CHATTANOOGA FAST BREAK NOTES

- Eboni Williams has led UTC in scoring three times this season and rebounding six times. She is second on the team in points and is the Mocs' top rebounder.
- Lakelyn Bouldin joined the 1,0000-point club and is ranked 20th all-time at UTC for scoring. She is in the Top 10 at UTC for 3-pointers made and free throw percentage.
- UTC has two ACC foes on the schedule and both are ranked in the AP Top 25. The Mocs fell 86-37 at #8 Louisville. UTC will travel to #14 NC State on Dec. 19.
- Three of the Mocs opponents are ranked in the College Insider Mid-Major Top 25 and two more are receiving votes.
- Abbey Cornelius was named the Player of the Week in the Southern Conference by College Sports Madness for the week ending 11/17.
- Four UTC players scored in double figures in the win at Liberty.
- Bouldin and Williams were named to the SoCon Preseason All-Conference Team.
- Transfers Kallie Searcy and Ruona Uwusiaba were cleared to play immediately.
- Chattanooga has two foreign student-athletes on the roster. Pare Pene, from New Zealand, is in her second year at UTC and the Mocs' added transfer Ruona Uwusiaba from Nigeria. She is a transfer from UCF and went to high school at Southwest DeKalb County in Georgia.

LAST TIME OUT: No. 8/9 LOUISVILLE ROLLS OVER MOCS THURSDAY NIGHT

The Chattanooga women's basketball team overcame a slow start at Eastern Kentucky Sunday afternoon, bouncing back to take the lead in the second half. However, it wouldn't be enough as the Colonels held on in the final minutes for a 71-65 win. "That's the most fire and grit I've seen from my team all season," Burrows said "They gave us everything they had tonight but came up short." Eboni Williams recorded her fifth double-double of her career with a season-best 23 points and 11 rebounds. Also in double digits for the Mocs was Lakelyn Bouldin with 12 and NaKeia Burks with 10. Chattanooga shot 60 percent in the second quarter and pulled to within two points to close out the half. UTC was down 30-23 with just over two minutes to play in the frame and outscored the Colonels 8-3 down the stretch to make it 33-31 at intermission. Bouldin scored seven points in the quarter including a four-point play that cut the Colonel lead to 26-21, the closest UTC had been since early in the first. Dena Jarrells scored all six of her points in the period and left the game early in the third after going down on a cut. Williams scored Chattanooga's final six points in the half on an old-fashioned 3-point play and then draining a 3-point shot in the final minute. Chattanooga continued its momentum into the third quarter and fired off four points to take its first lead of the game, 35-33 on a put back by Bouldin. The lead changed three more times with four ties and UTC held on to lead 45-44 at the end of the third. Burks drained back-to-back 3-pointers to start the third, giving UTC it's largest lead of the game, 51-44 less than two minutes into the final frame. ECU's Davis drained a 3-pointer, but the Mocs' Bria Dial answered with one more for UTC to make it 54-47. The Colonels went on an 8-0 run over the next 2:10 to briefly retake the lead. The lead bounced back-and-forth four times over the next 3:24 before ECU got back out front and held on. The Mocs didn't make it easy, however. Eastern Kentucky led 65-59 with 52 seconds to play. Burks drew the foul and connected on both free throws to cut the lead to 65-61 with 46 seconds on the clock. Burks and Bouldin then pressed the inbounds play, forcing a turnover. Burks picked up the ball and fed it to Williams for a fast break layup, making it 65-63 with 39 seconds to play. ECU scored the next six points and Williams added a layup in the final seconds to close the game. Chattanooga was 24-of-63 from the field and made seven from the 3-point line. From the free throw line, UTC was 10-of-16 and out rebounded 46-34. In the paint, the Mocs edged the Colonels 32-28. UTC scored 17 points off 15 Eastern Kentucky turnovers and had a season-low 10 miscues resulting in nine points for ECU. "This was a much brighter light for me," Burrows said. "I hate losing and I'm not going to go in there with a smile on my face. They battled their hearts out tonight and still came up short. We're going to figure out how to not come up short in the next one."

