The Mocs are posting impressive offensive numbers while supplementing with a still dangerous defense. The Keydets are a disciplined, dangerous foe. It has all the makings of an interesting SoCon matchup in the final road test Chattanooga faces in the league.

VS. VMI

- 29 meetings overall are the fewest against current SoCon members. One behind Wofford's 30. 27th SoCon matchups is tied for 5th-most (Wofford).

- First meeting was a 31-8 win in Lexington on Nov. 20, 1971. All but the first two matchups have come in SoCon play.

- Won last year's meeting 41-13 after dropping two in a row in the series - 2019 (24-31) & 2021 (34-37 OT) in Lexington. There hasn't been a single-game series streak since the Mocs 1994 triumph at home (49-14).

- Held the Keydets to -2 yards rushing on 27 carries last year. Gained 52 yards but lost 54 on the Mocs 12 tackles for loss including sacks. Tied for 6th-fewest rushing yards allowed (ETSU on Oct. 1, 1988) & fewest allowed since -16 at VMI on Oct. 27, 2018.

OPENERS

- Chattanooga is No. 15 in the AFCA Coaches Top 25 & 17th per Stats Perform.

- FIRST in the NATION in first downs gained (195/24.38). Record is 266 (24.2) in 2000.

- A win provides 26th season with seven or more triumphs. Last? 2022. There are five since 1997 with the other four coming 2013-16. Rusty Wright was an assistant coach for all four.

- A win provides first 6-win conference season since 2016 & the fifth in 47 years in the league. Prior four? 2013-16.

- Just a single game separates 1-3 in the SoCon standings: Furman (4-0), UTC (5-1) & Western Carolina (3-1). Mercer (3-2) & VMI (2-2) are lurking with the Keydets facing all three leaders.

The Bears are at the Catamounts this weekend.

- 164th ranked week (83-79-1), 26th under Wright (15-10).

- Best Red Zone team in FCS. The Mocs are 4th in defense (66.7%) and 12th on offense (92.1%). ONLY team ranked in top 13 in both categories.

QUICK STRIKES

- Sixth win clinched winning season. 59th in school history and fourth under **Coach Rusty Wright**. **Wright** is .500 or better in each of his five seasons, only Mocs head coach to start career .500 or better for five campaigns.
- **Wright's** 28 wins to date are tied for 3rd most in school history in first five years as head coach: *Russ Huesman* (31), *Bill Oliver* (29) & *Joe Morrison* (28).
- 2nd fastest to 28 wins by games: *Oliver* (42), **Wright** (47), *Huesman* (51), *Scrappy Moore* (53) & *Morrison* (55).
- *Huesman* has the most ranked weeks (52) as a head coach ahead of *Moore* (44). Neither came close to **Wright's** 26 in first five seasons. Other coaches: *Buddy Nix* (19), *Harold Wilkes* (9), *Oliver* (8), *Tom Arth* (4) & *Buddy Green* (2).
- Most points in a season & per game? 486 in 2014 (34.7 ppg). On pace currently for 382 over 11 games (34.7).
- Offense is averaging a robust 6.10 yards per play. Record is 6.22 in 2000.
- The wide receiver trio of **Sam Phillips** (46-476), **Jamoi Mayes** (45-737) & **Javin Whatley** (35-639) exceeded their season total from 2022 with the fourth catch of the 1st quarter in Week 8. Last year: 115-1682 (9TD). This season: 126-1852 (13TD).
- Defense limited ETSU to 120 yards total offense, fewest since 90 at North Alabama on Sept. 2, 2021. 9th time with 200 or fewer allowed in the **Rusty Wright/Lorenzo Ward** Era (2nd in 2023).
- Bucs threw for just 46 yards, lowest total since 9 at Wofford on Nov. 6, 2021. 7th time under **Wright/Ward** with less than 100 pass yards (2 in 2023)...27th with less than 200 (4 in 2023).
- Defense corralled the ETSU rushing attack with just 74 yards (2.5/carry). 74 given up the last two games combined. 17th time with less than 100 yards on the ground under **Wright/Ward** (3 in 2023).
- SoCon leading offense: First Downs (195), Time of Possession (34:04), Yds/Comp (14.07), Red Zone Offense (92.1).
- SoCon leading defense: Scoring Defense (20.8), Sacks (3.00), Turnovers Gained (15), Red Zone Defense (66.7), Fewest First Downs (123), Defensive TDs (2), 3rd down Conv (32.4%).
- SoCon leaders in penalties per game (4.25) & yards per game (36.62). 2nd to VMI in fewest total (34/30) and yards (293/289) in one more game played.

