QUICK HITTERS

- MTSU has 32 explosive plays (20 or more yards) on the season and **13** have been passes from Nicholas Vattiato to Omari Kelly.
- MTSU has had **seven** different starting lineups among its offensive line unit in eight games, which ranks as the most in the country.
- Nicholas Vattiato is **9th** in the Group of 5 with 257.1 passing yards per game and Omari Kelly is **4th** in receiving yards (779).
- QB Nicholas Vattiato ranks **28th** nationally in passing yards/game and **22nd** in completions/game.
- The Blue Raiders have played 11 true freshmen this season (Amarrien Bailey, Jordan Beasley, Aidan Butts, Grant Chadwick, Zach Clayton, Austin Clemons, Josh Evans, Roman Gagliano, Evan Poticher, Tiyyan Robinson and Corey Smith).
- WR Holden Willis has at least one catch in **17** straight games to own the longest streak on the team
- With the TTU win, Derek Mason became just the seventh head coach out of 15 who won their opening game as head coach of the Blue Raiders. The other six were: Alfred Miles, Johnny Red Floyd, E.W. Midgett, Charles Murphy, Bill Peck and Rick Stockstill.
- Between the 11 full-time coaches (head coach and 10 assistants), four have either played or coached at the NFL level (Derek Mason, Brian Stewart, Kendall Simmons and Calvin Lowry).
- The Blue Raiders have two seven-year players on their roster in Brendon Harris and Alex Williams. However, both are now out for the season with injuries.
- MTSU has played four home games in 2024 and two have had lightning delays. The delays have totaled four hours and 22 minutes or basically another complete game.
- **Consecutive Start Leaders:** Nick Vattiato: **20**
- The Blue Raiders had seven one-score games in 2023, which went down as tied for the 8th most nationally behind ODU (11), Boston College (8), Colorado (8), Illinois (8), North Texas (8), Northern Illinois (8), Northwestern (8) and Washington (8).
- 2024 marks the 40th anniversary of the 1984 team that went 11-3 and knocked off top-ranked Indiana State in the playoffs to reach the 1-AA National Semifinals.
- When the Blue Raiders kicked it off against TTU in the season opener, marked **1,372** days since Derek Mason was on the sidelines as a head coach (Nov. 28, 2020) or 196 weeks.
- The 2024 season for MTSU is the 110th for Blue Raider football and the 26th at the FBS level.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the seventh meeting all-time between MTSU and UTEP on the gridiron. The Blue Raiders own a 5-1 advantage in the series, which began in 2013. MTSU won the first meeting in 2013 in Murfreesboro, 48-17, then the Miners bounced back with a win in El Paso the following year, 24-21. The Blue Raiders have gone on to win the next four in a row, including a 34-30 decision in Murfreesboro last season. Overall, MTSU is 2-1 in El Paso.

IN REACH OF 1,000

Omari Kelly is enjoying a breakout season from his wide receiver spot. Heading into the UTEP game, Kelly has 46 receptions for 779 yards. With 221 more yards, Kelly will become just the third different player in school history to reach 1,000 receiving yards. He would join Richie James and Kerry Wright who both did it twice, and Ed Batties. Kelly would go down as the first 1,000-yard receiver at MTSU since James in 2016.

KELLY ON A ROLL

Junior Omari Kelly, who entered this season with just five career receptions, has been one of the hottest receivers in the country. In the last six games, Kelly has hauled in 41 receptions for 733 yards and three touchdowns. That equates to 17.9 yards per catch and 122.2 yards per game. Currently, Kelly ranks **9th** nationally and 1st in CUSA in receiving yards with 779 yards.

TACKLE MACHINE

Since changing positions and entering the starting lineup five games ago against Duke, Xavier Williams has been a tackling machine for the Blue Raiders. During that span, Williams has amassed 42 total tackles to take over the team lead. He has averaged just over eight stops per game. The graduate student is coming off a career-high 13-tackle performance at Jacksonville State.

