CoFC has already beaten two teams who accounted for the team's 11 overall losses last season in Morehead State on Nov. 15 and Clemson on Nov. 19. The Cougars are off to their second-best start in the Bobby Cremins Era next to a 6-1 record in their first seven games of the 2008-09 campaign. Both squads feature two of the top point guards in the league in CoFC's Andrew Lawrence (3.08) and UTC's Keegan Bell (1.78) as both rank first and fifth respectively in assist-to-turnover ratio and No. 2 and No. 1 in assists per game.

**SCOUTING CHATTANOOGA**

Chattanooga looks to snap a two-game losing skid with tough setbacks against Gardner-Webb (76-74) in overtime on Nov. 27 and a SoCon-opening loss at Georgia Southern (84-76) on Dec. 1. The Mocs currently lead the league in steals (8.9 avg) and boast the preseason Player of the Year in senior guard Omar Wattad, who started off his collegiate career at Georgetown and is averaging a team-leading 11.6 points per game along with fellow teammate Ricky Taylor (11.6 ppg). They opened the year with non-conference road losses at undefeated Indiana (78-53) on Nov. 13 and 2010 and 2011 NCAA runner-up Butler (57-46) on Nov. 15. UTC was one of three SoCon schools, along with CoFC and Davidson, to place two players on the 10-member preseason All-SoCon Team with Wattad and Bell.

**HOME COURT ADVANTAGE**

CoFC has won its last 10 consecutive home games at TD Arena and remains undefeated on its home court in the year 2011. Since the venue's opening in 2008, the Cougars have enjoyed 16 sold-out games (including the Holy Cross opener and The Citadel SoCon opener) creating one of the toughest home-court environments in college basketball. They are 40-6 (.870) all-time on John Kresse Court with their current 10-game streak beginning with an 87-66 victory over crosstown rival The Citadel on Jan. 15, 2011. One of the program's six losses in the arena was against Clemson (66-59) on Dec. 22, 2010.

### FROM THREE

The Cougars love the three-ball. They knocked down a season-high 12 three-pointers against UMass on Nov. 26 in the Bahamas and have averaged nearly eight-or-more a game. Senior Antwaine Wiggins currently ranks 10th all-time in the CofC record books with 127 career treys, while Andrew Lawrence is just outside of the top 10 with 104. This year, Wiggins (13) and Lawrence (16) are joined in the three-point marksmanship department by sophomore Jordan Scott (9), freshman Anthony Stitt (9) and redshirt junior Matt Sundberg (8).

### NO-NONSENSE SCHEDULE

The Cougars have never been afraid to schedule a tough non-conference schedule to prepare them for the SoCon season. They will face 13 opponents who reached postseason play a year ago in the likes of Morehead State, Clemson, Tennessee, Louisville and George Mason as well as potential meetings with defending national champion Connecticut, UNC Asheville and Florida State at the inaugural Battle 4 Atlantis tournament on Nov. 24-26 at the Atlantis Bahamas Resort in Paradise Island, Bahamas. Central Florida and Harvard, who reached the CBI semifinals and NIT first round respectively, also make up the eight-team tournament field. Last year, CofC went 12-7 against non-conference foes with a 91-78 road win at Tennessee on Dec. 31. The Cougars also faced notables in Maryland, North Carolina, Rhode Island, Clemson, Vermont (ESPN BracketBusters) and Dayton, Cleveland State and Wichita State in the NIT.

**COUGARS PICKED SECOND IN SOCON SOUTH DIVISION**

College of Charleston was picked to finish second in the South Division in a vote by the league's head coaches. CofC was one of only three schools to place a pair on the all-conference team in senior Antwaine Wiggins and sophomore Trent Wiedeman next to Chattanooga and Davidson, who were both tabbed the favorites to capture the SoCon's divisional titles in 2011-12. Appalachian State's Omar Carter was named Preseason Player of the Year. The Cougars, who compiled a 14-4 league record, captured a divisional regular-season title and advanced to the quarterfinals of the NIT a year ago, earned two first-place votes in the South Division with 56 points, behind Davidson (65) and ahead of Georgia Southern (42), Furman (34), Wofford (32) and The Citadel (17). Three of CofC's projected starters played at least 24 minutes or more in each game including the team's third-leading scorer and top returning rebounder in Wiedeman, who was named to the 2011 SoCon All-Freshman Team and Mid-Major Freshmen All-America Team by CollegeInsider.com.



**AMONG THE TOP MID-MAJORS**

The Cougars are currently ranked No. 23 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll released on Nov. 28. They are the only team from the SoCon represented on this week's list as preseason South Division favorite Davidson is receiving 78 votes, one place out of the poll at 26th. Gonzaga leads the pack followed by Creighton, Harvard, Iona and Cleveland State to round out the top 5.

