## OPENING TIP

The UTEP men's basketball team (11-8, 2-2 CUSA) will look to build on the momentum of its first league home sweep in two years when it plays at league-leading LA Tech (13-6, 3-1 CUSA) at 5 p.m. MT/6 p.m. CT Thursday. The Miners clawed back to .500 in CUSA play and into a tie for fourth place in the conference by knocking off both Middle Tennessee (W, 73-59, Jan. 18) and WKU (W, 93-87, Jan. 20). They will have quite the task at hand to secure a third consecutive victory, however, with the Bulldogs sitting atop CUSA in three-way tie for first place. Furthermore, LA Tech is undefeated (9-0) at home on the season and is riding a three-game winning streak. Most recently, it drilled Jax State on the road, 74-57, on Jan. 20. It was just the fourth triumph by a road team within conference play since it commenced, and LA Tech is responsible for two of them. UTEP will be looking to join that exclusive group thus far in league action, in addition to vying to secure its initial road victory (0-5) of the season. The Miners nearly pulled that off at FIU on Jan. 13, as they led by 15 with seven minutes remaining before the Panthers rallied for a 72-68 win. One thing to keep an eye on is that UTEP leads the nation in both steals per game (11.9) and turnovers forced per contest (19.3), but LA Tech is second in CUSA in ball security by making just 12.2 turnovers per tilt. They have 11 games with 12 giveaways or less, including somehow managing to play a turnover-free contest (first college team since Wisconsin in 2015) in a buzzer-beating loss at Saint Louis on Dec. 16 earlier this year. This will be the first of two meetings on the campaign between the programs, with the Bulldogs venturing to El Paso for a match-up on Feb. 22. **Jon Teicher** (43rd year) will be on the call on "The Home of UTEP Basketball" 600 ESPN El Paso and the UTEP Miners App. It will also stream on ESPN+ (subscription required).

**SOLOMON NEARING 1,000 CAREER POINTS**

**Calvin Solomon** is 13 points away from 1,000 in his collegiate career. He heads into Thursday's contest with 987 total points between his time with SFA and UTEP, including 439 with the Miners. Fellow senior **Tae Hardy** surpassed 1,000 career points in the Orange and Blue's victory against Wyoming on Dec. 21.

**GET TO KNOW LA TECH**

LA Tech is having a strong year, sitting in a three-way tie for first place in CUSA. The Bulldogs are 13-6 overall (tied for most total wins by CUSA team), including 3-1 in CUSA action. LA Tech is riding a three-game winning streak, most recently handling Jax State, 74-57, on the road on Jan. 20. The Bulldogs are 2-1 away from home in CUSA action, which accounts for half (two of four) of the total road victories across the board since league play commenced. LA Tech is even better at home, standing undefeated at 9-0, including taking out co-preseason favorite Liberty, 80-76, in OT on Jan 14. The Bulldogs have the top defense in CUSA in terms of field-goal percentage defense (39.4-19th NCAA) and are also second in the league and 23rd nationally in scoring defense (64.2). Both of those areas are benefited by LA Tech topping CUSA in blocks per game (4.8-36th NCAA). Making those numbers even more impressive is that they only commit 15.6 fouls per contest (second CUSA/80th NCAA). A direct result of that is LA Tech taking more than 100 free throws (310-448, 69.2 percent) than its opposition has (233-336, 69.3 percent). It is also second in the league in rebounding margin (+5.7-46th NCAA), scoring margin (+11.7-40th NCAA), 3-point percentage (36.3-70th NCAA) and fewest turnovers per game (12.2). The Bulldogs account for 75.9 points per game (fourth CUSA), securing extra possessions as result of being the best in the league at getting offensive rebounds with 11.9 orpg (94th NCAA). The one area where it has struggled some has been in knocking down free throws, with the Bulldogs rating 257th in the country at 69.2 percent. There is a lot of talent up and down the roster, with LA Tech sporting the league leaders in several categories. 6-11 forward Daniel Batcho tops CUSA in blocks per game (2.2-20th NCAA), field-goal percentage (57.2-46th NCAA), free throw attempts (105-64th NCAA), offensive rebounding (4.0-seventh NCAA), defensive rebounding (5.9-72nd NCAA) and total rebounds per game (9.9-16th NCAA). Sean Newman paces CUSA in assists per game (4.9-52nd NCAA). All-around talent and CUSA Preseason Player of the Year Isaiah Crawford, who is coming off a 30-point, five-steal performance in the victory at Jax State, leads the way offensively at 15.9 ppg. He is joined in double figures by Batcho (14.6 ppg) and Tahlik Chavez (12.2 ppg) while Newman Jr. pitches in 7.7 ppg. Four others are between 5.0 and 7.0 ppg. Chavez is lethal from distance, rating second in CUSA for 3-point percentage (49-119, 41.2) while his 2.6 triples per tilt are fifth in the league. Crawford is also a sharp shooter, nailing 22-52 (42.3 percent) from distance and 109-213 (51.2 percent) overall. He has gotten to the line early and often, making 63-85 (74.1 percent). He's third in CUSA for free throw attempts and fourth for makes. That offensive firepower up and down the roster has helped LA Tech produce 70+ points in nine of the past 10 tilts. Notable alumni include former NFL star and Super Bowl Champion and now TV personality Terry Bradshaw, former NBA standout Karl Malone and Duck Dynasty's Phil Robertson.

**SERIES HISTORY: LA TECH LEADS, 18-14**

LA Tech leads the series with UTEP, 18-14, with both teams successfully defending their home courts last year. LA Tech is 12-2 all time when playing at home (11-2 in Ruston), but the Miners did pick up a 63-60 road triumph during the '21-22 season. That was their first victory against the Bulldogs on the road since the '03-04 campaign. The past three contests have been decided by five points or less, including LA Tech holding on for a 60-58 triumph in Ruston in the most-recent meeting on Jan. 7, 2023. The two sides have squared off against each other as members in both the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) and now Conference USA.

