



# Official Visit Planning

As each sport prepares for official visits this Fall, please remember the following points...

- The first opportunity for a PSA to take an official visit is on or after the first day of classes for their senior year in high school.
- Official Visits may not occur during a Dead Period.
- Official Visits may not exceed 48 hours.
- Official Visit plans should not be finalized prior to the submission of the Official Visit Approval Form.

In order for the visit to be approved for a high school PSA the following must occur:

- The PSA must be registered with the NCAA Eligibility Center.
- The PSA must be added to our IRL.
- Test scores and transcripts must be submitted to Jeff Amey.

In order for the visit to be approved for a transfer PSA, the following must occur:

- Submission of current college transcripts.

## Recruiting Materials

Recruiting materials may be sent out to recruits on September 1st at the beginning of his or her Junior year (June 15th at end of Sophomore year in MBB). NCAA Bylaw 13.4 regulates these items. The legislation was changed with an effective date of August 1, 2010. Prior to sending stationary and general correspondence mail outs please refer to this new legislation and contact the Compliance Office with any questions.

## Written Offers

With the adoption of NCAA Proposal 2009-47-B, coaches are prohibited from issuing written offers of athletics financial aid or a written promise thereof until August 1st of the prospect's senior year. This includes all written correspondence (email, letter, etc.) to a prospect and his or her parents or coach. Verbal offers of financial aid or a promise thereof are still considered permissible.

## Skill Instruction

If you are in your 8 hour per week period, only two of those eight hours may be devoted to skill instruction. From the start of classes to Sept. 14th, not more than four student-athletes from one team may participate in skill instruction at the same time in any facility. From Sept. 15 to one week prior to final exams, more than four student-athletes from a team may participate in skill instruction at the same time.

**Beginning September 1st, the Eligibility Center has increased its registration fee from \$60 to \$65 for Domestic PSA's and from \$85 to \$90 for International PSA's.**
