THE KICKOFF

Fresh off its first win since the 2016 season, UTEP (1-8, 1-4 C-USA) looks to string together back-to-back victories for the first time in more than three years when Middle Tennessee (6-3, 5-1 C-USA) comes to the Sun Bowl for "Fan Appreciation Day" on Saturday. Early kickoff is set for 1 p.m. MT. The Miners ended a 20-game losing streak with a 34-26 triumph at Rice on Nov. 3. It was UTEP's first win since Nov. 26, 2016, and its first road victory since Oct. 22, 2016. The last time the Miners notched consecutive wins was in September, 2015 at NM State (50-47 in overtime) and versus Incarnate Word (27-17). The last occasion UTEP registered two Conference USA victories in a row was during the 2014 season with three consecutive triumphs over Old Dominion (42-35), at UTSA (34-0) and against Southern Miss (35-14). Middle Tennessee has won three straight games and five of its last six. The Blue Raiders are 2-3 on the road, 2-1 in league play with victories over Marshall (34-24) and Old Dominion (51-17) and a loss at FIU (24-21).

SATURDAY'S OPPONENT

The Blue Raiders are in first place in Conference USA's East Division, a half-game in front of FIU (4-1). Middle Tennessee knocked off WKU, 29-10, on Nov. 2 in Murfreesboro to become bowl eligible. Middle Tennessee is second in C-USA in scoring offense (30.2 ppg) and second in scoring defense (18.7 ppg) for league games only. Over the last three games, the Blue Raiders have yielded 13.3 ppg to Charlotte, Old Dominion and WKU. The Blue Raiders are third in the league in punt returns (13.0 avg.) and fourth in kickoff returns (24.0 avg.) for conference games. Middle Tennessee brings a balanced rushing attack to El Paso as six players are averaging between 20 and 45 yards per game. Senior QB Brent Stockstill, a four-year starter, owns Middle Tennessee career records in passing yards (10,897), passing yards per game (272.4) and touchdown passes (94). He rates fourth in passing yards, third in passing yards per game and first in passing touchdowns among active FBS players. His top target in 2018 has been junior WR Ty Lee, who leads the team in catches (41) and yards (463). The defense is anchored by sophomore safety Reed Blankenship, who was recently named the Bronko Nagurski National Defensive Player of the Week (Oct. 30) after putting up a career-high 17 tackles (nine solo), a sack, three tackles for losses and a 100-yard interception return for a touchdown at Old Dominion. Blankenship has a team-leading 71 stops this season along with six tackles for losses, two picks and four pass break ups. Over the last six games, the Blue Raider defense has forced 14 turnovers. Middle Tennessee had a balanced offensive showing in its last game versus WKU as it gained 246 yards rushing and 228 passing. Stockstill completed 24-of-42 passes with two touchdowns, and redshirt-freshman Chaton Mobley had a big night with 25 carries for 198 yards. Middle Tennessee holds national top-30 rankings in red zone defense (third, .667), defensive touchdowns (seventh, 3.0), punt returns (10th, 17.17), completion percentage (19th, .657), penalties per game (20th, 4.89), fourth down conversion percentage (21st, .647), kickoff returns (22nd, 24.00) and turnover margin (27th, 0.44).

THE LAST MEETING

True freshman running back and El Paso native **Joshua Fields** produced a career-high 87 yards on 17 carries, but Middle Tennessee scored a 30-3 victory on Nov. 4, 2017 at Floyd Stadium. The Miners struggled on offense, gaining 137 yards and six first downs, while the Blue Raiders registered 400 yards of offense and 18 first downs. Brent Stockstill, who was a game-time decision, made his first start in two months. He threw for 190 yards on 13-of-30 passing with three scores. **Nik Needham** intercepted one of Stockstill's passes. Middle Tennessee got on the board first after Canon Rooker connected on a career-long 51-yard field goal. The Blue Raiders took a 17-0 lead after a pair of Stockstill touchdown tosses. The first came with 16 seconds left in the first quarter, a 25-yard hookup to Ty Lee, while the second was a five-yard pass to Jimmy Marshall in the second quarter at the 4:35 mark. After a Tavares Thomas two-yard touchdown run to put MT up 24-0, UTEP kicker **Jason Filley** got the Miners on the board with his first career field goal, a 26-yard kick with over six minutes to play in the third quarter. **Alan Luna** gathered a career-high 414 yards on nine punts (46.0 avg.), while **Dante Lovilotte** led the defense with seven tackles. **Terry Juniel** ran a kickoff back 49 yards and averaged 29.0 yards on three kickoff returns.

