MINERS AT A GLANCE

▶ UTEP HEADS TO THE EAST COAST FOR CONFERENCE CLASH WITH FIU

UTEP will travel across two time zones this weekend as the Miners head to Miami for the a matchup against East Division foe FIU. Kickoff is set for 5 p.m. MT on Saturday, Oct. 19 at Riccardo Silva Stadium in Miami. The Miners and Panthers last met in 2016 in a game FIU won, 35-21, in El Paso. FIU leads the all-time series, 2-1, over UTEP, with the Panthers winning the only meeting between the two teams in Miami during the 2015 season.

▶ MINERS RANKED 17TH NATIONALLY IN THE ZONE

UTEP enters the week ranked 17th in the nation after putting up near perfect numbers in the red zone through the first seven weeks of the college football season. The Miners enter Saturday's road game at FIU 15-for-16 inside the 20-yard line. In five games, UTEP has eight touchdowns (7 rushing) and seven field goals for a total of 75 points put on the board in the red zone thus far.

▶ HUGHES SEES PAYDIRT

UTEP RB Treyvon Hughes is making a living finding paydirt for the Miners this season. The senior currently leads the Miners in TDs with five rushing scores in five games, which ranks 3rd in C-USA and 40th nationally. Hughes scored his first two TDs of the season in the 2019 season opener versus Houston Baptist, while he followed that performance with another pair of scores in UTEP's last home game versus Nevada. Following his performance against the Wolf Pack, Hughes became the first Miner to score multiple TDs in the first two home games of a season since Aaron Jones in 2014.

▶ MINER TRANSFERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Prior to the start of the 2019 season, the Miners saw two key additions to the team during fall camp, both of which are paying off in a big way early in the campaign. Ykili Ross (USC) and Devaughn Cooper (Arizona) both joined the Miners midway through camp, but it didn't take long for the two to make an impact. Ross currently leads the defense with a pair of interceptions, while Devaughn Cooper (Arizona) is one of the top receivers on the team with 10 catches for 147 yards.

TRUSSELL BECOMING A GO-TO TARGET FOR THE MINERS



UTEP tight end Jess Trussell, one of the many new additions for the Miners this season, has turned into a big target on offense through five games. The 6-5, 250-pound Trussell has caught a pass in every for the Miners, including a long reception of 37 yards against Nevada. Trussell had a pair of 13-yard receptions in the first two games and continued his strong play with three catches for 53 yards against the Wolf Pack. Against Southern Miss, Trussell had three catches for 33 yards, while he caught a pass for nine yards versus UTSA. A transfer from Purdue, Trussell had no catches in 22 games for the Boilermakers from 2016-18.

POUNDING THE ROCK AT HOME WITH HUGHES AND FIELDS



UTEP is averaging 41.0 rushing attempts in three home games in 2019. The Miners ran the ball 46 times in the opener versus Houston Baptist, 47 times versus Nevada and 30 times against UTSA. The last time UTEP had 46+ carries in consecutive home games was in 2014 against Texas Tech (53) and New Mexico State (58). The Miners are led by Treyvon Hughes and Josh Fields, who have combined for 102 carries, 477 yards and 5 TDs.

Senior punter Mitchell Crawford earned a 2018 All-Conference USA Honorable Mention following his first season with the Miners. The native of Townsville, Queensland, Australia, booted 73 punts for 2,909 yards (39.9 avg.) in 12 games played. Crawford added three touchbacks, 16 punts inside the 20-yard line and six punts of 50-plus yards. He ranked third in C-USA in total punts (73) and punt yards (2,909). In only his third collegiate football game played, Crawford produced career highs in punts (12) and punt yards (471) at Tennessee. He averaged a career-best 52.2 yards on six punts (313 yards), including a career-long 66-yard boot against Southern Miss.

BIG BACK

Senior Treyvon Hughes, after playing the linebacker position during the 2017 season, made the switch back to running back in 2018. The 6-foot-1, 235-pounder finished third on the team with 320 yards rushing and rushed for a touchdown – the first of his career. Hughes came to UTEP as a running back in 2015, then missed the 2016 campaign due to an injury. He bounced back and played in all 12 games on the defensive side of the ball, recording 40 tackles.