CHADWICK HAVING SOLID FIRST YEAR

True freshman Grant Chadwick is having a memorable first year for the Blue Raiders punting the football. Entering the UTEP contest, Chadwick is averaging **43.6** yards punt with eight of his 35 kicks going more than 50 yards. His 43.6 yard average is currently the sixth best single-season average in school history and the best ever by a freshman. Chadwick also has the **fourth** best average nationally by a freshman and is **11th** overall among Group of 5 punters.

SPECIAL K

Junior Omari Kelly has made the most of his impact catching the football but against Kennesaw State he made a huge play on special teams. With MTSU clinging to a 7-2 lead, Kelly ran up on a punt and scampered 61 yards for a touchdown to seal the win. It was the first punt return TD of his career and the first by an MTSU player since Jaylin Lane went 70 yards on Sept. 4, 2021 against Monmouth. Kelly's 61-yard return went down as the longest of the season in the conference and earned him CUSA Special Team's Player of the Week honors.

WILLIS RANKS AMONG NATION'S MOST PRODUCTIVE TE'S

Senior tight end Holden Willis is a favorite target of QB Nicholas Vattiato and the second year Blue Raider is off to a strong start to 2024. Willis is second on the team with 39 catches for 600 yards and two TDs. His 600 yards ranks **2nd** nationally among tight ends and his receptions are tied for the **5th** most. A first team all-conference pick last year, Willis has 85 receptions in his two years as a Blue Raider.

CREDLE TOPS CENTURY MARK

Junior running back Jaiden Credle recorded the first 100-yard rushing game for the Blue Raiders since he accomplished the feat last year in a home game against Murray State. Credle rushed for 125 yards and a touchdown on just 12 carries against Duke for his second 100-yard game as a Blue Raider (he also had one at Northern Illinois). When Credle gets to 100 yards he has a tendency to turn in an impressive per carry average. Against Murray State last year it was 12.0 per attempt for his 132 yards, then last week against Duke it was 10.4. His 66-yard TD run against Duke was the longest run of the season for MTSU.

VATTIATO FLIRTS WITH ONE RECORD, SETS ANOTHER

Omari Kelly (239 receiving yards) wasn't the only player flirting with school records against WKU on Sept. 14, quarterback Nicholas Vattiato had quite the night as well. Vattiato fell three yards shy of Wes Counts' school record of 459 passing yards with a 456-yard night on 24 of 31 passing. It was the second 400-yard game for Vattiato, making him just the second signal-caller at MTSU with multiple 400-yard games. However, against WKU Vattiato did set the single-game total offense record with 477 yards. He broke the previous mark of 471 yards set by Joe Craddock in 2007 against ULM.

EXPLOSIVE PLAYS

Entering the WKU game on Sept. 14, the Blue Raiders had seven explosive plays on the season (20 or more yards) with a long play of 44 yards. Against WKU, Duke, Memphis, LA Tech, KSU and JSU, the offense has

put up 25 total explosive plays to give them **32** for the year. The Blue Raiders put six explosive plays on the board against WKU, including a season-best 71-yard pass from Nicholas Vattiato to Omari Kelly, then added three more against Duke. A 66-yard TD run against the Blue Devils was the longest run of the year and the second longest play. MTSU had four plays at Memphis, including the second longest of the season with a 69-yard pass from Vattiato to Kelly.

NEWCOMERS GALORE

There have been a lot of changes surrounding the MTSU football program since the end of the 2023 season but none more than the overall roster. When the Blue Raiders take the field in 2024, there will be 60 newcomers (33 transfers - 17th most nationally) on the roster since the end of the '23 campaign which ranks tied for **9th** most nationally. There are a total of 41 new scholarship players (8th most nationally) and 43 who returned from the '23 team. Here is the 115-man roster breakdown:

VATTIATO JUMPS INTO TOP 10

Redshirt junior quarterback Nicholas Vattiato, who has played 28 career games, made his way into the top 10 career list at MTSU for passing yards following his 209-yard effort against Ole Miss. Vattiato enters the UTEP game with **6,489** passing yards (6th place) and 39 touchdown passes. The signal-caller needs **576** more passing yards to overtake Kelly Holcomb (7064) for 5th place and he needs one more TD pass to tie Dwight Dasher (40) for 5th place in that category. Vattiato is coming off a 3,000-yard season, making him just the third different QB in school history to reach that plateau.