LAST GAME

UTEP burst out to a 27-0 lead in a dominating first-half performance, then held off resurgent Rice in the second half for a 34-26 win on Nov. 3 in Houston. The Miners stamped out their 20-game losing streak and notched their first win under coach **Dana Dimel**. It was UTEP's first triumph at Rice Stadium since 2005, its initial year in Conference USA. UTEP piled up 310 yards of offense in the first half. **Kai Locksley** threw for 193 yards in the first 30 minutes, and joined **Quardraiz Wadley** in rushing for two touchdowns. It didn't take long for the Miners to get on the board. Wadley's 12-yard scoring run with 12:32 left in the first quarter made it 7-0. Wadley and Locksley alternated TD runs in the first half, with Wadley scoring twice on 12-yard runs and Locksley picking up a pair of one-yard scores. Rice only managed four first downs in the first half, with one coming on a 35-yard pass from Wiley Green to Austin Walter late in the half that set up a 43-yard field goal. The Owls had 96 yards in the first half. The teams traded touchdowns in the third quarter, with **Treyvon Hughes** picking up a 19-yard rushing score for the Miners. But Rice came alive in the final period, as Green connected with Austin Trammell for a pair of long scores and the Owls converted back-to-back two-point conversions, suddenly making it a one-possession game (34-26) with a little over eight minutes to go. The Owls would get a few more cracks at it, but a UTEP defense that has been solid all season long stepped up time and time again. First, the Miners forced a three and out. Then **Justin Rogers** picked off Green's desperation pass on 4th and 20 at midfield. The game ended on a 25-yard completion from Green to Jordan Myers at the Rice 36-yard line when the clock ran out. UTEP was balanced as can be offensively with 210 yards passing and 200 rushing. Locksley completed 13-of-21 passes for 193 yards. Wadley and Hughes rushed for 91 and 76 yards, respectively. The Miners had a slim edge in total yards (410-383) as the Owls put up 287 yards in the second half. Green threw for 313 yards for Rice, which had a pair of 100-yard receivers in Trammell (112 yards) and Walter (104 yards).

STREAK BUSTERS

The Miners ended the longest losing skid in school history (20 games) with last week's 34-26 triumph at Rice. It marked the 11th time that UTEP ended a losing streak of 10+ games, but only the second time it did so on the road (first time 34-14 win at Hawaii on Oct. 4, 1980 that snapped a streak of 11 consecutive losses).

QUICK START

UTEP bolted to a 27-0 lead at Rice. It marked the third time UTEP has scored the game's first 27 points versus a C-USA opponent since joining the league in 2005. The Miners led 34-0 at UTSA in 2014, and 28-0 versus North Texas in 2014. The Miners scored their first touchdown with 12:32 remaining in the first quarter. It was UTEP's quickest score versus a C-USA opponent since Nov. 5, 2011, at Rice (**Nick Lamaison** 74-yard pass to **Mike Edwards**, 13:57 on the clock).

300 YARDS AT THE HALF

The Miners put up 310 yards in the first half at Rice. It marked the fifth time UTEP has compiled 300 yards or more in the opening half versus a C-USA opponent. This also happened previously against SMU in 2008 (325), UAB in 2009 (316), SMU in 2009 (302) and Tulane in 2012 (318). Overall, the 310 first-half yards were the most for the Miners since the 2014 season opener at New Mexico (326).

SEASON HIGH FOR POINTS

For the first time in 2018, UTEP put 30 points on the board in last week's 34-26 win at Rice. UTEP's previous season high for points was 24 (three times). The Miners scored 30+ points for the 41st time against a Conference USA opponent, and for the first time since Nov. 26, 2016, versus North Texas (52). UTEP is now 25-16 all-time versus C-USA foes when scoring 30 points or more (interesting side note: the Miners won their first six C-USA games when scoring 30+ points, and have now won eight of their last nine; in-between they posted an 11-15 mark in such contests).

