## OPENING DRIVE

- The ULM football team (1-1) remains on the road for another road test, this time facing UTEP (1-2) on Saturday (Sept. 20) at 8 p.m. CT in the Sun Bowl in El Paso, Texas. The Warhawks are looking to find success after a bye week.

- ULM is looking to rebound after falling at No. 20/21 Alabama in game two of the season, 73-0. The Warhawks head into week four 1-1, clinching their first shutout in over a decade against Saint Francis at Malone Stadium to open the season.

- Saturday's game marks the second-ever meeting in the series between the Miners and the Warhawks. UTEP holds a 1-0 record, claiming a 31-6 win in 2020 at Malone Stadium. Scotty Walden and **Bryant Vincent** have never faced each other.

- In the season opener against Saint Francis, ULM claimed a 29-0 shutout win. This is the first shutout win in over a decade for the Warhawks, the last coming against Nicholls in 2015 (47-0). Nine other teams in FBS secured a shutout in Week 1, including local foe Louisiana Tech.

- ULM's 12-game football schedule features five home games, four being conference opponents. According to ESPN, the Warhawks have the second-toughest schedule in the Sun Belt and the eighth toughest in the Group of Five.

- ULM's 2025 opponents went a combined 69-81 (.460) in 2024, with five opponents going over .500. In addition, six foes also participated in postseason bowl games a year ago: Alabama (ReliaQuest Bowl), Coastal Carolina (Myrtle Beach Bowl), South Alabama (IS4S Salute to Veterans Bowl), Arkansas State (68 Ventures Bowl), the Ragin' Cajuns (Isleta New Mexico Bowl) and Texas State (Servpro First Responder Bowl).

- ULM defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** was voted Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a media member panel vote on August 31. Perkins-McAllister is the second ULM player to receive Defensive Player of the Week honors in week one, with Wydett Williams Jr. receiving the honor last season.

Perkins-McAllister played lights out for the Warhawks against the Red Flash, leading the defense in the team's first shutout in a decade. His two sacks lead the Sun Belt Conference and the team's defense leads the conference in sacks and red zone defense. The Nashville, Tenn., native claimed five solo tackles on the evening and three assists in a game where the opponent only crossed the 50-yard line once.

- Offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher** was recognized on multiple preseason watch lists, including the All State Wuerffel Trophy Watchlist and the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy Watchlist. The Wuerffel Trophy recognizes college football players who exemplify community service, academic excellence and athletic achievement. The Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Trophy recognizes the top offensive player who exhibits the enduring characteristics that define Earl Campbell: integrity, performance, teamwork, sportsmanship, drive, community and tenacity.

- Seven Warhawks were named to the Phil Steele Preseason Sun Belt teams. On the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team were offensive lineman **Elijah Fisher**, defensive lineman **Kevontay**

**Wells**, defensive back **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** and placekicker **Max Larson**. On the fourth team were offensive lineman **Jay Mickle**, linebacker **Billy Pullen** and linebacker **Seidrion Langston**.

- **Kevontay Wells** was also named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team Defense, as voted on by the conference's coaches. In his first season with the Warhawks, Wells led the team with 11.0 tackles for loss, which ranked tied for sixth in the Sun Belt. He added 50 total tackles and three sacks in a breakout junior season. Wells is the first Warhawk to be named to a Preseason All-Sun Belt team since 2020, when ULM placed a trio of players (Josh Johnson, Josh Pederson and Corey Straughter) on the preseason first team.

- ULM added 40 new players to its 2025 roster in the offseason. Head coach **Bryant Vincent** and his staff signed 13 new Warhawks on the first day of the early signing period in December, featuring eight defensive players and five on offense. In total, ULM signed nine junior college transfers, 23 transfers from four-year colleges and six high school recruits. The Warhawks lost six starters on offense and six on defense from the 2024 squad.

- **Aidan Armenta** earned the start against Saint Francis for the Warhawks, going 12-for-23 and collecting 95 yards, as well as a rushing touchdown. Armenta then completed eight of 14 passes at Alabama on September 6. Monroe native **Landon Graves** has also seen action at quarterback this season, throwing four-for-seven across two games and collecting a touchdown in his first career drive. **Hunter Herring** also saw action in a unique position, appearing in crucial third and fourth down scenarios. Herring scored the first touchdown of the season for the Warhawks.

