## TIPOFF

After a pair of road tests at NM State and Arizona, UTEP (1-2) will return home for a Monday night contest against Eastern New Mexico (0-3). Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. in the Don Haskins Center. UTEP season tickets are available by calling (915) 747-6150.

The Miners are coming off a loss at national power Arizona on Nov. 14. UTEP's highly-touted freshman guard **Nigel Hawkins** made his collegiate debut in the McKale Center, scoring seven points with six rebounds, three assists and a steal. Hawkins struggled from the field, but did connect on 5-of-6 free throws, while he tied for the team lead in assists.

Fellow freshman **Efe Odigie** produced his first career double-double, leading the Miners in rebounds (11) and tallying 13 points against the Wildcats' experienced frontcourt. Odigie went 5-of-8 from the field coming off the bench for the first time this season during a season-high 28 minutes of action. Odigie has opened his UTEP career with three consecutive double-digit scoring games. The Houston native tipped off the campaign with a 23-point performance versus UT Permian Basin, while recording 13 points at rival NM State.

Senior **Paul Thomas** led the Miners with a season-high 14 points, while chipping in with six boards and tied Hawkins for the team lead with three assists. Thomas went 6-for-10 overall from the floor and 2-of-4 from beyond the arc.

barger Tip-Off Classic on Nov. 16. Chukuka Emili opened his senior campaign with a 21-point, nine-rebound effort in 36 minutes against Fort Lewis. The 6-8 forward followed with a double-double (11 points, 11 rebounds) in ENMU's second game, while producing his second double-double (10 points, 11 boards) against St. Edward's. Against N.M. Highlands, junior Isaiah Murphy led the Greyhounds with 17 points off the bench, while Zach Parker added 16 points.

## THE SERIES

The Miners and Greyhounds are facing each other for the first time in 43 years. The two programs last met on Jan. 4, 1975 during a 73-50 UTEP victory in El Paso. UTEP and ENMU first met during the 1944-45 season.

## HAWKINS' DEBUT

Freshman **Nigel Hawkins**, after missing the first two games of the season with an injury, saw his first collegiate action at national power Arizona on Nov. 14. Not only did he see action, Hawkins got the start against the Wildcats. Hawkins struggled from the field, but scored seven points on 5-of-6 shooting from the charity stripe. The Houston native added six rebounds, tied for the team lead with three assists and registered a steal in over 35 minutes of action. Hawkins' first collegiate points came at the 16:16 mark on a layup – the Miners' first points of the contest.

## FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman **Efe Odigie** came off the bench at national power Arizona on Nov. 14 and answered with his first career double-double against an experienced Wildcats' frontcourt. Odigie led the Miners with 11 rebounds, while finishing second on the stat sheet with 13 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the field.

## ODIGIE IN THE EARLY RANKINGS

**Efe Odigie** is currently ranked 13th in Conference USA with his 16.3 points per game. He currently leads UTEP at 8.3 rebounds per game, which is tied for fourth in C-USA with two other players.

## PAUL'S FG PERCENTAGE

Senior **Paul Thomas** leads the Miners with a .609 field goal percentage (14-23), while ranking 12th in Conference USA in that department.

## EZEAGU'S FIRST START

Freshman **Kaosi Ezeagu** made his first collegiate start at Arizona on Nov. 14. Ezeagu played over 12 minutes and scored two points on a put back after an offensive rebound. Ezeagu chipped in with a blocked shot and two rebounds against the Wildcats.

## LATHON'S FIRST COLLEGIATE TROY

Freshman **Jordan Lathon** connected on his first career three-point basket. It came at the 14:44 mark in the first half at Arizona. The bucket got UTEP within six points at the time.

## REBOUNDING GUARD

**Jordan Lathon** is averaging 6.3 rebounds per game, ranking second the team and tied for 18th in Conference USA. Lathon opened his UTEP career with a 10-rebound performance.

## UTEP FRESHMEN BIG MEN SCORING

**Efe Odigie** is averaging 16.3 points per game (49 points) to open his UTEP career. **Vince Hunter** scored 419 points in 34 games during the 2013-14 season, the second most points scored for a UTEP freshman, while averaging 12.3 points per game, ranked fifth all-time. **John Tofi** averaged 12.9 points per game during his first season (2002-03), ranked third all-time.

## COMPARISONS TO OTHER BIGS

**Efe Odigie** opened his career with 36 points in two games. Odigie's 36 points is the most for a UTEP freshman forward/center since **John Tofi's** 27 points to open his career (2002-03). **Matt Willms** scored 22 points and **Vince Hunter** tallied 20 points in their first two games during the 2013-14 season.

## FRESHMEN BIGS BANGING THE BOARDS

**Efe Odigie** is averaging 8.3 rebounds in his first three games. Anthony Burns averaged a program-best 9.4 rpg (1977-78), while **Terry White** averaged 8.6 rpg (1978-79). **Arnett Moultrie** (8.2 in 2008-09), **Gary Brewster** (6.6 in 1972-73) and **Vince Hunter** (6.5 in 2013-14) round out the top five.