BALANCED OFFENSE

The Miners couldn't have been any more balanced offensively at Rice, as they compiled 210 yards passing and 200 yards rushing. UTEP had 200+ yards passing and rushing in a game for the first occasion since the 2016 opener versus NM State (229 passing/289 rushing). Overall it marked only the third time in the last five seasons that UTEP posted 200+ yards passing and rushing in a game. The last time UTEP achieved the feat versus a C-USA opponent was on Oct. 5, 2013 versus LA Tech (237 passing/203 rushing).

BALANCED EFFORT ON THE ROAD

Against Rice, UTEP posted 200+ yards passing and rushing in a C-USA road game for only the fourth time since joining the league in 2005. This also happened in 2007 at SMU (overtime game, 250 passing/308 rushing) and in 2009 at Tulane (226 passing/260 rushing) and SMU (396 passing/231 rushing).

QUARTERBACK RUSHING

UTEP quarterbacks have been responsible for 434 of the team's 1,246 rushing yards (34.8 percent) in 2018. Quarterbacks have accounted for nine of the Miners' 15 rushing scores this season; the nine rushing TD's by signal-callers are a modern era (post 1965) school record. This is the first time since 2006 that three UTEP quarterbacks (**Brandon Jones**, **Kai Locksley**, **Ryan Metz**) have rushed for a touchdown in a season. Twelve years ago, **Lorne Sam**, Palmer and **James Thomas II** all turned the trick. Locksley and Jones both have games with multiple rushing touchdowns this season. Overall, a quarterback has led the Miners in rushing in five of nine contests this season.

LOCKSLEY CLOSING IN ON RECORD

With his sixth rushing touchdown of the season at Rice, **Kai Locksley** tied for the second-most rushing scores by a UTEP quarterback in the modern era (post 1965). **Gary Keithley** also had six in 1971, **Kevin Ward** had six in 1983 and **Rocky Perez** had six in 2000. The record is seven rushing TD's by **Bobby McKinley** in 1974. Locksley is tied for 20th nationally in quarterback rushing TD's and leads Conference USA in that department.

LOCKSLEY'S 100-YARD GAMES

With 106 rushing yards at UTSA (Sept. 29), **Kai Locksley** is the first UTEP quarterback to rush for 100 yards twice in a season in 35 years. Locksley ran for 119 yards at UNLV on Sept. 8. **Kevin Ward** rushed for 100 yards in the first and last game of the 1983 campaign, gaining 125 yards versus New Mexico State and 109 against Weber State. Locksley is the fifth UTEP quarterback to rush for 100 yards in a game since 1980.

MULTIPLE MINERS WITH RUSHING TD'S

Kai Locksley and **Quadraiz Wadley** both rushed for two touchdowns at Rice. The last time UTEP had two players with multiple rushing TD's in a game was on Nov. 15, 2014 versus North Texas (**Nathan Jeffery** three, **Aaron Jones** two). **Treyvon Hughes** also scored a rushing TD in the third quarter, giving the Miners three players with rushing scores for the first time since Sept. 29, 2015 at NM State (**Darrin Laufasa**, **LaQuintus Dowell**, **Ryan Metz** one each).

OFFENSIVE STANDOUTS VERSUS RICE

Warren Redix (63 yards) and **Erik Brown** (60 yards) accounted for 123 of the Miners' 210 receiving yards against the Owls. Redix now has 78 catches for 792 yards and five touchdowns in his UTEP career. Brown's 60 yards were a career high (previous best 52 yards versus UTSA in 2017). **Quadraiz Wadley** rushed 20 times for 91 yards, his third-highest total of the season and most since week four versus NM



State (111). The 91 yards were also his most versus a C-USA opponent in three years at UTEP. With 920 career rushing yards, Wadley needs 80 to join the 1,000-yard club. **Treyvon Hughes** rushed for a career-high 76 yards at Rice.

