QUICK HITS

- UTEP finishes 2-10 overall and 1-7 in CUSA.
- The Miners finished their 20-year run in CUSA with a 49-115 overall mark.
- UTEP allowed the most points (61) in a conference road game since allowing 52 at UTSA on Nov. 14, 2020.
- UTEP allowed the most points since Arizona scored 63 on Sept. 15, 2017 in El Paso.

BLUE BLAZE OFFENSE

- QB **Skylar Locklear** threw a season-high four touchdowns, also tying his career high. Locklear threw a career-high 338 yards and a career-most five interceptions. Locklear finished with 13 passing touchdowns.
- TE **Josh Schuchts** scored on a career-long 64-yard touchdown during the second quarter. Schuchts tallied a career-high 87 yards on four catches. Schuchts finished with 232 yards on 21 receptions and three touchdowns.
- WR **Wondame Davis Jr.** tallied 112 yards on three catches, making it a trio of 100-yard games in 2025 for the redshirt freshman. Davis Jr. scored on a 68-yard reception. Davis Jr. led the Miners with 604 yards on only 25 receptions (24.2 avg.) and tied for the team lead with six touchdown catches.
- WR **CJ Simon** in his first game action in his UTEP career, tallied a 23-yard kickoff return.
- WR **Kenny Odom** recorded 94 yards on a game-high seven receptions and added a 49-yard touchdown. Odom finished with a team-high 62 receptions for 582 yards and six scores (tied for the team lead).

ORANGE SWARM DEFENSE

- LB **Jayden Wilson** led the Miners with 10 tackles.
- S **Kode Lowe** recovered his first fumble as a Miner; he added seven tackles, his second-highest total in 2025.
- LB **Stratton Shufelt** tied his career high with seven tackles (also a season high).
- CB **TJ Tillman** recorded a career-high six tackles.

WEFENSE

- K **Tanner Cragun** hit a 28-yard field goal, his sixth successful attempt this season.
- WR/KR **CJ Simon**, in his first game action in his UTEP career, tallied a 23-yard kickoff return.
