### #WEEKDAYCUSA ACTION CONTINUES vs UTEP

- #WeekdayCUSA action continues for the Bearkats on Wednesday when Sam Houston hosts UTEP at Shell Energy Stadium in a battle of 2 teams searching for their first win in CUSA play
- Hunter Watson tied a career high with 3 TD passes vs Jax State, finishing 12/19 for 136 yards passing. He was better in the second half, completing 5 of 8 passes for 87 yards and a pair of scores, with 3 second-half completions being of 19+ yards
- Sam Houston is playing the third of 4 consecutive midweek games in the month of October. In all, the Kats are scheduled to play 5 non-Saturday games in 2025, having also opened the season on a Friday at WKU
- The Kats are went 3-1 in October midweek games in 2024 and 5-1 overall in non-Saturday games. In all, SHSU is 5-9 in non-Saturday games since joining FBS in 2023 after last week's loss to Jax State
- Sam Houston will be trying to avoid starting 0-7 for the second time in 3 seasons. Prior to its 0-8 start in 2023, the Kats had not started at least 0-5 since opening the 1977 season with 7 straight defeats. They are 1 of just 3 teams remaining in the FBS still searching for a victory, joined by UMass and Oregon State
- The Bearkats were even in turnovers on Thursday vs Jax State just a week after losing the turnover battle for the first time this year. Thru 6 games, the Kats are holding a -1 turnover margin
- Emon Allen had a 66-yard pick-6 in the Kats' game at Hawaii, joining JaMair Diaz as Bearkat defenders to reach the end zone this year. It is the third straight year the Kats' defense has had at least 2 scores in a season, with the 2021 season being the last time that side of the ball had 3 TDs to its credit

### BY THE NUMBERS

**6** The Bearkats have shown explosiveness on the offensive side of the football in 2025 with 6 plays of 50+ yards.

Of those, 3 have come on the ground, already marking the first time the Kats have had 3+ runs of 50+ yards in a season since 2021.

**16** Sam Houston quarterbacks have distributed the ball throughout the offense so far in 2025.



In fact, the Kats have had 16 different players catch passes this year. That is compared to only 16 total players hauling in passes in all of 2024.

**58** During Phil Longo's first stint at SHSU from 2014-16, the Bearkats were arguably the top offense in all of the FCS, averaging a staggering 40.9 points per game in 44 games over that 3-year span.

That included 2016 when the Kats averaged a school-record 49.5 ppg

- Wednesday's matchup will be the first meeting between the schools at a site other than El Paso or Huntsville

**THE LAST TIME**

- Sam Houston put up a season-high 517 yards of total offense against the Miners with Hunter Watson throwing for 224 yards and a pair of touchdowns
- The Bearkat defense forced 4 UTEP turnovers and had 3 sacks, holding UTEP to 323 yards of total offense in the game
- The win was the first for the Bearkats in the history of the series

**TEAM NOTES ENTERING 2025**

- Sam Houston has reached postseason play in 10 of the last 12 seasons in which it was eligible at the FBS and FCS levels
- Sam Houston's 10 wins in 2024 was its first winning season at the FBS level and 14th in the last 15 seasons overall. The Kats only season with a losing record since 2009 came in 2023, its first full year at the FBS level. The Kats finished their run at the FCS level with 13 consecutive winning seasons
- The Kats' 10 wins were the most of any team in Conference USA in 2024, and they were the only CUSA team to register a bowl victory

**QUICK RUN TO THE TOP**

Since 2000 there have been 22 programs to make the transition from the FCS/1-AA to the FBS level with the Kats being 1 of 3 programs in that span to post a season of 10+ wins within the first 2 years of the move up

**LOOKING FOR THE CENTURY MARK**

Despite more productive offensive games the last 2 weeks, the Kats are still in search of either their first 100-yard rusher or 100-yard receiver for a single game. The Kats had 6 100-yar rushers last year, with half coming from Watson, and enter this week with a streak of 9 straight games without a 100-yard rushing game from a running back with the last being Jay Ducker vs Kennesaw State in 2024. Meanwhile, it's been 17 consecutive games since the Kats' last 100-yard receiver with Qua'Vez Humphreys' 106-yard performance vs Hawaii in 2024 being the last time it has happened

**WHOA, THIS IS HEAVY**

The Bearkats have already played in 3 time zones in 2025, having already played at NM State (Mountain Time Zone) and Hawaii (Hawaii-Aleutian Time Zone). They have 8 games scheduled for the Central Time Zone and will collect the Pacific Time Zone in its Nov 8 game at Oregon State. SHSU is 1 of 9 FBS programs scheduled to play in 4 time zones in 2025, joined by BYU, Houston, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Nevada, TCU, Utah and West Virginia. The only program scheduled to play in 5 time zones is Stanford

**LONGO ERA HAPPENING IN HUNTSVILLE**

Phil Longo is in his first season at the helm of the Bearkat program in 2025, becoming the 16th head coach in Sam Houston history. He is looking to become the eighth SHSU head man to post a winning record in his first season in charge