40 MINUTES OF ACTION BY TWO MINERS

**Kobe Magee** and **Evan Gilyard** played all 40 minutes at NM State on Nov. 6. UTEP had two games last season where two players logged 40 minutes – versus LA Tech (Feb. 22, 2018) and at North Texas (March 3, 2018).

FIRST EVER MINER

**Kobe Magee** opened his sophomore campaign by logging 40 minutes in back-to-back games. Magee is the first Miner to open a season with two 40-minute games.

49 POINTS IN 2 GAMES TO OPEN SEASON

**Evan Gilyard** leads the Miners with 49 points during the first two games to open the 2018-19 season. Gilyard opened his sophomore campaign with a 24-point performance against UT Permian Basin, and put up another 25 at NM State. **Stefon Jackson** was the last UTEP player to score 49 points in the first two games of the season which was during the 2007-08 campaign. Jackson scored 22 against Arkansas-Pine Bluff and 27 versus Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Jackson scored 27 points in the third game of the season (27 vs. Texas A&M).

24 OR MORE

**Evan Gilyard** is the first Miner to score 24 points or more in the first two games of the season since **Antoine Gillespie** did so against Bellhaven (26 points) and at NM State (24) to open the 1994-95 campaign.

FROM BEYOND ARC

**Evan Gilyard's** six three-point field goals against UTPB were the most made by a UTEP player since **Dominic Artis** connected on six versus Southern Miss on Feb. 11, 2017.

SUPER SOPH

**Evan Gilyard** is the first sophomore in the program history to score 49 points in the first two games to open a season. Gilyard scored 24 points against UT Permian Basin and 25 points at NM State.

UTEP SOPHOMORE SCORING NOTES

**Evan Gilyard** is averaging 24.5 points early on in the season. The program record for a sophomore season scoring average is **Charlie Brown's** 21.1 points per game during the 1956-57 season, while **Nolan Richardson** averaged 21.0 points per contest during the 1960-61 campaign. UTEP's all-time leading scorer, **Stefon Jackson**, averaged 18.6 points during the 2006-07 season. **Randy Culpepper** scored the most points (648 in 37 games) for a UTEP sophomore (2008-09 season).

GILYARD'S TREYS

**Evan Gilyard** has made nine three-pointers during the first two games of the season, ranking tied for second in Conference USA. His 60 percent three-point field goal percentage (9-15) ranks tied for eighth in the league.

GILYARD'S BIG NIGHT

Sophomore **Evan Gilyard** poured in 24 points during the season opener on Nov. 6 during UTEP's 90-63 win against UT Permian Basin. His points were the most by a UTEP player in a season opener since **Jason Williams** scored 29 points versus Western New Mexico on Nov. 18, 2005. Gilyard's 24 points ties third-most by a UTEP player in a season opener since 2000 (**Eugene Costello** 26 points at Washington on Nov. 21, 2000, and **Omega Harris** 24 points versus Louisiana College on Nov. 12, 2016). Dating back to last season, Gilyard has scored in double figures in a career-high three consecutive games.

90 POINTS, MOST EVER IN A DEBUT

UTEP poured on 90 points on Nov. 6 to rev up the **Rodney Terry** Era. The 90 points scored was the most ever by a UTEP team during its head coaches' debut. **Doc Sadler's** squad opened his UTEP coaching career with 83 points on Nov. 21, 2004, while **Billy Gillispie's** team put up 75 points on Nov. 23, 2002.

MARGIN OF VICTORY

UTEP's 27-point triumph during the season opener tied the second-largest for a UTEP coach in his debut. The largest is 33 points by **Doc Sadler** versus Delaware State (83-50) on Nov. 21, 2004. **George McCarty** also a 27-point win over Sul Ross on Dec. 2, 1953 (71-44).



## TWO 20-POINT SCORERS

The Miners received a pair of 20-point performances during the season opener against UT Permian Basin, as **Evan Gilyard** (24 points) and **Efe Odigie** (23) got buckets on Tuesday night. It's the first time since the Nov. 21, 2000 season opener at Washington when **Eugene Costello** (26 points) and **Brandon Wolfram** (21 points) gathered buckets of their own.

## TWO FRESHMEN STARTING

New UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** had two freshmen (**Efe Odigie**, **Jordan Lathon**) in the opening night starting lineup. It's the first time since the 2011-12 season when Cedrick Lang and Julian Washburn both started in game one.

## SUCCESS IN SEASON OPENERS

UTEP won 90-63 over UT Permian Basin on Nov. 6 and improved to 18-3 in season openers since the 1998-99 season. The Miners fell to NM State on Nov. 13, 1998. The other two opening-season losses came in back-to-back seasons, the first was a setback against Pacific on Nov. 12, 2010 and the other came against UTSA on Nov. 11, 2011.

