UTEP KICKS OFF '25 AT UTAH STATE ON CBSSN SATURDAY

The highly-anticipated year two of the Scotty Walden era begins Saturday (Aug. 30) when UTEP opens the 2025 campaign at Utah State. The Miners and Aggies will be televised on CBS Sports Network with kickoff set for 5:30 p.m. MT in Merlin Olsen Field at Maverik Stadium.

- » **SEASON NO. 108**
UTEP will kick off its 108th season in Logan, Utah, on Saturday, Aug. 30 at 5:30 p.m. MT.
- » **FIRST TIME IN 11 SEASONS**
UTEP is taking on Utah State for the first time since Dec. 20, 2014, in the New Mexico Bowl.
- » **VERSUS THE MOUNTAIN WEST**
UTEP is 9-14 against Mountain West opponents. The Miners' last win came on Sept. 23, 2022, versus Boise State.
- » **BEEN A WHILE**
The Miners are playing in Logan for the first time since Sept. 16, 1961; first trip to the state of Utah since 1998.
- » **ROAD WARRIORS**
UTEP is starting the season on the road and playing two of its first three games on the road for a third consecutive year.
- » **ANOTHER AUGUST START**
For the fifth straight year (15th time overall in program history), UTEP will open a new season in the month of August.
- » **2025 OPPONENTS' POSTSEASON**
UTEP will face six teams from the '24 postseason; two other programs that finished with a winning record (no playoffs)
- » **QB1 #7 NELSON**
QB **Malachi Nelson** was named the starting QB on Aug. 21; will make his first collegiate start under center on Aug. 30.

MINER NOTABLES

WHERE TO WATCH & LISTEN

The Miners and Aggies will be nationally televised on CBSSN with Fran Charles and Taylor McHargue on the call. The action will be on 95.5 FM KLAQ with “The Voice of the UTEP Miners” **Jon Teicher**, calling play-by-play in his 45th season. Teich, who called his 500th game on Oct. 11, 2023, at FIU, is joined by former UTEP WR **Cole Freytag** (2012, 2014-16) in the booth providing analysis in his fourth season. El Paso native and long-running member of the local media, **Mando Medina**, will be reporting from the sidelines. The contest can also be heard on the UTEP Miners app.

SERIES VS. UTAH STATE

Saturday's game will mark the fourth meeting between UTEP and Utah State. The Aggies own a 3-0 mark against the Miners. The two programs last met in postseason action when UTEP took on Utah State in the 2014 New Mexico Bowl on Dec. 20 in Albuquerque. The Aggies won 21-6. UTEP RB **Aaron Jones** rushed for 88 yards, while the Miners got a pair of field goals from K **Jay Mattox** (32, 34). Utah State took the first two meetings – 20-7 on Sept. 17, 1960, and 21-6 on Sept. 16, 1961.

ABOUT UTAH STATE

New Utah State Head Coach Bronco Mendenhall was hired on Dec. 6, 2024, as the program's 31st coach, after one season at New Mexico (5-7 in 2024). Mendenhall has an overall record of 140-88 in 18 seasons at the helm. Utah State finished 4-8 overall and 3-4 in the MWC last season. USU's offense returns no one who started more than six games, and the defense returns three starters. Mendenhall brought in 30 transfers, including six from UNM. CB Noah Avinger is playing his senior season at Utah State after playing in 2024 at New Mexico (91 tackles, 10 passes defended in 12 games). Some other notable names are CB Dylan Tucker is a senior from Elon, who totaled 30 tackles (22 solo) in 10 games played (nine starts). OL Jimmy Liston is a 6-3, 305-pound transfer from Purdue and has three years of eligibility. DE John Gayer is a 6-4, 245-pound transfer from College of San Mateo with two years of eligibility. Gayer was a junior college All-American in 2024 at College of San Mateo (Ca.), recording 53 tackles. Gayer transferred to Cal in December before entering the transfer portal and moving to USU. DT Naki Fahina will be a familiar face as he's coming from NM State. Fahina is a 6-foot, 300-pound senior who started in all 12 games with NM State. Fahina was at UNLV before NM State. S Chika Eburnoha transferred from BYU, stands at 6-feet, 190 pounds, with two years of eligibility. S D'Andre Barnes is coming from Nebraska. He's 6-feet, 195 pounds with three years of eligibility. Barnes appeared in one game last season, which was against UTEP. WR Carlos Orr-Gillespie is a transfer from Illinois, while DT Nuuletau Sellesin is a transfer from BYU.