- The running back room in Monroe has proven to be deep, as five RBs have seen action so far this season. **Braylon McReynolds** has claimed both starts thus far, leading the team with 137 yards from 18 attempts. McReynolds also posted his first touchdown as a Warhawk against Saint Francis, a 13-yard reception into the end zone.

Four other running backs contributed to the 311 rushing yards against Saint Francis, the team averaging 7.2 yards per rush. **Tyrell Reed Jr.** collected 47 yards, averaging 6.7 yards per carry. **Dorian Lewis** posted 43 yards on six carries. Freshman **D'Shaun Ford** saw four carries and 22 yards on the evening and **Zach Palmer-Smith** recorded 21 yards off six carries. Ford followed behind McReynolds against the Crimson Tide, collecting 20 yards on five attempts.

- **Tyler Griffin** continues to lead ULM receivers, claiming 54 yards from five receptions, including a touchdown reception from quarterback Graves in the season opener. Veteran **Jake Godfrey** has notched 21 yards off three receptions. **JP Coulter** follows Griffin this season, posting 30 yards off four receptions.

- **D'Arco Perkins-McAllister** leads the defense with 12 tackles, two tackles for loss and two sacks so far this season. **Korian Wilson** follows closely behind with 11 tackles, with **Kamrin Canterbury** and **Noah Flemmings** rounding out the double-digits with 10 each. Wilson and Flemmings each also registered a tackle for loss each.

Canterbury led the team with seven tackles against the Crimson Tide. **Seidrion Langston**, **Marcus Ross** and **Jabari Tiller** each tallied six tackles in game two, Langston logging 0.5 tackles for loss and Ross recording one.

The ULM defense prevented the Red Flash from crossing the 50 all but one time. Perkins-McAllister registered eight tackles (five solo) in the season opener and two sacks. Wilson (seven tackles) and Flemmings (five tackles) each posted a tackle for loss as well. Flemmings' TFL shut down a fourth down conversion for Saint Francis, forcing a turnover on downs.

- **Cliff Mosley** also contributed to the defensive effort, catching his first career interception against the Red Flash to force another turnover. Mosley arrives at ULM from Henderson State, where the defensive lineman made eight tackles and recovered a fumble in 2024.

- Returning for the defense includes **David Godsey Jr.**, back for his sixth season with the Warhawks after posting 39 tackles, a tackle for loss, four pass breakups and two forced fumbles to receive All-Sun Belt Honorable Mention accolades. Also returning is **Carl Fautroy**, who totaled 55 tackles, four pass breakups, an interception and a forced fumble last season. Defensive back **Markeegan Gray** remains with ULM for his redshirt senior season after becoming a Burlsworth Trophy nominee in 2024.

- Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team member **Kevontay Wells** returns to ULM after a stellar 2024 campaign, tallying 50 tackles, 11 tackles for loss and three sacks while earning All-Sun Belt Second Team Defense honors. **Dylan Howell** returns for his third Warhawk season, after totaling 23 tackles and two quarterback hurries in 2024. **Billy Pullen** returns for his second season, named to the Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team, after starting in all 12 games and awarded All-Sun Belt Third Team last season.

- Newcomers in the defense include **Zy Jackson**, a two-time all-conference defensive back at Copiah-Lincoln CC, totaling 10 tackles, a fumble recovery and 586 return yards in 2024. Defensive back **Kamrin Canterbury** led West Florida with 49 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss last season before transferring to ULM for the 2025 season.

• The Warhawks return both starting guards from last season. **Elijah Fisher** is set for his sixth season in Monroe and has earned All-SBC Honorable Mention in back-to-back seasons. Fisher was voted Phil Steele All-Sun Belt Preseason Third Team. **Jay Mickle** started all 12 games for ULM last season and is back for his final season. The graduate student from Picayune, Miss., was voted Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Fourth Team. Also returning for the Warhawks' offensive line is **Que McBroom** and **Reese Steele**, both of whom made starts last season.

