AGENTS REMINDER

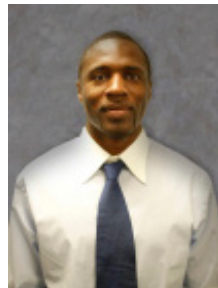
Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.

SPORTS WAGERING [GAMBLING]

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities within or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS REMINDERS

Official Visits (13.6.7.2)

- Maximum of three tickets to a home athletics event for use of PSA and those accompanying them
- Nontraditional family exception – If PSA is a member of a non-traditional family (ex- divorce or separation) two additional tickets may be provided to accommodate the parents accompanying the PSA
- Football exception – Two additional tickets may be provided to the PSA to accommodate other family members accompanying the PSA on the visit (ex- siblings, grandparent, domestic partner)
- PSA needs photo identification to receive complimentary admission

Unofficial Visits (13.7.2)

- Maximum of three tickets to a home athletics event for use of PSA and those accompanying them
- Nontraditional family exception – If PSA is a member of a non-traditional family (ex- divorce or separation) two additional tickets may be provided to accommodate the parents accompanying the PSA
- PSA needs photo identification to receive complimentary admission

RECRUITING SEASON IS IN FULL SWING! OFFICIAL VISIT REMINDERS (BYLAW 13.6)

- In sports other than basketball, an expense paid visit may not be provided earlier than the opening day of classes of the PSAs senior year
- A person who is not a qualifier and who is enrolled at a two-year college may not be provided an expense-paid visit until they have completed an academic year at the two-year college
- Institutional official visit limits
Football: 56, Basketball: 12
- Unused visits in football – May carryover a max of six unused official visits to be used in the following academic year
- If a high-school PSA, the following must have on file with compliance
 - o National Test Score if in high school (ACT, PLAN, PSAT, SAT)
 - o High School
 - o Must register with Eligibility Center and be placed on institutional request list
- If a transfer PSA, just need college transcript on file
- Visit is limited to 48 hours in length, exemption for extenuating circumstances beyond PSA and institution's control (cancelled flights, inclement weather conditions, etc.)

STUDENT ATHLETE COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS / GUEST LIST (16.2)

We have had a few issues already this academic year with individuals on the complimentary admissions list. Please review the following reminders:

- May be provided four complimentary admissions per event in the sport in which the individual participates regardless of whether the SA competes in the contest
- No boosters or agents may be allowed on the pass list

- Complimentary admissions tickets may not be sold or exchanged for any item of value
- All those receiving complimentary admissions must have valid photo identification in order to receive their ticket (exception only made for individuals below high school age)
- It is the responsibility of the student-athletes to be knowledgeable of complimentary admission regulations and inform their guests of the requirements

COACH ACCOMPANIES PSA ON VISIT

If a high school or JUCO coach of a PSA that is on their official or unofficial visit, UTEP is limited to providing a maximum of 2 complimentary admissions to the coach. A high school/ JUCO coach may also receive transportation in relation to the visit as long as the PSA is in the car and it is limited to transportation on campus to view athletic facilities.

UTEP may not provide the following to the coach:

- Any food/refreshments related to the visit
- Any transportation other than the above allowance (including flight, transportation to/from airport, etc.), or reimbursement for transportation expenses
- Any hotel/lodging expenses
- Any entertainment outside of the permissible 2 complimentary admissions
