OPENING TIP

The UTEP men's basketball team (3-2) heads to the "Sunshine State" to take on William & Mary (4-2) in its opening-round game of the Jacksonville Classic, presented by Just Play Solutions, at 2 p.m. MT/4 p.m. ET Monday. The Miners halted a two-tilt slide last time out with a wild 84-83 overtime victory against Division III powerhouse St. Thomas (Texas) on Nov. 19. The Tribe pushed its winning streak to two after most recently throttling first-year DIII member Regent University, 104-57, on its "Education Day" contest on Nov. 21. Monday's matchup will be the first on a neutral site for both programs this year. The Miners did fall in their lone contest on the road, 75-51, at perennial NCAA Tournament team Utah State on Nov. 21. William & Mary is 2-2 away from home this season, including an impressive 82-74 vanquishing of MAC power Bowling Green on Nov. 19. The Miners will play twice in as many days at the event, locking up with former Conference USA rival UAB at 2 p.m. MT/4 p.m. ET on Tuesday. The games open up a brutal stretch with four straight and seven of the next nine outside of the Sun City. UTEP will have a nice break following the MTE before true road games at Seattle (Dec. 7) and Hawaii (Dec. 13). The Orange and Blue then have another gap off before returning home to play host to the 2025 WestStar Bank Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational (Dec. 21-22). Following the holiday tourney, UTEP's first three league contests will also be in hostile territory. UTEP will venture to LA Tech (12/29), new CUSA member Missouri State (Jan. 2) and FIU (Jan. 4). **Jon Teicher** (45th year) will be on the call on "The Home of UTEP Basketball" 600 ESPN El Paso and the UTEP Miners' App for both contests in Florida. They will also be streamed on Pass Tha Ball Live.

GET TO KNOW WILLIAM & MARY (4-2)

William & Mary, picked fourth in the CAA preseason poll, is off to a solid 4-2 start on the year while under the direction of second-year head coach Brian Earl. The Tribe has won back-to-back games, with a noteworthy 82-74 road vanquishing at MAC power Bowling Green (11/19) before smashing first-year DIII program Regent University, 104-57, at home last time out (11/21). It returned seven letterwinners, but only starter, from the 2024-25 squad (17-15, 11-7 CAA). William & Mary boasts scoring up and down the roster, with seven players producing between 8.0 and 12.0 ppg. Kyle Pulliam (11.7 ppg) and Reese Millers (11.5 ppg) set the tone in double figures followed by Kilian Brockhoff (9.2 ppg), Ryan Jackson Jr. (8.7 ppg), Chase Lowe (8.3 ppg), Tunde Vahlberg Fasasi (8.3 ppg) and Cade Haskins (8.2 ppg). Kaleb Spencer is the top rebounder (6.3 rpg), aided by pulling down 3.0 offensive boards per game. He would be top-100 nationally for orpg, but his three games played do not let him qualify. The Tribe does plenty well across the board, leading the CAA and rating among the top-100 nationally as a team for assists per game (19.8-23rd), bench scoring (41.5-13th NCAA), field-goal percentage (48.0-98th), defensive rebounds per game (30.2-27th), steals per game (9.3-56th) and turnovers forced per game (16.0-59th). William & Mary is also among the league leaders and top-100 in the country for blocks per game (4.5-second/85th), fastbreak scoring (19.0-third/35th), field-goal percentage defense-39.2-second/69th), free-throw attempts per game (25.8-fourth/69th), free throws made per game (18.7-third/72nd), rebounds per game (41.0-fourth/74th), scoring offense (87.2-second/78th) and 3-pointers made per game (9.5-third/78th). Among the few things it struggles with is fouling (19.5 fpg-11th/257th), offensive rebounding (10.8-12th/239th), scoring defense (75.8-ninth/232nd), 3-point defense (32.4-sixth/220th) and turnovers per game (14.8-11th/303rd). Officially known as the College of William & Mary, the school predates the founding of the United States by 83 years. Launched in 1693, it is the second-oldest university in the country and the ninth-oldest English-speaking college in the world. Notable attendees/alumni include four of the country's first 10 presidents (George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, James Monroe and John Tyler), Glenn Close (actor), Jon Stewart (comedian), Bill Lawrence (creator of Scrubs and Ted Lasso), Mike Tomlin (Steelers head coach) and Sean McDermott (Bills head coach).

