## TIPOFF

UTEP will get another road test before finals week when the Miners play at Marquette of the Big East on Tuesday (Dec. 4) with tip-off set for 6:45 p.m. MT in Fiserv Forum.

The Miners (3-4) are coming off a 30-point blowout victory against Northwestern State on Dec. 1 in which UTEP's four scholarship freshmen combined for 50 points. The Golden Eagles (6-2) defeated no. 10/12 Kansas State, 83-71, behind junior Markus Howard's 45 points on Saturday afternoon.






On Saturday night, the Miners built a 17-point lead heading into the locker room and never looked back, beating up on Northwestern State, 77-47. Freshman guards **Nigel Hawkins** and **Jordan Lathon** each hit career highs with 16 points apiece, while Lathon displayed an all-around effort. Lathon led the Miners in rebounds (nine), dished out a trio of dimes, collected two steals and blocked a shot during a team-game high 31 minutes. Lathon threw down a dunk off a steal during UTEP's 8-0 run to open the game. Hawkins scored all of his points during the second half, connecting on 4-of-8 shots from downtown. Those treys were the first of his collegiate career and Hawkins sank them all with under four minutes remaining in the contest.

Fellow freshman **Efe Odigie** tallied another double-digit performance, scoring 14 points, recording five rebounds and blocking a shot, one of four for the Miners. Odigie has reached double-digit points in seven consecutive games to open his UTEP career. The last UTEP freshman to do so was **Henry Hall** in eight straight games to open the 1989-90 season. The last UTEP newcomer to achieve the feat was junior transfer **Lee Moore**, who went nine consecutive games with double figure points to christen the 2015-16 campaign.

## TUESDAY'S OPPONENT

Marquette is coming off an impressive 83-71 victory against no. 10/12 Kansas State on Dec. 1 as junior guard Markus Howard scored a 45-point performance against the Wildcats, while the Golden Eagles improved to 5-0 at home. Howard paces MU at 22.6 points per game and leads the squad with 38 assists. Sam Hauser averages 15.0 points per contest and is tied with brother Joey at 5.8 rebounds per game to lead the team. Joey averages 9.6 points per game. Overall, Marquette averages over 76 ppg and gives up over 66 ppg. MU's two losses came at Indiana (96-73) and against no. 2 Kansas (77-68) in Brooklyn, N.Y.

## THE SERIES

The last and only matchup between the teams was played on Dec. 7, 1962 during **Don Haskins's** second season as the Miners' head coach, as Marquette won 77-65 in Milwaukee.

## FRESHMEN TAKEOVER

**Nigel Hawkins** (16 points), **Jordan Lathon** (16 points), **Efe Odigie** (14 points) and **Kaosi Ezeagu** (four points) combined for 50 points against Northwestern State on Dec. 1. It's the most points scored by UTEP freshmen since last season, when **Trey Wade** (22 points), **Evan Gilyard** (14 points) and Kobe Magee (11 points) combined for 47 points at UAB. On Dec. 11, 1982, **Dave Feitl** (17 points) **Kevin Hamilton** (13 points) and **Wayne Campbell** (10 points) combined for 40 points.

## FRESHMAN PRODUCTION

UTEP has gotten 227 points (45.4 ppg) and 146 rebounds (29.2 rpg) from its five true freshmen this season. That puts the Miners on pace for 1,362 points and 876 rebounds from its freshmen over 30 games in 2018-19 (includes minimum one game in the Conference USA Tournament). It would mark the most points and rebounds by UTEP freshmen in a season. The 1977-78 Miners, received 1,134 points from the eight-man rookie class of **Roshern Amie**, **Anthony Burns**, **Tim Crenshaw**, **Earl Fuller**, **Joe Garrett**, **Kevin Jones**, **Darold Molix** and **Steve Yellen**. The 876 rebounds would shatter the previous UTEP record of 609 boards from its 1977-78 freshman group.

## CAREER HIGHS

Freshmen **Nigel Hawkins** and **Jordan Lathon** each hit career highs in points with 16 apiece against Northwestern State on Dec. 1. Jordan surpassed his previous high of 10 at New Mexico and Hawkins eclipsed his 12 points, also at UNM on Nov. 24.