BEEN A WHILE

The Miners are competing in Logan for the first time since Sept. 16, 1961, while it's their first trip to the state of Utah since Nov. 7, 1998, when UTEP played at The University of Utah. The Orange and Blue last won in the Beehive State in 1992 against the Utes. UTEP is 7-29 all-time in Utah.

UTEP IN SEASON OPENERS

The Miners are 46-56-5 in season openers. UTEP last won a season opener in three seasons when the Miners defeated NM State on Aug. 28, 2021. UTEP is opening a season for the third consecutive season and is 9-33-2 overall in road season openers.

ROAD WARRIORS

UTEP is starting the season on the road and playing two of its first three games on the road for a third consecutive year. The Miners open at Utah State on Aug. 30 and will then play at Texas in week three. UTEP opened last season at Nebraska and then play at Liberty in the third game. In 2023, the Miners started at Jax State, then played at North-western in the third contest. .

MORE ROAD NOTES

UTEP is starting the season on the road for the third straight season, something that hasn't happened since a four-year stretch (2003-06). It was 2-2 in the sequence, claiming triumphs in both 2005 and 2006. The Miners have dropped their past two in the situation, but they did stomp I-10 rival, NM State, 30-3, in the campaign lid lifter in 2021. UTEP also took out I-25 rival New Mexico, 31-24, in 2014. The last time that the Orange and Blue staked a victory in a season opener on the road outside of the states of Texas or New Mexico was in 2006 when they derailed San Diego State, 34-27.

VERSUS THE MOUNTAIN WEST

UTEP is 9-14 against Mountain West opponents. The Miners' last win came on Sept. 23, 2022, after defeating Boise State 27-10 in the Sun Bowl. UTEP's last win on the road against a MWC foe was at New Mexico, 31-24, on Aug. 30, 2014.

2025 OPPONENTS' POSTSEASON

UTEP will face six teams from the 2024 postseason. The Miners will take on UT Martin (FCS Playoffs), Texas (CFB Playoff), LA Tech (Independence Bowl), Liberty (Bahamas Bowl), Sam Houston (New Orleans Bowl) and Jax State (StaffDNA Cure Bowl). Although there was no postseason action for Missouri State (8-4) and Delaware (9-2), both programs finished with winning records in 2024.

SEVEN RETURNING STARTERS

The Miners have seven starters returning from last season – four on offense, three on defense. For the “Blue Blaze” are OL **Ivan Escobar**, QB **Skyler Locklear**, WR **Kenny Odom** and MB **Kam Thomas**. Returning for the “Orange Swarm” are DL **KD Johnson**, S **Xavier Smith** and S **Lantz Russell**.

QB1 #7 NELSON

QB **Malachi Nelson** will take the reins of the offense when the Miners kick off the 2025 campaign against the Aggies in Logan, Utah on Saturday, Aug. 30 at 5:30 pm MT. The game will be nationally televised on CBS College Sports. A native of Los Alamitos, Calif., Nelson joined the Miners for spring ball after transferring from Boise State. Nelson arrived in El Paso as the most decorated recruit in school history. He was a unanimous five-star recruit and rated the no. 1 prospect in the country by ESPN in 2022, coming out of Los Alamitos High School. The back-to-back Gatorade California Player of the Year (2021 and 2022), Nelson completed 67.1 percent (192-of-286) of his passes for 2,891 yards and 35 touchdowns with four interceptions during his senior season. A 6-3, 195-pound sophomore, Nelson began his college career at USC. He spent the 2024 season at Boise State, appearing in three games for the Broncos while completing 12-of-17 passes for 128 yards.

NELSON LOOKING TO JOIN EXCLUSIVE LIST

Transfer **Malachi Nelson** will be under center in his first start for UTEP vs. Utah State on Saturday. It marks the second straight year with a different QB (**Skyler Locklear**) making their initial start as a Miner in the opener. **Billy Stevens** holds the modern era school standard for most passing yards by a Miner in their first start. He was 21-35 for 500 yards and two TDs in a 61-15 rout of North Texas on Sept. 18, 1965. **Nick Lamaison** is the only other player to eclipse 300 yards in his first start in the Orange and Blue. He finished 24-38 for 365 yards and a trio of touchdowns in a 31-24 OT win vs. Stony Brook (9/3/11).