**GOING BACK IN TIME**

**Tae Hardy** erupted for a UTEP career-high 27 points while **Corey Camper** (career-best 19 points) and **Zid Powell** (17 points) also reached double figures as UTEP won a wild back-and-forth game with high-flying WKU, 93-87, at home on Jan. 20. The victory halted a seven-contest skid against the Hilltoppers and got the Miners back to .500 in CUSA play after an 0-2 start on the road.



### IT WAS DECIDED LATE

There were 15 ties and nine lead changes vs. WKU, with 11 of those deadlocks coming during the final 20 minutes of action. The Toppers played from ahead for a good portion of the second half and were up by three (75-72) with 5:39 remaining in regulation. The Miners ripped off eight consecutive points, which came as part of a 21-12 run, to close out the contest in style for UTEP.

### DEFENSE DOES IT

UTEP's defense took over late, forcing WKU turnovers on four straight possessions during its 8-0 run. The Toppers had five field goals and five turnovers in the final 5:39 of the contest.

### IT'S BEEN A LONG TIME TO WIN THIS WAY

In besting WKU, UTEP won a game in which the opposition hit at least 57.0 percent from the floor for the first time since a 97-84 victory against Fresno State on Jan. 4, 1995. The Toppers connected on 61.9 percent (39-63), the best effort by a Miner foe since Southern Miss eclipsed 60 percent on Jan. 4, 2018. The last time a UTEP opponent was better than 61.9 percent was when UCF made 70.2 percent (40-57) on Jan. 23, 2008.

### PUTTING UP THE POINTS

UTEP's 93 points against WKU were the most against a DI opponent since it surpassed the century mark in a 101-89 victory against Rice on Jan. 8, 2021.

### CRASHING THE BOARDS

UTEP stopped a five-game streak of being outrebounded when it won the boards (34-33) against WKU. The Toppers entered the game as the top rebounding team in CUSA in terms of both rebounds per game (41.1-17th NCAA) and defensive boards per contest (29.5-12th NCAA). The Miners came up with 12 offensive rebounds, marking the first time they hit double digits in the category since pulling down 13 against Norfolk State on Dec. 20.

### GOT IT DONE AT THE LINE

UTEP drilled 24-29 at the charity stripe for a season-best 82.8 percent in the win vs. WKU. **Zid Powell** (7-8), **Tae Hardy** (5-5) and **Corey Camper Jr.** (6-7) keyed the charge in the department. It marked the third time this season that UTEP has connected on at least 80.0 on free throws.

### TURNING IT AROUND ON FREE THROWS

After shooting just 61.3 percent (76-124) on free throws over the first four games, the Miners are at 72.2 percent (274-379) in the 15 contests since. That includes five games of at least 75 percent during that timeframe, including three at 80 percent or better.

### CONTINUING TO CUT DOWN ON FOULS

After a four-game streak with at least 22 fouls, which was the longest since also doing so in 2008-09, the Miners have cut down on their infractions. They have averaged 15.5 fouls per game the past six contests, including being tagged with just 14 last time out against WKU on Jan. 20. A direct result of that has been the opponents averaging 10.8 free throws made on 15.7 attempts (65-94) during the stretch. That's a huge drop from the first 13 tilts of the season in which foes were averaging 19.5 makes at the line on 26.6 attempts (253-346).

### UTEP SWEEPS CUSA WEEKLY AWARDS

**Otis Frazier III** (Player of the Week) and **Elijah Jones** (Freshman of the Week) helped UTEP sweep the Conference USA Weekly awards, it was announced by the league office on Jan. 23. It is the first time since the 2018-19 campaign (Nov. 26, 2018) that the Orange and Blue staked both the Player of the Week (**Evan Gilyard**) and Freshman of the Week (**Efe Odigie**) honors in the same week. It is the first career CUSA Player of the Week award for Frazier III and second of the season for UTEP (**Zid Powell**, Dec. 26, 2023). The last time the Miners had multiple Player of the Week honors was in 2019-20 when **Bryson Williams** took it home three times and **Daryl Edwards** did so once. Jones has now won CUSA Freshman of the Week four times this year, tying as the second most in school history. **Vince Hunter** holds the record at five in 2013-14 while Jones now shares second place with **Julian Washburn** (four times, '11-12).

### STREAKING ON FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

UTEP has claimed the Conference USA Freshman of the Week Award in three consecutive weeks, marking the first time since 2011-12 and second occasion ever that the Miners have done so. **David Terrell Jr.** claimed it on Jan. 8 before **Trey Horton III** secured the accolade on Jan. 15 and Jones on Jan. 22. The six total honors this year tie as the most ever in the category at the school, with the 2013-14 team also boasting six CUSA Freshman of the Week honors.

### MORE ON OTIS

**Otis Frazier III** averaged 13.5 points per game, on a team-leading 64.3 percent from the floor, to go along with pacing the team in rebounding (6.5 rpg), assists (4.0 apg) and steals (6.0 spg) during the pair of UTEP victories. That was aided by a historic performance against Middle Tennessee, where he became the first DI or NBA Player in the last 25 years to have 20+ points (21), 8+ steals (school-record tying eight) and shoot 100% from the floor (6-6) in that game. The junior had nine rebounds, six assists, six points and four steals (three in the final seven minutes) in the victory against WKU.

