TIPOFF

In their 217th meeting and second this season, rivals UTEP and NM State will tangle on Wednesday (Nov. 28) at 7 p.m. in the Don Haskins Center as the FirstLight Federal Credit Union Battle of I-10 resumes. Single-game tickets, starting at \$8, are available by calling (915) 747-5234.

The Miners (2-3) are coming off a loss at New Mexico (84-78) in which they had a five-point lead at the half on Nov. 24. The Lobos hit 8-of-11 from three-point range during the second half to pull away for the victory. Sophomore **Evan Gilyard**, who was named the Conference USA Player of the Week on Nov. 26, scored 22 points to lead the squad and connected on 5-of-9 from downtown. It was Gilyard's fourth time leading the team in scoring, while it was also his fourth 20-plus point performance of the young season. **Efe Odigie**, who was named the C-USA Freshman of the Week on Nov. 26, came up a rebound short of his third consecutive double-double. Odigie scored 11 points and went 4-for-4 from the charity stripe with under three minutes left in the game to keep the Miners in the contest. A pair of UTEP freshmen hit double figures in points for the first time during their careers. **Nigel Hawkins** scored 12 points and led the team with two steals. **Jordan Lathon** connected on a pair of three-point buckets, scoring 10 points and leading the team with four assists. **Paul Thomas** scored a season-high 16 points before fouling out and **Kaosi Ezeagu** came off the bench to score six points and tally five rebounds.

Gilyard is the third-leading scorer in C-USA and ranks 43rd nationally at 20.8 points per game, while Odigie leads the league in rebounds per contest (10.2) and ranks 23rd nationally. As a team, UTEP ranks second in C-USA in three-point shooting percentage (.376) and fifth in defensive rebounds per game (27.6).

MONDAY'S OPPONENT

NM State (3-1) is coming off a split since hosting UTEP on Nov. 9. The Aggies fell to Saint Mary's (Calif.), 73-58, on Nov. 14 in Las Cruces, while outscoring New Mexico, 98-94, on Nov. 17 in The Pit. Aggies 5-9 guard A.J. Harris led his team with 31 points, including a perfect 6-for-6 from downtown in 30 minutes of action against UNM. Terrell Brown chipped in with 20 points. Mohamed Thiam led the team in rebounds (nine) against the Lobos. NM State is led by Harris's 14.8 point per game, while Brown is averaging 12.8 points per contest. Eli Chuha paces the squad in rebounds per game (6.0).

THE SERIES

The Aggies lead the all-time series 113-103, while the Miners have lost the last eight contests. UTEP's last win came on Nov. 22, 2014, a 77-76 triumph in the Don Haskins Center. Earlier this year, NM State defeated UTEP, 96-69, on Nov. 9 at the Pan American Center.

CLEANING THE GLASS

Efe Odigie ripped down 17 rebounds against ENMU on Nov. 19. It was the most boards since **John Bohannon** tallied 17 versus Houston on Feb. 27, 2013. Odigie's 17 rebounds was the most by a UTEP freshman since **Arnett Moultrie** had 17 against Houston in the Conference USA Tournament on March 12, 2009. Odigie is the seventh Miner since 2000 to record 17 rebounds or more in a game (**John Bohannon**, **Stefon Jackson**, **Darius Mattear**, **Arnett Moultrie**, **Brian Stewart** and **Justino Victoriano**).

C-USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Evan Gilyard, ranked third in Conference USA in scoring (20.8 ppg), averaged 25.5 points per contest and 7.0 rebounds per game in UTEP's last two games. Gilyard also set career numbers in the process with his sharpshooting. Gilyard opened the week with a 29-point performance (matched career high) during the Miners' victory against Eastern New Mexico. The sophomore connected on a career-high 11 field goals from the field but really shined on the boards as he pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds, including five on the offensive side. Gilyard followed with his fourth 20-plus point effort (22 points) of the season in a hostile environment at The Pit. Gilyard went 5-of-9 from downtown and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe. Gilyard also recorded a steal and assist with a trio of rebounds against the Lobos.