CHATTANOOGA NEWS AND NOTES

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

BOULDIN HITTING MILESTONES

Lakelyn Bouldin became the 29th member of the Chattanooga 1,000-Point Club at Wofford on February 16, 2019 with 21 points. She has 1,206 career points, passed Brooke Hand (2004-08) for 20th all-time at Chattanooga.

WILLIAMS RECORDS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Sophomore Eboni Williams had a game- and season-high 23 points and 11 rebounds at Eastern Kentucky. She was 9-of-20 from the field and had two 3-pointers.

WILLIAMS LEADS MOCS VS. CARDS

Sophomore Eboni Williams had a game-high 18 points in the Mocs game at #8/9 Louisville. She was 7-of-14 and had a season-high three 3-pointers.

CORNELIUS NAMED CSM PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Abbey Cornelius was named the College Sports Madness Player of the Week for the Southern Conference. She was 8-of-11 against Liberty with 21 points and seven rebounds.

CORNELIUS BACK-TO-BACK BIG GAMES

Sophomore Abbey Cornelius recorded her second straight 20-point game with 21 in the Mocs' win at Belmont. She made her first eight attempts and drained two from the 3-point line while going 3-of-4 from the charity stripe. She grabbed a game-high seven rebounds.

CORNELIUS SCORES CAREER-HIGH

Sophomore Abbey Cornelius was 10-for-14 from the field with a pair of 3-pointers for a career-high 22 points against Hampton this season. Her previous career-best was 14 against Samford last season when she made 7-of-7.

BOULDIN'S FREE THROWS ON POINT

Lakelyn Bouldin is the Mocs' all-time best free throw shooter by percentage. She has made 214-of-253 and is shooting 84.6 percent over her career. She is 68th in the NCAA for free throws made and 122nd for percentage.

3-POINT SHOOTING BOULDIN IN THE BOOKS

In three seasons, Lakelyn Bouldin has placed herself firmly in the Mocs' record books. She ranks fifth at UTC all-time with 195 from long range. She needs 19 to reach Jenaya Wade-Fray (2007-10) 21 for third, Katasha Brown (2002-06) and 44 to match Kayla Christohper (2009-13). Brooke Hand (2004-08) is the Mocs' all-time leading 3-point shooter with 315.

BURKS SHOWING WITH TIME ON FLOOR

Redshirt senior NaKeia Burks made her way back to Chattanooga after graduation to play

her final season. After years of injuries sidelined her throughout her career, she has now started every game for UTC and has recorded career-highs in scoring, rebounding, assists and multiple other categories.

PENE FINDING HER WAY

Pare Pene has played in every game for the Mocs this season and has more than doubled her scoring output from last year. She has posted double-digit minutes on the floor and recorded career-highs for scoring, rebounds and assists.

AN ABUNDANCE OF SOPHOMORES

The Mocs have seven sophomores on the roster for this season. SoCon Freshman of the Year Eboni Williams highlights the group. Abbey Cornelius and Morgan Williams saw significant minutes as freshmen and Pare Pene had a good showing in the exhibition match with eight points. Joining the crew are transfers Kallie Searcy and Ruona Uusiaba who cleared waivers, and Brooke Hampel who will redshirt.

TEAM NOTES

MOCS AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

The Mocs are shooting 70.7 percent from the free throw line. UTC has shot better than 70 percent four times and is 77-of-123 for the year. Against Austin Peay, the Mocs were 14-of-15 and have made double-digit free throws even times in nine games.

HOME COURT FOR THE WIN

With an 8-6 record at the McKenzie Arena last season, UTC has posted a winning record at home for the 20th consecutive year and 39th out of 45 seasons.

LONG-RANGE BOMBERS

The Mocs have made at least one 3-pointer in 632 consecutive games dating back to December 1999. Chattanooga reached the 600-consecutive game mark against UT Martin on November 28, 2018 at the Roundhouse.