RETURNING WR VETS

Redshirt senior Kavika Johnson and redshirt junior Walter Dawn Jr. will return to the field after redshirting following the first four games of the 2018 season. Johnson has been versatile on offense, playing quarterback and receiver during his first four seasons. He enters his final year with 263 yards on 27 receptions and two touchdowns, while passing for 387 yards and four scores during his career. Dawn Jr. has tallied 285 yards on 22 receptions and a touchdown, while rushing for 151 yards and three touchdowns during his career. Back in 2016, Johnson hooked up with Dawn Jr. on a 74-yard touchdown pass at UTSA.

ADDING DEPTH

UTEP head coach Dana Dimel added depth to the Miners' 2019 roster on national signing day. Dimel inked 32 signees with 15 offensive players, 14 defensive players and three specialists. The Miners signed eight three-star recruits according to 247sports.com. It marked the most three-star signees for UTEP since 2010 (13), and the third-most since 2000. The Miners had eight mid-year enrollees, including defensive back Miles Banks, tight end Rashad Beecham, defensive back Robert Corner III, quarterback TJ Goodwin, safety Ty'reke James, tight end Luke Laufenberg, defensive back Duron Lowe and linebacker Joe Jay Smith.

JUST-IN TIME 🕒

Senior defensive back Justin Rogers has played in 35-career games dating back to his true freshman season in 2016. Rogers has registered 109 tackles, including a career-high 53 stops in 2018. The 195-pound nickel back has also picked off four passes, including the game-clinching interception at Rice on Nov. 3. Rogers has also tallied 15 pass breakups in his career, needing six to crack the program's all-time top-10 list.

STRONG PLAY FROM LEWIS

Senior Michael Lewis started in 11 of 12 games played at the strong safety position during his junior season in 2018. Lewis totaled a career-high 49 tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and posted four pass breakups. Career wise, Lewis has played in 34 contests and has tallied 134 tackles along with nine pass breakups. Lewis recorded a season-high eight tackles at Rice, while his career high is nine stops at no. 7 Oklahoma back in 2017.

TUPOU KNOWS TACKLING



Sione Tupou, after redshirting in 2016 and missing all of 2017 due to an injury, played in all 12 games last season, while making nine starts at the linebacker position in his first full season. Tupou finished fifth on the defense and returns with the most tackles at 60. Tupou produced solid numbers, adding 3.5 tackles for loss, a sack and a fumble recovery. Tupou established a career-best with nine tackles at LA Tech and posted another nine stops with a sack at WKU.

VETERAN PRESENCE ON THE D-LINE

UTEP improved from 107th nationally in total defense in 2017 to 68th in 2018. The unit will depend on the veteran presence of the defensive line to provide pressure on the quarterback. Denzel Chukwukelu brings three years of experience to the unit, having played in 30 games and making 16 starts. Chukwukelu led all UTEP defensive linemen with 42 tackles in 2018. He added 6.5 tackles for loss (21 yards) and 2.0 sacks (13 yards). He led the defense with seven quarterback hurries, while chipping in with a breakup, fumble forced/recovery and blocked two kicks. Also returning for his senior season is two-year letterwinner Chris Richardson. The nose tackle started all 12 games last season and has played in a total of 24 games. Richardson notched 31 tackles, while tallying 2.0 tackles for loss, two breakups and a pair of quarterback hurries during the 2018 campaign. Returning to the lineup is redshirt-sophomore Dedrick Simpson. The defensive lineman sat out the 2018 due to a season-ending injury. As a true freshman, he played in all 12 games and made four starts. Simpson registered 14 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss, one sack and a quarterback hurry in 2017.

Dana Dimel was named the 26th head coach in UTEP football history by Director of Athletics Jim Senter on Dec. 6, 2017 and is in his second season as UTEP head coach and his eighth season overall as a head coach.

Dimel directed the Miners to their first victory in two years with a 34-26 win at Rice on Nov. 3, 2018. The 34 points were the most for the Miners since the final game of the 2016 season. The Miners scored 32 points the next week against Middle Tennessee, making it the first time since 2016 that UTEP scored 30 or more points in back-to-back contests.