GILYARD'S EARLY EXPLOSION

Evan Gilyard has been on quite the scoring spree to start the 2018-19 season, putting 24, 25, 4, 29 and 22 points on the board in the first five games. He's the first Miner to open a season with four 20-point games in the first five outings since **Stefon Jackson** recorded 22, 27, 27, 17 and 30 points in the first five contests of the 2008-09 campaign. Gilyard is on pace for 624 points over 30 games, which would be the 11th-most in a season in school annals and the third-most by a Miner who played in 30 games or fewer (**Jim Barnes** scored 818 points in 28 games in 1963-64, and **Antoine Gillespie** scored 710 points in 30 games in 1993-94).

POURING IN POINTS

Evan Gilyard is ranked third in Conference USA in scoring (20.8). He's not far behind FIU's **Brian Beard Jr.** (22.1 ppg) and Charlotte's **Jon Davis** (21.3 ppg).

EVAN'S CAREER NIGHT

Evan Gilyard came up with a huge night rebounding as the 5-foot-10 guard pulled down 11 rebounds, including five on the offensive side against ENMU on Nov. 19. The sophomore surpassed his previous high of five at Old Dominion on Feb. 17, 2018. Gilyard also tallied his first career double-double against ENMU on Nov. 19. The sophomore scored 29 points and recorded a career-high 11 rebounds.

C-USA FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Efe Odigie, the only player averaging a double-double (14.8 ppg, 10.2 rpg) in Conference USA and the league leader in rebounding, averaged 13.0 boards per game and 12.5 points per contest during his last two games. Odigie ripped down a career-high and single-game C-USA best 17 rebounds on Nov. 19 during a win against Eastern New Mexico. Odigie also scored 14 points, leading to his second consecutive double-double. At New Mexico, Odigie came up a rebound short of his third straight double-double. Odigie also recorded his first career assists (three) against the Greyhounds. Odigie scored 11 points against the Lobos on 4-of-5 from the field and 3-of-4 at the charity stripe, while connecting on a pair with ease down the stretch to keep the Miners in the ball game. The big man played with urgency in the loud environment at The Pit, tallying a blocked shot, steal and five offensive rebounds. Odigie set the tone for the game when he dove for a loose ball in the opening minutes against the rival Lobos.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MAN

Efe Odigie is averaging 14.8 points and 10.2 rebounds as he attempts to become only the ninth player in school history, and the first since 1982, to average a double-double for a season. The others are Jim Barnes in 1962-63 (18.9 ppg/16.5 rpg) and 1963-64 (29.2 ppg/19.2 rpg), Charlie Brown in 1956-57 (21.1 ppg/10.2 rpg), Jim Forbes in 1971-72 (12.0 ppg/10.7 rpg), Dick Gibbs in 1970-71 (17.4 ppg/10.6 rpg), Ed Haller in 1954-55 (16.6 ppg/11.2 rpg) and 1955-56 (16.2 ppg/12.6 rpg), David Lattin in 1966-67 (15.1 ppg/10.1 rpg), Al Tolen in 1960-61 (20.0 ppg/11.5 rpg) and Terry White in 1981-82 (10.1 ppg/10.2 rpg).

LEADING BIG MAN

Efe Odigie ranks first in Conference USA in rebounding per game (10.2) and is the only player in C-USA averaging a double-double on the season.

FIVE STARTERS IN DOUBLE FIGURES

The Miners placed five starters in double figure scoring at New Mexico for the first time since Feb. 15, 2018 at Charlotte, when Evan Gilyard (22 points), Isiah Osborne (22), Paul Thomas (15), Omega Harris (11) and Matt Willms (11) turned the trick.

HAWKINS & LATHON HIT DOUBLE-DIGIT FIGURES

For the first time in their young careers, freshmen **Jordan Lathon** and **Nigel Hawkins** hit double-digit figures in points at UNM on Nov. 24. Lathon scored a career-high 10 points that included hitting a couple of treys, while Hawkins scored a career-best 12 points.

THREE FRESHMEN IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Against New Mexico, UTEP had three freshmen (**Nigel Hawkins**, **Jordan Lathon**, **Efe Odigie**) score in double figures in a game for the first time since Jan. 25, 2018, when **Trey Wade** (22 points), **Evan Gilyard** (14) and **Kobe Magee** (11) did so at UAB. It marked only the second time since 1982 that UTEP had three freshmen score in double figures in a game. This also happened versus Roosevelt on Dec. 11, 1982 as Dave Feitl tallied 17 points, Kevin Hamilton 13 and Wayne Campbell 10.