### BIG IMPACT IN LITTLE MINUTES

**Elijah Jones** was a spark off the bench in both of UTEP's victories on the week. He averaged 5.5 points per game, 2.5 rebounds per contest and 1.0 blocks per game in only 7.6 minutes per game. He was combined perfect 5-5 from floor.

### BACK-TO-BACK 20-POINT OUTINGS FOR HARDY

For the first time of his D1 collegiate career (including time at ECU and Southern Miss), **Tae Hardy** has produced back-to-back 20+ point games. He recorded 20 points against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 18 before going off for his UTEP-high 27 points vs. WKU on Jan. 20. Hardy now has eclipsed 20 points in three of the past five contests and a team-most five occasions this season.

### MOST POINTS ON BREAK VS. DI TEAM IN 17 YEARS

UTEP racked up 31 fastbreak points in its win vs. WKU, marking the most in a game against a division I opponent since it also produced 31 on the break in an 88-64 rout of Marshall on Jan. 10, 2007.

### STEALS GALORE FOR OTIS

UTEP piled up 16 steals against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 18, with **Otis Frazier III's** eight equaling the school standard by **Eddie Moreno** against Division II program UT-Permian Basin on Nov. 21, 2005. Making Frazier III's feat more impressive is that it didn't just come against a DI opponent, but a league foe as well.

### UNPRECEDENTED STRETCH FOR STEALS

The Miners have now recorded at least 15 steals in four consecutive contests for the first time in school history. That effort has helped them vault to the top of the national ratings with 11.9 steals per game. Overall, UTEP has registered 13 games this year double figures in steals. That figure surpasses the number of such contests for both the 2022-23 (10) and 2009-10 (nine) teams. That is significant given that the '22-23 and '09-10 Miners share the school record for steals in a season at 288.



## DEFENDING THE DON

UTEP finished 2-0 at home last week, marking its first CUSA weekend sweep in the Sun City since defeating Rice and North Texas during the final week of the regular season in 2021-22. The Miners are now 10-2 at home on the year, their fifth straight campaign of at least 10 home victories.

## DIALING IT IN FROM DISTANCE

UTEP is a combined 46.7 percent (28-60) on 3-pointers the past four games (3-1 record), a stark contrast from how it had been shooting the long ball. The Miners were 24.6 percent (48-195) in their first 12 contests of the campaign against Division I opposition.

## PILING UP THE GAMES AT 50 PERCENT

UTEP has registered six games on the year of shooting at least 50 percent, equaling the amount by both last year's team and the 2021-22 squad. The last time the Miners had more than six contests above 50 percent in a year was during the 2017-18 campaign when they recorded eight such tilts.

## FINDING WAYS TO WIN LATE

After having lost 22 straight games when trailing with five minutes to play, the Miners are 3-2 when faced with that situation since halting the skid against Norfolk State. UTEP trailed by two in that contest with five minutes left before fighting back for a 67-65 victory on Dec. 20. UTEP was down four points with 4:10 left against Chicago State, but it closed the game on a 13-4 run for the win. Last time out, WKU was up by one with 5:18 left but UTEP overcame that as part of a contest-closing 21-12 surge.

## HARDY CONTINUES TO LEAD OFFENSE

**Tae Hardy** has been the most consistent player at the offensive end for UTEP in 2023-24. He has reached double figures in scoring in 10 of the past 11 games and a team-best 17 times total this season. He has also produced a squad-most five 20+ point showings, doing so in back-to-back tilts (first time of DI career) and three of the past five.

## ZID SCORES IN DOUBLE DIGITS, WE WIN

UTEP is 9-1 on the season when senior **Zid Powell** hits double figures in scoring, with the lone setback coming by six points (L, 88-82, at ACU, Dec. 17). Conversely, the Miners are 2-7 (0-7 vs. DI opposition) when Powell falls short of 10 points.

## GET THE LEAD AND WE'RE PRETTY, PRETTY GOOD

UTEP is 8-2 on the season when leading at the half and a stout 8-1 this year when holding an advantage with five minutes remaining in regulation. It's not a recent trend, with the Miners a combined 35-7 under head coach **Joe Golding** when leading at the break.

## STEALS KEEP COMING

UTEP has registered at least seven steals in every contest on the campaign, including 10 or more 13 times. UTEP's average of 11.9 steals per game leads the nation. The Miners tied the school record for steals with 288 last year, but they are on pace to smash that figure with 381 thefts. UTEP already has 226 thefts heading into Thursday's contest and needs to average just 4.84 steals the rest of the way to best the school standard.

## TURNOVERS DO TOO FOR OPPONENTS

UTEP is leading the country by forcing 19.3 turnovers per game, which projects to 618 by season's end. The school record for most turnovers in a season by a Miner opponent is 573, which was set in 2007-08.

## TAE DOING IT ALL

Senior **Tae Hardy** has done it all for the Miners thus far in 2023-24, including hitting the buzzer-beating 3-pointer against Cal on Nov. 20. He paces the team in scoring (15.6-third CUSA), minutes per game (32.5-first CUSA), 3-pointers made (40), attempted (99) and 3-pointers per game (2.1-tied sixth CUSA). Hardy rates second in assists per game (2.5-tied 14th CUSA) and steals (2.0-fourth CUSA/55th NCAA). He has reached double figures in scoring 17 times, aided by five straight and 10 of the past 11. He has produced a team-best five 20+ point outings, including three of the past five times out. The Ellenwood, Ga., native also moved past 1,000 career points (1,110) this year, with more than 650 of those coming with UTEP (708).

