## AGENTS REMINDER

Any agreement with an agent, in writing or verbally to market his or her athletic skills will render a student-athlete ineligible for intercollegiate athletic competition. Additionally, any athletics department staff member that introduces an agent to a student-athlete is in violation of NCAA Bylaw 10.1.



## SPORTSWAGERING (GAMBLING)

The NCAA prohibits any athletics department staff members, staff members who have responsibilities with or over the athletics department, and student-athletes from wagering anything of tangible value on intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition.

## Super Bowl Gambling Reminder

Patrick Mahomes or Jimmy Garoppolo? Andy Reid or Kyle Shanahan? Chiefs or Niners? Either way, don't bet on it! UTEP staff, coaches, and student-athletes cannot participate in sports wagering activities related to the Super Bowl that have entry fees or other associated costs (e.g., point squares, prop bets, daily fantasy).

## Nonchampionship Segment Reminders

### Season of Competition

In Soccer, Volleyball, and Softball, a student-athlete may engage in intercollegiate competition during the segment of the playing season that does not conclude with the NCAA championship without using a season of competition, provided the student-athlete remains academically eligible during the segment that concludes with the NCAA championship.

### Academic Requirements

Student-athletes are not permitted to miss class time in conjunction with nonchampionship segment competition, including activities associated with such competition (e.g., travel and other pregame or postgame activities).

### Maximum Number of Contests

Soccer is limited to 5 contests during the nonchampionship segment. Volleyball is limited to 4 contests during the nonchampionship segment.

### Travel Restrictions

Travel to and from competition is restricted to ground transportation and must be within 400 miles of UTEP.

## Film Review with Prospects

Prospects who have signed with UTEP (e.g., NLI or financial aid agreement) may not participate in any film review activities with coaches. But unsigned prospects may watch film with coaches as part of the recruiting process. Additionally, an unsigned prospect may attend a closed film review session with the team during an official or unofficial visit to campus.

### Coaches may not:

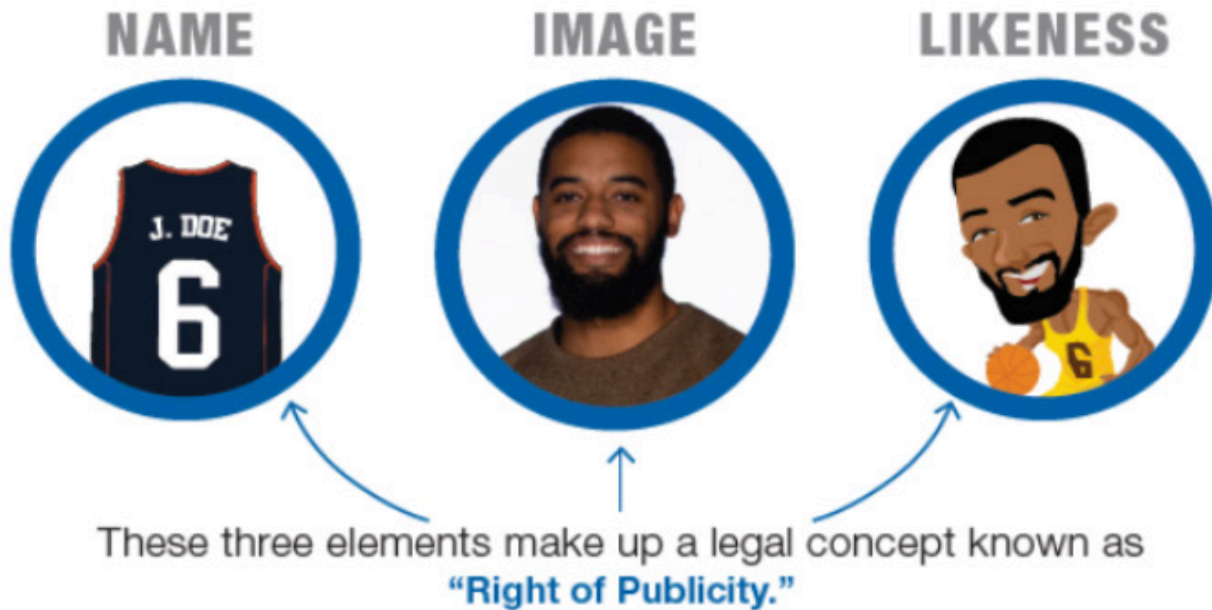
- Provide technical or tactical instruction to the prospect while watching film.
- Watch film with a prospect on a regular basis (e.g., weekly or frequently).

### But coaches may:

- Watch UTEP game film with the prospect and provide feedback regarding how the prospect fits in UTEP's program.
- Watch the prospect's film (e.g., game or highlight film) with the prospect and provide general feedback.

# Name, Image, and Likeness

## What "Name, Image and Likeness" Means



Examples of Name, Image and Likeness Related Activities: autographs, personal appearances, promoting a business, sale of merchandise with name, image or likeness, social media endorsements, representation in video games.

## Current Rules for NCAA Student-Athletes

In general, a Division I student-athlete may not use their name, image or likeness to promote or endorse a commercial product or service, even if he or she is not paid to participate in the activity.