BIGGER O-LINE

UTEP has 17 offensive linemen listed on the 2025 roster. The OL averages over 6-foot-4 and 303 pounds. Last year, the offensive line averaged just over 6-feet, 299 pounds.



MINER NOTABLES

RETURNING ROUTE RUNNER

WR **Kenny Odom** displayed elite playmaking skills in his first season with the Miners. Odom, who started in 10 of 12 games his first season at UTEP, ranked second in CUSA with eight touchdown receptions. Odom ranked sixth in yards per catch (16.1) and eighth in receiving yards (741). Odom led the Miners in receiving yards, yards per catch and touchdown catches. He ranked third on the team with 46 receptions. Odom added 123 yards on seven kickoff returns (17.6 avg.). He hauled in a career-high three touchdown receptions on a career-high eight receptions with 108 yards in a victory over Kennesaw State. The native of Savannah, Ga., was the first Miner to tally three touchdown receptions in a single game since 2010. He posted a career-high 128 yards on seven catches with two touchdowns at Colorado State and scored on a career-long 76-yard TD at WKU. Against rival NM State in the final contest of the season, Odom helped the Miners rally back from a 24-7 deficit. His 30-yard scoring reception gave UTEP the go-ahead lead at 28-24 late in the third quarter. UTEP beat NM State 42-35.

BIG PLAY KENNY

Kenny Odom made multiple big plays in 2024 as he tied for the CUSA lead with four 50+ yard receptions, ranked second with six 40+ yard receptions, and tied first with a trio of 60+ yard receptions.

KAM CAN DO IT ALL

MB **Kam Thomas** was another big playmaker in his first season donning the Orange and Blue. The redshirt senior, who started in all nine games played in 2024, led UTEP in all-purpose yards (871) and all-purpose yards per game (96.8). Thomas ranked fifth in Conference USA in all-purpose yards. Thomas also ranked first on the team in punt returns (10), punt return yards (200), return average (20.0), and took one back 93 yards for a touchdown at rival NM State. He was one of two CUSA players to return a punt for a score, while he ranked second in the league in punt return yards. Thomas tied for the team lead in receptions (47), gaining 532 yards and scoring two touchdowns. The Birmingham, Ala., product added 27 yards rushing and 112 yards on seven kickoff returns.

SPECIAL PLAYER

Kam Thomas was named to the 2024 All-CUSA first team special teams following his successful campaign as a punt returner. Thomas gained 200 yards on 10 punt returns (20.0) and was one of two CUSA players to return a punt for a score. He opened his UTEP career with a 29-yard punt return at Nebraska. At NM State, Thomas had 109 yards on a pair of punt returns. His 93-yard punt return for a TD put the Miners up 35-24 early in the fourth after being down 24-7. Thomas added an 18-yard return at Liberty and a 19-yard return at LA Tech.

X MARKS THE SPOT

S **Xavier Smith** returns for a second season with the Miners after leading all UTEP defensive backs and ranking third on the team overall with 78 tackles in 12 games (10 starts). He added a half tackle for loss, fumble recovery and five pass breakups. Smith a season-high 10 tackles at Liberty, while he came up with a big day at NM State, leading the Miners with nine tackles (season-high five solo stops) and two pass breakups in a come-from-behind win at rival NM State.

LANTZ SZN

S **Lantz Russell** returns for his redshirt senior season following a solid effort in 2024. Russell recorded 54 tackles (31 solo) with 4.5 tackles for loss, 2.0 sacks, two interceptions and a pair of breakups. He recorded a career-best 12 tackles (10 solo) against Sam Houston early in the season. He played in four games in his first season with UTEP (2023), and jumped that to making six starts in 12 games played last season.

