MOCS TRAVEL TO MERCER IN SOCON ACTION

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga football team is on the road for a Southern Conference contest at Mercer this weekend. The Mocs take on the Bears at 3:30 p.m. (E.D.T.) in Macon, Ga., on Saturday, Oct. 14.

Chattanooga has been hit hard by injuries this season, having lost their top two quarterbacks for an extended period of time. True freshman Cole Copeland started last week against Furman, setting freshman record with 317 passing yards and 30 completions on 42 attempts. He also had two touchdown passes against four interceptions. The Mocs were also without defensive starters Tae Davis (LB) and Markell Boston (DB) last week.

Chattanooga is 1-5 overall and 1-2 in SoCon. The Mocs are trying to get back on track after the worst start since the 2008 season.

Mercer brings a 3-3 record and is in fifth place in the SoCon race at 2-2. Mercer is coming off an impressive 24-14 road win at No. 17 The Citadel. It was the Bears' first win over The Citadel since restarting their program in 2013.

Chattanooga's defense currently leads the SoCon in passing yards allowed (175.7). However, the Mocs are fifth in rushing defense (176.7) and fourth in the league in total defense (352.3).

Turnovers have been a killer this season with Chattanooga sitting at -9 in that margin. The Mocs have not caused a turnover in the last two games, while committing seven.

Mercer currently leads the league in scoring defense, allowing just 18.8 points per game. Senior LB Lee Bennett is the reigning STATS FCS National Player of the Week after posting 16 tackles in the win over The Citadel. Offensively, the Bears are fourth in the SoCon in scoring at 30.2 ppg and sixth in the league in total offense at 368.2 yard per outing.

QUICK NOTES TO KNOW ABOUT THE MOCS

General

- Tom Arth is in his first season with the Mocs ... he came to UTC from John Carroll University where he was the NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year ... 40-8 record the previous four years at JCU.
- School-record streak of 51 consecutive weeks ranked was snapped after the UT Martin game ... prior to that, the last time UTC was out of the top 25 was Oct. 28, 2013 ... it was the sixth-longest active streak in the nation.
- 57-55 all-time at Finley Stadium ... 38-42 in SoCon home games.
- 31-10 in league play since the start of the 2012 season ... 26-7 since 2013.

Offense

- Eighth in the league in total offense (263.2) ... ninth in rushing (59.0) and fifth in passing (204.2).
- Eighth in the SoCon in scoring offense (19.5 ppg).
- Seventh in the SoCon on third down (30/84 - 35.7%).
- The Mocs have given up a league-high 21 sacks.
- Senior RB Darrell Bridges had a strong showing at LSU with 88 rushing yards and a TD on 15 carries.
- Senior WR Alphonso Stewart posted a career-high 138 rec. yds and a TD on 7 rec. against Furman.
- Mocs have to replace six starters on offense, including All-American RB Derrick Craine, All-American OG Corey Levin and All-American center Jacob Revis. Others not returning include WRs C.J. Board and Xavier Borishade and OT Hunter Townson.
- Two offensive linemen return with SoCon postseason honors. Senior Josh Cardiello started all 13 games and made the All-SoCon second team. Sophomore-to-be Malcolm White returns to the offensive line after making the SoCon All-Freshman team.

Defense

- Senior Lucas Webb has three career pick-6s ... school record and tied for the SoCon record ... 12 career INTs is tied for third all-time at UTC ... twice been tagged as a preseason All-American.
- Junior LB Tavon Lawson is seventh in the SoCon with 8.3 tackles per game.
- Fourth in the league in total defense (352.3) ... fifth in scoring defense (31.0) ... eighth in pass efficiency defense (164.72).
- Mocs lead the SoCon in passing yards allowed (175.7).
- Senior LB Dale Warren led the SoCon with 19.0 TFLs in 2016.
- Warren and Webb lead five returning starters on the defensive side. Senior Taylor Reynolds is the lone returning starter on the defensive line. Junior Isaiah Mack is also back on the interior. He posted 7.5 sacks in 2016. Senior Trevor Wright and junior C.J. Fritz give the Mocs a total of three returning starters in the secondary.
- Mocs have to replace six starters on defense, including All-American DL Keionta Davis, All-American LB Nakevion Leslie and first team All-SoCon DL Vantrel McMillan. Others not returning include DBs Montrell Pardue and Cedric Nettles and DL Justin King.