MOVING PARTS

Injuries have ravaged UTEP's offensive unit. The Miners started their eighth offensive line combination in nine games at Rice. **Jerrod Brooks** and **Zuri Henry** were the starting tackles, **Bobby DeHaro** and **Elijah Klein** were the guards and **Markos Lujan** was the center. True freshman Klein was playing in only his second collegiate game. Even so, UTEP put up 410 yards against the Owls, its third most of the season. The Miners had their most balanced effort of the season versus Rice with 210 yards passing and 200 rushing.

TRUST THE PROCESS

DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT

Could UTEP end the season with a top-50 defense? The Miners rank 56th nationally in total defense (382.8 ypg); a year ago they were 107th (446.6 ypg). Northwestern is 50th in the country in total defense (377.6 ypg). The Miners have climbed from 76th in the nation in total defense to 56th over the last three games. Over the final three contests, UTEP will face offenses currently ranked 99th (Middle Tennessee), 102nd (WKU) and 69th (Southern Miss) in the country.

UTEP'S "D" IN C-USA PLAY

The Miners have allowed 133 points (26.6 ppg) in their five C-USA games, but that number is misleading. The UTSA Roadrunners scored 14 points off turnovers that enabled them to start drives inside the red zone. Seven more points were tallied off a pick-six (at LA Tech), and two from a safety (against UAB). Deduct those 23 points, and the defense has surrendered 110 points (22.0 ppg). Last year in their eight league games, the Miners allowed 32.0 ppg and 410.9 yards against league competition. This year UTEP is giving up 354.2 yards per game versus C-USA opponents. UTEP is fifth in C-USA in total defense for league games only behind UAB (241.2), Southern Miss (274.2), Charlotte (299.4) and Marshall (345.4).

DEFENSIVE STANDOUTS VERSUS RICE

DBs **Michael Lewis** and **Kahani Smith** led the Miners with eight tackles apiece versus the Owls. Lewis paced UTEP in tackles for the second time, and for the initial occasion since the 2017 opener at Oklahoma (nine stops). LB **Jamar Smith** recorded his first career interception in the fourth quarter. DB **Justin Rogers** picked up his fourth career pick and has had at least one interception in each of his three seasons at UTEP. Rogers also matched his career high with two pass break-ups.

THIRD DOWN "D"

Over the last three games, UTEP opponents are 9-for-36 on third down conversions (25 percent). During that stretch the Miners have risen from 101st in the nation in third down conversion defense to 48th (.371). UTEP's third-down conversion defense for C-USA games only (.323) ranks fourth in the league. No UTEP opponent has converted more than 50 percent of its third downs in 2018 after eight of 12 achieved the feat last season.

DEFLECTING DUO

Senior DBs **Nik Needham** and **Kalon Beverly** have combined for 52 pass break-ups in their careers. Needham set the school record with his 26th career pass break-up in the second quarter against NM State and now has 31 pass break-ups. The previous record of 25 pass break-ups was held by **Jahmal Fenner**, who played for the Miners from 2001-04. Needham's seven pass break-ups in 2018 leads the team. Beverly tallied his third PBU of the season versus UAB and now has 21 in his career, tied for the 10th-top total in the Miner record book.

HOTCHKINS'S SECOND CHANCE

LB **A.J. Hotchkins** has made the most of his move from Oregon to UTEP. The graduate transfer has led the Miners in tackles in six of nine games, including five double-digit performances against Northern

Brent Stockstill, who was a game-time decision, made his first start since Sept. 9 at Syracuse. The junior threw for 190 yards on 13-of-30 passing and three scores. Nik Needham intercepted one of Stockstill's passes, as it was Needham's first of 2017 and second in his career.

POSTGAME NOTES

- True freshman RB Joshua Fields gained a career-high 87 yards on a career-most 17 attempts, including a career long 27-yard dash that helped set up a UTEP field goal.
- UTEP walk-on junior K/P Jason Filley connected on his first career field goal, a 26-yard make in the third quarter.
- Senior P Alan Luna punted nine times for a career-high 414 yards (46.0 avg.).
- Junior LS Jake Sammut tallied a pair of tackles – the first of his career – and downed a punt.