Under Dimel in 2018, transfer linebacker A.J. Hotchkins tied for the Conference USA lead with 126 tackles and finished 17th nationally in tackles per game (10.5). He added a team-high 7.0 sacks to earn an All-C-USA second team honor.

Seven other Miners earned postseason accolades as fullback Winston Dimel, offensive lineman Bobby DeHaro, tight end David Lucero, defensive lineman Chris Richardson, linebacker Jamar Smith, defensive back Nik Needham and punter Mitchell Crawford earned honorable mention All-C-USA.

Needham finished his career as UTEP's all-time leader in pass breakups (33) and signed a free-agent deal with the Miami Dolphins. Winston received an invitation to the Seattle Seahawks rookie minicamp, while Lucero (Oakland Raiders and New Orleans Saints), defensive back Kahani Smith (Seattle Seahawks) and offensive lineman Jerrod Brooks (Kansas City Chiefs) received invites to rookie minicamps.

UTEP's pass defense (198.9 yards per game) ranked fifth in Conference USA. The Miners also allowed the second-fewest completions (203) and pass yards (2,387) in C-USA. UTEP opponents averaged 26.8 attempts per game, which ranked no. 1 in the league.

Overall, the defense made improvements from the 2017 season. The Miners allowed over 440 yards in 2017, ranking 13th in Conference USA. The UTEP defense cut its yards per game allowed to 394.7 in 2018. The Miners yielded 4,736 yards, ranking sixth in C-USA. Quadraiz Wadley, who sustained multiple injuries during his first few seasons, played in all 12 games with 10 starts in 2018. Wadley led the way with 627 yards and seven rushing scores. Transfer quarterback Kai Locksley gained 340 yards and six touchdowns, while Treyvon Hughes rushed for 320 yards and a score. Three Miners rushed for more than 300 yards for the first time since the 2014 season.

Locksley was the first UTEP quarterback to hit the century mark in rushing twice (119 yards at UNLV, 106 yards at UTSA) since the 1983 campaign, and was also the first UTEP quarterback since 1994 to rush and pass for 100 yards in the same contest (106 rush yards, 117 pass yards at UTSA).

Locksley also led the Miners in completions (83) and passing yards (937), while fellow transfer field general Brandon Jones passed for 673 yards and four touchdowns. Jones's 340 yards at WKU on Nov. 17 were the most passing yards by a UTEP quarterback since the 2013 season. Ryan Metz threw for 313 yards against North Texas on Oct. 6.

Dimel was previously the head coach at the University of Wyoming and the University of Houston. He most recently served as the offensive coordinator, running backs coach and tight ends coach at his alma mater, Kansas State University, where he worked from 2009-17. He also spent three seasons on the staff at the University of Arizona.

Dimel completed his third tour of duty with the Wildcats, including a year (2005) continuing work on his graduate degree. Working under legendary coach Bill Snyder, he was a part of 12 bowl teams during 19 seasons in Manhattan. The Wildcats posted an 11-win season

(2012), two 10-win campaigns (1995, 2011) and five nine-win seasons (1993, 1994, 1996, 2014, 2016) during that span, and finished in the top-18 of the national poll on three occasions (2011, 2012, 2014). They won the Big 12 championship in 2012.

Dimel compiled the most wins of any active offensive coordinator in college football from 2011-17 (61), and was a part of eight straight bowl appearances including in 2017. The 2016 Wildcats defeated Texas, Texas A&M, Texas Tech, Baylor and TCU. With Dimel calling the plays over seven seasons, the Wildcats averaged 33.4 points per game and 6.2 yards per play. They ranked third nationally in fewest turnovers per game behind LSU and Alabama from 2011-17.

During Dimel's tenure as offensive coordinator, Kansas State routinely ranked among the nation's best teams in red zone and third down efficiency. In 2016, Kansas State rated 10th in the country in red zone offense and 22nd in third down conversions behind a rushing attack that rated third-best in the Wildcat record book (3,013 yards).

In 2014, Kansas State led the nation in scoring efficiency (scoring drives/total drives), while the Wildcats ranked 11th in the country in team passing efficiency, 14th in red zone offense, 16th in passing offense and 24th in scoring offense. K-State was also 25th in third down conversions and 12th in fourth down conversions while shattering the school record for passing yards (3,736) and completion percentage (65.3). The Wildcats tallied 5,481 yards of offense (fourth in the school record book) and 465 points (sixth).

