RECAP VS HAMPTON

Keith Thompson's put-back with 5.5 seconds left lifted Utah Valley to a 42-40 win over Hampton in the opening game of the Dr Pepper Classic on Thursday.

Ben Aird led all scorers with 15 points and knocked down the front end of a 1-and-1 to tie it at 40. After a miss on the second, Alfonzo Hubbard pulled down the offensive rebound on the for UVU. Hubbard's shot was blocked by David Bruce before Thompson hauled in the Wolverines' 52nd rebound and scored his only bucket of the night, a jump hook, as the game-winner.

Geddes Robinson had 13 of UVU's season-high rebounds, 19 of which came on the offensive glass.

The Wolverines trailed by seven early before Hubbard hit a three and Aird a layup to tie the game at 10. The Pirates (4-9) led by two late in the half before Isiah Williams knocked down a trey and Aird added a free throw to give UVU a 24-22 lead at the break.

Hampton, the defending MEAC Tournament champions, scored five straight to take a 35-30 lead with 8:37 remaining on a 3-pointer from Darrion Pellum and a lay-in by Bruce. A Williams three with 8:13 to go got UVU within two and then, after nearly three minutes elapsed, hit another to put the Wolverines in front 36-35 with 5:22 left.

The Pirates led by one with 2:02 to go when Robinson fed Aird, who scored and was fouled and converted on the free throw to put Wolverines up 39-37.

Hampton regained the lead after getting to the line twice on 3-point attempts. Pellum hit 1-of-3 with 1:02 to go before Jasper Williams hit 2-for-3 with 25 seconds left to make it 40-39, setting up the final play.

Both teams struggled from the field; UVU hit 24.6 percent while Hampton finished at 29.4 percent from the floor.

UVU GWC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior Geddes Robinson was named the Great West Conference's first Player of the Week on Nov. 17 after finishing with 18 points and 12 rebounds in a season-opening win over Simpson University. Robinson received the award for a second time when he was named co-player of the week along with Marcus Davis of Houston Baptist on Nov. 28 after double-doubles at Arkansas and at Oakland.

Holton Hunsaker received the award on Dec. 12 after scoring a career-high 26 in a win over Portland State. In the win, Hunsaker set a school record for free throws made without a miss, making all 16 he took including 12 in the closing minutes.

WOLVERINES IN FIVE-TEAM SOUTHWEST CLASSIC

UVU was one of five teams to compete in the Southwest Classic as Arkansas, Houston, Grambling State, Oakland and UVU each played one another for four early-season games. Arkansas, Houston and Oakland each went 3-1, while Utah Valley finished 1-3 and Grambling was 0-4 during the classic.

TWO UVU HOME GAMES TO BE TELEVISED LIVE NATIONWIDE

For the first time in program history, Utah Valley University men's basketball will have two home games broadcast nationwide. The Nov. 19 Homecoming game against UMKC will air in 56 million homes across the country on Fox College Sports as will the Jan. 3 contest against Wyoming. Eight other home games will air on FCS on tape-delay.

WILLIAMS HEADLINES FOUR TO RECEIVE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

As the 2011-12 college basketball season gets underway, Utah Valley's Isiah Williams has been selected by the GWC coaches to repeat as Great West Conference Player of the Year in 2011-12. Sophomore Ben Aird was selected along with Williams on the first team while two other Wolverines, Holton Hunsaker and Geddes Robinson, were picked to the second team.

Williams, a senior guard from Chicago, Ill., was named 2010-11 GWC Player of the Year after a stellar season, averaging 17.5 points per game and leading the Wolverines to the Great West Conference championship. In addition, Williams was also the GWC Newcomer of the Year and became Utah Valley's first basketball All-America honoree when he was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press.

Also on the first team are Aird, who was a 2010-11 second-team all-GWC honoree, North Dakota's Troy Huff and NJIT's Chris Flores and Isaiah Wilkerson. Second-team honorees include Hunsaker, Robinson, UND's Patrick Mitchell, Chicago State's Jeremy Robinson and Texas-Pan American's Brandon Provost and Aaron Urbanus.

UVU MEN'S BASKETBALL HAS NEW RADIO HOME

UVU basketball is now in The Zone. Utah Valley University Athletics and Utah's Sports Radio Network - 97.5 FM/1280 AM/960 AM - The Zone have reached an agreement to broadcast Wolverine men's basketball games.