## ALL-AROUND EFFORT

Besides **Jordan Lathon** hitting a career high in points, his all-around play is what stuck out on Dec. 1 against the Demons. Lathon led the Miners with nine rebounds, his second time doing so, and dished out three assists with two steals and a blocked shot. Lathon threw down a dunk during the Miners' 8-0 run to open the game.

## SECOND HALF FIRE

**Nigel Hawkins** scored all 16 of his points during the second half against NSU on Saturday night. He also connected on his first collegiate three-pointers – all made with under four minutes remaining in the contest. Hawkins finished 4-for-8 from downtown.

## SHOOTING IMPROVEMENT

After starting the season 2-for-16, **Nigel Hawkins** is shooting better at just over 41 percent (12-29). Hawkins is shooting over 31 percent (14-45) on the season.

## RARE ACHIEVEMENT

Freshman **Efe Odigie** has started his UTEP career by scoring in double-digit figures in his first seven games after tallying 14 points versus NSU on Dec. 1. Henry Hall was the last freshman to do so, as he scored in double-digits in his first eight games to open the 1989-90 season. The last Miner to open his career with consecutive double-digit efforts was junior Lee Moore, who scored in double-digits the first nine games to commence the 2015-16 campaign. Odigie opened his collegiate career with a 23-point performance on Nov. 6 and followed with back-to-back 13-point efforts (at NM State, at Arizona). Odigie then put in 14 points against ENMU, 11 points at New Mexico and 12 points against NM State.

## THREE-POINT PAUL

Senior **Paul Thomas** has connected on a career-high 11-made three-point buckets this year. Thomas didn't attempt a trey till his sophomore season when he went 0-for-3 in 2015-16. Last year, Thomas hit 8-of-29 three-point attempts. Thomas has

NEWLY ELIGIBLE

Redshirt junior transfer **Ountae Campbell**, after a petition was sent to the NCAA, was named eligible prior to the NM State contest on Nov. 28. Campbell gives head coach Rodney Terry another body off the bench as the 6-4 guard/forward played 15 minutes against the Aggies and another 16 against Northwestern State. Campbell led the Miners with four assists, chipped in with two points, four rebounds, and drew a pair of charges (third this season). Campbell played for Terry at Fresno State for two seasons before transferring to Casper College where he started in multiple games.

DEEPER BENCH

With **Ountae Campbell** now eligible and **Nigel Hawkins** making his collegiate debut at Arizona on Nov. 14, head coach **Rodney Terry** now had four bodies he can use off the bench **Kobe Magee**, **Kaosi Ezeagu**, **Gilles Dekoninck** and Campbell. Magee played in back-to-back 40-minute games to open the season, but has come off the bench the last five games, averaging 24.8 minutes per game.

EFE CLEANING GLASS

**Efe Odigie** ranks tied second in Conference USA at 8.6 rebounds per game. Southern Miss' Leonard Harper-Baker is averaging the same while WKU's Charles Bassey leads the league at 9.6 per game. Odigie also ranks third in defensive rebounds per game (5.9) and sixth in offensive rebounds per contest (2.7).

ODIGIE'S FG PERCENTAGE

**Efe Odigie** leads UTEP in field goal percentage (.563), while ranking fourth in Conference USA behind Florida Atlantic's Jailyn Ingram (.567), FIU's Devon Andrews (.630) and North Texas' Zachary Simmons (.686).

GETTING TO THE LINE

**Evan Gilyard** ranks third in Conference USA in free throw attempts (48), while Efe Odigie ranks tied fourth (44).

LEADING POINT SCORER

**Evan Gilyard** leads the Miners at 19.1 points per game, while ranking sixth in Conference USA and 43rd nationally. The sophomore has led the Miners in five of seven games in scoring this season, as his season high was a career-tying 29 points against ENMU. Gilyard recently led the Miners with 18 points against rival NM State on Nov. 28. and scored another 12 points against NSU on Dec. 1.

GILYARD BIG ON THE BOARDS

**Evan Gilyard** recorded six rebounds against NSU on Dec. 1, but not before ripping down nine rebounds against NM State on Nov. 28, his second most during his career. His career high is 11 on Nov. 19 against ENMU, while the 5-10 guard ranks second on the team averaging 5.3 rebounds per game and 7.3 rebounds per contest during the last four games.