SERIES HISTORY: UTEP LEADS, 2-0

UTEP leads the all-time series with William & Mary, 2-0, with matchups in consecutive campaigns in the mid 1960s. Both came at holiday tournaments around Christmas. The Miners dispatched the Tribe, 61-51, to win the Arkansas State Tournament (Jonesboro, Ark.) on Dec. 21, 1963. The Orange and Blue then held off William & Mary, 56-51, in their opening-round victory of the Sun Carnival Classic Tournament (El Paso, Texas) on Dec. 29, 1964.

GOING BACK IN TIME (AT UTEP 84, ST. THOMAS (TEXAS), 11/19/25)

Jamal West Jr. tipped in a shot with 1.1 seconds left to lift UTEP past upset-minded powerhouse DIII member St. Thomas (Texas), 84-83, in overtime at the Don Haskins Center on Nov. 15. The Miners dug themselves an 11-point (41-30) deficit at the half. UTEP fought back to eventually lead by as many as five (61-56, 7:13, 2H). The Celts, who went 26-3 last year and hosted the DIII NCAA Tournament, rallied back to go up by three (72-69) with 8.2 seconds to play in regulation before **Elijah Jones** drilled a corner 3-pointer as time expired to force overtime. The visitors vaulted to a five-point cushion (81-76) two minutes into the extra session, but UTEP kept its composure and closed the contest on an 8-2 surge to pull out the victory.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

Jamal West Jr. poured in a season-high 20 points, including a tip-in with 1.1 seconds remaining in OT, to send the Miners to the 84-83 OT win vs. St. Thomas (Texas). It was UTEP's third shot attempt of the possession, with a misfire on a contested layup by **Caleb Blackwell** and an unsuccessful tip-in by **Kaseem Watson** before West Jr's heroics. UST, which played the game as an exhibition, called timeout to set up a play but was unable to get a shot off before time expired.

MADE IT WHEN IT MATTERED MOST

Elijah Jones was 1-4 on 3-pointers in the win against St. Thomas (Texas), but his one make was monumental. He sank a corner triple on a pass from **Trey Horton III** as time expired to tie the tilt at 72 and send it to OT.



CLUTCH FREE THROWS FROM CALEB

With UTEP trailing by four (71-67) with only 11 seconds left in regulation, **Caleb Blackwell**, who had a season-best 11 points, stepped up and drilled a pair of free throws to keep the Miners in striking distance. Coupled with a missed free throw from UST on the ensuing possession, those makes set the stage for **Elijah Jones's** buzzer-beating triple to send the game to OT. Overall, Blackwell has nailed 11-12 for a team-best readout of 91.7 percent at the charity stripe. He finished with a career-most five made free throws (5-5 in game).

ALL FIVE STARTERS IN DOUBLE DIGITS

All five Miner starters reached double figures in scoring against St. Thomas (Texas), something that hadn't happened in seven years (at New Mexico, 11/24/18). **Jamal West Jr.** led the way with a season-best 20 points, followed by 15 each from **Kaseem Watson** and **Elijah Jones**, and 11 apiece courtesy of **Caleb Blackwell** (campaign most) and **Tyreese Watson**.

OT SKID STOPPED

UTEP's 84-83 OT victory against St. Thomas (Texas) halted a five-game skid in the situation for the Miners that had dated to a 79-73 double-OT loss at UAB (12/29/22) nearly three years ago.

BIG EFFORT ON THE BOARDS AGAIN FOR KJ

After pulling down a career-best four rebounds at Utah State (11/15), **KJ Thomas** matched that total with four boards in the OT victory against St. Thomas (Texas).