### OTIS STEPPING UP

Junior **Otis Frazier III**, who was named the CUSA Player of the Week for the first time of his career on Jan. 22, has continued to ascend. He averaged 2.5 ppg in 35 appearances for George Mason from 2020-22 before transferring to UTEP. Last year he averaged 7.5 ppg on 50.3 percent (81-161) shooting in his first year with the Miners. His numbers are even better this year, accounting for 10.7 ppg with a readout of 52.6 percent (71-135). He's getting after it on defense, leading the squad at 2.1 steals per contest (third CUSA/45th NCAA). That figure was boosted by a school-record tying eight steals vs. Middle Tennessee on Jan. 18. Frazier III is also working the boards (4.2 rpg-third team/24th CUSA). He is doing a better job of getting to the charity stripe, having already made more than last year. Furthermore, he's knocking them down at a better rate. Frazier III is at 68.5 percent (50-73) from the charity stripe after finishing at 40-63 from the line (63.5 percent) a season ago. He is fourth on the team in both free throws made and attempted. He has hit double figures in scoring 11 times total this season (second on team)

### ZID'S DOING HIS PART

Buffalo grad transfer **Zid Powell** is contributing across the board despite having battled through some injuries and foul issues at times. Powell leads the team in assists (3.1apg-tied eighth CUSA), free throws made (73-first CUSA), attempted (98-second CUSA/91st NCAA) and percentage among players with 20+ attempts at 74.5 percent. Those figures are aided by him going 17-19 at the line in league play. He is second on the squad for scoring (11.4-16th CUSA) and rebounding (4.9-tied 14th CUSA) and is third in steals (1.6-tied sixth CUSA). His 3.7 defensive boards per game pace the team and tie for 12th in CUSA. Powell has produced 10 double-digit scoring efforts (UTEP is 9-1 in those tilts), including the most points by a Miner since '21-22 with a career-high 32 vs. Wyoming on Dec. 21.

### CAMPER JR. MAKING HIS MARK

JUCO Honorable-Mention All-American (Tyler JC) **Corey Camper Jr.**, who came off the bench for nine of the first 10 games of the season, has started eight of nine since. He is second on the team for 3-pointers made (15) and attempted (53), fourth in scoring (8.3 ppg) and fifth in steals (1.4-ninth CUSA). The Arkansas native has also done a good job at the charity stripe, nailing 72.3 percent. That included going 2-2 in the waning seconds of the game against Chicago State to seal the victory. Camper Jr. has seven games with double-digit scoring totals, including a career-high 19 points last time out vs. WKU. The Miners are 7-0 when he hits double figures for points.

### SOLOMON'S ALL-AROUND GAME

Senior **Calvin Solomon** is displaying the full arsenal of his abilities in 2023-24, rating second on the squad in blocked shots (0.6 bpg-tied 14th CUSA), fourth in rebounding (3.6), assists (1.6-tied 24th CUSA) and steals (1.5 eighth CUSA). He also contributes 7.0 ppg (fifth on team). He has proven to be a team player by coming off the bench eight of the past nine contests. Solomon has also done an outstanding job of drawing contact and finishing at the free throw line once there. He is second on the team in both free throws made (57-fifth CUSA) and attempted (77-seventh CUSA). Solomon has drained 74.0 percent, the third best among Miners with at least 20 attempts. It is also a vast improvement from his readout of 59.8 percent (76-127) last year.

### KALU ON THE GLASS

**Kevin Kalu** has been the top rebounder for the Miners in 2023-24, pulling down a team-leading 5.2 rpg (13th CUSA). The junior is 10th in the league for offensive boards per game (1.8) and tied for 18th in CUSA for defensive rebounds per contest (3.4). He has pulled down at least four rebounds in 15 games. Kalu also leads the team in blocked shots (0.6-tied 13th CUSA). He is chipping in 4.7 ppg but is doing so at an efficient 60.0 percent (36-60) from the floor. One area of concern has been his team-leading three foul outs. Five other Miners have been sent packing early once.

### KEEPING A FAMILY TRADITION ALIVE

Freshman **David Terrell Jr.** is following in the footsteps of both his mom and dad by competing with the Miners. His mom (**Kiana Taylor**) was a standout on the women's basketball team at UTEP (1993-96, 97-98), finishing her career as the then school record holder for double-doubles (20) and the then second-leading scorer (1,134) and rebounder (676) in program history. His father, David, was an all-WAC performer for UTEP and played with the football team from 1994-96. Terrell Jr. has adapted well to the college game, rating third on the squad in assists per game (1.9-18th CUSA) and placing sixth in steals (1.3 spg-tied 10th CUSA). His scoring is coming around as well, as he's elevated it to 4.7 ppg on a strong 50.8 percent from the floor. The CUSA Freshman of the Week on Jan. 8 has scored at least six points in five of the past six contests.

### 4X CUSA FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

UTEP forward **Elijah Jones** has been named the Conference USA Freshman of the Week four times this season, including each of the first three weeks. He became the first Miner in program history to win three straight CUSA Freshman of the Week honors, with it being more impressive that he did it out of the gates. After a strong showing in a pair of home wins against Middle Tennessee (Jan. 18) and WKU (Jan. 20), he picked up his fourth such honor on Jan. 22. Overall, Jones is second among reserves and sixth overall for scoring (5.3 ppg). He adds 2.2 rpg (third for Miner back-ups and seventh overall). He is an accurate free throw shooter, connecting on 12-16 (75.0 percent). He is also 7-17 (41.2 percent) from distance.



## WELCOME TO THE COURT, BAYLOR HEBB

After sitting out the first 10 games of the season due to NCAA transfer rules, **Baylor Hebb** is now part of the rotation. That included making his first start as a Miner at NM State on Jan. 4. He's chipping in 2.4 ppg and 1.0 rpg in 10.6 mpg, aided by a campaign-best seven points vs. Seattle U on Dec. 30.