THE 200 MAN

In 28 career games played, Nicholas Vattiato owns **20** 200-yard passing games to rank third all-time at MTSU. He needs one more to tie Logan Kilgore for second place. He tallied 10 games with 200 or more yards last season which ranked second most in a season behind Brent Stockstill's 12 in 2015. Vattiato has thrown for 200 or more yards 16 times in his last 19 games.

WILLIS CONTINUES UPWARD TRAJECTORY

Holden Willis, the Blue Raiders' only first team all-conference offensive or defensive player returning in 2024, is building nicely on his productive 2023 debut. Willis, a 10-game starter in 2023, enjoyed a career year with 46 receptions for 697 yards and five touchdowns. The Greenback, Tenn., native had three 100-yard receiving games with two being against CUSA foes LA Tech and UTEP. After eight games in 2024, Willis ranks second on the team with 39 grabs for 600 yards (37 catches last seven outings).

BLOCK PARTY

Since MTSU joined the FBS ranks in 1999, the Blue Raiders own **75** total blocked kicks in 311 games. That total breaks down as 34 field goals, 27 punts and 14 PATs. MTSU has at least one blocked kick in 24 straight years entering the '24 campaign (no blocks so far in 2024). The most blocked kicks in a single-season in the I-A era is eight set in 2009.

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

Winning the turnover battle is critical in collecting victories in football. Over the last 152 games (since middle of 2012), MTSU is **53-13** when winning the turnover battle. The Blue Raiders are 11-3 over the past two years when winning the turnover battle.

7TH YEAR PLAYERS

In FBS football this season there are **34** players competing in their seventh season of college football. The Blue Raiders are one of seven schools nationally with multiple seven-year guys with safety Brendon Harris and defensive end Alex Williams. Indiana leads the nation with four while Nevada, Utah State, Oklahoma State, Illinois, Hawaii and North Texas join MTSU with two.

LOOKING FOR 100

During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive **178-59-1** (.750) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing in a single game. Since joining the FBS ranks in 1999, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark 100 times and the team has a **76-24** (.760) mark in those games.

30 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

Since joining the FBS ranks in 1999, the Blue Raiders are **111-23** (.828) when scoring 30 or more points. Over the last 106 games when scoring 30 points, MTSU is 87-14. As a head coach, Derek Mason owns a mark of **19-5** when scoring 30 or more points in a game.

GIANT KILLERS

Since 1999, the Blue Raiders have had a knack of knocking off Power 4 opponents. With the win at Miami in 2022, MTSU now has nine wins over Power 4 foes in the FBS era. MTSU owns wins over Vanderbilt (2001, 2002, 2005), Maryland (2008, 2009), Georgia Tech (2012), Missouri (2016), Syracuse (2017) and Miami (2022) with seven others being decided by a TD or less.

GAMES PLAYED LEADERS

Brody Butler and Jalen Davis lead the Blue Raiders with **55** career games played. Next in line are: Brendan Harris 50, Drew Francis 46, Zeke Rankin 46, Frank Peasant 45, Jalen Jackson 42, and Devyn Curtis 37.

1-POINT GAMES

The Blue Raiders made the move to FBS status in 1999, since that time the program has an impressive mark in one-point games. During that span, MTSU is **8-4** in those games.