Longo is not unfamiliar with Huntsville, having served as the Kats' offensive coordinator from 2014-16 and helping direct quarterback Jeremiah Briscoe to the 2016 Walter Payton Award after breaking Willie Totten's FCS record of 56 touchdown passes in a single season which had stood since 1986

Longo returned to Huntsville after a 7-year hiatus which included stops as the offensive coordinator at Ole Miss (2017-18), North Carolina (2019-22) and Wisconsin (2023-24)

It has been nearly 2 decades since his last stint as a head coach, going 7-14 as the head man at LaSalle in 2004 and 2005 before the program was discontinued following the conclusion of the 2007 season

**KATS JOIN OTHER TEXAS TEAMS TO REMEMBER KERRVILLE FLOOD VICTIMS**

This season Sam Houston has joined with the other football programs across Texas in wearing a helmet sticker in memory of those affected by this summer's devastating floods in the Kerrville and Central Texas areas. The sticker features a green ribbon over the state of Texas in memory of the victims and all those impacted by this summer's devastating floods

**SPECIAL TEAMS BEING SPECIAL**

Sam Houston has had its share of highlights on special teams in 2025, including converting an on-side kick late in it's game vs UNLV off the foot of backup kicker Nico Ottomanelli. It was the first time the Bearkats had even attempted an on-side kick since the opening game of 2019 at New Mexico, a kick SHSU also converted behind then kicker Connor Crow

The Kats had a pair of special teams highlights last week at NM State, including a 72-yard punt by freshman Curtis Gerrand which was downed at the 2-yard line. The 72-yarder was the fourth longest punt in program history and only the sixth of 70+ yards. Each of the 3 kicks longer than Gerrand's came from fellow Australian, former Bearkat Matt McRobert who had kicks of 74, 74 and 73 yards in 2018, 2019 and 2021

Christian Pavon also stood out in Las Cruces, subbing in late in the first half to nail a 51-yard field goal on his first try of the year. It was the 15th field goal of his Bearkat career, including the second of 50+ yards. His career long was a 52-yarder in last year's season-opener at Rice, a kick which was the first field goal try of his career



Sam Houston will face an out-of-the-box challenge in 2025, not playing any of its games at Bowers Stadium. Due to an approximately \$60M upgrade to the stadium which includes new concessions, concourses and a completely new press box, the Bearkats will play all home games in 2025 at Shell Energy Stadium in downtown Houston

Shell Energy Stadium, which also hosts Texas Southern football home games, is primarily the home of the Houston Dynamo and Dash of the professional soccer ranks. The Kats are 1-0 all-time at the venue, having defeated Texas Southern there in 2012

The venue will be the first time the Kats have hosted a season of games on a grass venue since they left Pritchett Field for Bowers Stadium for the 1986 season. The games there this season are the only games scheduled for grass in 2025 with all road venues having artificial surfaces



**CHANGES COMING TO BOWERS STADIUM**

Bowers Stadium has been the home of the Bearkats since the program moved to the Division I level for the 1986 season, but it has not received a major renovation since its inception.

That will not be the case for much longer as major renovations to the west side of Bowers Stadium began at the conclusion of the 2024 season.

The primary piece of the upgrades was the demolition of the current press box and the construction of a new facility, with expected completion in time for the start of the 2026 season.

The box will span approximately 47,000 gross square feet, boasting an additional 13,000 square feet of covered exterior space and culminating in a total of approximately 60,000 square feet.

At a price tag of approximately \$60 million, it will include updated concessions and restrooms, premium seating options and suites with access to outdoor balcony seating.

A state-of-the-art media center will also be integrated, elevating coverage for TV, radio, digital and print platforms.

**KAT TO WATCH CHRIS REED**

The Bearkats had been looking for an impact game from a wide receiver this season and got it last week from Chris Reed. The transfer from Kilgore College hauled in 3 grabs for 63 total yards, the high for any Bearkat receiver this season, with 2 of those catches going for scores. Each of Reed's catches gave the Kats hte lead, including a 24-yard touchdown catch from Hunter Watson to give SHSU a 27-26 lead with under a minute to play

**OFFENSIVE QUICK HITTERS**

- The Bearkats got the return of Alton McCaskill to the lineup for the NM State game after missing 3 straight games since the season opener at WKU. The 3-time transfer has made an immediate impact since his return, hauling in 64 yards of total offense and a TD reception at NM State before putting up 87 yards on the ground vs Jax State, the highest rushing total by a Bearkat running back in 2025. He has 197 yards on the ground in 3 games this year, already his highest total since rushing for 961 yards and 16 touchdowns at Houston as a freshman in 2021

- Playing from ahead has been a struggle for the Kats this year, but they held the lead for 14:04 of game time against Jax State, going ahead for the first time in a game since the season opener at WKU. In all, the Kats have only held the lead for 19:42 of 360 total minutes of games this season

- Since returning to CUSA play, Hunter Watson has put together 2 of his most efficient games of the season throwing for a season-high 222 yards and his first touchdown at NM State. He followed that outing with 3 touchown passes against Jax State, tying his career high set in the 2024 season-opening win at Rice