Arizona (13), Tennessee (10), North Texas (14), LA Tech (11) and UAB (career-high 15). Hotchkins ranks 23rd nationally and third in C-USA, averaging 10.1 tackles per game. He is averaging 10.4 tackles in C-USA games, second in the league. Hotchkins has 91 tackles and is on pace to tally 121 in 2018, which would be the most by a Miner player since **Troy Collavo** had 125 in 2006.

SPECIAL TEAMS STAR

Terry Juniel now has 1,896 all-purpose yards (five rushing, 530 receiving, 353 punt returns, 1,008 kickoff returns) in his UTEP career. Juniel needs just 25 kickoff return yards to tie **Johnnie Lee Higgins, Jr.** (1,033 yards) for 10th place in school history. Juniel has gone over 100 all-purpose yards three times this season, and leads the Miners with 637 in 2018. Juniel is 35th in the nation in combined kick returns (410).

SPECIAL TEAMS BITS

The Miners are third in C-USA in kickoff coverage (43.9 net avg.). **Terry Juniel** is second in C-USA in punt return average (5.2). **Jason Filley** is 19-for-20 on extra point attempts this season, and he's 6-for-9 on field goals. Filley is 8-for-9 on field goal attempts from inside 40 yards during his Miner career and hit his career-long 37-yard field goal against North Texas on Oct. 6. **Gavin Baechle** has converted 24 of his 35 kickoffs for touchbacks.

SEEING RED

The Miners finished 5-for-5 in the red zone with five touchdowns at Rice. In five C-USA games, UTEP is 13-for-15 in the red zone with 11 TD's. The Miners have the fourth-most prolific red zone offense in C-USA for league games only, converting at an 86.7 percent clip.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

There are nine programs in the FBS, including UTEP, that have sons playing for their fathers. UTEP first-year head coach **Dana Dimel** has his son, Winston, at fullback. The other eight programs include UAB (head coach Bill Clark and son Jacob), Colorado (head coach Mike Macintyre and son Jay), Tulsa (head coach Philip Montgomery and son Cannon), Navy (head coach Ken Niumatalolo and son Ali'i), TCU (head coach Gary Patterson and son Blake), Middle Tennessee (head coach Rick Stockstill and son Brent), Clemson (head coach Dabo Swinney and son Will) and Old Dominion (head coach Bobby Wilder and son Derek). Winston previously played at Kansas State (2015-17) where his father was the offensive coordinator. The younger Dimel earned a spot on the 2018-19 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List after garnering All-Big 12 honors each of the last three years.

Case Cookus completed 19-of-26 passes for 211 yards, and connected with Emmanuel Butler for a couple of scores as Northern Arizona spoiled UTEP's 2018 home opener with a 30-10 victory in the Sun Bowl.

Butler reeled in six catches for 138 yards for the Lumberjacks (1-0), who are coming off a seven-win campaign in 2017.

Junior college transfer Kai Locksley saw the bulk of the action at quarterback for the Miners (0-1) and was the team's leading passer (120 yards) and rusher (50 yards). His 18 carries were the most by a UTEP signal-caller in six years.

With Derron Gatewood and Greg Long both out with injuries, the Miners started two freshmen on the offensive line in LG Bobby DeHaro and LT Zuri Henry. UTEP tallied 229 yards of offense (127 passing, 102 rushing).

POSTGAME NOTES

- Junior QB Kai Locksley made his UTEP debut and rushed 18 times for 50 yards. The 18 rushing attempts were the most by a Miner signal-caller since Blaire Sullivan rushed 23 times for 74 yards versus UCF on Nov. 10, 2012.
- Senior WR Terry Juniel had a big night with 124 all-purpose yards, including 96 on kickoff returns and 24 on punt returns.
- Graduate transfer LB A.J. Hotchkins tallied eight first-half tackles on his way to 13 stops. The 13 tackles were the most by a UTEP player in an opener since Traun Roberson also had 13 stops against New Mexico on Sept. 7, 2013.

Lexington Thomas and Armani Rogers accounted for 230 of UNLV's 414 rushing yards, as the Rebels handed UTEP a 52-24 setback at Sam Boyd Stadium.