"Having our games broadcast to a wider audience, on an all-sports station has been a priority for UVU athletics and we're pleased that we'll now be on The Zone," said UVU director of athletics Mike Jacobsen.

WILLIAMS IS FIRST UVU MBB ALL-AMERICAN

After leading UVU to the Great West Conference Championship and earning himself the GWC Player of the Year award, Isiah Williams added All-American to his list of accolades when he was named honorable mention All-America by the Associated Press.

Williams averaged 17.4 points per game and was also named to the Great West's All-Conference first team and received the league's Newcomer of the Year award. Williams is the first men's basketball All-American in Utah Valley's young NCAA Division I history and the fifth UVU athlete, in any sport, to garner the honor.

WOLVERINES PICKED TO REPEAT

Defending Great West Conference champion Utah Valley has been selected by the coaches to win the men's basketball title again in 2011-12.

The Wolverines, who won the championship last season with an 11-1 conference record (19-11 overall), received five of six first-place votes and 34 total points in the balloting.

Hunsaker, who enters his 10th season at UVU, returns one of the league's most experienced teams including 2010-11 GWC Player and Newcomer of the Year Isiah Williams. The Wolverines also return second-team all-GWC honoree Ben Aird and honorable mention selections Holton Hunsaker and Geddes Robinson.

2011 GWC Tournament champion North Dakota received the other first-place vote and tallied 28 points followed by NJIT with 27 points. Texas-Pan American (4th), Chicago State and Houston Baptist t-5th round out the poll.

UVU WINS BACK-TO-BACK GWC COMMISSIONER'S CUPS

For the second year in a row, Utah Valley University was the winner of the Great West Conference Commissioner's Cup in 2010-11. The Wolverines won the inaugural award with a total of 80.5 points and tallied the same total of 80.5 points during the 10-11 season. The award is given to the institution that performed best overall in GWC-sponsored sports.

As it did last year, UVU won six Great West championships in 2010-11. Titles won by the Wolverines included men's and women's cross country, men's basketball, baseball, and men's and women's outdoor track and field. In addition, UVU was the runner-up in volleyball and men's and women's indoor track and field.

North Dakota finished in second place in the standings with 68 points, while South Dakota garnered 63.5 points for third place. NJIT and Chicago State rounded out the rankings finishing sixth and seventh, respectively.

ABOUT UTAH VALLEY'S RECENT ATHLETIC HISTORY

Until 2003, Utah Valley University competed as a NJCAA athletic program. The 2003-04 season was the school's first competing at an NCAA Division I level.

For six years, until the summer of 2009, UVU was termed a 'provisional' school by the NCAA and not eligible for NCAA postseason competition. On July 8, 2009 UVU had its provisional status lifted and became a full member of NCAA Division I.

The Wolverines spent six seasons as an independent before the Great West Conference became an all-sports conference in 2008 and began its first full season in 2009.

UVU also became a university in 2008, changing its name from Utah Valley State College (UVSC) to Utah Valley University (UVU).

During his successful coaching career, which spans more than 30 years, Dick Hunsaker's players have demonstrated desire, determination and discipline while on the basketball court. These characteristics have led to successful collegiate basketball teams and players competing at the next level.

A telling example of Hunsaker's success was the 2001 University of Utah basketball team. After only one game, the Utes head coach, Rick Majerus, took a leave of absence from coaching. Utah administrators turned to Hunsaker to take over the team. He led the team to an 18-12 record, winning the Mountain West Conference and garnering local and national attention.

Hunsaker was named Mountain West Coach of the Year and Los Angeles Times National Coach of the Year.

"Dick Hunsaker did a remarkable job at the University of Utah under some very difficult circumstances," Mountain West Conference Commissioner Craig Thompson said. "The timing of his taking over the basketball program and then ultimately winning the league and being named coach of the year are a testimony to not only his on-court coaching ability, but also his numerous skills. He is a real tribute to college basketball."

Hunsaker has brought attention and success to Utah Valley in transitional years when some teams struggle. In fact, Utah Valley finished with a 22-7 record in the 2006-07 season, the best record by a Division I Independent since Notre Dame's 1985-86 year.

During the following off-season, Hunsaker was rewarded for his success with a five-year contract renewal. Hunsaker's efforts have not gone unnoticed as he earned Street & Smith Independent Coach of the Year three straight years. In 2007, Hunsaker was named the Independent Coach of the Year as voted upon by the Independent head coaches and sports information directors. Hunsaker was also tabbed as the Independent Coach of the Year by Collegeinsider.com.