OPENING THE BOOK ON SEASON 46

UTC begins its 46th season of play as a Division I team and has had just six coaches in its history. The Mocs are 870-470 (.649) over the first 45 years, averaging just under 20 wins per season.

SCHEDULE NOTES

SEASON OPENING RECORDS

The Mocs opened the season away from McKenzie Arena for the 27th time and 19th on an opponents home court. UTC is 15-4 when opening the season at home, 7-12 on an opponent's home court and 2-6 in neutral venues. UTC has opened the season three times at Belmont and have fallen in each contest.

CHATTANOOGA NEWS AND NOTES

MID-MAJOR TOP 25 FOES

Two Chattanooga foes are ranked in the Top 25 of the College Insider Mid-Major Poll. South Dakota State is 12th in the rankings followed by Ohio at 13th. Belmont received 31 points and is three spots out of the Top 25 while Eastern Kentucky received two points.

MOCS FACE PAIR OF TOP 25 TEAMS

The Mocs hit the road to take on Louisville and NC State. Both ACC teams are ranked in the AP Top 25 and the USA Today Coaches Top 25 Poll. Louisville was ranked eighth by the AP and ninth in the Coaches poll when UTC faced the Cards.

SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NOTES

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Lakelyn Bouldin and Eboni Williams were selected to the SoCon Coaches' Preseason Poll. Bouldin was an all-conference performer last season and Williams was the SoCon Freshman of the Year. They were the Mocs' top two scorers and Williams was second on the team in rebounding. Bouldin led UTC from the 3-point and free throw lines and became the 29th member of the Mocs' 1,000-Point Club.

MOCS PICKED SIXTH IN PRESEASON POLL

The Southern Conference coaches picked the Mocs to finish sixth in the preseason poll. The Mocs have been the No. 1 pick 14 times since 2000-01, Wes Moore's third season. UTC has twice been picked second and twice third in that time. UTC was fourth in Moore's second season and fifth last year.

SOCON MEDIA PICKS MOCS THIRD

For the third time on record with the SoCon, the conference media selected Chattanooga to finish third in the preseason poll.

REGULAR SEASON TITLES

The Mocs have won 21 regular season SoCon titles including the last five. Sharon Fanning won the first three beginning in 1984. Craig Parrott won two in his tenure. Wes Moore, the winningest women's basketball coach in SoCon history, led the Mocs to 12 in 15 years. Jim Foster won the regular season in four of his five seasons at Chattanooga.

SOCON TOURNAMENT CROWNS

The Mocs are winners of 18 SoCon Tournament crowns. Fanning won the first three. Craig Parrot won two and led UTC to the first NCAA Tournament appearance by a SoCon women's team. Wes Moore claimed nine of UTC's 18 and Jim Foster led the Mocs to four in his five seasons.

ROSTER NOTES

MOCS RETURN EIGHT LETTERWINNERS

Chattanooga returns eight letterwinners to its lineup this season including starters Lakelyn Bouldin, Bria Dial and Morgan Hill. SoCon Freshman of the Year Eboni Williams will see her role increase this season as will sophomore center Abbey Cornelius. Returning for a fifth season is senior NaKeia Burks along with junior Liz Wood and sophomore Pare Pene.

UTC ADDS FIVE NEWCOMERS

Chattanooga signed freshman Dena Jarrells in the early period last fall and added walk-on Audrey Canter from Chattanooga. Three transfers have joined the bench. They are sophomores Kallie Searcy, Ruona Uwusiaba and Brooke Hampel.

UWUSIABA CLEARS NCAA WAIVERS

Sophomore transfer Ruona Uwusiaba cleared NCAA waivers and is eligible to play immediately. She came to UTC after one season at UCF.

SEARCY CLEARS NCAA WAIVERS

Sophomore transfer Kallie Searcy cleared NCAA waivers and is eligible to play immediately. Searcy came to UTC after one season at Western Kentucky.