3VAN SHOOTING TREYS

**Evan Gilyard** is tied for first in Conference USA and ranks 39th nationally in three-point shooting percentage (.475), while he ranks sixth in C-USA in three-pointers made per game (2.7).

GILYARD'S MINUTES

Evan Gilyard is averaging 36:49 minutes per game, ranking fourth in Conference USA and 22nd nationally.

CONSISTENT SHOOTING

**Kaosi Ezeagu** is shooting 11-for-13 during the last five games after going 2-for-2 against NSU. Ezeagu, at one point, had shot 7-for-7 during a three-game stretch (Nov. 14-24), including back-to-back 3-for-3 efforts against ENMU and at New Mexico. Ezeagu is shooting over 77 percent from the field.

OVERALL 3-POINT SHOOTING

UTEP ranks second in three-point shooting percentage (.383), behind North Texas (.402). Nationally, UTEP ranks 55th in three-point percentage. UTEP is averaging 7.0 three-point makes per contest.



### C-USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK [NOV. 26]

**Evan Gilyard**, ranked second in Conference USA in scoring (20.8 ppg), averaged 25.5 points per contest and 7.0 rebounds per game in UTEP's last two games. Gilyard also set career numbers in the process with his sharpshooting. Gilyard opened the week with a 29-point performance (matched career high) during the Miners' victory against Eastern New Mexico. The sophomore connected on a career-high 11 field goals from the field but really shined on the boards as he pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds, including five on the offensive side. Gilyard followed with his fourth 20-plus point effort (22 points) of the season in a hostile environment at The Pit. Gilyard went 5-of-9 from downtown and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe. Gilyard also recorded a steal and assist with a trio of rebounds against the Lobos.

### C-USA FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK [NOV. 26]

**Efe Odigie**, one of two players averaging a double-double (14.8 ppg, 10.2 rpg) in Conference USA and the league leader in rebounding, averaged 13.0 boards per game and 12.5 points per contest during his last two games. Odigie ripped down a career-high and single-game C-USA best 17 rebounds on Nov. 19 during a win against Eastern New Mexico. Odigie also scored 14 points, leading to his second consecutive double-double. At New Mexico, Odigie came up a rebound short of his third straight double-double. Odigie also recorded his first career assists (three) against the Greyhounds. Odigie scored 11 points against the Lobos on 4-of-5 from the field and 3-of-4 at the charity stripe, while connecting on a pair with ease down the stretch to play the Miners in the ball game. The big man played with urgency in the loud environment at The Pit, tallying a blocked shot, steal and five offensive rebounds. Odigie set the tone for the game when he dove for a loose ball in the opening minutes against the rival Lobos.

## UTEP SOPHOMORE SCORING NOTES

**Evan Gilyard** is averaging 19.1 points this season. The program record for a sophomore season scoring average is **Charlie Brown's** 21.1 points per game during the 1956-57 season, while **Nolan Richardson** averaged 21.0 points per contest during the 1960-61 campaign. UTEP's all-time leading scorer, **Stefon Jackson**, averaged 18.6 points during the 2006-07 season. **Randy Culpepper** scored the most points (648 in 37 games) for a UTEP sophomore (2008-09 season).

## 90 POINTS, MOST EVER IN A DEBUT

UTEP poured on 90 points on Nov. 6 to rev up the **Rodney Terry** Era. The 90 points scored was the most ever by a UTEP team during its head coaches' debut. **Doc Sadler's** squad opened his UTEP coaching career with 83 points on Nov. 21, 2004, while **Billy Gillispie's** team put up 75 points on Nov. 23, 2002.

## MARGIN OF VICTORY

UTEP's 27-point triumph during the season opener tied the second-largest for a UTEP coach in his debut. The largest is 33 points by **Doc Sadler** versus Delaware State (83-50) on Nov. 21, 2004. **George McCarty** also a 27-point win over Sul Ross on Dec. 2, 1953 (71-44).