GIVING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY

Since Derek Mason took over as head coach, he has emphasized giving back to the community. In his brief tenure, the program has put in **767** total hours of community service with everything occurring from March through July. The team has been involved with the Boys and Girls Club, Camp Ability, Read Across America, Rutherford County School Systems, Percy Priest Youth Ducks Football, Special Olympics, American Heart Association, Murfreesboro Farmer's Market and Endure Athletics.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- ▶ **90 Yard Drives:** The Blue Raiders have put together **44** scoring drives of 90 or more yards in the FBS era. The longest scoring drives in school history occurred in 2002 against Kentucky and 2007 at ULM - both covered 99 yards. MTSU had four 90-yard-or-longer drives in 2016 for the most in a single-season of the FBS era.
- ▶ The team passing yards of 456 against WKU this year went down as the second-most in school history.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders averaged 9.5 yards per play (54-514) against WKU on 9/14 which goes down as the fourth most in school history. The record is 10.4 per play against FAU in 2016.
- ▶ QB Nicholas Vattiato recorded a career long 30-yard run in 2023 opener at Alabama, then rushed for a personal-best 96 yards later that year against NMSU.
- ▶ MTSU has registered over 5,000 yards of total offense in a season **nine** times in its history, with all but one coming in the FBS era. The most yards in a single-season was 6,730 set in 2016.
- ▶ Since joining CUSA in 2013, MTSU has rushed for 15,054 yards in 90 league games. That averages out to 167.2 yards a game.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- ▶ MTSU has **49** total interceptions over the last four years combined. They had 17 in 2021, 20 in 2022, 8 in 2023 and 4 in 2024.
- ▶ DE Brandon Buckner had a career-best seven tackles at Memphis earlier this season, while fellow DE Anthony Bynum had a personal-best six stops against KSU.





- ▶ MTSU owns two shutouts since entering CUSA play in 2013. MTSU defeated FIU 48-0 in 2013 and downed Alabama A&M in 2016, 55-0.
- ▶ The most forced turnovers in the FBS era is 7 against Charlotte in 2015. The most in school history is 9 against Akron in 1985.
- ▶ The longest fumble returns in the FBS era are 100 yards by Rod Isaac vs WKU in 2010, 90-yards by Reed Blankenship against Marshall in 2021 and 71 yards by Jordan Ferguson at FAU in 2021.
- ▶ Former walk-on safety Chris Johnson turned in a career-best and team-leading nine tackles against WKU earlier this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- ▶ MTSU has three current players with at least one blocked kick in their career. The three are: Jalen Jackson (FG), Taharin Sudderth (Punt), and Parker Hughes (Punt).
- ▶ In a rarity, long snapper Brody Butler has earned first team all-conference honors in back-to-back seasons (2022 and 2023).
- ▶ Placekicker Zeke Rankin has scored 263 total points in his career which ranks 4th all-time in points scored by kicking in MTSU history. He needs nine more to take over 3rd place from Brian Kelly (2000-03). Overall, Rankin's 263 points rank 6th most in Blue Raider history and he needs nine more to tie for 5th place.
- ▶ Placekicker Zeke Rankin had made 11 straight field goals entering the 2022 FAU game before he missed. The 11 consecutive makes ranks as the second longest streak in school history.
- ▶ Placekicker Zeke Rankin owns **41** career made field goals to rank 3rd all-time. He needs five more field goals to tie for **2nd** place.

RAIDER ROUNDUP

- ▶ The Blue Raiders have had a representative on the Super Bowl Champion roster for the last five years in a row. 2020 Kansas City Chiefs (Charvarius Ward and Darius Harris), 2021 Tampa Bay Buccaneers (ILB Coach Mike Caldwell), 2022 Los Angeles Rams (Chandler Brewer), 2023 Kansas City Chiefs (Darius Harris) and 2024 Kansas City Chiefs (Richie James, Darius Harris, Izaiah Gathings).
- ▶ As a FBS (I-A) member (311 games), MTSU has scored 50 or more points 25 times.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders are **114-22** in the FBS era when leading at the half and are **123-13** when leading a game entering the 4th quarter.
- ▶ When trailing at the half, the Blue Raiders are just 25-128 in the FBS (I-A) era.
- ▶ The Blue Raiders have a streak of scoring in **54** consecutive games (last shutout was 2020 season opener at Army). However, MTSU has scored in **154** straight home games (last shutout was 9/23/1995 vs Murray State).
- ▶ Largest margin of victory in the I-A era: 59 points vs Charlotte 9/19/15 (73-14) ... Largest margin of defeat in the I-A era: 59 points vs Oklahoma 9/23/06 (59-0).
- ▶ **Raiders in the NFL:** MTSU currently has five players on NFL rosters: Kevin Byard (Bears), Charvarius Ward (49ers), Darius Harris (Cowboys), Robert Jones (Dolphins), and Reed Blankenship (Eagles).