• Special teams players **Max Larson**, **Makenzie Ryan**, **Andrew Wells** and **Nolan Wilson** are all back on ULM's 2025 roster. Larson went 14-for-17 on field goal attempts and 27-for-28 on PATs in his first season with the Warhawks and was named Phil Steele Preseason All-Sun Belt Third Team. Ryan booted 58 punts with an average of 39.2 yards per punt, downing 18 inside the 20-yard line. Wells served as the team's holder and Wilson was the long snapper for all games last season. ULM signed West Monroe native **Peyton Todd** to the roster. Todd appeared in all 13 games last season at LSU and averaged 41.3 yards per punt on 19 punts for the Tigers.

• ULM's coaching staff features four new faces in 2025, including running backs coach and run game coordinator **Hindley Brigham**, wide receivers coach **Kishawn McClain**, defensive ends coach **Jontavius Morris** and offensive assistant coach **Cody Wells**. Brigham arrives after nine seasons at UAB, McClain joins the staff after stops at ETSU and Gardner-Webb and Morris was added after being on staff at Louisville and Purdue. Former ULM quarterback Wells returns to Monroe after a few seasons at Evangel University.

• Family connections on the ULM football coaching staff include **Bryant Vincent's** son, **Brady Vincent**, as the team's Tight Ends Coach. **Bret Vincent** makes it three Vincents featured in the ULM football program, with Bret playing wide receiver for the Warhawks. The Vincent family is not the only family tie for ULM. Defensive Coordinator **Ernest Hill** enters his second season on the staff, with his son **Bryan Hill** working as a defensive assistant coach.

### LAST MEETING –

**UTEP 31, ULM 6 (Sept. 26, 2020 in Monroe, La.)** – The Warhawks fell behind early again on Saturday and failed to rally at Malone Stadium in a 31-6 loss to UTEP.

In building a 24-0 halftime lead, UTEP outgained ULM, 330-74, and ran 40 plays to ULM's 18. The Warhawks were 0-for-5 on third-down conversions and managed just two first downs while possessing the ball just 9:06 through two quarters.

**Colby Suits** started at quarterback and completed 17-of-27 passes for 186 yards with one touchdown and one interception. The offense was limited to 45 plays with six first downs and finished 0-for-11 on third-down conversions. With ULM playing catch-up, the Warhawks never got their running game going and finished with 7 net rushing yards.

Overall, the underdog Miners outgained ULM with 512 yards on 72 plays to 193. Quarterback **Gavin Hardison** completed 13-of-25 passes for 302 yards and delivered big days to receivers **Justin Garrett** (7 catches for 120 yards) and **Jacob Cowing** (3 for 102). Running back **Deion Hankins** scored three touchdowns and added 118 yards on 22 carries.

Hardison completed 5-of-10 passes for 160 yards in the first quarter to set the tone. UTEP staggered the Warhawks with big aerial plays in the opening quarter, including an 82-yard reception by Cowing to the ULM 2. Hankins pounded in the touchdown on the next play with 7:40 to play at the Miners led 7-0.

ULM squandered a big play of its own after Suits and **Jevin Frett** connected for a 49-yard gain to the UTEP 16. Three plays later, UTEP's **Duron Lowe** picked off Suits at the 3 as he targeted Frett again.

The Miners shifted their offensive attack to the ground early in the second quarter as Hankins ripped off a 37-yard run to the ULM 7. Hankins finished the drive with two more runs, including a 1-yard touchdown to give UTEP a 14-0 lead with 13:33 left in the half.

Hankins' third touchdown gave UTEP a 21-0 lead with 6:57 remaining in the second quarter. His bullish 8-yard run capped a nine-play, 73-yard drive. The Miners boosted their advantage to 24-0 on **Gavin Baechle's** 42-yard field goal with 21 seconds left in the half.

Quarterback **Jeremy Hunt** directed the offense for the first two series in the second half but Suits returned after **Keilos Swinney** recovered a UTEP fumble at the ULM 45. Suits hit four-straight passes with a 35-yard touchdown pass to **Jahquan Bloomfield** to finally get ULM on the scoreboard, 24-6, with 55 seconds remaining in the third quarter. After a penalty on ULM's 2-point conversion try, **Zach Elder** missed the PAT.

With reserves in the game late and UTEP running out the clock, Ronald Awatt broke loose for a 23-yard touchdown with 2:32 left remaining, sending the Miners back to El Paso with a 31-6 score.