The Miners (0-2) trailed just 14-10 entering the second quarter, but the Rebels (1-1) put 24 points on the board in the next 15 minutes to take a 38-10 lead at the midway point. Then UNLV capitalized on a fumble by the Miners' Quardraiz Wadley deep in UTEP territory to start the third quarter, as Thomas' short touchdown run made it 45-10.

Wadley was coming off a big first half for UTEP, including a career-long 41-yard scamper.

The Miners were able to establish the ground game in the first half, running for 164 yards, but couldn't put the clamps on the Rebels' rushing attack as they pounded out 277 yards of their own.

UTEP got the run game going early and late, but struggled to move the ball in-between.

POSTGAME NOTES

- The Miners scored a touchdown on their opening possession for the first time since the 2017 season opener versus Oklahoma.
- Quardraiz Wadley posted the longest rush of his collegiate career (41 yards) in the first half. His previous longest run was 29 yards versus NM State on Sept. 3, 2016.
- Kai Locksley is the first UTEP quarterback to rush for two touchdowns in a game since James Thomas II did so versus NM State on Sept. 20, 2008.
- With 119 yards, Locksley is the first UTEP quarterback to rush for 100+ in a game since Blaire Sullivan gained 104 versus FIU on Nov. 16, 2013.

UTEP wasn't able to get its offense untracked. The Miners finished with seven first downs and 134 yards, including 39 passing. Kai Locksley completed 9-of-22 passes for 39 yards, and rushed nine times for 24 yards.

UTEP fell just shy of 100 yards rushing (95) as Treyvon Hughes and Quardraiz Wadley tied for the team lead with 33 yards apiece.

POSTGAME NOTES

- The attendance was 87,074. The crowd was the largest to witness a game involving UTEP since 92,863 attended the Miners' matchup at Texas on Sept. 10, 2016.
- Graduate transfer LB A.J. Hotchkins posted double-digit tackles (10) for the second time in three games. He had 13 stops in the opener versus Northern Arizona.
- Junior LB Dylan Parsee's nine tackles were a career best. He had six stops at Southern Miss on Oct. 14, 2017.
- The Miners picked up a pair of sacks today after tallying two in the first couple of games this season. The sack by Dylan Parsee was the first of his career, and the sack by Mike Sota was his second. Sota also recorded a sack in the opener against Northern Arizona.

Royce Caldwell scored the go-ahead touchdown on a long pass play late in the third quarter, and NM State held on for a 27-20 victory over UTEP in the FirstLight Federal Credit Union Battle of I-10 in the Sun Bowl.

On a third-and-five play near midfield, Aggie quarterback Josh Adkins hooked up with Caldwell for the 53-yard score with 2:46 remaining in the period, breaking a 17-17 deadlock.

The Miners (0-4) closed the gap to 24-20 on a 34-yard field goal by Jason Filley with 8:20 to go in the final period. UTEP held the Aggies (1-4) to a field goal and got the ball back with 3:24 remaining, but Kai Locksley's desperation pass on fourth and long was intercepted by NMSU's Austin Perkins to seal the outcome.

POSTGAME NOTES

- The 34-yard rush by Kai Locksley in the first quarter was the longest by a UTEP quarterback since Ryan Metz had a 42-yard run against North Texas on Nov. 26, 2016 in the Sun Bowl.
- Kai Locksley scored his third rushing touchdown of the season in the first quarter. The three rushing TD's are the most by a UTEP quarterback since Jameill Showers had four during the 2014 season.
- Keynan Foster registered a career-long 43-yard reception in the second quarter. The previous long catch for Foster was an 18-yard grab at UNLV on Sept. 8. With 56 yards receiving, Foster more than doubled his previous career best of 23 yards at UNLV on Sept. 8.
- The 76-yard pass and catch by Kai Locksley to Terry Juniel in the third quarter was the longest by a Miner duo since Ryan Metz completed an 83-yard reception to Tyler Batson versus LA Tech on Nov. 18, 2017. Juniel scored his first touchdown as a Miner in his 28th game for UTEP.
- Quardraiz Wadley picked up the second 100-yard rushing game of his career, finishing with 111 yards on 20 attempts.
- Nik Needham set a new school record with his 26th career pass break-up in the second quarter. The previous record of 25 pass break-ups was held by Jahmal Fenner, who played for the Miners from 2001-04.