Special Teams

- Sophomore Colin Brewer returns as the punter, earning SoCon All-Freshman honors in 2016. He is currently eighth in the league at 40.3 yards per kick.
- Freshman K Victor Ulmo hit four of his first five FG attempts.
- Ulmo is replacing K Henrique Ribeiro, the school's career scoring leader at UTC with 307 points ...

76.2% (48/63) career FG% is second all-time at UTC ... eight-time SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week is tied with Appalachian State's Sam Martin (2009-12) for the SoCon mark.

- True freshman Brandon Dowdell took over the punt return duties at VMI and posted 42 yards on two tries ... averaging 11.8 yards on five attempts.
- Fifth in the league in kickoff coverage (41.6).
- Sixth in the SoCon in net punting (36.6).

MORE ON THE QB SITUATION

Senior QB Alejandro Bennifield started against Western Carolina after sitting out the first four games due to an NCAA Academic Suspension. The preseason All-SoCon pick was knocked out of the game in the first quarter and did not return. He did not play against Furman and his status for the Mercer game is still unknown.

Sophomore Nick Tiano, who played the first four games of the season, stepped back in, but was injured early in the fourth quarter against Western Carolina. He did not play against Furman and his status for the Mercer game is also unknown. Freshman Dominic Caldwell came in for the final three drives against Western Carolina, tossing a TD pass to Darrell Bridges for UTC's only score of the game. The transfer from Florida International was 1-2 for the six-yard score.

During Bennifield's suspension, freshman Cole Copeland was listed as the No. 2 QB on the depth chart, but he was also attempting to redshirt. The former two-star prep prospect from Bradley Central High School in Cleveland, Tenn., started against Furman and set UTC freshman records with 317 yards on 30/42 passing with two touchdowns and four interceptions.

MORE ON COLE COPELAND'S DEBUT

Copeland was the first freshman to start a game at QB for the Mocs since Jacob Huesman vs. Elon (W, 24-17) on Nov. 17, 2012. He was also the first true freshman to play at QB for the Mocs since Antonio Miller in 2004 and the first true freshmen to start at QB for the Mocs since Brian Hampton in a 21-23 loss to Furman on Nov. 18, 1995, on Chamberlain Field. Hampton won his first start that season, 29-24 over The Citadel on Nov. 4, 1995. Copeland's first pass was a seven-yard completion to Alphonso Stewart and he went on to complete his first eight. His 317 passing yards were the most by a Moc since Jacob Huesman had 335 at No. 1 New Hampshire on Dec. 12, 2014.

WARREN SET TO RETURN

Senior LB Dale Warren is eligible for the first time this season after sitting out the first six games due to an NCAA suspension. The preseason All-American led the SoCon with 19.0 TFLs last season.

- Senior LB Lee Bennett was named the STATS FCS National Defensive Player of the Week his performance in a 24-14 victory over No. 17 The Citadel last weekend. - Prior to the 2014 game, the last meeting was a 40-13 win for the Mocs in Chattanooga on Nov. 26, 1941 ... this was the final game of the 1941 season ... less than two weeks later, the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor and sent the United States into World War II ... Mercer did not take the field again until the start of the 2013 season.
- UTC is 2-5 at Mercer ... Mocs were No. 3 in the nation on their last trip to Macon in 2015 when they lost 17-14 on Nov. 7.

- Former NBA guard/forward Gerald Wilkins played for the Mocs from 1983-85.

- Steven Fox won the U.S. Amateur title in 2012 as a senior at UTC. The men's golf team has twice been ranked No. 1 in the nation since 2009.