QUARTERBACKS

- All new room performing at peak efficiency. Lone returning member is redshirt freshman **Luke Schomburg**.
- **Chase Artopoulos** has three 300-yard efforts thus far matching *Preston Hutchinson's* total from 2022. The season record of six was set by *Chris Sanders* in 1999 and done again in 2000. Three is tied for third on the career list.

- **Artopoeus** is tied for 10th in season TD passes (17) at UTC. One behind 8th-place duo of *Kenyon Earl* (1994) and *Ryan McCall* (2002) and three from becoming 7th Mocs QB with 20+.
- **Artopoeus** has five multi-TD games.
- **Artopoeus** is top 20 in the FCS: 3rd, Pass TDs (17); 4th, Pass Yds (2199); 6th, Yds/Att (9.05); 9th, Total Offense (291.5); 9th, Pass Eff. (158.4); 9th, Pass Yds/Gm (274.9) & 14th, Yds/Comp (13.92).
- **Schomburg** saw his first career action going 1-1 with a 57-yard TD strike against The Citadel. . . that score was the first career reception for true freshman wideout **A.J. Little**.

RUNNING BACKS

- **Ailym Ford** is out for the season with a lower body injury. Ford is the school record holder with 19 100-yard games and is the only Mocs rusher with three 1,000-yard seasons. He has 785 career carries for 3,928 yards and 36 rushing TDs (38 total). He finishes three carries, 123 yards and seven rush TDs shy of *Jacob Huesman's* '15 program records.
- **Gino Appleberry** tied his career high with two rushing TDs. . . ran 20 times for 71 yards.
- **Appleberry** combined with **Reggie Davis** (15-68) for 35 rushes and 139 yards.
- **Davis'** numbers are also career highs in his third appearance.
- **Appleberry** is 10th in the SoCon in rushing (52.3 ypg).
- Along with **Ford's** 19, **Appleberry** (2022: 109 vs VMI) and **Lance Jackson** (2020-21: 135 vs Mercer) also have 100-yard games in their career.
- **Chris Houston** got a score on his first touch of the season at UNA, a 36-yard catch from **Artopoeus**.

OFFENSIVE LINE

- Four new starters but picked up where the last units left off ranking among the nation's best: 26th nationally in sacks allowed (11) and 29th in TFLs allowed (37).
- PFF Colleges rates the pass blocking at 87.9. That's 3rd in DI (FBS/FCS) behind Oregon (91.8) & Arizona (90.2) and just ahead of Georgia (87.0) & Illinois State (86.8).
- Big reason the offense leads the NATION in first downs (195).
- Big reason for the team ranking 15th nationally and first in the league in time of possession (34:04).
- Chasing Time of Possession school record. Currently 34:04. Record is 34:50 in 1987.
- G/C **Reid Williams** (Jr.) was a second All-SoCon pick in 2022. He was also a Sophomore All-America.
- A Mocs offensive lineman has won the last three Jacobs Blocking Trophies: 2020-21: *Cole Strange*; 2021: *Cole Strange*; 2022: *McClendon Curtis*.
- Three of Chattanooga's five alums currently on NFL rosters play on the offensive line: *Corey Levin* (Tennessee), *Strange* (New England) & *Curtis* (Seattle).

TIGHT ENDS

- **Camden Overton** had a career-high four catches against Western Carolina.
- **Evan Brown** had his first TD reception in the matchup with Western Carolina.
- **Overton's** 11 catches so far exceeds his season total from 2022 (6).
- **Overton** has four TDs and is one of eight Mocs with TD receptions in 2023.
- Former All-America tight end *Faysal Shafaat* has transitioned from the gridiron to the limelight. "Fessy" has been a contestant on Big Brother, American Ninja Warrior and the Challenge. He also competes as a stopper for Lava in Slam Ball ranking third in the league in, wait for it, stops.