## ROSTER MAKEOVER

Since head coach **Rodney Terry** was hired, he and his staff signed 13 new student-athletes. Of the 13 players, five will sit out due to NCAA transfer rules. Guard **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), guard/forward **Ountae Campbell** (Fresno State), guard/forward **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), forward **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will all be eligible for the 2019-20 season. Boum and Verhoeven will each have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two and Campbell will have one year of eligibility. Freshman **Deon Stroud** will be the sixth Miner to sit out, as he will concentrate on academics. Eight other newcomers will grace the roster as **Jakobe Dill**, **Kaosi Ezeagu**, **Nigel Hawkins**, **Jordan Lathon**, **Efe Odigie** and **Garrett Sullivan** makeup the remaining freshmen. Sophomore **Gilles Dekoninck** is the other new face.

## BUILDING FOUR THE FUTURE

UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** will have four student-athletes sitting out during the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will be eligible for the 2019-20 campaign. Boum and Verhoeven will have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two years. All four made major contributions at their respective previous programs. Williams, a 6-foot-8, 225-pound forward, was named All-Mountain West third team following his sophomore season after averaging 14 points per game. Verhoeven, a 6-foot-9, 215-pound forward, played in all 32 games, while starting the final 27 contests during his freshman campaign. He broke the school's freshman blocked shots record (71), while leading the A-10 in blocks per game (2.22). Tarke, a 6-foot-6, 220-pound forward/guard, led NJIT in scoring (15.7 p/g) during his sophomore season. Boum, a 6-foot-3, 160-pound guard, set USF's freshman record with 121 free throws made.

## TALENTED FRESHMAN CLASS

The 2018-19 UTEP roster will feature five freshmen who will be eligible for the upcoming season and should see significant playing time. **Rodney Terry** signed three freshmen guards in **Jakobe Dill**, **Nigel Hawkins** and **Jordan Lathon**, and forwards **Kaosi Ezeagu** and **Efe Odigie**. Odigie will be a physical presence in the paint with his 6-foot-9, 280-pound frame, while Ezeagu will also take up space in the paint with his 6-foot-10, 240-pound body. Dill (6-foot-3), Hawkins (6-foot-4) and Lathon (6-foot-4) are a trio of big and physical guards who will also provide athleticism at the position.

## COACH TERRY'S STAFF

**Rodney Terry** brought in three assistant coaches, **Lamont Smith**, **Brian Burton** and **Nick Matson**, with a wealth of coaching experience. Smith most recently served as the head coach at the University of San Diego for three seasons. He directed the Toreros from nine wins his first year (2015-16) to a 20-win campaign his final season (2017-18). Burton served as Terry's Director of Basketball Operations at Fresno State in 2017-18, but not before spending the previous three years (2014-17) as an assistant coach at Lamar. Matson was on Terry's staff for all seven seasons at Fresno State, most recently as an assistant coach.

## 2018-19 SCHEDULE NOTES

The upcoming hoops' schedule will feature 16 home contests, as the Miners open the new era against UT Permian Basin on Nov. 6. UTEP and I-10 rival NM State will battle in Las Cruces on Nov. 9 and in the Don Haskins Center on Nov. 28. UTEP will play at Pac-12 power Arizona on Nov. 14. It's the first contest in Tucson between the two programs since Nov. 15, 2012. The Miners and Wildcats last met on Dec. 19, 2014 in El Paso. UTEP will play at another Power Five program Marquette of the Big East on Dec. 4. The Miners and Golden Eagles will meet for the first time since Dec. 12, 1962. UTEP will take on New Mexico for a third consecutive season on Nov. 24 in Albuquerque. The series is the longest since the Miners and Lobos faced one another four consecutive times from 2005-2009.

## "C-USA BONUS PLAY"

Conference USA rolled out an innovative scheduling format for the 2019 league contests. The new C-USA schedule format will see the 14 teams play each other once and their travel partner twice in the first seven weeks of the conference season. UTEP will open at UTSA on Jan. 3, while the Miners and Roadrunners will play each other again on Jan. 5 in the Don Haskins Center. Following the first 14 league contests, teams will be placed into one of three groups based on their conference standing. The teams will be divided into two groups of five (1-5 and 6-10) and a group of four (11-14). During the final three weeks, teams will play four games (two home/two away) within their respective grouping. Home and away matchups will be determined by the preset formula.

## WINNING IN THEIR DEBUTS

**Charles Finley** won his game at the helm, overwhelming Hardin-Simmons, 59-36, to start the 1944-45 campaign. **Dale Waters** followed suit when he won his contest as head coach, coming out on the winning side against NM State, 41-36, to begin the 1945-46 season. **Ross Moore's** squad defeated International Petro, 66-60, on Dec. 2, 1947 while **George McCarty's** Miners blasted Sul Ross, 71-44, on Dec. 2, 1953. **"The Bear" Don Haskins** won at Iowa State, 66-59, on Dec. 2, 1961 to begin his Hall of Fame career. Years later, **Jason Rabedeaux** took over after Haskins retired and kept the winning way going with a 72-53 victory over LA Tech on Nov. 23, 1999. **Billy Gillispie's** team defeated New Mexico Highlands, 75-66, on Nov. 23, 2002 and **Doc Sadler** beat up on Delaware State, 83-50, on Nov. 21, 2004. **Tony Barbee** defeated Penn, 69-66, on Nov. 10, 2006.
