MOCS HOST THE CITADEL ON MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY

The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga football team hosts The Citadel in Southern Conference action this weekend. The Mocs welcome the Bulldogs for Military Appreciation Day on Saturday, Oct. 21, at 2:00 p.m. (E.D.T.).

Both teams entered the 2017 campaign with high hopes and a national ranking, and both are now trying to stop three-game losing skids. The Mocs started the year at No. 13 in the country, but are trying to right a 1-6 overall record and 1-3 mark in SoCon action.

The Bulldogs came into the season ranked No. 12 in the FCS Coaches Poll and ran out to a 3-0 start. Since then, they have dropped three-straight and are 1-3 in league action.

Chattanooga has been hit hard by injuries this season, having lost its top two quarterbacks for an extended period of time. True freshman Cole Copeland has started the last two games, setting freshman records with 317 passing yards and 30 completions on 42 attempts against Furman. He is 52-81 (64.2%) for 523 yards, two touchdowns and five interceptions in two games.

Chattanooga's defense is currently third in the SoCon in passing yards allowed (183.7). However, the Mocs are fifth in rushing defense (163.4) and fourth in the league in total defense (347.1). On offense,

the Mocs are eighth in the SoCon in scoring (18.1 ppg) and total yards (261.3).

Turnovers have been a killer this season with Chattanooga sitting at -10 in that margin. The Mocs have not caused a turnover in the last three games, while committing eight.

The Citadel currently leads the league in rushing and is No. 5 in the FCS, posting 293.5 yards per game with a triple-option attack. Offensively, the Bulldogs are fourth in the SoCon at 402.2 ypg. Defensively, they are tied for second in points allowed (20.8) and second in the SoCon in yards allowed (298.7). The Bulldogs are coming off a 20-16 loss to No. 5 Wofford last weekend.

Coleman (analyst) have the call from Finley Stadium. UTC kicked off against Jacksonville State on ESPN, while the LSU game was on the SEC Network. Two of the Mocs' final three games can be found on ESPN3.

FREE DOWNTOWN SHUTTLE

The FREE CARTA Electric Shuttle runs from downtown to the corner of Main & Chestnut streets on gameday.

STUDENT SHUTTLE FROM CAMPUS

The Mocs-branded CARTA busses run from Noon until 12:30 a.m., on game days. Students can catch the bus at any of the regular CARTA stops on campus. Drop off at Finley is the corner of Main and Chestnut Streets. Students ride for free with a valid Mocs Card.

- 31-11 in league play since the start of the 2012 season ... 26-8 since 2013.

Offense

- Eighth in the league in total offense (261.3) ... ninth in rushing (56.9) and fifth in passing (204.4).
- Eighth in the SoCon in scoring offense (18.1 ppg).
- Seventh in the SoCon on third down (32/98 32.7%).
- The Mocs have given up a league-high 24 sacks.
- Senior RB Darrell Bridges had a strong showing at LSU with 88 rushing yards and a TD on 15 carries.
- Senior WR Alphonso Stewart posted a career-high 138 rec. yds and a TD on 7 rec. against Furman.
- Mocs have to replace six starters on offense, including All-American RB Derrick Craine, All-American OG Corey Levin and All-American center Jacob Revis. Others not returning include WRs C.J. Board and Xavier Borishade and OT Hunter Townson.
- Two offensive linemen return with SoCon postseason honors. Senior Josh Cardiello started all 13

games and made the All-SoCon second team. Sophomore-to-be Malcolm White returns to the offensive line after making the SoCon All-Freshman team.