ATTENDANCE AT FINLEY STADIUM

Chattanooga had four crowds over 10,000 in one season for the first time in 2010. The second largest crowd for a Mocs game - 17,414 - attended Chattanooga's 35-27 win over No. 18 Georgia Southern on Oct. 9. UTC's record crowd is 22,642 set against Tennessee State in the first game at Finley Stadium on Oct. 18, 1997. Seven of the top 10 crowds in Finley Stadium history have been in the last nine seasons. UTC has reached the 10,000 mark 27 times at Finley Stadium and 22 of those crowds have also come in the last nine years.

- Mocs did not record a sack for second game of the year ... only other time was against triple-option Wofford.
- Lucas Webb's third quarter interception was the first committed by Mercer QB John Russ this season.
- There was only one penalty in the game between the two teams ... face-mask against UTC in the 4th quarter.
- Malcolm Colvin – One catch for five yards ... first career catch and only catch by a TE this season.

MOCS ON ESPN3

Nine of the 11 games on the Mocs slate are scheduled to be on the ESPN family of networks, including the Furman game on ESPN3. Chris Goforth (pxp) and former Moc B.J. Coleman (analyst) have the call from Finley Stadium. UTC kicked off against Jacksonville State on ESPN, while the LSU game was on the SEC Network. Five of the Mocs' other six games can be found on ESPN3.

SEASON NO. 110

The Chattanooga Mocs are in their 110th season of college football in 2017. The University of Chattanooga was founded in 1886 and football began play in 1904. No teams were fielded in 1917 and 1918 due to World War I. There was also a two-year hiatus from football action during World War II in 1943 and 1944. The Mocs have an all-time record of 530-524-35 (.502) and have won 13 conference titles.

IT'S ALL IN THE NAME

On first reference, it is acceptable to refer to us as the "University of Tennessee at Chattanooga". After that, we prefer to be called "Chattanooga" or "UTC." Our nickname is "Mocs".

SCHOOL-RECORD EIGHT ON NFL ROSTERS

Prior to final cuts, the Mocs had a school-record eight former student-athletes on an NFL roster. Those included C.J. Board (Ravens), Keionta Davis (Patriots), Jacob Huesman (Giants), Corey Levin (Titans), Chris Lewis-Harris (Broncos), Derrick Lott (Lions), Buster Skrine (Jets) and Davis Tull (Rams). Levin and Skrine both made the 53-man rosters for their respective teams, while Lott is currently on the practice squad in Detroit and Davis is on the injured list in New England.

ARTH NAMED 23RD MOCS HEAD COACH

Tom Arth was named the 23rd head coach of Mocs football on Dec. 19, 2016. He was the 2016 NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year from John Carroll University in Cleveland, Ohio. A former NFL quarterback, Arth (35) owned a 40-8 overall record in four seasons at his alma mater. His building of the John Carroll program was highlighted by 2016 road victories over two No. 1-ranked opponents in Mount Union and Wisconsin-Whitewater. The 2016 Ohio Athletic Conference Coach of the Year guided the Blue Streaks to the NCAA Division III Playoffs for the third time in his four-year tenure. In the four seasons under Arth's leadership, John Carroll was among the nation's elite, finishing inside the Top 25 every season, including top 5 finishes in 2016 (No. 3) and 2014 (No. 5). John Carroll won the league's automatic bid for the first time in school history in 2016, breaking Mount Union's run of 24 consecutive OAC titles. The Blue Streaks finished the season ranked No. 3 in the nation, tying a school record with a 12-2 overall tally and a 9-0 mark in league action.

LETTERMEN/STARTERS RETURNING/LOST

UTC returns a total of 46 lettermen from the 2016 campaign. It is the most returning lettermen from one season to the next since 52 came back for the 1997 season. There are 20 on the offensive side of the ball, 23 on defense and three specialists. There are 12 starters back, including five on offense, five on defense, the punter and long snapper.

LEAGUE-HIGH 10 ON PRESEASON ALL-SOCON TEAMS

UTC put a league-high 10 student-athletes on the preseason All-Southern Conference Football Team, picked by the league coaches and released as part of SoCon Media Day on July 18.