#2 LUKE LAUFENBERG #LiveLikeLuke

The UTEP football team will continue to pay tribute to the late Luke Laufenberg throughout the 2025 season. Laufenberg passed away at the age of 21 on Thursday, Aug. 22, 2019 after battling cancer for two years. A tight end from Dallas, Texas, Laufenberg joined the Miners for 2019 spring ball after playing at Mesa Community College in 2017. UTEP players have worn black "LUKE" stickers on their helmets since the start of the 2019 season. Redshirt freshman and El Paso native WR Marcus Torres will wear his #2 Laufenberg jersey throughout the season. WR Justin Garrett was the first Miner to don the #2 jersey during the 2020 season and continued the trend in 2021. QB Gavin Hardison was the second Miner to don the #2 jersey (2022-23) and WR Javoni Gardere was the third (2024). Laufenberg played his senior season at Argyle Liberty Christian High School in Argyle, Texas, where he was named 2016 Offensive Newcomer of the Year and honorable mention All-District. He initially walked on at Texas A&M before continuing his football career at Mesa Community College, where he appeared in six games prior to being diagnosed with Burkitt lymphoma.



#3 TRENCH WARRIOR

The "Trench Warrior" is a single digit that is assigned to the most deserving D-Lineman. They are a leader, and they embody UTEP's culture on and off the field. It is something head coach Scotty Walden created to signify that wearing a single digit on the DL means you're a "bad dude." On Aug. 21, Walden announced that junior defensive lineman Shakaun Bowser will don the no. 3 number in 2025.



MINER NOTABLES

CUSA PRESEASON WATCH LIST

Five UTEP players were announced to Conference USA's 2025 Preseason Football Watch List on July 18. P **Noah Botsford** played at Valdosta State for the last two seasons. In 2024, he booted 37 punts for 1,563 yards (42.2 avg.) in 14 games played. DL **Derick Burns** saw action in one contest while at NM State during the 2024 season. He tallied a tackle against WKU. Before NM State, Burns played at Kilgore College for two seasons (2022, 2023). LB **Micah Davey** saw action at McNeese State the last four seasons (2021-2024). Davey started in 18 of 29 games, totaling 311 tackles, 20.0 tackles for loss, 5.5 sacks, an interception, seven break-ups, three forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries. OL **Mark Robinson** was named the Sun Conference Freshman of the Year and was second team All-Sun Conference while starting all nine games at left tackle for Southeastern University in 2024. RB **Hahsaun Wilson** played three seasons at Charlotte (2022-24) while also redshirting with the 49ers in 2021. He paced the team in rushing in 2024 with 559 yards on 91 carries (6.1 avg per carry) and rushed for seven touchdowns.

NOTABLE TRANSFERS ON DEFENSE

Notable transfers on the "Orange Swarm" defense include S **Solo Barnes**, who played at Fayetteville State for three seasons (82 tackles in 26 career games). CB **Marcell Blocker** is 6-foot-3, coming from Florida Memorial (93 tackles in 37 career games). CB **Neil Campbell**, a two-time NAIA All-American at Indiana Wesleyan (intercepted 16 passes in 49 career games). Bandit **Udoka Ezani** is coming from Boise State. DL **Ashaad Hall** played three seasons at South Carolina State (59 tackles, 12.0 sacks in 26 career games). LB **Joshua Rudolph** saw action at Indiana in 2023 and part of 2024, getting ample playing experience against some of the top programs in the nation. LB **Jayden Wilson** is returning to his hometown after playing in 23 games (43 tackles, 2.0 sacks) at New Mexico for the previous two seasons.

NOTABLE TRANSFERS ON OFFENSE

Notable transfers on the "Blue Blaze" offense include WR **Jet Thompson** played in 36 career games at Georgia Southern during the previous three seasons. OL **James Williams**, who stands at 6-3, 325 pounds, started at left guard as a freshman at NE Oklahoma A&M in 2024. WR **Eric Willis III** played at California (PA) in 33 career games. He racked up 139 receptions for 2,236 yards and 17 touchdowns.

MB **Kam Thomas** landed on the Dave Campbell's Texas Football All-Texas second team and the Paul Hornung Watch List, and WR **Kenny Odom** made the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award Watch List.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

UTEP has 43 transfers heading into the new campaign (10 DL, 9 DB, 7 WR, 5 K/P, 4 LB, 4 OL, 1 LS, 1 QB, 1 RB, 1 TE). Fourteen are from FBS schools, nine from FCS, nine JUCO, seven Division II, and four NAIA.

CAPTAINS

UTEP head coach **Scotty Walden** announced his captains for the 2025 season on Aug. 21. Redshirt senior C **Ivan Escobar**, redshirt junior WR **Kenny Odom**, and redshirt senior MB **Kam Thomas** will head up the "Blue Blaze" offense, while for the "Orange Swarm" defense, graduate student CB **Neil Campbell**, senior LB **Joshua Rudolph** and fifth-year DT **KD Johnson** were appointed. Junior LB **Garrett Hawkins** and sophomore LB **Stratton Shufelt** will head the Defense unit.