## LAST TIME OUT –

**Alabama 73, ULM 0 (Sept. 6, 2025 in Tuscaloosa, Ala.)** – The ULM football team (1-1) fell in a difficult battle with top-ranked Alabama (1-1) on the road, in the Warhawks’ first road game of the season. While ULM fought to build momentum on both sides of the football, the game came up all Alabama with a final score of 66-0.

**Aidan Armenta** made the start at quarterback, completing eight of 14 pass attempts for 28 yards. **Landon Graves** also saw action, completing two of four attempts for 27 yards. **Tyler Griffin** led the pack in receiving yards with 22 on two receptions. **Braylon McReynolds** led the offense with 24 rushing yards on seven carries.

**Kamrin Canterbury** led the defense with seven tackles (five solo, two assists). **Marcus Ross** posted six tackles (four solo, two assists) and a tackle for loss.

The Crimson Tide got off to a quick start, as a three-minute scoring drive, concluding in a 29-yard reception for **Germie Bernard**, got Alabama off to an early 7-0 start. While the Warhawks made an attempt at momentum on offense, ULM was shut down with a three-and-out. A second drive for Alabama brought a second touchdown, this time a 16-yard reception for Bernard, giving the Crimson Tide a 14-0 lead with eight minutes remaining in the quarter.

ULM had a second attempt at a drive but succumbed to a three-and-out yet again. While the defense began to pick up momentum, Alabama continued to forge ahead. A five-yard sack by Ross sent the Crimson Tide to third and long, but were able to convert, adding to the tally for a 21-0 score with three minutes remaining in the first quarter.

The second quarter began with a 25-yard pass to **Rico Scott** from **Ty Simpson**, placing the Crimson Tide in the red zone yet again. A quarterback keeper for Simpson placed Alabama ahead, 28-0, early in the second quarter. While the Warhawks pushed to find a rhythm on offense, Armenta’s pass was intercepted by **Justin Jefferson**, placing the ball in Alabama’s hands again. A couple of long passes set up the fifth touchdown for the Crimson Tide, securing a 42-0 score at the half.

While the Warhawks were able to secure a first down in the first pass attempt of the second half, they were snuffed by the Crimson Tide yet again, unable to find a score. A five-minute drive for Alabama, the team’s longest of the contest, brought up a field goal for the Crimson Tide.

After Alabama regained possession, a handful of receptions to **Cole Adams** secured another touchdown for the Crimson Tide, making it a 52-0 score at the close of the third quarter.

A fumble recovered by the home team brought another touchdown for the Crimson Tide at the start of the fourth quarter. The Warhawks kept fighting for the momentum to shift but were unable to reach the end zone. After a turnover on downs, the Crimson Tide scored again for a 66-0 score. Another fumble recovery for Alabama in the fourth quarter brought the final score of the game, giving the Crimson Tide a 73-0 advantage over ULM.

## SECOND SEASON AT ULM (6-8) THIRD SEASON OVERALL (13-14)

Bryant Vincent, known for his strong leadership and expertise in creating powerful offensive schemes in college football, was named the 17th head football coach in University of Louisiana Monroe history on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. Vincent was also named Interim Athletic Director for ULM on August 5, 2025.

In his first season as head coach of ULM football, Coach Vincent began establishing a culture of grit and resilience that propelled the Warhawks to one of their most successful starts in nearly four decades. ULM opened the 2024 season 5-1, the program's best start in 37 years, and Vincent was the only Sun Belt Conference Coach named to the 2024 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List.

Vincent secured his first victory as head coach with a 30-14 win over Jackson State on August 29, 2024. In week two, the Warhawks stunned UAB with a dominating 32-6 win after shutting out the Blazers in the second half inside Malone Stadium. After defeating Troy on the road 13-9 in the Sun Belt Conference opener, Vincent led the Warhawks to a signature victory over JMU by a score of 21-19 to give ULM its first 4-1 start in the FBS era. ULM completed the 5-1 start with a 38-21 win over Southern Miss in week six.

Under Vincent's direction, the Warhawks led the SBC in several statistical categories, including passing yards allowed (183.9), blocked kicks (3) and few-

est penalty yards per game (43.25).

He developed 2024 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year Ahmad Hardy, who led the league with 1,351 rushing yards and 13 rushing touchdowns as a true freshman. Hardy was named ULM's first FWAAs Freshman All-American in program history and was also voted Louisiana Freshman of the Year by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.