WIDE RECEIVERS

- **Javin Whatley** (83.2) and **Jamoi Mayes** (79.7) are the 18th & 39th-ranked WR in DI (FBS/FCS) on PFF Colleges.
- **Whatley's** six TDs are the most since TE *Chris James* snagged seven in 2019 (12G).
- **Sam Phillips** (476) needs 24 yards for 500. If he reaches it, he'll join **Mayes** (737) and **Whatley** (639) as the first trio with 500 yards each since 2004: *Alonzo Nix* (819), assistant coach **Tyrus Ward** (660) & *Emanuel Hassell* (647).
- **Mayes & Whatley** are chasing just the 5th Mocs season with 1,000 yards: *Joel Bradford* 1,284 (2010), *Bryce Nunnally* 1,237 (2018), *Alonzo Nix* 1,060 (2003) & *Richmond Flowers* 1,035 (2000).
- **Mayes** (1,722) is 99 yards shy of the top 10 for career receiving yards at Chattanooga. *Larry Stokes* is No. 10 (1,821). **Mayes** is 278 yards short of becoming the 7th Moc with 2,000+.
- **Mayes** (737) is also 99 yards from the top 10 in season yards. 10th? *Terrell Owens* with 836 in 1994.
- **Whatley** (6) is two TD catches from the top 10 in the season category with five tied for 6th at eight. Most recent? *Xavier Borishade* (2016). **Whatley** is four TDs from becoming the 6th Moc with double-digit receiving scores.
- **Phillips** is 10 receptions from 100 with 46 in 2023. Already eclipsed freshman-record total (44) from a year ago.
- Five different WR have TDs - **Whatley** (6), **Phillips** (4), **Mayes** (1) **Tyler Smith** (1) & **A.J. Little** (1).

DEFENSIVE LINE

- Defense leads the SoCon in sacks. D-line combines for 19.
- DE **Ben Brewton** (6.0) is the SoCon leader in sacks. Edge **Jay Person** (T2nd, 4.5) & DT **Quay Wiggles** (T9th, 3.0) & are also top 10.
- **Person** leads league with 11.5 TFLs. **Brewton** (7th, 7.0) & NT **Marlon Taylor** (T10th, 5.5) are top 10.
- **Person** (22.0) is 2.0 sacks from passing *Josh Williams*'12 (23.5) into 4th on the all-time list.
- **Person** (50.5) is 9.5 off *Davis Tull*'s '14 school-record 60 TFLs & 5.0 behind 2nd-place *Devonnsha Maxwell*.
- Since 2009, eight Mocs won the league's DPOTY Award: 2009: *Josh Beard*; 2012: *Davis Tull*; 2013: *Davis Tull*; 2014: *Davis Tull*; 2016: *Keionta Davis*; 2018: *Isaiah Mack*; 2021: *Devonnsha Maxwell* & 2022: *Jay Person*.

LINEBACKERS

- Longtime starters **Ty Boeck** & **Kam Jones** depart. Despite their presence, **Alex Mitchell** and **Bo Spearman** saw a lot of snaps on a rotational basis with the pair. Good depth with 4-year transfers **Kameron Brown** (Auburn) and **Kobe Joseph** (Harvard) already making impacts.
- **Mitchell** is tied for team lead in tackles (44) despite missing last two games. He had his first career touchdown with a 38-yard pick 6 on Samford's first play in the 47-24 win in Birmingham on Sept. 23.
- **Spearman** (2 in 2023) has three career fumble recoveries. He's third in stops (42).
- **Kobe Joseph** tied for team lead with eight tackles at Mercer adding a 4th quarter interception. The defense has allowed just 74 rushing yards in his two starts.