SACK ATTACK IN '24

UTEP racked up a Conference USA-high 36 sacks during the 2024 season. The Miners ranked in the top 25 nationally. It was the most sacks since the 2004 season (42 sacks). UTEP's 36 sacks were tied for the third most all-time (36 in 1988). UTEP totaled a season-high eight sacks to cap 2024 in its come-from-behind win at rival NM State.

PICKING OFF PASSES

UTEP recorded 11 interceptions, the most since 2014 by the Miners. UTEP ranked tied for third with FIU in Conference USA. The Miners came up with a huge performance against FIU when they picked off four passes in a win over FIU on Oct. 17. It was the most interceptions in a single game since tallying four INTS Oct. 15, 2011, while it was the most in the Sun Bowl since Nov. 15, 2008.

UTEP FATHER-SON CONNECTION

LB **Pete Shufelt**, the father of LB **Stratton Shufelt** and RB **Paul Smith**, the father of QB **Shay Smith**, also played their college ball at UTEP. Pete was a linebacker from 1989-93, ranking 10th on the program's all-time tackles list with 385 (236 solo). Paul played from 1996-1999 and ranks eighth on the school's all-time rushing list with 2,539 yards.

NFL KIDS

S **Lantz Russell**, LB **Stratton Shufelt** and QB **Shay Smith** come from pro backgrounds as their fathers all played in the NFL. RB Leonard Russell played in the NFL for six seasons after being drafted by the New England Patriots in 1991 (first round, 14th overall). He tallied 3,973 yards and 29 rushing touchdowns in 85 games. RB **Paul Smith** played in the NFL for seven seasons after being drafted in 2000 by the San Francisco 49ers (fifth round, 132nd overall). Smith rushed for 210 yards and a touchdown in 79 career games. LB **Pete Shufelt** played in five regular-season games for the New York Giants in 1994.

SECOND SEASON AT UTEP
EIGHTH SEASON AS A HEAD COACH

Scotty Walden, native Texan and one of the most dynamic young head coaches in the country, was named UTEP Football's 27th head coach on Dec. 4, 2023.

The Miners won two of the last three games to conclude Walden's first season at the helm in 2024. Walden chalked up his first victory with the Orange and Blue on Oct. 16 when the Miners defeated FIU, 30-21, in the Sun Bowl. UTEP also defeated Kennesaw State, 43-35, in double overtime, while the Miners concluded the 2024 season with a come-from-behind victory at NM State, 42-35, in the 101st Battle of I-10 on Nov. 30.

In its three victories, UTEP's "Blue Blaze" offense averaged 38+ points per game and over 374 yards of total offense. Offensively, multiple players, who transferred from Austin Peay (Walden's previous school), were team leaders in specific statistical categories. Jevon Jackson gained a team-high 754 yards on the ground with six total touchdowns (four rush, two rec.). Jackson ranked sixth in CUSA in rushing yards. Kam Thomas, who was a 2024 All-CUSA first team special teams player, was the team leader in punt returns on wefense. He ranked second in CUSA with 200 yards on 10 returns (20.0 avg.), including a long return of 93 yards for a TD at NM State. Thomas was one of two players in CUSA to return a punt for a score. Thomas also grabbed 47 receptions - tied for the team lead with Trey Goodman. Goodman tallied 469 yards receiving. Goodman set career highs in receptions (12) and receiving yards (150) during the Miners' win against Kennesaw State. Goodman caught all 12 balls that were thrown his way. Kenny Odom, a 2024 All-CUSA second team selection, led the way with 741 yards receiving and eight touchdowns. Odom ranked second in CUSA in receiving scores (eight) and sixth in yards per reception (16.1 avg.). Odom's eight touchdown receptions were the most

by a Miner since 2016. Odom recorded a season-best 128 yards on seven receptions with a pair of touchdowns at Colorado State. Odom racked up a career-best three touchdown receptions against Kennesaw State. He tallied 108 yards on eight catches against the Owls.