FRESHMAN PRODUCTION

UTEP has gotten 147 points (29.4 ppg) and 107 rebounds (21.4 rpg) from its freshman class this season. That puts the Miners on pace for 882 points and 642 rebounds from its freshmen over 30 games in 2018-19 (includes minimum one game in the Conference USA Tournament). It would mark the second-most points and rebounds by UTEP freshmen in a season behind the 1977-78 Miners, who received 1,134 points from the eight-man rookie class of **Roshern Amie**, **Anthony Burns**, **Tim Crenshaw**, **Earl Fuller**, **Joe Garrett**, **Kevin Jones**, **Darold Molix** and **Steve Yellen**. The 642 rebounds would surpass the previous UTEP record of 609 boards from its 1977-78 freshman group.

FROM DOWNTOWN

UTEP is ranked second in Conference USA in three-point shooting percentage (.376). North Texas leads the way (.426). The Miners' 7.0 three-pointers made per game ranks eighth, while their 35 made treys rank ninth.

FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE DEFENSE

UTEP ranks in the top half of Conference USA in field goal percentage defense, coming in at no. 6 with its .420 percentage allowed. Old Dominion ranks first (.372), while North Texas (.377), Southern Miss (.404), WKU (.411) and FIU (.419) round out the list.

DEFENSIVE REBOUNDS

UTEP ranks fifth in Conference USA in defensive rebounds per game (27.6).

GILYARD'S OPENING NIGHT

Sophomore **Evan Gilyard** poured in 24 points during the season opener on Nov. 6 during UTEP's 90-63 win against UT Permian Basin. His points were the most by a UTEP player in a season opener since **Jason Williams** scored 29 points versus Western New Mexico on Nov. 18, 2005. Gilyard's 24 points ties third-most by a UTEP player in a season opener since 2000 (**Eugene Costello** 26 points at Washington on Nov. 21, 2000, and **Omega Harris** 24 points versus Louisiana College on Nov. 12, 2016). Dating back to last season, Gilyard has scored in double figures in a career-high three consecutive games.



UTEP SOPHOMORE SCORING NOTES

Evan Gilyard is averaging 20.8 points early on in the season. The program record for a sophomore season scoring average is **Charlie Brown's** 21.1 points per game during the 1956-57 season, while **Nolan Richardson** averaged 21.0 points per contest during the 1960-61 campaign. UTEP's all-time leading scorer, **Stefon Jackson**, averaged 18.6 points during the 2006-07 season. **Randy Culpepper** scored the most points (648 in 37 games) for a UTEP sophomore (2008-09 season).

FIRST EVER MINER

Kobe Magee opened his sophomore campaign by logging 40 minutes in back-to-back games. Magee is the first Miner to open a season with two 40-minute games.

90 POINTS, MOST EVER IN A DEBUT

UTEP poured on 90 points on Nov. 6 to rev up the **Rodney Terry** Era. The 90 points scored was the most ever by a UTEP team during its head coaches' debut. **Doc Sadler's** squad opened his UTEP coaching career with 83 points on Nov. 21, 2004, while **Billy Gillispie's** team put up 75 points on Nov. 23, 2002.

MARGIN OF VICTORY

UTEP's 27-point triumph during the season opener tied the second-largest for a UTEP coach in his debut. The largest is 33 points by **Doc Sadler** versus Delaware State (83-50) on Nov. 21, 2004. **George McCarty** also a 27-point win over Sul Ross on Dec. 2, 1953 (71-44).

SUCCESS IN SEASON OPENERS

UTEP won 90-63 over UT Permian Basin on Nov. 6 and improved to 18-3 in season openers since the 1998-99 season. The Miners fell to NM State on Nov. 13, 1998. The other two opening-season losses came in back-to-back seasons, the first was a setback against Pacific on Nov. 12, 2010 and the other came against UTSA on Nov. 11, 2011.