Defense

- Senior Lucas Webb has three career pick-6s ... school record and tied for the SoCon record ... 12 career INTs is tied for third all-time at UTC ... twice been tagged as a preseason All-American.
- Junior LB Tavon Lawson is ninth in the SoCon with 8.3 tackles per game.
- Fourth in the league in total defense (347.1) ... seventh in scoring defense (30.9) ... eighth in pass efficiency defense (165.9).
- Third in the SoCon in passing yards allowed (183.7).
- Senior LB Dale Warren led the SoCon with 19.0 TFLs in 2016.
- Warren and Webb lead five returning starters on the defensive side. Senior Taylor Reynolds is the lone returning starter on the defensive line. Junior Isaiah Mack is also back on the interior. He posted 7.5 sacks in 2016. Senior Trevor Wright and junior C.J. Fritz give the Mocs a total of three returning starters in the secondary.
- Mocs have to replace six starters on defense, including All-American DL Keionta Davis, All-American LB Nakevion Leslie and first team All-SoCon DL Vantrel McMillan. Others not returning include DBs Montrell Pardue and Cedric Nettles and DL Justin King.

Special Teams

- Sophomore Colin Brewer returns as the punter, earning SoCon All-Freshman honors in 2016. He is currently eighth in the league at 39.9 yards per kick.
- Freshman K Victor Ulmo is five for six on FG this season, including a career-long 44-yarder at Mercer.
- Ulmo is replacing K Henrique Ribeiro, the school's career scoring leader at UTC with 307 points ... 76.2% (48/63) career FG% is second all-time at UTC ... eight-time SoCon Special Teams Player of the Week is tied with Appalachian State's Sam Martin (2009-12) for the SoCon mark.
- True freshman Brandon Dowdell took over the punt return duties at VMI and posted 42 yards on two tries ... averaging 10.1 yards on seven attempts.
- Seventh in the league in kickoff coverage (40.2).
- Seventh in the SoCon in net punting (35.9).

MORE ON THE QB SITUATION

Senior QB Alejandro Bennifield started against Western Carolina after sitting out the first four games due to an NCAA Academic Suspension. The preseason All-SoCon pick was knocked out of the game in the first quarter and did not return. He did not play against Furman and his status for the Mercer game is still unknown.

Sophomore Nick Tiano, who played the first four games of the season, stepped back in, but was injured early in the fourth quarter against Western Carolina. He did not play against Furman or Mercer and his status for The Citadel game is also unknown. Freshman Dominic Caldwell came in for the final three drives against Western Carolina, tossing a TD pass to Darrell Bridges for UTC's only score of the game. The transfer from Florida International was 1-2 with the six-yard score.

During Bennifield's suspension, freshman Cole Copeland was listed as the No. 2 QB on the depth chart, but he was also attempting to redshirt. The former two-star prep prospect from Bradley Central High School in Cleveland, Tenn., started against Furman and set UTC freshman records with 317 yards on 30/42 passing with two touchdowns and four interceptions. He followed that with 206 yards and a pick on 22/39 passing at Mercer.

MORE ON COLE COPELAND'S DEBUT

Copeland was the first freshman to start a game at QB for the Mocs since Jacob Huesman vs. Elon (W, 24-17) on Nov. 17, 2012. He was also the first true freshman to play at QB for the Mocs since Antonio Miller in 2004 and the first true freshmen to start at QB for the Mocs since Brian Hampton in a 21-23 loss to Furman on Nov. 18, 1995, on Chamberlain Field. Hampton won his first start that season, 29-24 over The Citadel on Nov. 4, 1995. Copeland's first pass was a seven-yard completion to Alphonso Stewart and he went on to complete his first eight. His 317 passing yards were the most by a Moc since Jacob Huesman had 335 at No. 1 New Hampshire on Dec. 12, 2014.

WARREN BACK IN THE LINEUP

Senior LB Dale Warren returnd to the lineup for the first time, recording seven tackles at Mercer. He sat out the first six games of the season due to an NCAA suspension. The preseason All-American led the SoCon with 19.0 TFLs last season.

WEBB SCORING ON DEFENSE

Senior DB Lucas Webb scored on a 28-yard fumble return at VMI. It was the fourth defensive score of his career, which is now second in SoCon history. Furman's Ryan Steed has the record with three pick-sixes and two fumble returns for a TD from 2008-11. Webb and Steed and both tied with four others with the most pick-sixes in SoCon history.