Dimel's play calling helped wide receiver Tyler Lockett leave K-State with the school's career receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdown records, while quarterback Jake Waters broke the school marks for single-season passing yards (3,501) and total offensive yards (3,985).

Dimel's units found success again in 2013 as K-State rated eighth nationally in yards per completion and 13th in passing efficiency, while the Wildcats ranked fifth and third in school history in those respective categories. One of the best offenses in the nation on third downs (No. 13) and inside the red zone (No. 27), K-State ranked in the top-10 in school history in yards per play (second), total yards (fifth), passing yards (fifth) and points (eighth). John Hubert concluded his career as the Wildcats' no. 2 all-time leading rusher with 2,993 yards.

The 2012 season was another banner year on offense as Dimel co-coordinated an offense that finished in the top-25 nationally in nearly 10 categories, including a ninth-place ranking in yards per attempt, 11th in scoring offense and 13th in yards per completion. That year Dimel coached Heisman Trophy finalist Collin Klein, who passed for 2,641 yards and 16 touchdowns while rushing for 920 yards and 23 scores.

In 2011, Dimel led a rushing offense that saw Klein set a new Big 12 record and NCAA record by a quarterback with 27 rushing touchdowns while surpassing the 1,000-yard rushing mark on the season.

In 2010, the Wildcat offense ranked third in the Big 12 and in the top-25 nationally at 33.6 points per game. K-State was also ranked among the top-10 teams in the country in total red zone efficiency and No. 1 in touchdown percentage in the red zone.

In 2009 and 2010, Dimel had the charge of molding a former community college quarterback into a physical running back in the Big 12 Conference. That player was Daniel Thomas, and 2,850 yards and 30 touchdowns later, Thomas left Kansas State as a two-time Big 12 rushing champion, an All-American and the school's no. 3 all-time rusher.

Dimel started his career at K-State as a graduate assistant from 1987-88 prior to being elevated to offensive line coach in 1989. He took over as offensive coordinator in 1995. Overall Dimel spent 10 seasons in Manhattan (1987-96) prior to accepting the head coaching position at Wyoming. At the time of his hire, he was the youngest Division I-A head coach in the nation at the age of 34.

Wyoming's three seasons at Wyoming (1997-99) produced a record of 22-13, with one eight-win season (1998, 8-3) and two seven-win campaigns (1997, 7-6 and 1999, 7-4). The Cowboys posted a combined conference mark of 14-9 while splitting time in the Western Athletic Conference (1997-98) and the Mountain West Conference (1999). In 1998, Wyoming was 6-2 in the WAC's Mountain Division, good for a second-place finish. Dimel coached three Academic All-Americans at Wyoming.

Dimel spent 2000-02 as the head coach at Houston. Spearheading a major rebuilding effort, he led the Cougars to five wins in 2002 following a 0-11 campaign in 2001. In Dimel's final game with the Cougars, Houston upset

conference champion Louisville. Dimel brought in the top-ranked recruiting class in Conference USA in both 2001 and 2002 and coached Jeffrey Reynolds, who broke the C-USA season rushing record with 1,545 yards.

He continued work on his graduate degree at Kansas State in 2005 prior to taking over as Arizona's tight ends coach and, eventually, run game coordinator from 2006-08. In 2008, he added running backs to his list of responsibilities as he was promoted to Associate Head Coach with the Wildcats. The 2008 Arizona squad finished 8-5 while posting a bowl victory (Las Vegas Bowl) for the first time in 10 years. Among Dimel's protégés at Arizona was Rob Gronkowski, who has emerged as one of the top tight ends in NFL history with the New England Patriots.

During his initial tenure at K-State, Dimel coordinated an offense that established school records for touchdowns, points and yards in 1995. He mentored 11 offensive linemen who went on to sign NFL contracts over those 10 years, while he was also instrumental in developing

All-Americans Barrett Brooks, Jim Hmielewski and Quentin Neujahr.

During his career as a head or assistant coach, Dimel has coached 37 players who have gone on to play in the NFL.

Dimel was a two-year letterman as an offensive lineman at Kansas State. He was a member of the Wildcats' All-Decade Team for the 1980's. He signed a free agent contract with the Minnesota Vikings and attended training camp in 1987.