UTSA built a big halftime lead, then held off a fierce UTEP second-half rally and topped the Miners, 30-21, in the Conference USA opener for both teams at the Alamodome.

The Roadrunners (2-3, 1-0 C-USA) led 24-7 at halftime, but allowed the Miners (0-5, 0-1 C-USA) to get within three points in the fourth quarter before holding them off at the end.

Jared Sackett kicked three field goals for UTSA, including a 51-yarder at the end of the first half and a 47-yarder with 35 seconds to go that put it away. He accounted for all six of the Roadrunners' points in the second half, when they were outscored 14-6.

The Miners scored two touchdowns in the second half, but couldn't come all the way back from a 24-7 deficit.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Kai Locksley picked up his fourth rushing TD of the season, the most by a UTEP quarterback since Jameill Showers also had four during the 2014 season. The last Miner with five rushing TDs in a season was Orlando Cruz in 2003.
- Kai Locksley (106 rushing yards) is the first UTEP quarterback to rush for 100 yards twice in a season since Kevin Ward in 1983. Locksley ran for 119 yards at UNLV on Sept. 8. Ward rushed for 100 yards in the first and last game of the 1983 campaign, gaining 125 yards versus New Mexico State and 109 against Weber State.
- The six-yard touchdown reception by David Lucero in the third quarter was the first by a Miner tight end since Josh Weeks scored on a two-yard catch at UAB on Nov. 25, 2017.
- Walk-on Tre'shon Wolf picked up his first college catch on a key third-down play in the fourth quarter. Wolf was also seeing his first action for UTEP tonight. He was the Miners' leading receiver with two catches for 38 yards.

Down 27-24, the Miners (0-6, 0-2 C-USA) got the ball back with 2:45 to go. Following a roughing the passer call on the Mean Green, UTEP had a first down at its own 31-yard line and a chance to win. But the drive stalled after that, as David Lucero couldn't corral Metz's long pass on fourth and 17.

The Mean Green (5-1, 1-1 C-USA) ran out the clock and averted a major upset.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Senior Jason Filley kicked the longest field goal of his UTEP career (37 yards) in the first quarter.
- The 29-yard TD pass from Ryan Metz to Quadraiz Wadley in the second quarter marked Metz's first TD pass since Nov. 18, 2017 versus LA Tech, and Wadley's first career touchdown catch.
- Metz passed and rushed for a touchdown in the same game for the third time in his UTEP career. This also happened at NM State in 2015 and against Rice in 2017.
- Metz (313 passing yards) is the first Miner to throw for 300 yards in a game since Jameill Showers passed for 365 yards at Colorado State on Sept. 28, 2013.
- Senior WR Warren Redix had a career night with seven catches for 131 yards. His previous career bests were five receptions versus Florida Atlantic (Oct. 24, 2015) and 75 yards at Old Dominion (Nov. 14, 2015).
- Redix posted the first 100-yard receiving game by a Miner in over two years. The last was a 102-yard effort by Eddie Sinegal at LA Tech on Oct. 1, 2016.
- The 67-yard TD catch by Keynan Foster in the fourth quarter gave him a career-high 76 receiving yards (previous high 56 yards versus NM State on Sept. 22). Foster's previous long catch was 43 yards in the aforementioned NM State game.
- The 313 passing yards were the Miners' most versus a C-USA opponent since compiling 376 at Tulsa on Oct. 11, 2012.

UTEP took LA Tech down to the wire in Ruston but Brandon Jones, on for the injured Ryan Metz, overthrew David Lucero in the end zone on fourth and 20 in the final seconds and the Bulldogs escaped with a 31-24 triumph.

The Miners (0-7, 0-3 C-USA), playing a game where they were tied or leading in the fourth quarter for the first time since the 2016 season finale, knotted it at 24 on a 36-yard field goal by Jason Filley with 11:23 to go. On fourth and one at the UTEP 43 with under seven minutes remaining, LA Tech quarterback J'Mar Smith broke free for a 43-yard rushing score that proved to be the difference in the game.

The Miners started their final drive at their own 49 with 1:47 to go following a 16-yard punt return by Terry Juniel. They got to the Bulldog eight, but a 15-yard facemask penalty was a back breaker.