NOTES ON LAST WEEK'S LOSS AT MERCER

- The Mocs dropped a 30-10 Southern Conference game at Mercer ... UTC falls to 1-6 overall and 1-3 in SoCon action. Mercer improved to 4-3 and 3-2 in league play.
- Mocs are 18-8-1 all-time against Mercer, but just 2-2 since the Bears joined the SoCon in 2014 ... UTC has lost both of its two games at Five Star Stadium.
- The Mocs had one turnover, an interception in the second half ... UTC is -10 in turnovers for the season ... -8 last three games ... third game in a row UTC has not forced a turnover.
- Defense allowed 82 yards rushing, 2.4 yards per carry. That performance came after a combined 512 yards (256 per game) over the last two.
- Defense matched its season-high with seven tackles for loss but with zero sacks. Also turned in seven against Western Carolina (4 sacks) and UT Martin (1).
- The running attack showed signs of life gaining 82 yards on 22 carries. Three sacks dropped the net to just 44. Third time this season the Mocs have posted less than 50 rushing yards.
- 11 penalties for 97 yards are both season-highs ... most penalty yards in a game since getting 100 against Liberty on Nov. 13, 2004.
- Mocs allowed 232 passing yards, tying for the most given up this season (LSU).
- The Mocs were without six potential starters for the game in QBs Alejandro Bennifield and Nick Tiano, RB Richardre Bagley, LBs Tae Davis and Tavon Lawson and DB Markell Boston. Each were out with different injuries.
- Darrell Bridges 58 yards on 19 carries and TD ... 19 carries are the most by a Moc this season ... more rushing yards today (58) than his previous four combined (43) ... five catches for 40 yards ... tied a career-high for receptions and set one for receiving yards.
- Cole Copeland 22-39 for 206 yards and one INT ... second career start for the true freshman.
- Khayyan Edwards Career-high six tackles.
- Bailey Lenoir Career-high and team-high six catches for 56 yards ... 21-yard catch in third quarter.
- Derek Mahaffey Career-high and game-high nine tackles ... included 2.0 TFLs and one hurry.
- Alex Trotter Career-long 12-yard run on his first carry of the game (3rd quarter) ... only carry of

the game.

- Victor Ulmo Career-long 44-yard FG in the second quarter ... previous best was from 31 ... 5-6 on the season.

SCOUTING THE CITADEL

- Head coach Brent Thompson is in his season season leading The Citadel program. He is 13-5 overall and won last year's meeting with the Mocs.
- Wofford's Andre Stoddard scored on a 3-yard run with 1:10 remaining to lift the No. 5 Terriers past No. 22 The Citadel, 20-16, last weekend at Johnson Hagood Stadium.
- The Citadel fell to 3-3 and 1-3 in conference play with that loss.
- The Citadel led 14-7 at the half, but a key turnover in the third quarter and only 67 yards of total offense in the second half kept the Bulldogs from handing Wofford its first loss of the season.
- The Bulldogs held Wofford to only 99 yards rushing on 41 carries, their fewest yards in a game since 2005.
- Citadel QB Jordan Black engineered an impressive drive as the Bulldogs took the lead and controlled the clock into the break. A 2-yard TD run capped a 16-play drive that took over eight minutes off the clock going into the locker room. Josh LeBlanc's 22-yard reception set up Johnson's short TD run.
- On the ensuing possession, Citadel quarterback Jordan Black broke loose on the option and was headed for the go-ahead score, but Wofford's Mason Alstat punched the ball loose just shy of the goal line and Datavious Wilson pounced on it as the Bulldogs came up empty inside the Wofford 5.
- The Bulldogs have allowed just 41 points in the second half this season.
- The Citadel was ranked for a school-record 26 consecutive weeks before losing to Wofford.
- 45.7% on third down ... No. 3 in the SoCon and No. 13 in the FCS.
- 4.5 penalities per game ... No. 4 in the SoCon and No. 12 in the FCS.
- 37.2 penalty yards per game ... No. 3 in the SoCon and No. 8 in the FCS.
- Defense leads the SoCon and is No. 7 in the FCS in first downs allowed (14.5).