## GETTING TO THE LINE

The Miners' relentless drive toward to the paint (34.6 points in paint per game) and getting out in transition (18.9 fastbreak points per game-second NCAA) has led to them taking the fifth-most free throws per game (26.5) in the country. UTEP is also ninth nationally for free throws made per contest (18.4). The Miners have three players within the top 10 of CUSA for free throws made, including league-leading **Zid Powell** (73). He is joined in the top 10 by **Calvin Solomon** (57-fifth) and **Tae Hardy** (55-fifth).

## POUNDING THE PAINT

UTEP has demonstrated the ability to get points in the paint in 2023-24. A good chunk (658-1,453, 45.2 percent) of the Miners' points on the season have come in the paint. On the year, the Orange and Blue have a 658-586 advantage for points in the paint. That works out to 34.6 ppg in the paint for UTEP compared to 30.8 by foes.

## LET'S GET OUT AND RUN

The Miners are accounting for 18.9 fastbreak points per game, the second-highest average in the country. They have tallied at least 12 points on the break in 17 of 19 contests this year, including a campaign-best 47 against USAO on Nov. 9. Their DI high (31 vs. WKU) was the most since the '06-07 season when they also had 31 vs. Marshall. UTEP has a remarkable 360-191 cushion against opponents this season in the category, with the 18.9-10.1 ppg differential on average.

## SHARING IS CARING

UTEP is dishing out 13.6 assists per contest to rate third in CUSA. The Miners have surpassed 20 assists three times, including setting a school record with 33 in the opener vs. Division III opponent McMurry on Nov. 6. **Zid Powell** (3.1 apg-tied eighth CUSA) and **Tae Hardy** (2.5 apg-tied 14th CUSA) lead the charge. Freshman **David Terrell Jr.** (1.9 apg-18th CUSA) and senior **Calvin Solomon** (1.6- tied 24th CUSA) have also been good at setting up teammates.

## GIVE ME THAT BALL

UTEP has notched at least seven steals in all 19 games, with double-digit totals 13 times. That effort has led to it leading the nation in both steals per game (11.9) and turnovers forced per contest (19.3). Foes have committed at least 17 turnovers 12 times, including the past five. During the recent stretch both Chicago State (Jan.7) and Middle Tennessee (Jan. 18) make 27 turnovers, the most by a DI Miner opponent since Norfolk State had 32 on Dec. 28, 2009.

## LOTS ARE CAUSING PROBLEMS FOR OPPOSITION

UTEP has six players in the top 15 of Conference USA for steals per game, with five of those individuals also happening to be the top five scorers on the squad. **Otis Frazier III** (2.0-tied second CUSA) leads the way, with **Tae Hardy** (1.9-fourth CUSA) just back of him. **Zid Powell** is at 1.6 spg (tied sixth CUSA), **Corey Camper Jr.** and **Calvin Solomon** produce 1.4 spg (tied eighth). **David Terrell Jr.** rounds out the list at 1.3 spg (tied 13th CUSA). Last season, Solomon joined **Randy Culpepper** and Hall of Famer **Tim Hardaway** as the lone Miners in program history to average at least 2.0 steals per game.

## HIGH-OCTANE BENCH

UTEP's reserves have helped the Miners put up 75.5 points per game (fifth CUSA), with the bench accounting for 24.8 ppg (fifth CUSA/77th NCAA). Overall, the Miners hold a 472-414 differential in reserve scoring. That works out to a 24.8-21.8 advantage per contest.

## WHO IS PUTTING UP THE POINTS

Heading into Thursday's contest at LA Tech, three Miners are accounting for double figures in scoring while three others are between 5.0 ppg and 8.0 ppg. Senior **Tae Hardy** (15.6 ppg-third CUSA) tops the team. Buffalo transfer **Zid Powell** (11.4 ppg-16th CUSA) and junior **Otis Frazier III** (10.7 ppg-17th CUSA) join him in double digits on average. JUCO Honorable-Mention All-American (Tyler JC) **Corey Camper Jr.** (8.3 ppg), senior **Calvin Solomon** (7.0 ppg) and four-time CUSA Freshman of the Week **Elijah Jones** (5.3 ppg) round out the list. Aiding the balanced approach were eight different Miners (most on record) hitting double figures in scoring in the 120-71 season-opening win against McMurry on Nov. 6.

## WHAT ABOUT PLAYING TIME

Ten different Miners have earned double figures in playing time on average, including seven who have appeared in every contest. **Tae Hardy** (32.5-first CUSA) is the only one on the squad to be earning more than 30.0 minutes per contest. **Otis Frazier III** (26.4 mpg) and **Zid Powell** (25.8 mpg) and are the only others above 25.0 mpg.

## UTEP IN THE RANKINGS

UTEP leads Conference USA in six major stat categories and is second in another. The Miners top the conference in fastbreak scoring (18.9-second NCAA), free throw attempts per game (26.5-1-fifth NCAA), free throws made per game (18.4-ninth NCAA), steals per game (11.9-first NCAA), turnover margin (4.3-16th NCAA) and turnovers forced per contest (19.3-first NCAA). UTEP is also second in field-goal percentage (46.3-95th NCAA), in addition to rating in the top-100 nationally for bench scoring (24.8-fifth CUSA/77th NCAA).

## DERICK HARDLY MISSES

**Derick Hamilton** hasn't attempted enough field goals per game to qualify nationally for field-goal percentage, but he has done enough to show off his talents thus far in 2023-24. Hamilton is 14-22 from the floor (63.6 percent) in 56 total minutes of action. That was aided by starting the season 12-12. The high-percentage shooting shouldn't come as a surprise given he was 22-33 last year (66.7 percent) in 20 appearances.