INTERNATIONAL PLAYERS ON THE ROSTER

Pare Pene came the farthest to join the Mocs. She traveled from Rotorua, New Zealand and was the second international player to join UTC's roster. Jenaya Wade-Fray was from Bermuda and represented Great Britain in the Olympics. The third Chattanooga player to come from another land is Ruona Uwusiaba from Delta State, Nigeria. She spent three years at Southwest Dekalb Co. High School in Georgia. She played one season at UCF and transferred over the summer to play for the Mocs.

COACHING NOTES

BURROWS RETURNS FOR SECOND SEASON

Katie Burrows begins her second campaign on the bench leading the Mocs. She was an outstanding player for the Mocs from 2000-04 and helped UTC to four straight SoCon regular season and tournament titles and four NCAA Tournament appearances that included an NCAA win over Rutgers in her senior season. She spent three seasons on the bench beside her mentor Wes Moore and all five years as an assistant to Hall of Fame coach Jim Foster. Burrows became the sixth head coach in Chattanooga women's basketball history in May of 2018.

COACHING STAFF REMAINS IN TACT

Chattanooga's assistant coaches remain the same for a second season. Brittany Johnson begins her eighth season with UTC. She played for Jim Foster at Ohio State and he brought her on board when he arrived at UTC in 2013 and she remained with the coaching change. Jon Goldberg starts his fourth season as an assistant after serving as a graduate assistant for two seasons and then the Director of Student-Athlete Development. Debbie Black is in her second year as an assistant for the Mocs and her third overall. She has made every stop with Jim Foster beginning as a student-athlete at St. Joe's in the 1980s. She played professionally after college for various leagues around the world and the WNBA where she was the Defensive Player of the Year in 2003. She began her time at Chattanooga as the Director of Operations but moved to assistant when Burrows was promoted to head coach. Former Moc Ka'Vonne Towns begins her second season as UTC's Director of Operations and was the Director of Student-Athlete Development in Foster's last season.

MOLLY MELTON CLOUNCH JOINS THE TEAM

Following her graduation from UTC last spring, Molly Melton married Chase Clouch, former basketball manager and nephew of head coach Katie Burrows. She returns to Chattanooga to serve as a student assistant coach while attending graduate school. Molly was the Mocs' starting point guard for nearly two seasons and led Chattanooga in steals.

Katie Burrows became the sixth head coach in the history of Mocs women's basketball on May 25, 2018. She spent the previous eight seasons as an assistant at UTC.

In her first season at the helm, the Mocs finished third in the Southern Conference, a repeat from the previous season, and advanced to the semifinal of the SoCon Tournament. The Mocs posted an overall record of 14-17 and went 8-6 in league play. Chattanooga's non-conference schedule was one of the most grueling in the nation with a non-conference strength of schedule rating of five. UTC hosted Louisville, a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament and N.C. State, led by former Mocs' head coach Wes Moore who guided his team to 21 consecutive wins to start the season. The Wolfpack reached a ranking as high as seven in the AP Top 25 Poll and earned a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Ten of Chattanooga's 15 non-conference foes earned postseason berths and two from the SoCon received bids. Eight of UTC opponents, including Mercer, advanced to the NCAA Tournament while Furman highlighted four foes in the Women's NIT.

Lakelyn Bouldin was named to the All-Conference Team for a second year and earned her second postseason recognition. She was selected to the SoCon All-Tournament Team for

her performance in the Mocs' two games. Eboni Williams was named the Southern Conference Freshman of the Year, UTC's fourth all-time and first since Heather Dykes in the 1998-99 season.

In her time as an assistant coach at Chattanooga, Burrows served on staffs for both Wes Moore and Jim Foster. During that span, UTC advanced to the postseason seven times, with five trips to the NCAA Tournament following five Southern Conference titles.

The Mocs posted an impressive overall record of 189-68 (.735) and a 112-22 (.836) mark in league play during her time as an assistant.