- The Mocs have faced The Citadel more than any other opponent.
- UTC holds a 30-18-2 advantage in the rivalry that dates back to 1926.
- The Mocs have won six of eight in the series.
- UTC holds a slight 6-4 advantage in the last 10 meetings.
- Chattanooga is 18-6-1 at home, including 6-4 at Finley Stadium.

VS. THE TRIPLE-OPTION

UTC has an 11-10 record against triple-option teams since 2009. The Mocs are 6-2 against The Citadel, 4-4 against Wofford, 1-3 against Georgia Southern and 0-1 against Furman's new offense.s

CITADEL-UTC RIVALRY IS A HOT ONE

This is turning into one of the more heated rivalries in the league over the last few meetings. UTC has won six of eight since 2009, but five of the last six encounters have been battles.

Last year, the Mocs only gave up two touchdowns in a 22-14 loss to the eighth-ranked Bulldogs. The Mocs were held to just 295 yards of total offense (240 pass, 55 rush) on just 47 plays in that outing. UTC allowed a season-high 342 rushing yards to the triple-option Bulldogs.

In 2015, UTC ran out to a 21-0 halftime lead before a 31-23 victory gave the Mocs a share of the SoCon title. Chattanooga posted a fourth quarter comeback in the 2013 meeting, scoring with just over two minutes remaining for a 28-24 win on Oct. 26. The Mocs had to overcome a 17-7 halftime deficit in that victory.

In 2012, the Bulldogs were ranked No. 11 in the nation when they hosted the 1-3 Mocs. The Citadel had just posted wins over No. 3 Georgia Southern and No. 7 Appalachian State, before losing an

- Was Peyton Manning's backup with the Indianapolis Colts (2003-05).
- Future NFL Hall of Famer Terrell Owens played football, basketball and ran track at UTC from 1992-96.
- Actor Hugh Beaumont, famous for the role of Ward Cleaver on Leave it to Beaver, played freshman football at UC in 1927.

ATTENDANCE AT FINLEY STADIUM

Chattanooga had four crowds over 10,000 in one season for the first time in 2010. The second largest crowd for a Mocs game - 17,414 - attended Chattanooga's 35-27 win over No. 18 Georgia Southern on Oct. 9. UTC's record crowd is 22,642 set against Tennessee State in the first game at Finley Stadium on Oct. 18, 1997. Seven of the top 10 crowds in Finley Stadium history have been in the last nine seasons. UTC has reached the 10,000 mark 27 times at Finley Stadium and 22 of those crowds have also come in the last nine years.

FBS game at N.C. State. The Mocs went into Johnson Hagood Stadium and put on a dominating performance in a 28-10 victory for one of the biggest road wins in school history.

The 2011 game was the other side of the coin for UTC fans. The 15th-ranked Mocs took a 27-0 lead into halftime. The Citadel stormed back with 28 unanswered points in the second half to post a 28-27 win.

UTC captured a three-point squeaker (31-28) in 2009. The Citadel's Andre Roberts, currently with the Atlanta Falcons, scored on a rain-soaked 43-yard punt return with 1:46 left to play to give the Bulldogs a 24-21 win in 2008.

NOTES FROM LAST YEAR'S 22-14 LOSS AT THE CITADEL

- The No. 3 Chattanooga Mocs dropped a 22-14 game at No. 8 The Citadel. UTC fell to 6-1 overall and 4-1 in SoCon play. The Bulldogs took over first place in the SoCon at 4-0 and 6-0 overall.
- The Mocs were held to just 295 yards of total offense (240 pass, 55 rush) on just 47 plays. UTC allowed a season-high 342 rushing yards to the triple-option Bulldogs.