Senior defensive back Lucas Webb (Northport, Ala.) is one of four Mocs on the first team. He is joined by junior defensive lineman Isaiah Mack (Tunnel Hill, Ga.), senior linebacker Dale Warren (Covington, Ga.) and senior offensive lineman Josh Cardiello (Buford, Ga.) on offense.

Senior quarterback Alejandro Bennifield (Lovejoy, Ga.), senior running back Richardre Bagley (Powder Springs, Ga.), sophomore offensive lineman Malcolm White (Johnson City, Tenn.) and senior wide receiver James Stovall (Cleveland, Tenn.) were all named to the second team offense. Senior defensive lineman Taylor Reynolds (McCalla, Ala.) and senior defensive back Trevor Wright (Greeneville, Tenn.) earned second team defense honors.

MOCS PICKED FOURTH IN THE SOCON PRESEASON POLLS

The Mocs were picked to finish fourth in the Southern Conference by both the league coaches and media. Wofford was tops in both polls, with 11 of 22 first-place votes on the media side and seven of the nine from the coaches. The Citadel and Samford were 2-3 in both polls.

MOCS GRABBED PRESEASON NATIONAL ATTENTION

The Mocs entered the 2017 season with a No. 12 national ranking in the STATS.com FCS Poll. UTC is also No. 13 in the FCS Coaches Poll. These are the two rankings officially recognized by the NCAA.

MOCS WERE RANKED FOR 51 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS

UTC was ranked in the Top 25 for 51 consecutive weeks, dating back to Nov. 4, 2013, before falling out this week. That was the sixth-longest active streak in the country. The Mocs have been in the Top 25 for 54 weeks since 2009. UTC was ranked as high as No. 3 on Nov. 1, 1968, in the Small College Top 20, before the FCS was created in 1978.

STAFF CHANGES

With the head coaching change, come a number of additional staff changes. The following are new faces on UTC's sideline: Tom Kaufman (Defensive Coordinator), Justin Rascati (Offensive Coordinator), Ryan Aplin (Receivers), Brian Cochran (Defensive Line), Chris Cook (Tackles/TEs), Jonathan Cooley (Defensive Backs), Matt Feeney (Linebackers), Shelton Felton (OLB), Nick Hennessey (Offensive Line), Chris Hurd (Special Teams/Running Backs).

TWO NEW ASSISTANTS GET NFL JOBS

Before they even coached a snap at UTC, two members of Tom Arth's staff were picked up by NFL teams. Arth's first defensive coordinator was hired by the Chicago Bears in February to be their new linebackers coach. Then outside linebackers Coach Demarcus Covington was hired by the New England Patriots in May as a member of their defensive staff.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Captains for the upcoming season are Alejandro Bennifield (Sr.-QB-15), Taylor Reynolds (Sr.-DL-94), Alphonso Stewart (Sr.-WR-9), James Stovall (Sr.-WR-8) and Lucas Webb (Sr.-DB-29).

NFL TIES

The Mocs coaching staff has some obvious NFL ties with their connections to John Carroll University and the number of coaches and administrators who have come from that institution. There are a trio of student-athletes on the roster who are also connected to the NFL. Junior WR Kota Nix is the grandson of former UTC head coach and Buffalo Bills General Manager Buddy Nix. Freshman tight end Jacob Webster is the son of former Tennessee Titans General Manager Ruston Webster. Freshman quarterback Dominic Caldwell is the nephew of current Jacksonville Jaguars General Manager David Caldwell.

RECRUITING CLASS PICKED SECOND IN THE SOCON, NO. 11 IN THE FCS

New head coach Tom Arth and his staff did an outstanding job in a short amount of time, bringing in a 21-member recruiting class. Both 247Sports.com and HeroSports.com tabbed it as the No. 2 class in the Southern Conference and No. 11 overall in the FCS. The Mocs have had a top 15 recruiting class in eight of the last nine years.