DROPPING THE DIMES TOO

KJ Thomas had eyes in the back of his head against St. Thomas (Texas), dish-ing out five helpers (second most of his career). He has recorded at three assists on a trio of occasions this year after doing so once last year (three, vs. Yale, 12/21/24). He enters the matchup with William & Mary producing 3.4 apg (second team/19th CUSA). Thomas has also taken good care of the ball with a team-leading +2.13 assist-to-turnover ratio (13th CUSA).

BOUNCE BACK FOR KASEEM

After being held to two points at Utah State (11/15), **Kaseem Watson** was a stout 6-8 from the floor (2-2 on 3-point-ers) and 1-3 at the line for 15 points in a season-best 31 minutes vs. St. Thomas (Texas).

DT CLEANED UP THE GLASS

David Tubek skied for a career-best seven rebounds, including two on the offensive end in only 15 minutes of action vs. St. Thomas (Texas).

KASEEM HAS DONE THAT ALL YEAR

Kaseem Watson tops UTEP at 5.2 rpg, aided by three games of at least five caroms. After four offensive rebounds through four games, he nearly matched that total (three) last time out against St. Thomas (Texas). Overall, he has a team-most 19 defensive caroms.

ELIJAH DOES TOO

Elijah Jones has snagged 4.4 rpg. He has the second-most offensive boards (nine) on the team to go along with 13 defensive caroms.

CASH MONEY

Cassius Brooks has made his presence felt off the bench this year. He is pitching in 6.0 ppg off the pine on a stout 63.2 percent shooting (12-19), doing so in only 17.0 mpg, aided by a pair of eight-point efforts. He is 3-5 on 3-point tosses and 9-14 inside the arc, in addition to knocking down 3-4 at the charity stripe.

STUFFING THE STAT SHEET

Tyreese Watson has done it all for the Miners thus far in 2025-26. He paces the team in assists (4.0 apg-seventh CUSA) and steals per game (3.0-first CUSA/11th NCAA) and is second for assist-to-turnover ratio (+1.78-16th CUSA). Watson also is one of three players to produce double figures for scoring (10.3 ppg-third on squad), aided by reaching double figures in three of his four contests this season. He missed the opener with an injury.

JONES HAS ELEVATED HIS PLAY

Elijah Jones has stepped things up at both ends of the court this year, pacing the Miners in blocked shots (1.4-sixth CUSA), rating second in scoring (13.4 ppg) and third in rebounding (4.4 rpg).

STREAKING IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Elijah Jones has posted double-digit scoring efforts all five games this year, matching his total such combined efforts (five) in a UTEP uniform over his first two years (60 contests). His prior career-long streak was two (twice). He has been steadfast, recording respective point totals of 13, 16, 10, 13 and 15.

JAMAL JUST DOESN'T MISS

Jamal West Jr. is connecting on a ridiculous 67.6 (27-40) of his shots on the year which is second in CUSA and 23rd in the country. He has also been solid at the charity stripe, connecting on 71.4 percent (15-21), pacing the Miners in both makes and attempts. It all adds up to him leading the Orange and Blue for scoring at 14.0 ppg. West Jr. also has a team-high four And-1s.

HE'S NOT THE ONLY ONE SHOOTING IT WELL

Four Miners are connecting on at least 50.0 from the floor (min. 10 FGA). **Jamal West Jr.** leads the way with a stunning 67.5 percent (27-40, first CUSA/23rd NCAA), followed by **Cassius Brooks** at 63.2 percent (12-19), **LA Hayes** at 58.3 percent (7-12) and **Elijah Jones** at 53.3 percent (26-47). Overall, UTEP has drained 46.7 percent as a team, including 52.5 percent (115-219) on two-point tosses. Brooks has topped 50.0 percent in every contest while Jones and West Jr. have passed that metric in four contests.

OPPONENTS CAN'T HOLD ONTO IT

The Orange and Blue have done a sensational job turning over the opposition once again in 2025-26, forcing a Conference USA-leading 18.8 opponent giveaways per game (eighth NCAA).