JOHNNY "RED" FLOYD STADIUM

Officially named Johnny "Red" Floyd Stadium/Horace Jones Field in 1968, Floyd Stadium will host its 89th season of Blue Raider football with the 2024 campaign. Set on the northwest end of campus, Johnny "Red" Floyd Stadium has one of the top settings in the region and Conference USA.

On January 26, 2023, the Blue Raiders officially broke ground on a new \$66-million Student-Athlete Performance Center that will be located in the north end zone of Floyd Stadium. Completion is scheduled for the 2025 season.

The three-story, 85,500-square-foot performance center will provide all MTSU student-athletes with new facilities for weight training, nutrition, and sports medicine. It will also be the new home for Blue Raider Football, allowing MTSU to relocate its football operations from Murphy Center to Floyd Stadium. The project will also include a new videoboard for the south end zone that is expected to be in place for the 2024 campaign.

During the summer of 2014, a new synthetic surface was installed to replace the turf that was installed in 2006. The surface is by Shaw Sports Turf and the brand used is Legion 46, which combines a high-performance monofilament fiber with a durable slit film fiber to provide a soft and resilient playing surface.

The Blue Raiders are **301-138-14** all-time at Floyd Stadium.

The stadium opened its doors on October 14, 1933, with a scoreless tie against Jacksonville State.

Originally built as two sideline grandstands on either side of an outdoor track, it was enlarged in 1940, 1960, 1968, and most recently in 1998 to bring it to its current configuration as an octagonal bowl.

The move to NCAA Division I-A (FBS) football was the catalyst for the 1998 renovation to Floyd Stadium. On August 24, 1995, the University announced plans for a \$25 million renovation, which was approved by the State Building Commission. After a lengthy bid process, ground was officially broken for the stadium in January of 1997 with Turner Construction handling the project.

Upon completion, the stadium featured 30,788 seats

with only the east side grandstands remaining from the original structure. The old press box gave way to a five-story tower including luxury suites on the third level, a large press area and suites on the fourth level, and a camera deck on the fifth level. The renovation also included the addition of more chair-back seats as well as a club level.

The stadium is also equipped with 16 indoor suites and 26 outdoor boxes (reduced from 38 due to construction in 2023).

The first game in the renovated stadium took place on Sept. 5, 1998. The game, in which Middle Tennessee hosted local rival Tennessee State, drew a school record at the time 27,568 fans. The attendance helped push Middle Tennessee over the top for its I-A qualifying attendance of 17,000 per game.

The Blue Raiders set a new stadium attendance record with 30,502 seeing the home team face Georgia Tech on Sept. 10, 2011.

The following is a rundown of the other facelifts that have been added during the 88-year history of Floyd Stadium:

1948: Permanent concrete stands added to Horace Jones Field to bring capacity to 6,200.

1960: Horace Jones Field expanded to 10,000 seats and a press area was added.

1968: Facility officially becomes Johnny "Red" Floyd Stadium/Horace Jones Field.

1968: Seating capacity expanded to 14,000. In addition, a larger press box was added.

1971: Artificial turf was installed and natural grass became a thing of the past. First game on the new turf was Oct. 2, 1971, against Chattanooga.

1979: On Nov. 3, stadium is officially dedicated and press box sign unveiled.

1998: \$25 million renovation expands seating capacity to 30,788 and the old press box gave way to a five-story facility with a club level, suites, press floor, and a camera deck.

2006: A new synthetic surface was installed to give the Blue Raiders one of the top surfaces in the country.

2007: A new state-of-the-art video board with an

18'x32' display was installed.

2011: A new fence was installed around the perimeter of the stadium.

2012: The Jeff Hendrix Stadium Club debuted on the west side of the stadium.

2014: New synthetic surface was installed, along with a new design.

2017: New ribbon video boards installed on east side

2019: Debut of the Blue Raider Beer Garden in the south end zone.

2021: Announced a new student-athlete performance center on the north end of the stadium that is expected to be ready for the 2025 season.

2024: A new state-of-the-art Daktronics video board with an 60'x33.6' display was installed. The new board has a 10mm pixel pitch.