- Mocs had the ball for only 20:29 in the game.
- Alejandro Bennifield 17-28 for 240 yards and a TD ... 75-yard TD pass to C.J. Board in the first quarter tied a career-long.
- C.J. Board Six catches for a career-high 120 yards and a score ... career-long 75-yard TD catch in the first guarter.
- Derrick Craine Eight carries for 35 yards and a TD ... missed most of the second half with an injury.
- Keionta Davis Career-high 10 tackles.
- Justin King Career-high seven tackles.
- Nakevion Leslie Career-high and game-high 19 tackles ... most tackles in a game since Ryan Consiglio had 19 against Wofford on Nov. 19, 2011.

NOTES FROM THE CITADEL'S LAST VISIT TO FINLEY STADIUM ON NOV. 14, 2015

- The No. 8/9 Chattanooga Mocs posted a 31-23 win over No. 20/21 The Citadel at Finley Stadium on Nov. 4, 2015 ... the win gave UTC a share of its third straight Southern Conference title with a 6-1 mark in league play, 8-2 overall ... the Bulldogs drop to 6-1 in SoCon action and 7-3 on the year.
- UTC secured the SoCon's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs for the second year in a row and the third time in school history ... seventh SoCon title overall (1977t, 1978, 1979t, 1984, 2013t, 2014, 2015t).
- The Mocs held an opponent scoreless in the first half for the second time this season (Presbyterian).
- First play from scrimmage was a 75-yard TD pass from Alejandro Bennifield to Xavier Borishade for a score ... took 12 seconds ... quickest TD for the Mocs in Division I history ... longest pass play of the season ... fastest points for the Mocs since a safety on the first snap (14:53) at Arkansas on Oct. 6, 2007 ... UTC opened last year's game at The Citadel with a 66-yard pass completion from Jacob Huesman to C.J. Board for a touchdown on the first play from scrimmage.
- The Mocs had two 100-yard receivers C.J. Board (5-116) and Xavier Borishade (5-107) for the first time in a game since Clint Woods (175) and Blue Cooper (159) did it against Cumberland in 2008.

SEASON NO. 110

The Chattanooga Mocs are in their 110th season of college football in 2017. The University of Chattanooga was founded in 1886 and football began play in 1904. No teams were fielded in 1917 and 1918 due to World War I. There was also a two-year hiatus from football action during World War II in 1943 and 1944. The Mocs have an all-time record of 530-525-35 (.502) and have won 13 conference titles.

IT'S ALL IN THE NAME

On first reference, it is acceptable to refer to us as the "University of Tennessee at Chattanooga". After that, we prefer to be called "Chattanooga" or "UTC." Our nickname is "Mocs".

SCHOOL-RECORD EIGHT ON NFL ROSTERS

Prior to final cuts, the Mocs had a school-record eight former student-athletes on an NFL roster. Those included C.J. Board (Ravens), Keionta Davis (Patriots), Jacob Huesman (Giants), Corey Levin (Titans), Chris Lewis-Harris (Broncos), Derrick Lott (Lions), Buster Skrine (Jets) and Davis Tull (Rams). Levin and Skrine both made the 53-man rosters for their respective teams, while Lott is currently on the practice squad in Detroit and Davis is on the injured list in New England.

ARTH NAMED 23RD MOCS HEAD COACH

Tom Arth was named the 23rd head coach of Mocs football on Dec. 19, 2016. He was the 2016 NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year from John Carroll University in Cleveland, Ohio. A former NFL quarterback, Arth (35) owned a 40-8 overall record in four seasons at his alma mater. His building of the John Carroll program was highlighted by 2016 road victories over two No. 1-ranked opponents in Mount Union and Wisconsin-Whitewater. The 2016 Ohio Athletic Conference Coach of the Year guided the Blue Streaks to the NCAA Division III Playoffs for the third time in his four-year tenure. In the four seasons under Arth's leadership, John Carroll was among the nation's elite, finishing inside the Top 25 every season, including top 5 finishes in 2016 (No. 3) and 2014 (No. 5). John Carroll won the league's automatic bid for the first time in school history in 2016, breaking Mount Union's run of 24 consecutive OAC titles. The Blue Streaks finished the season ranked No. 3 in the nation, tying a school record with a 12-2 overall tally and a 9-0 mark in league action.