THAT'S A MARGIN WE LIKE

Thanks in large part to forcing 18.0 turnovers per game (first CUSA/eighth NCAA), the Miners enter the matchup with William & Mary with one of the best turnover margins nationwide. UTEP boasts a +6.4 turnover margin, which places it third in CUSA and 21st nationally.

NOTHING WRONG WITH STEALING THIS WAY

With both **Tyreese Watson** (3.0 spg-first CUSA/11th NCAA) setting the tone and **KJ Thomas** (1.8 spg-eighth CUSA) also doing his part, the Miners go into the game against William & Mary third in CUSA and 30th nationally with 10.4 steals per game. UTEP has been among the very best in the nation for the category the past few years under **Joe Golding**. The Orange and Blue were second nationally for steals per game in 2024-25 (10.2), led the country in 2023-24 (11.4) and were 12th in the NCAA in 2022-23 (9.0).



THE BEST DEFENDERS ARE CONSISTENT THREATS

KJ Thomas (1.8 spg-tied 10th CUSA) and **Caleb Blackwell** are the only Miners to record at least one steal in every contest (all five) while team leader **Tyreese Watson** (3.0 spg-first CUSA/11th NCAA) has produced multiple thefts in all four games he's appeared in.

LOOKING FOR MORE NOVEMBER SUCCESS

UTEP stands 22-11 in the month of November under head coach **Joe Golding**, including 3-2 this year. That trend of success is not recent, though, as the Orange and Blue have not endured a losing record in the month since going 2-4 in 2018-19.

QUICK RUNDOWN

- Lost all five starters and 11 letter winners overall from last year.
- Lost 89.0 percent of scoring, 77.7 percent of the rebounding, 90.3 percent of its assists, 90.8 percent of the steals and 74.7 percent of its blocks.
- Returned four players from last year, including two who started the opener (**Elijah Jones & KJ Thomas**), and another (**Jordan Hernandez**) who made his UTEP debut.
- Ten newcomers joined the squad, including DI transfers **C.J. Smith** (Oklahoma State), **David Tubek** (Seton Hall), **Tyreese Watson** (ULM), third-team All-MEAC member **Kaseem Watson** (Delaware State) and back-to-back All-Southland Conference second-team honoree **Jamal West Jr.** (Nicholls State). Second-team NJCAA All-American and the No. 12 JUCO player nationally **Caleb Blackwell** (South Plains), first-team all-conference and NJCAA All-Tourney team **LA Hayes** (Frank Phillips College) and 2025 NJCAA National Champion **Mouhamed Mbaye** (Trinity Valley CC) venture from the JUCO ranks. Three-star recruit **Bobby Montgomery Jr.** (Mt. Zion Prep) is a true freshman. DII transfer and second-team All-GAC recipient **Cassius Brooks** (Arkansas Tech), who scored more than 900 points in two years, rounds out the list of newcomers.

WINNING WAYS WITH GOLDING

UTEP head coach **Joe Golding** has led his squad to three winning seasons in four years, securing 18+ wins in each of them. That hadn't happened since the Miners claimed 18+ games in four straight seasons from 2012-16. UTEP has also posted consecutive campaigns with 18 wins for the first time since that stretch.

HOME COOKING

The Miners are 3-1 thus far at home, and they are looking for 10+ wins in the Sun City for the sixth straight year. UTEP was 11-5 at the Bear's Den last year, including winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight year.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE

UTEP stands 25-4 at home in nonconference games dating to the start of the 2022-23 campaign, including 3-1 this year. The Miners were 7-0 in the Sun City in the situation last year. It was the first undefeated effort (min. five games) in the area since 2019-20 (8-0).

THE BEST FANS IN CONFERENCE USA

UTEP has led Conference USA in attendance for either total number of fans or average attendance for all four years of head coach **Joe Golding's** tenure. In 2024-25 the Orange and Blue topped the league in both categories. UTEP averaged a CUSA-best 5,247 fans and had a league-most 83,954 pass through the turnstiles.