POSTGAME NOTES

- The Miners played a game where they tied or led in the fourth quarter for the first time since Nov. 26, 2016, when they beat North Texas in the Sun Bowl 52-24.
- QB Ryan Metz completed 11-of-17 passes for 164 yards with a touchdown. His .647 completion percentage was his best since Nov. 26, 2016 versus North Texas (12-for-17, .706).
- Reserve QB Brandon Jones saw his first action for the Miners in relief of the injured Ryan Metz in the third quarter. The Bakersfield College transfer completed 7-of-15 passes for 98 yards.
- The Miners completed a season-high 19 passes, their most since Nov. 9, 2016 at Rice (19). Nine players caught passes, a season high.
- WR Keynan Foster posted a career-high 84 yards on four catches. He picked up 73 of those yards on the Miners' first touchdown drive in the first quarter.

UTEP held Conference USA West Division leader UAB to a season-low 19 points, but a depleted Miner offense was held scoreless on Saturday night in the Sun Bowl.

The Miners (0-8, 0-4 C-USA) limited the Blazers to 357 yards. The 19 points were the fewest scored by UAB (7-1, 5-0 C-USA) versus a Conference USA opponent in its remarkable two-year run since reinstating its football program.

The UTEP offense, however, was only able to generate 120 yards, including 19 rushing, against a stout Blazer defense that has now surrendered seven points or fewer in four of five league games.

POSTGAME NOTES

- The 357 yards by UAB were the second-fewest for the Blazers this season (333 versus Charlotte). The 92 passing yards were the second-fewest for the Blazers against a C-USA opponent since returning to football in 2017 (49 passing yards at UTSA last season).
- The 19 points were a season low for UAB, and its fewest versus a C-USA opponent since returning to football last year.
- Overall the 19 points were the fewest surrendered by the Miner defense since Oct. 7, 2017 versus WKU (15), and it marked only the second time in its last 20 league games (dating back to the 2016 season) that UTEP gave up fewer than 20 points.
- The blocked field goal by junior DT Denzel Chukwukelu in the second quarter was the first for the Miners since Nov. 19, 2016 at Rice. Chukwukelu had a career-high eight tackles.
- Grad transfer LB A.J. Hotchkins led the Miners in tackles for the sixth time in eight games. He finished with a career-high 15 stops. Hotchkins posted double-digit tackles for the fifth time this season and for the third consecutive game.

GAME 9 AT RICE

UTEP burst out to a 27-0 lead in a dominating first-half performance, then held off resurgent Rice in the second half for a 34-26 win, its first victory since 2016.

The Miners (1-8, 1-4 C-USA) stamped out their 20-game losing streak, notched their first win under coach Dana Dimel and handed Rice (1-9, 0-6 C-USA) its ninth consecutive defeat.

It was UTEP's first triumph at Rice Stadium since 2005, its initial year in Conference USA.

POSTGAME NOTES

- UTEP ended its 20-game losing streak with its first win at Rice since 2005.
- The Miners scored their first touchdown with 12:32 remaining in the first quarter. It was UTEP's quickest score versus a C-USA opponent since Nov. 5, 2011 at Rice (Nick Lamaison 74-yard pass to Mike Edwards, 13:57 on the clock).
- UTEP scored the game's first points for the third time this season, all in Conference USA play (at UTSA, versus North Texas).
- When Kai Locksley scored a one-yard rushing TD with 14:59 left in the second quarter, the Miners had a double-digit lead (13-0) against a C-USA opponent for the first time since Nov. 26, 2016 versus North Texas. UTEP's biggest lead was 35 points (52-17) in that game.
- Locksley's one-yard TD run with 17 seconds to go in the second quarter made it 27-0, marking the third time UTEP has scored the game's first 27 points versus a C-USA opponent (led 34-0 at UTSA in 2014, led 28-0 versus North Texas in 2014) since joining the league in 2005.
- Locksley and Wadley both rushed for two touchdowns. The last time UTEP had two players with multiple rushing TD's in a game was on Nov. 15, 2014 versus North Texas (Nathan Jeffery three, Aaron Jones two).
