UTEP ATHLETICS COMPLIANCE LETTER



AGENTS REMINDER

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.

SPORTS WAGERING (GAMBLING)

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities within or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

NATIONAL LETTER of INTENT

Early Signing Period

The Early Signing Period for the National Letter of Intent (NLI) begins November 13, 2013 for all sports EXCEPT: Football, Soccer and Track. The below table lists the start and end date for each sport.

- A prospective student-athlete (PSA) may not sign the NLI prior to 7:00 AM on November 13, 2013 and the final signing date is November 20, 2013 for all sports in the signing period.
- A PSA has 7 calendar days to sign the NLI from the date of issuance.
- Please submit all NLI requests to Fadia as soon as possible. The earlier, the better.
- **November Dead Periods for all sports in the NLI signing period: November 11-14**

Calls and Texts after Commitment



Institutional coaching staff members (see Bylaw 13.1.3.4.1) may make unlimited telephone calls to a prospective student-athlete on the initial date for the signing of the National Letter of Intent and during the two days immediately following the initial signing date. One calendar day after a PSA has signed a NLI, Financial Aid Agreement/Offer of Admission, or submitted a financial deposit to UTEP, there is no limit on the number of phone calls or text messages that may be sent to the PSA.

Publicity after Commitment

There is no restrictions on publicity after a PSA signs a NLI, FAA/Offer of Admission, or makes a financial deposit to UTEP. Coaches are permitted to write on the Facebook walls of PSAs, like their photos on Facebook or Instagram, and post on their Twitter feed.