PRESEASON PREMONITIONS

UTEP was predicted to finish eighth in Conference USA for the 2025-26 season, as voted upon by the league's head coaches. Defending regular-season and tournament champion Liberty (143) led the way, followed by Kennesaw State (113), NM State (113), Middle Tennessee (103), LA Tech (82), WKU (79), Jax State (67), the Miners (66), Sam Houston (56), FIU (36) and league newcomers Delaware (35) and Missouri State (30). UTEP did not land anyone on the league's All-CUSA Preseason Team.

A YEAR IN REVIEW

- Compiled a record of 18-15 in 2024-25, marking the third season of at least 18 triumphs in four years under head coach **Joe Golding**.
- Outlasted I-10 rival NM State, 66-63, on the road, for its first victory against the Aggies in the Pan-American Center in 14 years.
- Won the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight season.
- Surged out to the best record through 20 games (15-5) in 15 years.
- Won at least one contest at the CUSA Championships for the second consecutive campaign. That hadn't happened since an eight-season run (2010-17).
- Nailed 241 triples, the second-most in a single season in program history.

THE BASIC FACTS ON UTEP'S PROGRAM

- This is the 105th season of UTEP men's basketball. The Miners made history by starting five African-Americans to defeat Kentucky, 72-65, and win the 1966 NCAA Championship on the way to inspiring the Disney hit movie *Glory Road*.
- UTEP has 17 NCAA Tournament appearances (last in 2010), 11 NIT bids (last in 2015), 12 conference championships (last in 2010) and 26 seasons with at least 20+ victories (last in 2015). The Miners have won five league tournaments (last in 2005).
- The Miners have a strong presence in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame with **Don Haskins**, **Nate Archibald**, **Nolan Richardson**, the **1966 team** and **Tim Hardaway** all representing UTEP.

GET TO KNOW COACH GOLDING

Joe Golding is in his fifth year at UTEP, and he is the 20th head coach in program history. He is the eighth head coach for the Miners since legendary Hall of Fame Coach **Don Haskins** retired following the 1998-99 season. Golding is 231-209 in his 15th season as a collegiate head coach, including 73-65 at UTEP. He has enjoyed three winning seasons in four years, piling up at least 18 triumphs in those campaigns above .500. He stands fifth all-time on the school's list for career victories, and he has a very good chance of taking over third place by year's end. **Tony Barbee** (82-52, 2006-10) and **George McCarty** (77-58, 1954-59) hold third and fourth, respectively. Golding set the tone for his tenure in his first year on the sidelines in the Sun City in 2021-22. He became the fourth head coach in program history to have a winning season in their initial season. **Don Haskins** was the first to do so when he directed the Miners to a mark of 18-6 in 1961-62. **Doc Sadler** (27-8, 2004-05) and **Tim Floyd** (25-10, 2010-11) also achieved the feat. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP. Previously Golding spent 10 years at Abilene Christian (158-144), helping it transition from a Division II to a Division I program. Golding led the Wildcats to the 2019 and 2021 NCAA Tournaments, including a stunning upset as a 14-seed of third-seeded Texas in the first round of the 2021 Big Dance.

UTEP Head Coach Joe **GOLDING**

Abilene Christian '99

Fifth Season at UTEP
27th Season as a Coach

Joe Golding was appointed the 20th head coach in UTEP men's basketball history on April 13, 2021. He will carry a career record of 228-207 (14 years) into the 2025-26 season, including a mark of 70-63 (four years) with UTEP. The 70 victories place him fifth all-time on the school's career coach win list.

Golding has directed the Miners to three winning seasons in four years, with UTEP picking up at least 18 victories in each of those campaigns. That hadn't occurred since the Orange and Blue claimed 18+ games in four straight seasons from 2012-16. UTEP has also posted consecutive campaigns with 18 wins for the first time since that stretch. Under his tutelage, nine Miners have combined to secure 12 Conference USA postseason honors.

UTEP compiled a record of 18-15 in 2024-25, including its first road vanquishing of I-10 rival NM State in 14 years. Other notable achievements were winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight season, surging out to the best record through 20 games in 15 years and winning at least one contest at the CUSA Championships for the second consecutive campaign. That hadn't happened since an eight-season run (2010-17).

