MINERS AT A GLANCE

> UTEP TO TAKE ON UC IRVINE IN THE SUN BOWL INVITATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME TUESDAY NIGHT

The UTEP Miners (7-1) will play in the nation's oldest holiday tournament championship game for the first time in two years when it takes on UC Irvine (7-5) in the 58th Annual WestStar Bank Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational Tuesday night in the Haskins Center. Kent State (8-2) will take on North Carolina A&T (3-8) in the consolation game with tipoff set for 5 p.m. The Miners and Anteaters will start 20 minutes following the first contest.

> LAST GAME [UTEP 72, NORTH CAROLINA A&T 54]

Bryson Williams produced his second double-double (21 points, 10 rebounds) of the season after going 6-for-6 from the free-throw line and 3-of-4 from downtown. Williams scored 15 of his 21 points in the second half. **Souley Boum** made a career-high five three-point buckets on his way to 26 points - his most in a Miner uniform. Boum scored 26 points on a pair of occasions while at San Francisco during the 2017-18 season. The redshirt sophomore out of Oakland, Calif., added a season-high seven rebounds and dished out three assists.

> WILLIAMS ON A TEAR

Bryson Williams Williams has averaged 25.0 points and 9.3 rebounds per game during the last four contests. He's connected on 72.0 percent (36-50) of his buckets, while making 7-of-10 three-pointers and shooting 91.3 percent (21-23) from the charity stripe.

> WILLIAMS' TORRID START

Bryson Williams is averaging a team-leading 19.6 points and 7.5 rebounds, and his .700 field goal percentage ranks fourth nationally behind Kansas' Udoka Azubuike (.831), Evanville's DeAndre Williams (.724) and FIU's Osasumwen Osaghae (.718). The real revelation in Williams' game has been his three-point shooting. He has made 9-of-13 attempts from beyond the arc (team-leading .692). In his first two seasons at Fresno State (2016-18), Williams was a combined 1-for-4 (.250) from downtown.

UC Irvine has won four of its last five games. Collin Welp leads UCI in points per game (14.3) and rebounds per contest (6.4). Eyassu Worku averages 10.9 points per game. Welp led the way with 18 points on Monday night, while Eyassu chipped in with 15 points and six assists, and Brad Greene with 16 points. UCI outrebounded Kent State, 35-32, and recorded six steals. The Anteaters defeated San Diego, 76-73, on Nov. 5, while defeating Boise State by nine points (69-60) on Nov. 15 in Idaho. Prior to its win Monday night, UCI trashed Pacific Union, 120-63, behind 22 points from Austin Johnson and 21 from Tommy Rutherford.

QUICK NOTES ON THE TOURNEY

UTEP is 87-28 in 57 previous Sun Bowl Tournaments. The Miners opened first round action against North Carolina A&T with a 72-54 win, as they are now 46-12 in the first round of the Sun Bowl Tournament. The Orange and Blue have won 31 Sun Bowl Tournament titles, but not since 2014 when it defeated Kent State, 78-75, on Dec. 22. UTEP last played in the championship game on Dec. 22, 2017. The Miners fell to North Dakota State, 63-51, that night.

SEASON HIGHS VS. NC A&T

UTEP made a season-high 13 three-point buckets, while registering a season-best 48.1 percent from downtown. The Miners also dished out a season-high 18 assists against the Aggies Monday night. **Tyodus Verhoveen** made his second consecutive start, playing a season-high 23 minutes, while dishing out a season-most three assists.

HEAR THE BOUM

Souley Boum tied his collegiate career high with 26 points Monday night versus North Carolina A&T. He accomplished the feat two other times while at San Francisco. He scored 26 points at Portland on Dec. 30, 2017, while going for 26 against Colgate on March 14, 2018. Boum connected on a collegiate career-high five three pointers, while he added a season-high seven rebounds against NC A&T.

FAST START IN THE CITY

The Miners are 7-0 in the Haskins Center for the first time since the 2003-04 season. Overall, it marks just the second time in the 2000's that UTEP has won its first seven home games. UTEP began the 2003-04 campaign 8-0 in the Haskins Center before falling to Boise State, 98-94, to begin Western Athletic Conference action on Jan. 3, 2004. The Miners are also one of four remaining Conference USA teams with unbeaten home records along with FIU (4-0), LA Tech (5-0) and WKU (4-0).

MAKING A BOUM AT THE LINE

Souley Boum has made his first 24 free throws to start the season before missing his first against North Carolina A&T. It's the longest streak by a Miner since **Omega Harris** who made 22 straight foul shots during the 2017-18 campaign. The school record for consecutive made free throws is 46 by **Antoine Gillespie** during the 1993-94 season. For his collegiate career, Boum is an 84.9 percent (147-for-173) free throw shooter.

WILLIAMS JOINS 30-POINT CLUB

Bryson Williams became the 26th player in UTEP basketball history -- and the second on the 2019-20 roster -- to score 30 points in a game against East Central on Nov. 27. His 33 points were the most by a UTEP player since **Dominic Artis** also tallied 33 points versus Marshall in the Haskins Center on Feb. 4, 2016. Miner teammate **Jordan Lathon** posted 32 points against Rice last season.

SLAM CITY IN THE SUN CITY

The Miners have tallied 21 dunks in the first seven games of the 2019-20 season. Last season, UTEP recorded 20 total slams. **Bryson Williams** leads the way with 12 dunks (1.5 per game).

BEST IN THE LEAGUE

Nigel Hawkins' six steals versus East Central (Nov. 27) are tied for the most by a C-USA player early this season. Old Dominion's Jason Wade also recorded six thefts versus Northern Iowa on Nov. 5. **Bryson Williams'** 33 points against East Central are also tied for the most by any league player to date in 2019-20.

HAWKINS STEALING THE NIGHT

Nigel Hawkins tallied a career-high six steals against East Central on Nov. 27. His total tied for 10th best during a single game. The feat was achieved 12 times by nine different Miners in program history. Tim Hardaway did it twice and Randy Culpepper registered six steals on three occasions. Hawkins's total was the most since Earvin Morris snagged six at North Texas on Jan. 2, 2015 while the six steals in the Haskins Center were the most since Culpepper did it against Marshall on Valentine's Day 2009. Edgar Moreno (eight steals) holds the school record, while seven steals is the second most done by five different Miners.

SHOOTING GALLERY

The Miners have been a solid shooting team early in 2019-20 as their field goal (.474) percentage ranks fourth and free throw (.740) percentage ranks third in C-USA. The Miners have struggled from three-point range (31.1 percent), so they've connected on 57.9 percent (146-of-252) of their two-point tries.

STIFLING DEFENSE

The Miners' scoring defense (59.3 ppg) ranks first in Conference USA and 23rds nationally. UTEP's field goal defense (37.9) ranks second in C-USA behind LA Tech (37.7). The Miners rate 31st nationally in field goal percentage defense.