In the Wolverines first two seasons with a full Division I schedule they compiled back-to-back 16 win seasons. Such success is not common for teams competing in their first season of Division I basketball. In fact, in the last 25 years, only three out of 74 teams making their initial jump to Division I play have won over 16 games.

An evident success story from the Wolverines' 2005 squad was the play of super guard Ronnie Price. Price was third in the nation in scoring, averaging 24.3 points a game. Price's efforts earned him national attention as well.

In January 2005, CBS Sportsline tagged him as the top point guard in the nation. Price's success also got him a job after college: A guaranteed contract with the Sacramento Kings. Price came home to Utah after signing as a free agent with the Utah Jazz.

Entering his ninth season as the Wolverines' head coach, Hunsaker's record is an impressive 149-85 and boasts a 64 percent winning percentage.

One of Hunsaker's biggest wins at Utah Valley came in the 2005-06 season when his squad beat Arizona State of the Pac-10 75-71 in Tempe.

In his second year at Utah Valley he led the Wolverines to the Division I Provisional National Championship by beating Florida Gulf Coast 81-80. That year his team finished with a 23-5 record.

In Hunsaker's first year at Utah Valley, which was also the program's final year as a junior college, the Wolverines finished 27-6 and finished second in the Region 18 tournament. That same season the Wolverines finished with the schools' first-ever undefeated home record at 14-0.

"Dick is a proven 'big time' coach who has shown his teams are capable of beating any team in the country," Western Athletic Conference Commissioner Karl Benson said.

Hunsaker was named the 2010-11 Great West Conference Coach of the Year after leading Utah Valley to an 11-1 mark in conference play and a 19-11 overall record. The season included a win at Pac-10 Oregon State, his second win over a school from the power conference, during his tenure in Orem.

That season also represented a first for Utah Valley University, as junior guard Isiah Williams became the program's first NCAA Division I All-American following a year that also saw him named the GWC Player of the Year.

Hunsaker's success at Utah Valley is no surprise. Overall, in 16 seasons as a head coach, he has a 334-170 career record including a 167-97 record in nine seasons at UVU.

Hunsaker has been a head coach at Ball State University, University of Utah, Manchester College and a stint in the CBA. He has also been an assistant at his Alma Mater, Weber State.

In 1990, he led Ball State to the NCAA Sweet 16, as the Cardinals head coach. Two years later, Dick Vitale called Hunsaker the Mid American Conference Coach of the Year.

He compiled a 97-34 record and led the Cardinals to two NCAA tournament appearances. He also guided Ball State to two NIT appearances. He posted four 20-win seasons and never lost back-to-back regular season games. He won the Mid-American Conference twice and finished second twice.

Following four successful seasons at Ball State, Hunsaker headed to the CBA where he was the Head coach of teams in Hartford and Grand Rapids. In 1994-95 he was the head coach and the Director of Basketball Operations for Grand Rapids. During his time with Grand Rapids, Hunsaker was named the American Conference Coach of the Month for the month of December where he guided Grand Rapids to the best road record in the CBA. That same month, Flip Saunders (current Detroit Pistons coach) was named the CBA National Conference Coach of the Month. A year earlier he was the interim coach and Director of Basketball Operations for Hartford.

In 1995, he returned to the college game. Hunsaker led Manchester College (Ind.) to three of the 10 most successful seasons in school history while posting a 51-27 overall record before returning to Utah where he joined Majerus and the University of Utah staff.

While at Utah, Hunsaker served in many capacities: Director of Basketball Operations, Assistant Coach and Acting Head Coach.

In Hunsaker's year as Acting Head Coach, the Utes won the Mountain West Conference title while posting an 18-12 record with the toughest regular season schedule the Utes had faced.

Hunsaker, entering his 10th season at UVU, currently serves as the Independent Congressman for the NABC.

He played college basketball at UTEP under Hall of Fame coach Don Haskins in 1972-73. He then finished his playing career at Weber State from 1974-77.

Hunsaker earned his bachelor's degree from Weber State in 1977 in Psychology and in 1983 he earned his master's degree from BYU in Educational Psychology. In 1985, Hunsaker was named Weber State Alumnus of the Year.

Hunsaker and his wife Diane are the parents of four children: Lance, Jodi, Holton and Zachary. Dick has one grandchild named Lauren.