SECONDARY

- A year ago, just one starter returned. This year it's four led by All-America corner **Kam Brown**. He tied for second in the nation last year with six interceptions.
- **Brown** collected his 10th career pick Saturday and is one of 14 Mocs with double digits.
- **Brown** got his 2nd career pick 6 in the win at Samford (78 yards). First was vs. Mercer (53) last season.
- **Reuben Lowery III** has started at slot safety and at corner this season & saw action at deep safety.
- Safeties **Josh Battle** (44) & **Jordan Walker** (40) are T1st and T4th in tackles, respectively.
- **Walker** & **Brown** lead the team in picks (2).
- Safety **Clay Fields III** tied the program record with four pass breakups including three straight plays in the second quarter. Most since LB Doug Faatiliga (2009 vs. The Citadel).
- Eight different student-athletes have career starts in the UTC secondary: **Brown** (22), **Battle** (17), **Walker** (16), **Lowery** (16), **Wykle** (9), **Telly Plummer** (4), **Demetrius Coleman** (3) & **Fields** (2).

SPECIALISTS

- **Clayton Crile** handled all the kicking duties the last four weeks with 12-14 on FGs scoring 47 points and averaging 44.5 yards per punt on 15 attempts with seven downed inside the 20.
- Kickers combined for 88 points - **Clayton Crile** (47) & **Jude Kelley** (41). That's 11.0 per game.
- **Crile** is one of two punters in the SoCon (*James Platte*, Citadel) without a touchback.
- **Crile** leads the SoCon in FG Made (12) in just four games as PK.
- **Kelley** (4G) averages 2.0 FG/game and 10.3 ppg. He's 8-10 on FG - 7-7 inside 45 yards, 1-3 outside it.
- Mocs are 20-25 (.800) on FG, 18-19 inside 45 yards, 2-6 outside it.
- LS **Cody Olszewski** has played every game of the **Wright** era. That's 47 to date, seven short of the school record of 52 set by former All-Americans *Nakevion Leslie*'16 and *Corey Levin*'16 from 2013-16 each.
- **Crile** has a league-high 27 touchbacks in 56 kickoffs with nearly all flying through the end zone.
- **Crile** was a 2-time All-South Atlantic Conference punter & 1-time All-SAC placekicker at Catawba. He hit a school record 53-yard field goal in 2022 and led NCAA DII in punting in 2021 with a 47.6-yard average.
- LS **Jake Hall** gets a trip home in the regular season finale at Alabama. He transferred from the Crimson Tide prior to the 2022 season.

SEASON NOTES

- 11th winning season since 2009...59th in 116 years of football.
- 311 passing yards at North Alabama are the most in an opener since 318 in the Aug. 30, 2018 win over Tennessee Tech. Most opening total yards (488) since 492 on Sept. 4, 2010 in the 42-41 loss to App State.

SIAA Champions scored 100 in a 21-14 win over Centenary (Oct. 27) followed by 79-0 over Rhodes (Nov. 3).

- 0:11 between the first two TDs at Samford for the Mocs is the shortest span between scores on record.

- **Javin Whatley** had a school-record 353 all-purpose yards (231 rec./114 KR/6 rush) against Western Carolina. Broke the mark of 328 by *Charles McNeill* vs. Kentucky State on Nov. 24, 2001. It's the 1st time a Moc had 300+ in a SoCon game.

- **Whatley** recorded career highs in receptions (11), yards (231) & TDs (4) against Western. 3rd Moc with four or more receiving TDs in a game - 6 by *Cos DeMatteo* vs Mississippi Valley State (Sept. 16, 2000) & 4 by NFL Hall of Famer *Terrell Owens* at Marshall (Oct. 1, 1994). 231 receiving yards is 8th 200-yard game in school history ranking 5th.

- **Artopoulos'** 399 passing yards against Western Carolina was the 10th time a Mocs QB had 399 or more... most since 432 by *B.J. Coleman* in the comeback win at Furman on Oct. 23, 2010. His five TDs that game was the 7th time a Mocs QB threw for five or more scores & tied for fourth on the all-time list. Most since five by *Coleman* against Elon on Oct. 30, 2010, a week after this 432-yard effort at Furman.

- **Clayton Crile** was the FedEx Ground National Special Teams Player of the Week after program records of five field goals & 16 points in the 22-10 win at Mercer. **Crile's** performance was even more impressive with a strong crosswind during the game. He handled all kicking duties and was credited with throttling the Bears explosive kick and punt return game.

- **Jay Person** got his 20th career sack (5th Mocs) in the win at Mercer & 50th TFL (3rd) in victory over ETSU.

- **Ben Brewton** became 6th with 20 sacks in win over ETSU.