Including Hardy, nine Warhawks garnered SBC post-season honors for the first time in over five seasons including All-Sun Belt Second Team defensive lineman Kevontay Wells and All-Sun Belt Third Team defensive stars Billy Pullen, Carl Glass Jr., and Wydett Williams Jr. Additionally, two of Vincent's players went on to compete at the professional level after senior cornerback Car'lin Vigers signed an undrafted free agent contract with the NFL's Washington Commanders and senior offensive lineman Sam Carson was drafted by the CFL's Ottawa Redblacks.

Off the field, Vincent's leadership produced unprecedented academic results. ULM football recorded the highest term GPA in program history in Fall 2024, and the team's 84% graduation success rate (GSR) led all Sun Belt programs. Additionally, major facility upgrades were completed at Malone Stadium, including renovations to the team room, locker room and main athletics lobby.

Before arriving in Monroe, Vincent served as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of New





Mexico during the 2023 season. Under Vincent's offensive schemes, the Lobos earned national top-20 rankings in red zone offense (14th) and rushing offense (19th). Additionally, Vincent coached running back Jacory Croskey-Merritt to a record-breaking season. The New Mexico running back was the first Lobo to ever have back-to-back 200-yard rushing games and finished with 17 rushing touchdowns, which is third all-time in New Mexico football history.

Prior to New Mexico, Vincent served as the Interim Head Coach at UAB following the retirement of Bill Clark and led the Blazers to a 7-6 season and a win in the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB's offense generated 30.1 points per game and 438.2 yards per game, which was the 33rd highest mark in the country. Vincent spent four seasons as UAB's offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach and was a key figure in elevating the program since its reinstatement in 2017. In all, Vincent helped lead UAB to a pair of Conference USA Championships and bowl game victories.

UAB has been the winningest team in Conference USA since returning to the playing field and collected 42 wins since Vincent returned as OC. The Blazers won the 2018 CUSA title game 27-25 over Middle Tennessee State, winning on the road, and the 2020 CUSA title game, that one 22-13 over Marshall, again on the road.

UAB also made it to the 2019 championship game as champions of their division. Since the reinstatement of the program in 2017, Vincent coached in five bowls games, qualifying for six. UAB won the 2018 Boca Raton Bowl 37-13 over Northern Illinois, the 2021 Independence Bowl 31-28 over BYU and the 2022 Bahamas Bowl. UAB also played in the 2017 Bahamas Bowl against Ohio and the 2019 New Orleans Bowl against App State, and the team qualified for the 2020 Gasparilla Bowl against South Carolina, before being canceled due to COVID-19.

With Vincent at offensive coordinator, the Blazers set FBS-program records for wins in 2018, going 11-3. Vincent never had a losing season with Blazers, going 7-6 as head coach and going 48-27 overall in his six years with UAB. The 2018 Blazers had the best offensive season in program history which resulted in 21 school records, including the aforementioned 11-3 overall record and winning the program's first Conference USA title and

bowl game.

Among the school records that fell in 2018 included total points (418), total touchdowns (53), rushing touchdowns (32), total yards (5,680) and rushing yards (2,818). Additionally, UAB set the single game school record for total yards (668) and rushing yards (419) in a 52-3 victory over UTSA on Nov. 3, 2018.

Vincent is no stranger to the Sun Belt Conference and spent six years in two separate stints with South Alabama. He served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2015-17 and was an assistant coach from 2011-13 for the Jaguars' football program. Vincent helped guide the Jaguars to the 2016 Nova Home Loans Arizona Bowl led by record setting quarterback Dallas Davis. In Vincent's offense, Davis threw for the most yards in school history (2,706) and his 2,951 total yards of offense are second most in program history.

Before entering the collegiate ranks, Vincent was a successful high school football coach in Alabama and tallied a record of 49-16 in five seasons at two different schools. In his first season as a head coach, Vincent led Greenville High School to a 10-3 record and was selected as the Class 5A Coach of the Year in 2006. Vincent was at the helm of Spanish Fort High School football for four seasons and produced a record of 39-13. His team captured the Alabama 5A State Championship in 2010.

Vincent is a native of Glasgow, Kentucky. He and his wife Holli have two sons, Brady, a member of the ULM football coaching staff and Bret, a wide receiver for the Warhawks.