ROSTER MAKEOVER

Since head coach **Rodney Terry** was hired, he and his staff signed 13 new student-athletes. Of the 13 players, five will sit out due to NCAA transfer rules. Guard **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), guard/forward **Ountae Campbell** (Fresno State), guard/forward **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), forward **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will all be eligible for the 2019-20 season. Boum and Verhoeven will each have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two and Campbell will have one year of eligibility. Freshman **Deon Stroud** will be the sixth Miner to sit out, as he will concentrate on academics. Eight other newcomers will grace the roster as **Jakobe Dill**, **Kaosi Ezeagu**, **Nigel Hawkins**, **Jordan Lathon**, **Efe Odigie** and **Garrett Sullivan** makeup the remaining freshmen. Sophomore **Gilles Dekoninck** is the other new face.

BUILDING FOUR THE FUTURE

UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** will have four student-athletes sitting out during the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will be eligible for the 2019-20 campaign. Boum and Verhoeven will have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two years. All four made major contributions at their respective previous programs. Williams, a 6-foot-8, 225-pound forward, was named All-Mountain West third team following his sophomore season after averaging 14 points per game. Verhoeven, a 6-foot-9, 215-pound forward, played in all 32 games, while starting the final 27 contests during his freshman campaign. He broke the school's freshman blocked shots record (71), while leading the A-10 in blocks per game (2.22). Tarke, a 6-foot-6, 220-pound forward/guard, led NJIT in scoring (15.7 p/g) during his sophomore season. Boum, a 6-foot-3, 160-pound guard, set USF's freshman record with 121 free throws made.

TALENTED FRESHMAN CLASS

The 2018-19 UTEP roster will feature five freshmen who will be eligible for the upcoming season and should see significant playing time. **Rodney Terry** signed three freshmen guards in **Jakobe Dill**, **Nigel Hawkins** and **Jordan Lathon**, and forwards **Kaosi Ezeagu** and **Efe Odigie**. Odigie will be a physical presence in the paint with his 6-foot-9, 280-pound frame, while Ezeagu will also take up space in the paint with his 6-foot-10, 240-pound body. Dill (6-foot-3), Hawkins (6-foot-4) and Lathon (6-foot-4) are a trio of big and physical guards who will also provide athleticism at the position.

COACH TERRY'S STAFF

Rodney Terry brought in three assistant coaches, **Lamont Smith**, **Brian Burton** and **Nick Matson**, with a wealth of coaching experience. Smith most recently served as the head coach at the University of San Diego for three seasons. He directed the Toreros from nine wins his first year (2015-16) to a 20-win campaign his final season (2017-18). Burton served as Terry's Director of Basketball Operations at Fresno State in 2017-18, but not before spending the previous three years (2014-17) as an assistant coach at Lamar. Matson was on Terry's staff for all seven seasons at Fresno State, most recently as an assistant coach.

"C-USA BONUS PLAY"

Conference USA rolled out an innovative scheduling format for the 2019 league contests. The new C-USA schedule format will see the 14 teams play each other once and their travel partner twice in the first seven weeks of the conference season. UTEP will open at UTSA on Jan. 3, while the Miners and Roadrunners will play each other again on Jan. 5 in the Don Haskins Center. Following the first 14 league contests, teams will be placed into one of three groups based on their conference standing. The teams will be divided into two groups of five (1-5 and 6-10) and a group of four (11-14). During the final three weeks, teams will play four games (two home/two away) within their respective grouping. Home and away matchups will be determined by the preset formula.

WINNING IN THEIR DEBUTS

Charles Finley won his game at the helm, overwhelming Hardin-Simmons, 59-36, to start the 1944-45 campaign. **Dale Waters** followed suit when he won his contest as head coach, coming out on the winning side against NM State, 41-36, to begin the 1945-46 season. **Ross Moore's** squad defeated International Petro, 66-60, on Dec. 2, 1947 while **George McCarty's** Miners blasted Sul Ross, 71-44, on Dec. 2, 1953. **"The Bear" Don Haskins** won at Iowa State, 66-59, on Dec. 2, 1961 to begin his Hall of Fame career. Years later, **Jason Rabedaux** took over after Haskins retired and kept the winning way going with a 72-53 victory over LA Tech on Nov. 23, 1999. **Billy Gillispie's** team defeated New Mexico Highlands, 75-66, on Nov. 23, 2002 and **Doc Sadler** beat up on Delaware State, 83-50, on Nov. 21, 2004. **Tony Barbee** defeated Penn, 69-66, on Nov. 10, 2006.
