



## Eligibility for Competition– Transfer

For a transfer student-athlete to be eligible for competition, they must meet the below credit-hour requirements based on attendance at their previous college(s) for the specified time and may use any hours of academic credit earned at any collegiate institution:

- Equivalent of one semester/one quarter: six semester or six-quarter hours of academic credit
- Equivalent of one academic year (e.g., two semesters/three quarters): 24-semester or 36 quarter hours of academic credit
- Equivalent of three semesters/four quarters: 30-semester or 42-quarter hours of academic credit; or
- Equivalent of four semesters/six quarters and thereafter: six-semester or six-quarter hours of academic credit during the previous term of full-time enrollment

## Four Year Transfer

A transfer student from a four-year college shall not be eligible for intercollegiate competition until the student has fulfilled a residence requirement of one full academic year (two full semesters).

## One-Time Exception

A student who transfers to UTEP from another four-year college will not have to fulfill the residence requirement if they meet the following conditions:

- The student did not participate in baseball, basketball or FBS football at their previous college
- The student has not previously transferred from a four-year college
- At the time of the transfer, the student would have been academically eligible to compete at their previous four-year college
- The student's previous college will certify in writing that it does not object to the student being granted a one-time transfer exception

\*There are other exceptions to the residency requirement. Please contact the compliance office with any questions.

## Agents Reminder

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletics competition.

**Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1**

Coaches, please be advised that awards given by the institution to student-athletes have limitations on maximum value. For participation awards, the limitations are listed below, including the number of times an award may be received by the student-athlete. There are additional opportunities for Championship Awards through the Conference or NCAA administered championships. The compliance office will be distributing a form to all the coaches that will help track the awards given to the student-athletes.

Type of Award	Max Value of Award	Number of Times Award May be Received
Annual Participation– Underclassmen	\$225	Once per Year per Sport
Annual Participation– Senior	\$425	Once per Year per Sport
<b>Special Event Participation</b>		
Postseason Conference Championship Contest or Tournament	\$375	Once per Event
Postseason NCAA Championship Contest or Tournament	Institution- \$375 NCAA– No Limit	Once per Event
All-Star Game or Postseason Bowl	Institution- \$400 Management of Event- \$550	Once per Event
Established Meets, Tournaments and Featured Individual Competition	\$400	Once per Event