## ROSTER MAKEOVER

Since head coach **Rodney Terry** was hired, he and his staff signed 13 new student-athletes. Of the 13 players, four will sit out due to NCAA transfer rules. Guard **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), guard/forward **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), forward **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will all be eligible for the 2019-20 season. Boum and Verhoeven will each have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two and Campbell will have one year of eligibility. Freshman **Deon Stroud** will be the sixth Miner to sit out, as he will concentrate on academics. Eight other newcomers will grace the roster as **Jakobe Dill**, **Kaosi Ezeagu**, **Nigel Hawkins**, **Jordan Lathon**, **Efe Odigie** and **Garrett Sullivan** makeup the remaining freshmen. Sophomore **Gilles Dekoninck** is the other new face, while redshirt junior **Ountae Campbell** is now eligible as of Nov. 28.

## BUILDING FOUR THE FUTURE

UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** will have four student-athletes sitting out during the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. **Souley Boum** (San Francisco), **Anthony Tarke** (NJIT), **Tyodus Verhoeven** (Duquesne) and **Bryson Williams** (Fresno State) will be eligible for the 2019-20 campaign. Boum and Verhoeven will have three years of eligibility, while Tarke and Williams will have two years. All four made major contributions at their respective previous programs. Williams, a 6-foot-8, 225-pound forward, was named All-Mountain West third team following his sophomore season after averaging 14 points per game. Verhoeven, a 6-foot-9, 215-pound forward, played in all 32 games, while starting the final 27 contests during his freshman campaign. He broke the school's freshman blocked shots record (71), while leading the A-10 in blocks per game (2.22). Tarke, a 6-foot-6, 220-pound forward/guard, led NJIT in scoring (15.7 p/g) during his sophomore season. Boum, a 6-foot-3, 160-pound guard, set USF's freshman record with 121 free throws made.

## TALENTED FRESHMAN CLASS

The 2018-19 UTEP roster will feature five freshmen who will be eligible for the upcoming season and should see significant playing time. **Rodney Terry** signed three freshmen guards in **Jakobe Dill**, **Nigel Hawkins** and **Jordan Lathon**, and forwards **Kaosi Ezeagu** and **Efe Odigie**. Odigie will be a physical presence in the paint with his 6-foot-9, 280-pound frame, while Ezeagu will also take up space in the paint with his 6-foot-10, 240-pound body. Dill (6-foot-3), Hawkins (6-foot-4) and Lathon (6-foot-4) are a trio of big and physical guards who will also provide athleticism at the position.

## JOINING THE MOVEMENT

UTEP Head Coach **Rodney Terry** announced three signees eligible to start playing next season. The 2019-20 season will see a pair of guards from the state of Texas. **Jesse Zarzuela** (Houston) and **Brendan Wenzel** (San Antonio) were officially signed on Nov. 14. Zarzuela is a 6-3, playmaking point guard, while Wenzel is a 6-6 sharpshooter. **Eric Vila** will transfer from Northwest Florida State College. He's a 6-11 all-around forward who will be eligible starting next season.

## COACH TERRY'S STAFF

**Rodney Terry** brought in three assistant coaches, **Lamont Smith**, **Brian Burton** and **Nick Matson**, with a wealth of coaching experience. Smith most recently served as the head coach at the University of San Diego for three seasons. He directed the Toreros from nine wins his first year (2015-16) to a 20-win campaign his final season (2017-18). Burton served as Terry's Director of Basketball Operations at Fresno State in 2017-18, but not before spending the previous three years (2014-17) as an assistant coach at Lamar. Matson was on Terry's staff for all seven seasons at Fresno State, most recently as an assistant coach.

## "C-USA BONUS PLAY"

Conference USA rolled out an innovative scheduling format for the 2019 league contests. The new C-USA schedule format will see the 14 teams play each other once and their travel partner twice in the first seven weeks of the conference season. UTEP will open at UTSA on Jan. 3, while the Miners and Roadrunners will play each other again on Jan. 5 in the Don Haskins Center. Following the first 14 league contests, teams will be placed into one of three groups based on their conference standing. The teams will be divided into two groups of five (1-5 and 6-10) and a group of four (11-14). During the final three weeks, teams will play four games (two home/two away) within their respective grouping. Home and away matchups will be determined by the preset formula.

## NEXT UP

UTEP will host UC Riverside on Sunday, Dec. 16 with a 1 p.m. tip-off in the Don Haskins Center. The contest can be seen on CUSA.TV. The Miners will then play in the WestStar Bank Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational Dec. 21-22. The Miners will open against Norfolk State.
