AGENTS REMINDER

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.



SPORTS WAGERING (GAMBLING)

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities with or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

Super Bowl Gambling Reminder

Will Tom Brady win his sixth ring? Or will the LA Rams finally win a Super Bowl after 20 years? Either way, **don't bet on it!** UTEP staff, coaches, and student-athletes cannot participate in sports wagering activities related to the Super Bowl that have entry fees or other associated costs (e.g., point squares, prop bets, daily fantasy).

UTEP Camps and Clinics

Any sport camp or clinic owned and operated by the athletic department or its staff members, with prospective student-athlete participants is subject to NCAA legislation on camps and clinics.

Recruiting Conversations

During UTEP camps and clinics, recruiting activities are limited to only recruiting conversations between prospects and countable coaches. In football and basketball, coaches may have recruiting conversations with all prospects attending the camp. In all other sports, coaches may have recruiting conversations with prospects only after September 1 of their junior year of high school.

Please note coaches and staff may not have recruiting conversations at non-institutional camps or clinics.

Prospects and Incoming Student-Athletes Working Camps

The general rule is prospects cannot be employed at camps considered "institutional" under NCAA legislation (i.e., owned or operated by an employee of UTEP) or any other camp conducted at UTEP at which UTEP coaches are employed.

One exception to the general rule, however, allows camp operators at UTEP to employ prospects who have signed NLI or scholarship agreements with UTEP or for whom UTEP has received a financial deposit in response to admission.

Remember! NCAA employment rules apply to camps (e.g., prospects and student-athletes must be paid the going rate). In addition, prospects and student-athletes may not be compensated if they only demonstrate or lecture.

Camps/Clinics Advertisements

All advertisements for camps and clinics must include the language that the event is "open to any and all entrants", regardless of the form the advertisement takes (e.g., social media posts, email, flyers/brochures). Prospect aged participants at a UTEP run camp or clinic may only be limited by number, age, grade level and/or gender.

In order to avoid violations related to camps and clinics the athletics compliance office requires a total of 5 different forms be filled out for each camp hosted. Please fill out the appropriate forms with the athletics compliance office prior to hosting any camp or clinic.

Competing While Not Representing UTEP

Competing while not representing UTEP athletics allows student-athletes in individual sports to maintain redshirt status or not use a date of competition if the student-athletes:

- Represent only themselves and not a club, team, or other organization;
- Receives no coaching from UTEP staff members and does not wear any UTEP apparel or uniform;
- Pay all their own expenses, including travel costs and participation fees.

A student-athlete who is competing as an individual may accept prize money that does not exceed the student-athlete's actual and necessary expenses.

Compliance Approval: All student-athletes must fill out an Outside Competition Approval form with the Athletics Compliance Office in order to assure they are in compliance with NCAA rules and to prevent any loss of eligibility.
