## AGENTS REMINDER

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.



## SPORTS WAGERING (GAMBLING)

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities with or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

## Prospect Medical Exams (\*2019-20 New Legislation)

An institution's medical staff members, including athletic trainers, may conduct medical screenings for prospects while on recruiting visits. (e.g., official or unofficial visits)

- Non-medical staff members (e.g., coaches, managers, GAs, noncoaching staff members) may not be present and the exam cannot test the athletics agility or skill of the prospect.
- A physician must still perform the mandatory medical examination for incoming student-athletes.
- This legislation is effective immediately.

## Coach/Staff Appearance Request

There are limits on coach's and staff member's ability to attend or speak at events, including those that take place either at a prospect's educational institution, or at events where prospects are in attendance at locations other than a prospect's educational institution. Among other things, coaches and staff cannot:

- Attend or speak at events held during dead periods if prospects attend.
- Promote prospects' teams, coaches, or athletic facilities.

## Coaches Attending Funeral or Memorial Services (\*2019-20 Revised Legislation)

Institutional staff members may now attend the funeral or memorial services of a student-athlete, prospect, or member of the student-athlete's or prospect's family, where prospects are in attendance, provided no recruiting contacts occur.

## Recruiting During Camps/Clinics (\*2019-20 Revised Legislation for Olympic Sports)

Interactions during camps and clinics between prospective student-athletes and those coaches employed by the camp or clinic are not subject to the recruiting calendar restrictions. However, keep in mind that UTEP staff members employed at any camp or clinic are prohibited from recruiting any prospective student-athlete during the time period that the camp or clinic is conducted (from the time the prospective student-athlete reports to camp to the conclusion of all camp activities). The prohibition against recruiting includes extending verbal or written offers of financial aid to any prospective student-athlete during his or her attendance at the camp or clinic. Additionally, game day simulations are not allowed during UTEP camps and clinic which involve prospects.

- Exception: In sports other than Softball, Basketball and Football, recruiting conversations during a camp/clinic may only occur between an institution's coach and participating individuals after August 1st, at the beginning of the individual's junior year of high school.
- Exception: In Softball, recruiting conversations during a camp/clinic may only occur between an institution's coach and participating individuals after September 1st, at the beginning of the individual's junior year of high school.
- Exception: In Women's Basketball, a coach may engage in recruiting activities (e.g., campus tour, meeting with academic advisor) with prospects during camps or clinics. Additionally, telephone calls that relate solely to institutional camps/clinics may be made during the July evaluation periods, provided no recruiting conversations or solicitation of particular individuals to attend a camp/clinic occur during the call.
- Exception: In Football, a coach may engage in recruiting conversations with prospects during the time period that the camp/clinic is conducted. (from the time of reporting to the conclusion of camp activities)
- Exception: In Men's Basketball, it is permissible for a coach to recruit prospective student-athletes during the institution's camp or clinic.