He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Marketing from Kansas State in 1986.

Dimel and his wife, Julie, have a son, Winston and a daughter, Josey. His son was a graduate transfer fullback on the UTEP football team in 2018. He previously played at Kansas State and scored 25 touchdowns over the three seasons. He was a three-time All-Big 12 player, garnering first team honors in 2015 and 2016.

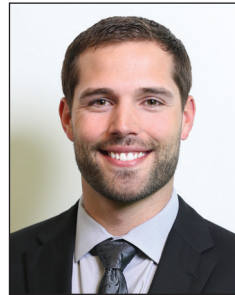

UTEP - 36 | HOUSTON BAPTIST - 34

AUG. 31 • EL PASO, TEXAS

EL PASO, Texas - Treyvon Hughes rushed 23 times for a career-high 144 yards and two touchdowns, and UTEP pounded out 240 yards on the ground in a 36-34, season-opening win over Houston Baptist in the Sun Bowl.

The Miners (1-0) rallied from a 28-20 third-quarter deficit, scoring 16 of the game's final 22 points before a crowd of 34,646, the largest for a home opener in five years. UTEP scored an emotional win while playing for the city of El Paso and fallen teammate Luke Laufenberg.

Gavin Baechle converted three field goals for UTEP, including a 35-yarder with 8:15 to go for the game winner.

Jones, making his second start for UTEP under center, completed 10-of-20 passes for 268 yards. His ten completions went to eight different receivers, as Wolf led the way with 96 yards on two catches. El Paso's own Josh Fields supplemented Hughes in the ground game, as he racked up 61 yards on only seven carries (8.7 ypc).

The Miners outgained HBU (0-1) 508-413 in total yards. With UTEP clinging to a 36-34 lead midway through the fourth quarter and the Huskies driving for another score, the defense needed to make a big play and it did. Chris Richardson sacked HBU quarterback Zappe inside the red zone and teammate Justin Rogers recovered the fumble to give the ball back to the Orange and Blue. The Miners were able to run out the final 5:57 on the clock.

A UTEP defense with a lot of new pieces was led by returning safety Rogers, who tallied 10 tackles.

LUBBOCK, Texas - Alan Bowman completed 30-of-45 passes for 260 yards and three touchdowns, including two to T.J. Vasher, leading Texas Tech to a 38-3 win over UTEP on Saturday night at Jones AT&T Stadium.

Vasher had six receptions for 78 yards for the Red Raiders (2-0), who compiled 424 yards of offense while holding the Miners (1-1) to 131 yards and 11 first downs.

Bowman completed four of his first five passes to get Texas Tech inside the red zone, before handing off to Ta'Zhawyn Henry on three consecutive plays. Henry closed out the drive with runs of eight, four and five yards, the last giving Texas Tech its first touchdown of the night.

The Miners were held to 11 yards in the first quarter. Early in the second quarter, Texas Tech increased its lead to 14-0 as Bowman capped a 10-play, 77-yard drive with a 13-yard scoring toss to Vasher.

With the Red Raiders driving for another score late in the second quarter, USC transfer Ykili Ross stepped up with a big interception at the UTEP 17-yard line, keeping it a two-possession game momentarily. The Miners gained 77 of their yards on the ground with three players - Josh Fields (27), Treyvon Hughes (27) and Locksley (21) - responsible for 75 of those yards.

Jones completed 4-of-12 passes for 21 yards, and Locksley finished 3-of-7 for 33 yards.

The Miners played a turnover free game. Justin Prince led the Miners in tackles for the second time in as many games with 10 stops, including nine of the solo variety.

EL PASO, Texas - UTEP battled Mountain West power Nevada on virtually even terms for three quarters, but the Wolf Pack took control in the final frame and escaped El Paso with a 37-21 victory on Saturday night.

The Miners (1-2) trailed 24-21 heading into the final period before Nevada (3-1), an eight-game winner and Arizona Bowl champion in 2018, pulled away down the stretch.