Otis Frazier III (All-CUSA Second Team, All-Defensive Team), Corey Camper Jr. (All-Defensive Team, All-CUSA Honorable Mention) and David Terrell Jr. (All-CUSA Honorable Mention) were all recognized in postseason CUSA accolades. Frazier and Camper Jr. became the second Miner duo to earn all-defensive honors in the same season. Frazier III is also the first UTEP player since Julian Washburn (three times, 2013-15) and third all time (Julyan Stone, 2010-11) to do so on multiple occasions.

He guided UTEP to 18 victories and runner-up honors at the 2024 CUSA Championships. It marked the Orange and Blue's first appearance in the championship contest of the league tournament since 2011. The run to the finals was unprecedented for the program for multiple reasons. UTEP's No. 5 seed was the lowest in the 13 appearances that it has now made in a conference tournament championship game. The Miners took out the No. 1 seed, Sam Houston, 65-63, in the semifinals, their first win against a top seed at the league tournament since the 1993 WAC Championships. Furthermore, they became the first squad in school history to come back from double-digit deficits to win consecutive contests at the league tournament.

Some other notables for 2023-24 included helping UTEP lead the country in both steals per game (11.4) and turnovers forced per game (18.7). The Miners shattered the prior standard (280, 2002-023 and 2022-23) with their 389 total thefts, which also rates second all time in CUSA History. That trailed only the 395 by UAB in 2002-03. UTEP also broke the program mark for turnovers forced in a season with 636. The Miners showed grit, winning a game at the league tournament by two points or less for the first time since 1992 after they ousted top seed Sam Houston.

The Orange and Blue posted the biggest margin of victory (74-49, 25 points) against I-10 rival NM State in 20 years. UTEP claimed the 2023 WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the first time since 2019 (no event in 2020 due to Covid-19), in addition to knocking off a power conference program (Cal, 75-72, Nov. 20) at a neutral site for the initial occasion since 2014.

Senior guard Tae Hardy earned second-team All-District and All-CUSA Honors. The Miners accounted for three of the five players on the CUSA All-Freshman Team, including the Freshman of the Year Terrell Jr. Frazier III was All-CUSA Honorable-Mention and voted to the CUSA All-Defensive Team, the first selection to the squad for UTEP since 2015.

In 2022-23 he had to overhaul the roster after the Miners returned just one starter and three letterwinners total from a 20-win team a year prior. UTEP managed a 14-18 record, including a 67-64 victory against NM State on Nov. 12 for its first win against the Aggies in three years. That was the start of a five-game winning streak, which was aided by back-to-back OT triumphs. UTEP's five straight victories in November were the longest in the month in four years, which was aided by a mark of 3-0 in the inaugural Jim Forbes Classic Presented by Speaking Rock.

The Miners came within a point of winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational, falling 47-46 to eventual NCAA Tournament participant Kent State on Dec. 22. UTEP experienced a tough 1-4 stretch early in league play, with those four setbacks by a combined 14 points. The Miners remained resilient on the way to forging seven league triumphs, capped by a 77-65 "Senior Day" triumph against Middle Tennessee on March 4.

Shamar Givance was named to the five-member Conference USA men's basketball All-Academic team, becoming the first Miner to secure a spot since Dominic Artis (second team) in 2015-16. Givance also garnered 2022-23 College Sports Communicators' Academic All-District accolades.

Golding experienced immediate success in his first year on the sidelines with the Orange and Blue, directing the Miners to their first 20-win season (20-14) since going 22-11 in 2014-15. UTEP earned a spot in The Basketball Classic for its first postseason appearance since 2015. The Miners defeated Western Illinois, 80-54, on March 19 for their first postseason win since 2009.

UTEP was 11-7 in league play, securing the first winning record in conference action since forging a mark of 12-6 in 2016-17. That was aided by winning 10 of 14 down the stretch, including halting back-to-back C-USA West Division Champion North Texas' 15-game winning streak, 70-68, on "Senior Day" on March 5. The Miners then went on to defeat Old Dominion, 74-64, on March 9 for their first victory at the C-USA Championships in five years.