Skylar Locklear also followed Walden from APU. Locklear threw for 1,583 yards on 148-of-233 passing and 10 touchdowns in 10 games. He completed 63.5 percent of his passes, ranking fourth on the program's top 10 single-season list. Locklear added 237 yards rushing and two touchdowns, while also tallying 32 yards on three catches and a score. Locklear pulled a trifecta when he became the first FBS player since 2015 to throw a touchdown, rush for a touchdown and record a receiving touchdown in a single game. The feat was achieved against SUU when Locklear threw a five-year touchdown pass early in the first quarter and followed with a five-yard rushing score at the end of the first. Locklear then hauled in a four-year touchdown pass from Jaden Smith that tied the ball game at 24 apiece with no time left on the clock. Locklear ended the game, throwing for 295 yards on 22-of-29 passing (75.9 percent). Locklear put up career numbers during UTEP's win over KSU, throwing for a career-high 327 yards on a career-best 28 completions (33 attempts) with a career-most four touchdown passes. It was the most touchdown passes by a UTEP quarterback since 2014, while Locklear's 84.8 completion percentage was the third-best in program history.

On defense, the "Orange Swarm" racked up CUSA-highs in sacks (36) and tackles for loss (87). The Miners ranked tied for 20th in FBS in total sacks and tied for 11th in sacks per game (3.0). UTEP's 7.3 TFLs per game ranked first in CUSA and 13th in FBS. The defense scored three touchdowns, ranking tied for 12th in FBS and first in CUSA. Kory Chapman returned a fumble for the score

against Sam Houston, while Bryon Thompson scored a pair of touchdowns on fumble recoveries at NM State. Another defensive highlight in 2024 was the defense intercepting four passes in the victory over FIU. It was the most since picking off four passes at Tulane in 2011, and the most INTs by the defense in the Sun Bowl since 2008 (vs. SMU). The Miners' 11 interceptions were the most since the 2014 season. Maurice Westmoreland, an All-CUSA first team player, led the team and CUSA with 8.0 sacks. Kyran Duhon, who was named All-CUSA second team and the All-Freshman team, ranked second on the team and CUSA with 7.0 sacks. Duhon's sack total was the most by a UTEP freshman since 1990. KD Johnson picked up 3.5 sacks (third most on the team) from the interior defensive line. Linebacker Dorian Hopkins paced the defense with 87 tackles. Chapman, Hopkins, Amier Boyd-Matthews and Lantz Russell each intercepted two passes.

In the classroom, the UTEP football program set a school record with its 3.2 GPA following Walden's first year at the helm. Locklear and Johnson were named to the 2024 CUSA All-Academic Team on Nov. 22. Johnson, a senior defensive tackle, posted a

3.60 GPA in nursing, while Locklear worked towards a 3.83 GPA in business. Overall, 60 football players were named to the 2024-25 CUSA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll (3.0 GPA or higher), while 16 of them were also named 2024-25 CUSA Commissioner's Academic Medalists (3.75 GPA or higher).

Walden joined the Miners after four seasons as the head coach at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tenn. In 2023, he led the Governors to a 9-3 record, a perfect 6-0 mark in the United Athletic Conference, and a no. 13 FCS national ranking. It marked the first undefeated conference season in school history. He was named a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, presented by FedEx Ground and Stats Perform to the FCS National Coach of the Year. Austin Peay has won four conference titles since 1977 – with two coming under Walden's watch. He is the only coach to lead Austin Peay to two conference championships.

The Cleburne, Texas, native led the Governors to a 26-14 mark with four winning seasons (4-2 in COVID-shortened 2020-21 campaign, 6-5 in 2021, 7-4 in 2022, 9-3 in 2023). The Governors hadn't enjoyed back-to-back winning campaigns since 1983-84 prior to Walden's arrival. His career head coaching record is 34-20, including 7-3 in one season heading up the program at East Texas Baptist University in 2016. Walden was also interim head coach at Southern Miss for four games in 2020.

The 2023 Austin Peay squad ranked fourth nationally in passing efficiency (162.17), ninth in scoring offense (34.1 ppg), 11th in passing completion percentage (.667), 13th in passing offense (274.1 ypg) and 15th in total offense (426.8 ypg). The Governors set school records for scoring

offense, total offense and passing offense. Austin Peay also rated seventh in the country in third down conversion defense with a stingy .303 percentage, and the Governors' three defensive touchdowns ranked 12th nationally. Austin Peay's special teams unit was equally stellar, leading the country in punt returns with a 21.3-yard average.