The Wolf Pack took advantage of a Kai Locksley interception deep in Miner territory late in the third quarter. Kelton Moore's five-yard rushing touchdown extended Nevada's lead to 30-21. UTEP's next drive stalled, and the Wolf Pack put the game away with an eight-play, 70-yard scoring drive, as Moore found the end zone once again on a one-yard scamper.

The UTEP offense gained 253 yards on 50 plays (5.1 avg.) in the first three quarters, but was held to 25 yards on 14 plays (1.8 avg.) in the final period.

Locksley and Brandon Jones split time at quarterback for the Miners, combining to complete 10-of-17 passes for 116 yards. Jones was 8-for-11 for 106 yards with an interception, and Locksley was 2-for-6 for 10 yards with two picks.

The Miners enjoyed more success running the ball, gaining 162 yards on 47 carries with Treyvon Hughes (17 carries-80 yards) and Josh Fields (10 carries-44 yards) carrying the load.

The Wolf Pack scored two touchdowns off the Miners' three interceptions. Justin Prince was UTEP's leading tackler for the second straight game with 10 stops. The Miner defense forced two turnovers, leading to seven points, and yielded 403 yards.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. - Kai Locksley gave the Miner offense a spark with 109 yards passing and 114 yards rushing, including a 63-yard touchdown, but UTEP wasn't able to overcome a slow start and dropped a 31-13 decision at Southern Miss on Saturday night.

Jack Abraham threw for 351 yards for the Golden Eagles (3-2), who won their Conference USA opener over the Miners (1-3).

Southern Miss jumped out to a 14-0 lead in the opening minutes. Abraham completed a 74-yard touchdown pass to De'Michael Harris on the third play from scrimmage. Then, after the Miners had a punt blocked, Southern Miss set up shop at the UTEP two-yard line and Harris ran for another score.

After that, the Miners hung in with the Golden Eagles, who are picked to finish second in C-USA's West Division, for the final 55 minutes.

Locksley, who didn't play in the fourth quarter, tallied his third 100-yard rushing game as a Miner. He accounted for 114 of the team's 126 rushing yards. Brandon Jones also saw extensive action for UTEP at quarterback and completed 6-of-13 passes for 59 yards.

Southern Miss outgained the Miners in total yards, 519-294. Kevin Perkins (65 yards) and Harris (62) combined for 127 of the Golden Eagles' 168 rushing yards.

EL PASO, Texas - Sincere McCormick and Lowell Narcisse both went over the century mark in rushing, leading UTSA to a 26-16 victory at UTEP on Saturday night.

McCormick gained 189 yards on 22 carries, and Narcisse added 115 yards on 19 attempts as the Roadrunners (2-3, 1-1 C-USA) compiled 320 yards on the ground and spoiled the Miners' (1-4, 0-2 C-USA) 88th Homecoming game.

Kai Locksley made his first start of the season at quarterback for the Miners. He completed 2-of-8 passes for 41 yards and rushed 13 times for 17 yards. Brandon Jones came on late in the third quarter with the Miners trailing 16-3. The Miners started the drive at their own 45-yard line after UTSA failed to convert a fourth down conversion. Jones led the Miners to their first touchdown of the night. He went 2-for-2 passing on the drive, rushed once for four yards, and handed off to Treyvon Hughes for an eight-yard rushing TD that made the score 16-10.

UTSA put the game away with a 51-yard rushing touchdown and a 26-10 lead with 4:02 to go.

The Miners continued to move the ball with Jones under center, as they put together a 15-play, 50-yard touchdown drive. Tre'shon Wolf's two-yard touchdown reception from Jones sliced the deficit to 10 (26-16) with 44 seconds remaining. But UTEP was unable to convert the two-point conversion to make it a one-possession game.

Wolf had a big night for the Miners with nine catches for 91 yards. Jones finished 14-of-22 passing for 140 yards. Treyvon Hughes rushed 10 times for 62 yards and a score.

UTSA finished with 366 yards of offense while holding UTEP to 280. The Roadrunner defense tallied nine tackles for losses, four sacks and seven pass breakups. The defensive standouts for UTSA were Trevor Harmanson (three tackles for losses), Cassius Grady and SaVion Harris (two passes deflected apiece), and Jarrod Carter-McLin (two sacks).

Adrian Hynson and Michael Lewis both had 10 tackles for the Miners. The tally for Hynson was a career high.