## FIVE TIMES THIS CENTURY

The Miners got out of the gates at 5-0 this year before dropping their last two games, including most-recently, 67-47, at LMU on Nov. 25. It marked the fifth time since 2000 that the Orange and Blue had posted a start of at least 5-0. It happened previously in 2019-20 (5-0), 2015-16 (6-0), 2009-10 (5-0) and 2000-01 (6-0).

## TAE CALLED GAME AGAINST CAL

UTEP defeated Cal, 75-72, on Nov. 20, in a wild and memorable finish. After a couple of missed free throws by **Tae Hardy** (was 7-7 to that point), the Bears tied the game at 72 with a 3-pointer from Jalen Cone with six seconds left. Rather than sulk, **Otis Frazier III** inbounded the ball to **Zid Powell**, who raced up the court. He then dished it to Hardy, whose 3-point attempt spun around the rim before dropping through for the buzzer-beating victory. It was the first buzzer beater for UTEP since **Alfred Hollins's** tip-in as the horn sounded in a 70-68 triumph against Florida Atlantic on Jan. 27, 2022.

## GOT IT DONE VS. POWER PROGRAM

UTEP took down Pac-12 member Cal, 75-72, on Nov. 20, thanks to the heroics of **Tae Hardy's** buzzer beater. It marked the initial win against a Power Five program under head coach **Joe Golding** and first since knocking off Arizona State on the road, 76-63, on Dec. 16, 2020.

## BESTING A POWER PROGRAM ON A NEUTRAL COURT

UTEP's win against Cal marked the first time that it bested a Power Six program (Power Five + Big East) at a neutral site since taking out Xavier (Big East) on Nov. 28, 2014. It was also the initial occasion to defeat a Power Five foe in a neutral match-up since toppling SEC foe Tennessee, 78-70, on Nov. 28, 2013, in the Battle 4 Atlantis at Paradise Island, Bahamas.

## TAKING OUT A PRESEASON FAVORITE

UC Santa Barbara has been to two of the past three NCAA Tournaments and set a school record for wins (27) last year, but the Miners weren't intimidated. UTEP led for 25 minutes, including never trailing in the second half, on the way to taking out the in the 2023-24 preseason favorites in the Big West, 89-76, on Nov. 13.

## TALKING 100-POINT GAMES

UTEP finished with the second-most points (120, now third) in program history in the win vs. McMurry on Nov. 6. The Miners followed that up with a school-record 123 points in routing USAO. It was the first time UTEP started a season with consecutive 100+ point showings. In fact, the only other time the Orange and Blue ever posted back-to-back 100-point games came during the 1968-69 season when they blasted Montana (103-90, 12/28/68) and then drilled Tahoe Paradise (109-63, 1/2/69). Prior to the outbursts this year, the Miners hadn't topped 100 since besting Rice, 101-89, on Jan. 8, 2021. UTEP now stands at 33-2 all time when surpassing 100 points in a contest, including 31-0 in El Paso (22-0 at the Haskins Center). UTEP has won 18 straight games when hitting the century mark.

## AN OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION TO BEGIN THE YEAR

The Miners enjoyed a three-game scoring stretch with at least 89 points to begin the year. The last time UTEP did so at any point in the season was 14 years ago. That year, the Orange and Blue also had a three-contest span (12/19/09-12/28/09). Making this season's effort stand out a bit is that the Miners had back-to-back 100-point outings for just the second time in school history. It also happened in 1968-69.



## DUST OFF THE RECORD BOOKS

UTEP dented the record book in the first two games of the season.

- School-record 123 points vs. USAO (11/9) and third-most points (120) vs. McMurry (11/6). The 243 points are the most in a two-contest span in program history.
- Dished out a program-best 33 assists vs. McMurry, smashing the prior standard of 29.
- School-record 50 field goals vs. McMurry, crushing the previous mark (46) that had happened in both 1979 (vs. Illinois Tech, 12/22/79) and in 1966 (vs. NM State, 2/1/66).
- Second-most second-half points (71) at the school vs. USAO and tied for seventh-highest total (61) after the break against McMurry.
- Tied for fourth-most first-half points (59) against McMurry.
- Won back-to-back games by at least 49 points for first time ever, including tying for the seventh-biggest margin of victory (51) vs. USAO (W, 123-71).
- Posted 19 steals vs. McMurry, tying as the third most at the school, while the 18 thefts against USAO earned a share of fifth place.

## THE BEST FANS IN CONFERENCE USA

UTEP led Conference USA in attendance last year in both total number of fans (81,941) and average attendance (4,552). It marked the second straight season that the Miners paced CUSA in at least one of those categories. Last year, UTEP's advantage for per-game average was noticeable, with WKU more than 500 fans behind on average at 4,026. The Miners are solid in the area in 2023-24, leading the league for total fans (52,125) and placing second in average attendance (4,344).

## MORE THAN A MILLION FANS

UTEP has attracted more than one million fans to the Don Haskins Center over the past decade. A total of 1,116,176 individuals have passed through the turnstiles from the beginning of the 2012-13 campaign to the end of the 2022-23 season. That figure makes the Miners the only school out of the nine members in Conference USA to have topped one million fans in that timeframe.