Golding's charges achieved notable success on the road, compiling their most road wins (seven) since going 8-2 in 2013-14. UTEP (5-4) had its first winning record on the road in league play since 2016-17, and the five league road wins surpassed its total (four) of such games from the prior three seasons combined.

The Miners registered their first road win at LA Tech since 2004, at New Mexico since 2009, at ODU since 2015 and at UTSA since 2015. They also secured the first road sweep of the LA Tech and Southern Miss trip in six years.

UTEP enjoyed a six-game winning streak in conference play (Jan. 15 to Feb. 5), which was the longest since also posting six straight C-USA victories in 2016.

With the Miners finishing at 20-14, Golding joined Don Haskins (18-6, 1961-62), Doc Sadler (27-8, 2004-05) and Tim Floyd (25-10, 2010-11) as the only coaches in program history to have a winning season in their first year on the sidelines. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP.

Individually, Souley Boum (second team) and Jamal Bieniemy (third team) both earned All-Conference USA accolades. Boum was also a NABC All-District honoree.

He joined UTEP after leading Abilene Christian to the NCAA Tournament in two of his final three seasons with the program and an upset win over third-seed Texas in the 2021 "Big Dance"

Golding performed a remarkable turnaround at ACU after shepherding the Wildcats' transition from Division II to Division I. He guided the Wildcats to a record of 158-144 in 10 seasons at the helm of the program (2011-2021), including a 71-23 mark over the last three years. ACU chalked up three consecutive 20-win seasons, finishing with a 27-7 mark in 2018-19, the most wins in program history. ACU finished 20-11 overall and 15-5 in league play during the 2019-20 season before the postseason was canceled due to the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic. It marked just the second time in program history that the team put together back-to-back 20-win seasons including the postseason; the first came during coach Golding's playing days.

Golding directed ACU to a 24-5 overall record and a 13-2 Southland Conference mark during the 2020-21 campaign. The Wildcats claimed the Southland Conference tournament title, and the first NCAA Tournament win in program history when #14 seed ACU shocked the heavily favored Longhorns, 53-52, in the first round on March 20. Golding was named the NABC District 22 co-coach of the Year, while Kolton Kohl was selected to the All-District 22 first team. Kohl was also named to the 2020-21 All-Southland Conference first team, while Joe Pleasant earned second team All-League honors and Coryon Mason garnered third team recognition. Damien Daniels, Reggie Miller and Mason were also tabbed to the league All-Defensive team.

Golding, who played point guard at ACU from 1994-98, took over as the head coach at his alma mater in 2011. In his first season, the Wildcats were 12-16 overall and 4-14 in the Lone Star Conference. ACU began competing at the Division I level during the 2013-14 season. Four years later, they reached the postseason (College Insider Tournament) and, the year after that, they were in the Big Dance.

Golding's teams have also excelled in the classroom with a perfect 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last four years, and a 3.2 grade point average this season. Every one of his players who exhausted their eligibility graduated from ACU.

Golding's first coaching job was as a varsity assistant at South Garland High School, where he helped the team to back-to-back Class 5A playoff appearances. He spent the 2001-02 season as an assistant coach at Seminole Junior College before taking the head coaching job at Sachse High School. During the program's first years at the 5A level, Golding led the team to a 15-14 record in 2002-03 and an 18-10 mark in 2003-04. Golding spent the 2004-05 season as an assistant coach at Collin County Community College, and the next three seasons (2005-08) as the top assistant to head coach Jason Copeland at ACU before joining head coach Steve Shields' staff at Arkansas Little Rock. His three years at UALR (2008-11) produced a Sun Belt Conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Golding was a four-year letterwinner at ACU from 1994-98, playing in all 108 games, and was given the Teague Point Guard Award as a senior. He shot 46 percent from the floor over his four-year career, and averaged 4.2 assists per game. He graduated from ACU with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science in May of 1999.

Golding and his wife, Amanda, have two sons, Cason and Chase.