During Burrows' tenure, the Mocs have had one SoCon Athlete of the Year, one SoCon Player of the Year, four Defensive Players of the Year, 20 all-conference picks and five SoCon Tournament MVPs.

The Mocs earned a top-25 ranking in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls in the 2014-15 season, following wins over No. 4 Tennessee and No. 7 Stanford. UTC climbed as high as 17 in the AP Top 25 and 18 in the Coaches Poll.

Over the last eight years, the Mocs have defeated Tennessee, Alabama and Auburn twice each, Stanford, Villanova, Rutgers, Indiana, Northwestern, Georgetown and Florida.

Taylor Hall (2010-14) became the first player in SoCon history to earn league Player of the Year, Female Athlete of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Tournament Most Outstanding Player in the same season.

Jasmine Joyner (2013-17) earned back-to-back SoCon Defensive Player of the Year honors and was named the SoCon Tournament MVP in 2015 and 2017. She finished her career at Chattanooga as the second player to top 1,000 points and 900 rebounds, and is eighth all-time in the NCAA with 436 career blocks.

Alicia "Red" Payne became the first Chattanooga player to earn back-to-back SoCon Defensive Player of the Year honors (2015, 2016) and was named the SoCon Tournament Most Outstanding Player in 2016.

"Based on our long history of success in women's basketball, I felt it was necessary to conduct a national search," added Wharton. "I was pleased with the quality of individuals who were interested in our program and Katie was a strong candidate from the beginning.

"That being said, she clearly distanced herself from an extremely talented pool of coaches. She earned the chance to lead our women's basketball program by clearly being the person for the job."

A native of Lookout Valley, Katie came to Chattanooga in 2000 and was an integral

member of four straight SoCon titles. In her time as a student-athlete at UTC, the Mocs posted an overall record of 102-23 with wins over such teams as Florida State, Alabama and Louisville. UTC advanced to the NCAA championships all four seasons.

In her senior year, the Mocs posted the nation's longest active winning streak at 27 games that culminated with a first-round win over Rutgers in the NCAA Tournament. In that game, Burrows sank the most memorable shot in Chattanooga history, nailing a 30-foot bank shot from the right side to spark a comeback win over the Scarlet Knights.

Katie earned a spot as among former head coach Wes Moore's Top 10 players in the celebration of "Moore in McKenzie, a Decade of Dominance". She ranks in the top 10 in UTC history in 3-pointers made (107) and attempted (315).

Prior to her return to UTC, Burrows was a coach and teacher at Ringgold High School for three years. She took over a program that had just three wins in the season prior to her arrival. The Lady Tigers steadily increased their win total in each of her three seasons, culminating in Ringgold's first state playoff appearance since 1986 when the team lost to Rossville in the Class AAA finals.


Prior to that she was the head coach of the girl's basketball team at Tullahoma High School in Tullahoma, Tenn., from 2005-07 and taught health and physical education. Immediately following her graduation from UTC she was the assistant girls basketball coach at GPS from 2004-05 under former UTC player Susan Lance Crowmover.

Katie attended Lookout Valley High School where she was named the Chattanooga Times Free Press Best of Preps Female Athlete of the Year. She was a four-time first team Chattanooga Times Free Press All-City, three-time Region Player of the Year and first team all-state. She was named a Tennessee Class A Miss Basketball finalist in back-to-back seasons.

Katie learned her trade at an early age from her father Joe Galloway who was her high school coach. Joe serves on the Hamilton County School Board and, along with his daughter Kristen Clouch, is still coaching at Lookout Valley. Her brother Keith Galloway is married to former UTC standout Jennifer Wilson and the pair coach the boy's and girl's basketball teams at Hardin Valley Academy in Knoxville.

A 2004 graduate of Chattanooga, Katie earned a B.S. in Exercise Science and Health K-12. She is married to Nick Burrows. They are the parents of daughters, Jordan and Grace.