## ROSTER RUNDOWN

UTEP returned its leading scorer (**Tae Hardy**-12.8 ppg, 2.7 rpg, 1.2 spg) and rebounder (**Calvin Solomon**-6.0 rpg, 9.6 ppg, 2.0 apg, 2.0 spg) from last year's team. Overall, the Miners brought back 54.3 percent of their scoring and 50.5 percent of their rebounding. It is a stark difference from the situation the Orange and Blue faced going into the 2022-23 campaign, when they had just 20.8 percent of the rebounding and 11.1 percent of the scoring back. UTEP has seven lettermen in the fold, including three starters (**Hardy**, **Solomon** and **Otis Frazier III**; 7.5 ppg, 4.1 rpg). **Jon Dos Anjos** (4.2 ppg, 1.5 rpg), **Derick Hamilton** (2.7 ppg, 1.4 rpg), **Antwon Holmes** and **Kevin Kalu** are the other returning lettermen. The Miners landed six newcomers, including junior-college All-American **Corey Camper Jr.** (19.9 ppg, 5.0 rpg, 3.0 apg at Tyler JC) and DI transfers **Zid Powell** (13.0 ppg, 4.1 rpg, 2.7 apg, 1.9 spg at Buffalo) and **Baylor Hebb** (Colorado State). UTEP also has a pair of true freshmen (**Trey Horton III**, **David Terrell Jr.**) and another JUCO transfer (**Sebastian Cole**). **Garrett Levesque** (Tarleton State) and **Elijah Jones** (ECU) have also made their respective Miner debuts after redshirting the 2022-23 campaign.

## DI EXPERIENCE

UTEP has ample DI experience across its roster, with a combined 454 games played (210 starts) among the Miners as of the beginning of the 2023-24 season. **Calvin Solomon** leads with way with 114 appearances (88 starts).

## PRESEASON HONORS

UTEP seniors **Tae Hardy** and **Calvin Solomon** were tabbed to the 2023-24 CUSA All-Preseason Team in a vote by the league's nine head coaches. The Miners joined Middle Tennessee and WKU as the only programs in the conference to have a pair of members on the squad.

## NEW-LOOK LEAGUE

UTEP joined Conference USA as the newest school in the league for the 2005-06 campaign. It entered the 2023-24 season as the most-tenured member. The 11 programs who were part of CUSA when the Miners moved to it have since departed to other conferences. Joining UTEP as returning league members are FIU, LA Tech, Middle Tennessee and WKU while Jax State, Liberty, NM State and Sam Houston are all in their first year.

## A YEAR IN REVIEW

- UTEP had a new-look squad in 2022-23 with head coach **Joe Golding** having to overhaul the roster after the Miners returned just one starter and three letterwinners total from a 20-win team a year prior.
- The Orange and Blue managed a 14-18 record, including a 67-64 victory against NM State on Nov. 12, 2022, for their first win against the Aggies in three years. That was the start of a five-game winning streak, which was aided by back-to-back OT triumphs.
- The five straight victories in November were the longest in the month in four years, which was aided by a mark of 3-0 in the inaugural Jim Forbes Classic Presented by Speaking Rock.
- The Miners came within a point of winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational, falling 47-46 to eventual NCAA Tournament participant Kent State on Dec. 22, 2022. UTEP experienced a tough 1-4 stretch early in league play, with those four setbacks by a combined 14 points.
- UTEP remained resilient on the way to forging seven league triumphs, capped by a 77-65 “Senior Day” triumph against Middle Tennessee on March 4, 2023.
- The Orange and Blue tied the single-season school record for overtime games at five, matching the 1994-95 and 2011-12 teams. All five of the OT games were in the regular season, which are the most ever at the school. Both the 1994-95 and 2011-12 Miners had in four OT games during the regular season and one postseason OT tilt.

## THE BASIC FACTS ON UTEP

- This is the 103rd season of UTEP men’s basketball. The Miners made history by starting five African-Americans to defeat Kentucky, 72-65, and win the 1966 NCAA Championship on the way to inspiring the Disney hit movie Glory Road.
- UTEP has 17 NCAA Tournament appearances (last in 2010), 11 NIT bids (last in 2015), 12 conference championships (last in 2010) and 26 seasons with at least 20+ victories (last in 2015). The Miners have won five league tournaments (last in 2005).
- The Miners have a strong presence in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame with **Don Haskins**, **Nate Archibald**, **Nolan Richardson**, the **1966 team** and **Tim Hardaway** all representing UTEP.

## GOLDING REACHES 200 CAREER WINS

Third-year UTEP head coach **Joe Golding** guided the Miners past Wyoming, 78-67, on Dec. 21 to not only win the 2023 WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational but also hit the 200-career victory plateau. He is now 203-184 all time between Abilene Christian and UTEP, including 45-40 in his third season in the Sun City. That places him ninth on the Miners’ all-time coaching win list. He needs four triumphs to surpass **Jason Rabedeaux** (46-46, 1999-02).

## GET TO KNOW COACH GOLDING

**Joe Golding** is in his third year at UTEP and is the 20th head coach in program history. He is the eighth head coach for the Miners since legendary Hall of Fame Coach **Don Haskins** retired following the 1998-99 season. Golding is 203-184 in his 13th season as a collegiate head coach, including 45-40 at UTEP. Those 45 wins already place him ninth at the school, having passed current Texas head coach **Rodney Terry** (37) with the triumph vs. Austin Peay on Nov. 17. **Jason Rabedeaux** (46 wins, 1999-02) is Golding’s next target. In 2021-22, Golding became the fourth head coach (20 total) in program history to have a winning season in their first year on the sideline. **Don Haskins** was the first when he directed the Miners to a mark of 18-6 in 1961-62. **Doc Sadler** (27-8, 2004-05) and **Tim Floyd** (25-10, 2010-11) also achieved the feat. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP. Previously Golding spent 10 years at Abilene Christian (158-144), helping it transition from a Division II to a Division I program. Golding led the Wildcats to the 2019 and 2021 NCAA Tournaments, including a stunning upset as a 14-seed of third-seeded Texas in the first round of the 2021 Big Dance.

