AGENTS REMINDER

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.

SPORTS WAGERING [GAMBLING]

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities within or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

All students on a book athletics scholarship must return all of their books to the bookstore by Friday, May 13th.

*Failure to do so will constitute a charge of 100% of the cost of all books assessed to your account. If this happens, you can sell your books to help you pay for this charge.

SUMMER EMPLOYMENT REMINDER

Please be reminded of the rules regarding employment for student-athletes:

- (a) Only for work actually performed; Compensation may not be awarded based on athletics ability
- (b) At a rate commensurate with the going rate in that locality for similar services; and
- (c) An employer shall not use the athletics reputation of a student-athlete employee to promote the sale of the employer's product or services
- (d) Must be documentation of payments
- (e) The employment form must be submitted to the Compliance Office

OUTSIDE COMPETITION

Student-athletes who would like to compete on an outside team during the summer must submit the Outside Competition Form to the Compliance Office for approval prior to the start of the competition.

14.1.1.1 INELIGIBILITY FOR USE OF BANNED DRUGS

A student-athlete who, as a result of a drug test administered by the NCAA, is found to have used a substance on the list of banned drugs, shall be declared ineligible for further participation in postseason and regular-season competition in accordance with the ineligibility provisions

16.11.1.4 RETENTION OF ATHLETICS APPAREL AND EQUIPMENT

A student-athlete may retain athletics apparel items (not equipment) at the end of the individual's collegiate participation. Used equipment may be purchased by the student-athlete on the same cost basis as by any other individual interested in purchasing such equipment

VOLUNTARY SUMMER CONDITIONING

Workouts during the summer are strictly voluntary, and coaches/non-coaching staff members may not observe/attend such workouts or require student-athletes to participate in such workouts. (There are sport exceptions)

Student-athletes may not be penalized if he/she elects to not participate. Furthermore, no recognition or awards may be bestowed on those who do participate.