Austin Peay rattled off a school-record nine consecutive wins after opening the season 0-2, including a 30-13 setback at then-ninth ranked Tennessee on Sept. 9. Playing before over 100,000 hostile fans, the Governors were tied with the Vols, 6-6, shortly before halftime and trailed by 10 points (23-13) midway through the fourth quarter.

In 2022, Walden led the Governors to the third conference title in program history. Austin Peay was the top defense in the ASUN Conference, ranking fourth in the FCS in third down conversion percentage defense (.308), 12th in total defense (317.2 ypg), 19th in passing defense (188.7 ypg) and 20th in rushing defense (128.5 ypg). Offensively, Austin Peay averaged 202.3 rushing yards and 243.3 passing yards per game, marking the first time in program history that the Governors averaged 200-plus rushing and passing yards per game in the same season.

In 2021, the Governors tied a school record with seven First Team All-OVC selections and 14 total All-OVC picks.

While at Austin Peay, Walden has coached four consensus All-America honorees – Kordell Jackson (2020), DeAngelo Wilson (2020), Johnathon Edwards (2021) and Koby Perry (2021). Bucky Williams was an American Football Coaches Association Second Team All-American and a HERO Sports Sophomore All-American in 2020. Draylen Ellis and Terrell Allen received Sophomore All-America honors in 2021. Drae McCray was also tabbed a HERO Sports All-America in 2021.

Walden has also coached 28 All-Conference players and four league All-Newcomer selections during his time at Austin Peay.

His teams have also excelled academically. In five of six semesters since Walden's arrival, the Governors posted a 3.0 cumulative team grade point average, including a program record 3.28 GPA during the spring 2022 semester. The Governors also claimed the 2020-21 and 2021-22 OVC Team Academic Achievement Awards.

After joining the Southern Miss staff as wide receivers coach in 2017, he was promoted to co-offensive coordinator for the 2019 season. In 2019, the American Football Coaches Association tabbed Walden as a Top 35 coach under 35 years of age. He coached first team All-Conference USA se-

lection wideout Quez Watkins, who led the league with 64 catches and 1,178 receiving yards (17th in the FBS). Watkins' 107.1 receiving yards per game also ranked sixth in the FBS. He was selected in the sixth round of the 2020 NFL Draft by Philadelphia, and has appeared in 45 games for the Eagles with 23 starts since then.

Walden took over for Jay Hopson as interim head coach at Southern Miss in September of 2020, and was hired by Austin Peay as head coach shortly thereafter.

Walden was the youngest head coach in the NCAA (26 years old) at the time of his hiring at East Texas Baptist. He directed the Tigers to a national ranking in a school-record nine consecutive weeks, climbing as high as no. 15. East Texas Baptist also generated the no. 1 scoring offense (49.9 points per game) for all levels of the NCAA and the no. 2 total offense in Division III (school-record 564.3 yards per game).

Walden was offensive coordinator at East Texas Baptist for three years (2013-15) prior to being elevated to head coach. In his time as an assistant, ETBU football players broke a combined 26 individual and team records. One of his protégés was wide receiver Jamaine Sherman, a first team All-Conference honoree who became the first player in school history to sign an NFL contract with the St. Louis Rams in 2014.

He got his start in coaching at his alma mater, Sul Ross State, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the 2012 season. His team broke 16 offensive school records in 2012, including most yards in a game (800) and points in a game (75). The Lobos ranked no. 1 in Division III in total offense (581.9 ypg), no. 2 in first downs (271), no. 3 in scoring offense (48.8 ppg), no. 9 in passing efficiency (164.30), no. 11 in passing offense (333 ypg) and no. 19 in rushing offense (248.9 ypg). Walden coached six All-Conference players, two D3football.com All-Americans and one Beyond Sports Network All-American.

He began his college playing days at Dordt College in Sioux Center, Iowa (2008), where he was named the starting quarterback as a freshman. His career continued at Hardin-Simmons University (2009-10), where he doubled as a quarterback and defensive back, before concluding at Sul Ross State as a quarterback and team captain in 2011.

He earned his Bachelor of History, graduating Magna Cum Laude, from Sul Ross State in 2012. He added a Master of Education, graduating Summa Cum Laude, from Sul Ross State in 2014.

Walden and his wife, Callie have two sons, Luca and Maverick.