# UTEP Head Coach

# Joe GOLDING

Abilene Christian '99

Third Season at UTEP  
25<sup>th</sup> Season as a Coach



Joe Golding, who led Abilene Christian to the NCAA Tournament in two of his final three seasons with the program and an upset win over third-seed Texas in the 2021 "Big Dance" was appointed the 20th head coach in UTEP men's basketball history on April 13, 2021.

In 2022-23 he had to overhaul the roster after the Miners returned just one starter and three letterwinners total from a 20-win team a year prior. UTEP managed a 14-18 record, including a 67-64 victory against NM State on Nov. 12 for its first win against the Aggies in three years. That was the start of a five-game winning streak, which was aided by back-to-back OT triumphs. UTEP's five straight victories in November were the longest in the month in four years, which was aided by a mark of 3-0 in the inaugural Jim Forbes Classic Presented by Speaking Rock.

The Miners came within a point of winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational, falling 47-46 to eventual NCAA Tournament participant Kent State on Dec. 22. UTEP experienced a tough 1-4 stretch early in league play, with those four setbacks by a combined 14 points. The Miners remained resilient on the way to forging seven league triumphs, capped by a 77-65 "Senior Day" triumph against Middle Tennessee on March 4.

Golding experienced immediate success in his first year on the sidelines with the Orange and Blue, directing the Miners to their first 20-win season (20-14) since going 22-11 in 2014-15. UTEP earned a spot in The Basketball Classic for its first postseason appearance since 2015. The Miners defeated Western Illinois, 80-54, on March 19 for their first postseason win since 2009. UTEP was 11-7 in league play, securing the first winning record in conference action since forging a mark of 12-6 in 2016-17. That was aided by winning 10 of 14 down the stretch, including halting back-to-back C-USA West Division Champion North Texas' 15-game winning streak, 70-68, on "Senior Day" on March 5. The Miners then went on to defeat Old Dominion, 74-64, on March 9 for their first victory at the C-USA Championships in five years.

Golding's charges achieved notable success on the road, compiling their most road wins (seven) since going 8-2 in 2013-14. UTEP (5-4) had its first winning record on the road in league play since 2016-17, and the five league road wins surpassed its total (four) of such games from the prior three seasons combined.

The Miners registered their first road win at LA Tech since 2004, at New Mexico since 2009, at ODU since 2015 and at UTSA since 2015. They also secured the first road sweep of the LA Tech and Southern Miss trip in six years.

UTEP enjoyed a six-game winning streak in conference play (Jan. 15 to Feb. 5), which was the longest since also posting six straight C-USA victories in 2016.

With the Miners finishing at 20-14, Golding joined Don Haskins (18-6, 1961-62), Doc Sadler (27-8, 2004-05) and Tim Floyd (25-10, 2010-11) as the only coaches in program history to have a winning season in their first year on the sidelines. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP. Individually, Souley Boum (second team) and Jamal Bieniemy (third team) both earned All-Conference USA accolades. Boum was also a NABC All-District honoree.

Golding, 48, performed a remarkable turnaround at ACU after shepherding the Wildcats' transition from Division II to Division I. He guided the Wildcats to a record of 158-144 in 10 seasons at the helm of the program (2011-2021), including a 71-23 mark over the last three years. ACU chalked up three consecutive 20-win seasons, finishing with a 27-7 mark in 2018-19, the most wins in program history. ACU finished 20-11 overall and 15-5 in league play during the 2019-20 season before the postseason was canceled due to the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic. It marked just the second time in program history that the team put together back-to-back 20-win seasons including the postseason; the first came during coach Golding's playing days.

Golding directed ACU to a 24-5 overall record and a 13-2 Southland Conference mark during the 2020-21 campaign. The Wildcats claimed the Southland Conference tournament title, and the first NCAA Tournament win in program history when #14 seed ACU shocked the heavily favored Longhorns, 53-52, in the first round on March 20. Golding was named the NABC District 22 co-Coach of the Year, while Kolton Kohl was selected to the All-District 22 first team. Kohl was also named to the 2020-21 All-Southland Conference first team, while Joe Pleasant earned second team All-League honors and Coryon Mason garnered third team recognition. Damien Daniels, Reggie Miller and Mason were also tabbed to the league All-Defensive team.

Golding, who played point guard at ACU from 1994-98, took over as the head coach at his alma mater in 2011. In his first season, the Wildcats were 12-16 overall and 4-14 in the Lone Star Conference. ACU began competing at the Division I level during the 2013-14 season. Four years later, they reached the postseason (College Insider Tournament) and, the year after that, they were in the Big Dance.

Golding's teams have also excelled in the classroom with a perfect 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last four years, and a 3.2 grade point average this season. Every one of his players who exhausted their eligibility graduated from ACU. Golding's first coaching job was as a varsity assistant at South Garland High School, where he helped the team to back-to-back Class 5A playoff appearances. He spent the 2001-02 season as an assistant coach at Seminole Junior College before taking the head coaching job at Sachse High School. During the program's first years at the 5A level, Golding led the team to a 15-14 record in 2002-03 and an 18-10 mark in 2003-04. Golding spent the 2004-05 season as an assistant coach at Collin County Community College, and the next three seasons (2005-08) as the top assistant to head coach Jason Copeland at ACU before joining head coach Steve Shields' staff at Arkansas Little Rock. His three years at UALR (2008-11) produced a Sun Belt Conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Golding was a four-year letterwinner at ACU from 1994-98, playing in all 108 games, and was given the Teague Point Guard Award as a senior. He shot 46 percent from the floor over his four-year career, and averaged 4.2 assists per game. He graduated from ACU with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science in May of 1999.

Golding and his wife, Amanda, have two sons, Cason and Chase.

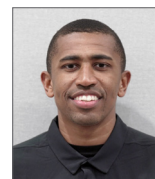