- Watson led the Kats in both passing and rushing in 2024, but did not have a game with 300+ yards of total offense last year. He hit that mark for the first time in his college career in the season opener at WKU with 209 yards in the air and 91 more on the ground

- Watson needs 145 more yards on the ground to become the fourth Bearkat quarterback in program history to reach 1,000 career rushing yards. Jared Johnson holds the record for rushing yards as a QB at Sam Houston with 1,601

- Despite Zack Patterson holding the offensive coordinator title, it is head coach Phil Longo calling the plays for the Bearkats in 2025. Known for his explosive air-raid offense at the FBS level with previous stops at Wisconsin, North Carolina and Ole Miss, Longo has had plenty of success developing NFL talent at quarterback, including signal callers Drake Maye and Sam Howell

**KAT TO WATCH DEAN FORD**

Ford hit the field for the first time in his career at NM State and responded with 5 stops and a TFL in his debut. That effort earned him a start against Jax State and the redshirt freshman linebacker responded with a big performance, picking up 7 total tackles and a TFL. He was also involved in 2 of the biggest plays of the game, starting with recovering a fumble at the JSU 1-yard line to set up SHSU's first touchdown of the game. He also made a key stop on a 4th & 1 late in the game to force a turnover on downs with the Kats taking the lead with 52 seconds left in the game on the ensuing drive.

**DEFENSIVE QUICK HITTERS**

- Emon Allen ranks third on the team in both tackles (25) and TFLs (2.5), but after blocking a field goal attempt in the first quarter vs Jax State, Allen has been involved in 5 of the Kats 8 impact plays (INT, FF/FR, BLK) this year, owning both of SHSU's interceptions along with a forced fumble and a fumble recovery

- The Kats have a takeaway in 5 of 6 games this year and 24 of the last 25 games dating back to 2023

- Sam Houston has had 7.0 TFLs against Jax State and now has at least 5.0 TFLs in 5 of 6 games this season

**PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

**Offensive Player of the Week – Cam Cook, Jax State**

Cook had a big-time performance in his return to the Lone Star State with a career-high 218 yards and two touchdowns on 31 carries in a 29-27 win over Sam Houston. He becomes the first CUSA player to rush for over 200 yards in a game this season and in the process, enters the weekend as FBS's leading rusher with 832. Cook, the FBS leader in rushes of 10+ yards (31), busted off eight double-digit runs, including a season-long 73-yard rumble in the opening quarter. It was also the third-most rushing yards in a game by an FBS player during the 2025 season, giving him two of the five highest single-game rushing totals this year.

**Defensive Player of the Week – Tylon Dunlap, KSU**

Dunlap wreaked havoc on the LA Tech backfield in Kennesaw State's (4-2, 2-0 CUSA) stifling 35-7 victory on Thursday night. He finished with eight tackles, a career-high 2.0 sacks and also broke up a pass. Dunlap tallied the top pass rush PFF grade (90.3) and the second-highest defensive PFF grade and top for a defensive lineman in CUSA (90.4) for week seven. After the first LA Tech drive of the game, he helped lead a KSU defense that held the Bulldogs to a paltry 235 yards of offense (3.8 yards per play). The Owls forced three three-and-outs and six punts and surrendered only 136 rushing yards (3.4 yards per carry).

**Specialist of the Week – Garrison Rippa, Jax State**

Rippa hit a career-long 52-yard field goal as time expired to give Jax State (3-3, 2-0 CUSA) a 29-27 win over Sam Houston on Thursday night. The kick also matched the program record and marked his third make of 50+ in his career. He has now converted four of the program's 13 longest field goals. The sophomore added makes of 30 and 26 yards during the contest and had three of his six kickoffs go for touchbacks. It marked the second walk-off field goal of his career after he sealed an overtime win in the 2023 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl.

**Freshman of the Week – Deuce Bailey, Missouri State**

In his first career start, Bailey went the distance to lead the Bears (3-3, 1-1 CUSA) to a come-from-behind victory at MTSU. He engineered a game-winning 10-play, 56-yard drive late in the fourth quarter that consumed nearly five minutes and culminated in the winning field goal with just over four minutes to play. Bailey also produced four consecutive scoring drives during a key stretch in the second and third quarters that elevated the Bears to leads at halftime and going into the fourth quarter. He finished the night 16-31 passing for 278 yards, no interceptions and a TD along with a five-yard rushing touchdown (the first of his career).

**Offensive Lineman of the Week – J.T. Pennington, KSU**

Pennington helped pave the way as Kennesaw State rolled up 400 yards of offense against first place LA Tech in the 35-7 victory. He played 65 snaps at right guard on Thursday, including 40 pass-blocking snaps, and recorded Conference USA's top PFF pass blocking rating (88.0) for week seven. Pennington did not incur a penalty or allow a sack, quarterback hit, hurry or pressure all night. He helped Kennesaw State record the PFF top pass blocking efficiency (94.7) as a unit, only allowing four total hurries and four total pressures.