- Coach Cremins is 15-5 lifetime versus Chattanooga in his 31 years as a Division I head coach and 7-3 all-time with the Cougars.
- Preseason All-SoCon selection Antwaine Wiggins, the lone Tennessee native on the team, is friends with Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, who is originally from Johnson City, Tenn. - Chattanooga freshman guard Ronrico White is the younger brother of Tony White, Jr., who starred for the Cougars from 2006-10. The older White still ranks ninth all-time in career scoring in the CofC record books with 1,499 points (sixth all-time in CofC Division I history). Both attended high school at Bearden High School in Knoxville, Tenn., and are the sons of Tony White, Sr., who played collegiately at Tennessee from 1983-87 and was selected by the Chicago Bulls with the 10th pick in the second round of the 1987 NBA Draft.

**WIGGINS AMONG TOP DEFENDERS IN COUNTRY**

Redshirt senior forward Antwaine Wiggins (Greeneville, Tenn.) is 63 points shy of becoming the 29th player in school history to record 1,000 career points. He missed the 2009-10 season with a torn ACL injury and would have been apart of the 2011 Senior Class that included Goudelock, Monroe and Simmons. Wiggins was recently named one of the best perimeter defenders in the country by CBSports.com college basketball insider Jeff Goodman alongside Aaron Craft of Ohio State, Shabazz Napier of Connecticut, Ronald Nored of Butler and Anthony Marshall of UNLV.

**A LOOK BACK**

Last season, the Cougars reached the quarterfinals of the Postseason NIT and finished ranked among the nation's top 50 teams in the final 2010-11 NCAA statistics summary in won-lost percentage (49th), scoring offense (26th), scoring margin (48th), field-goal percentage (11th), three-point field goals per game (19th) and free-throw percentage (40th).

**THE CREMINS FILE**

Coach Cremins, a legend in his own right, is in his 31st overall season in the Division I coaching ranks and sixth year at the College of Charleston. He recorded his 100th career victory in a 93-64 rout of Western Carolina on Jan. 20, 2011 and has put together a 119-61 record to date with the Cougars. Cremins has compiled an impressive 573-368 career record (.609) at Appalachian State, Georgia Tech and CofC combined.

### THE CITADEL RECAP

#### CofC 83, The Citadel 64

- For the seventh consecutive game, CofC used the starting lineup of junior Andrew Lawrence, sophomore Jordan Scott, senior Antwaine Wiggins, sophomore Trent Wiedeman and freshman Adjehi Baru (6-1).
- CofC saw its 16th all-time sell-out crowd at TD Arena with 5,101 fans in attendance. The Cougars have now won their last 10-straight games on John Kresse Court since an 87-66 win over The Citadel on Jan. 15, 2011.
- With the win, the Cougars improve to 48-39 in the all-time crosstown rivalry series with The Citadel and have now won the last three-straight meetings between the two schools.
- Trent Wiedeman registered a career-high 22 points and 10 rebounds against the Bulldogs to mark his sixth career double-double.
- Antwaine Wiggins turned in his third consecutive 20-point outing with 20 versus The Citadel. He is now 63 points short of reaching 1,000 career points with 937 to date. It marked the second time this season to have two Cougar 20-point scorers in the same contest next to 23 points each from Wiggins and freshman Anthony Stitt against UMass in the Battle 4 Atlantis on Nov. 26.
- Andrew Lawrence, who is currently one of the nation's best ball handlers, recorded 14 points and dished out seven assists with three turnovers (2.33). He also made a career-best five steals against the Bulldogs.
- CofC made a season-low 10 turnovers in the ballgame, while The Citadel committed an opponent season-high 21 miscues on the court.
- For the fourth time this season, the Cougars shot 50 percent-or-better from the floor (50.0).
- The Charleston Sports Network officially debuted on the air with Voice of the Cougars Jeff McCarragher handling play-by-play duties and veteran broadcaster Nate Ross and legendary CofC head coach John Kresse providing color commentary on MyTV Charleston and ESPN3.
- Former CofC great and current Los Angeles Laker Andrew Goudelock joined play-by-play announcer Everett German as a guest color analyst for the Cougar Sports Radio Network.

### FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

CofC returns eight letterwinners who accounted for 31 percent of the team's scoring and 45 percent of the team's rebounding in 2010-11. Six Cougars who played in the exhibition games against Queens on Oct. 29 and Limestone College on Nov. 5 averaged only 43.0 percent of the team's overall minutes a year ago. However, three of the team's 2011-12 projected starters played at least 24 minutes or more in each game a year ago including third-leading scorer (8.4 ppg) and top returning rebounder Trent Wiedeman (6.6 rpg) who was named to the preseason All-Southern Conference Team along with Wiggins.

### COUGAR SOUND BITES

*"Chattanooga is tough. Last year, we went up there and they beat us up. Omar Wattad can really shoot the ball. (Chattanooga Head Coach) John (Shulman) does a great job. Chattanooga won their division last year and is the preseason favorite this year. Chattanooga is always Chattanooga.
