GET TO KNOW DELAWARE (6-14, 2-7 CUSA)

Delaware is in its first year as a member of Conference USA after joining the league from the Coastal Athletic Association. After an 1-4 start to the year, the Fightin' Blue Hens regrouped to go 3-3 over the next six games to wrap nonconference play at 4-7. UD began league play at 1-2, including a 67-52 drubbing of Kennesaw State (1/4). The Blue Hens proceeded to lose five straight, including the Miners pulling out a one-point win (70-69) in Newark, Del., in the first meeting between the programs earlier this year (1/15). They put an end to the skid by posting an impressive 73-64 win at NM State on Jan. 28. The Aggies had routed the Blue Hens, 97-68, in the first matchup between the schools this year before UD avenged it last time out. It marked the first league road victory (1-3) for the Blue Hens and second road triumph overall (2-6) this year. The effort allows Delaware to enter the tilt at UTEP at 6-14 overall (2-7 CUSA) with momentum, but the Blue Hens have not claimed consecutive contests this year. Iron Man Christian Bliss (39.1 mpg-first NCAA) is the unquestioned leader for the squad. He paces the team in scoring (15.6 ppg-eighth CUSA), assists (6.0-second CUSA/32nd NCAA) and steals (1.85-second/88th) while adding 5.5 rpg (second on team). He tops the squad in field goals made (99), 3-pointers hit (44) and free throws made (70) and attempted (86). Justyn Fernandez (14.5 ppg-10th CUSA), Tyler Houser (13.3 ppg-16th CUSA) and Macon Emory (11.4 ppg) buoy him with offensive output. Emory gets on the glass (7.0 rpg-10th CUSA) and is a deterrent at the rim with 0.7 blocks per game. Bliss isn't the only one to play heavy minutes. In fact, UD has the top three players in the league for playing time and four among the top 10. They are in the form of Bliss (39.1), Emory (36.1-second CUSA/12th NCAA), Fernandez (35.6-third CUSA/20th NCAA) and Houser (32.3 mpg-eighth CUSA). Emory has produced a quartet of double-doubles (second CUSA). Both Bliss (2.2-ninth CUSA) and Fernandez (2.18-12th CUSA) connect on more than two triples per game. Delaware does a good job of defending without fouling, in part to its defensive scheme, committing only 14.2 fouls per contest (second CUSA/10th NCAA). The Blue Hens shoot it well from distance by nailing 36.0 percent (second CUSA/73rd NCAA). UD is also among the top five in CUSA for free-throw percentage (73.3-second) and 3-pointers made per game (8.5-fifth). UD hasn't gotten much scoring from its bench (7.55-12th CUSA/361st NCAA). It is also in the lower part of the league and national ratings for fastbreak scoring (4.4-12th/360th), free throws made (10.4-12th/355th) and attempted (14.3-12th/358th) per game, rebounding margin (-3.4-12th/322nd), offensive rebounds per game (6.7-11th/359th), total rebounds per contest (31.6-11th/337th), scoring margin (-5.8-12th/316th), scoring offense (65.8-12th/348th), steals per game (5.5-12th/314th), turnover margin (-2.9-12th/339th) and turnovers forced per game (9.3-12th/351st). The program has existed since the 1905-06 season and has played in the NCAA Tournament six times (1992, 1993, 1998, 1999, 2014, 2022, 0-6 record). It also has earned one NIT bid (2000, 0-1 mark) while making one appearance in the CBI (2012, 0-1). The University of Delaware has origins to 1743. Notable alumni include Joe Biden (former President of the USA), Chris Christie (former New Jersey Governor), Richard Heck (Nobel Prize-winning organic chemist) and Joe Flacco (Super Bowl MVP who later led the Cleveland Browns to the playoffs).

SERIES HISTORY: UTEP LEADS, 1-0

This year is the first time the two programs have squared off on the hardwood, with the Miners dispatching the Fightin' Blue Hens on the road, 70-69 (1/15/26) earlier in the season. Saturday's contest will mark the first between the programs in El Paso.

LAST GAME (LA TECH 69, AT UTEP 59, 1/28/26)

Elijah Jones (career-high 25 points) and **Kaseem Watson** (20 points) both had big offensive nights while **Jamal West Jr.** posted his fourth double-double of the year (10 points, 11 rebounds) but it wasn't enough as UTEP was clipped by LA Tech, 69-59, at the Don Haskins Center on Jan. 28. After a strong start by the Miners that put them ahead by nine (13-4), the Bulldogs found their footing by countering with a 16-2 surge to pull in front. As it turned out, UTEP would never lead again. The deficit was nine (36-27) at the break. LA Tech led by as many as 14 (52-38, 12:20, 2H) at one point, and the Miners couldn't fully recover. They showed heart by whittling the margin all the way down to three (61-58, 4:24, 2H), but the visitors were able to hold on.



JONES WENT OFF ON OFFENSE

Elijah Jones had a career night offensively against LA Tech, setting career bests for points (25), 3-pointers made (five) and attempted (eight) and free throws made (eight) and attempted (10). He achieved all of this in 31 minutes and drilled his first four treys (all in the first half) to set the tone.

BEST 3-POINT STREAK IN 23 YEARS

Elijah Jones has nailed at least four triples in three straight games to become the first Miner to achieve the feat in 23 years. El Pasoan **Omar Duran** ran off four such contests in 2002-03. Jones is a combined 13-18 (72.2 percent) in the timeframe. He was a perfect 4-4 vs. FIU (1/22), went 4-6 against Missouri State (1/24) and followed that up by setting career highs in makes (five) and attempts (eight) vs. LA Tech last time out. Duran went 5-9 at Nevada (1/9/02), 5-10 at Fresno State (1/11/02), 4-11 vs. Tulsa (1/16/02) and 4-8 vs. Rice (1/18/02) for a combined readout of 18-38 (47.3 percent).

THREE-HEADED MONSTER

Three players (**Elijah Jones**, career-high 25 points, **Kaseem Watson**-20 points and **Jamal West Jr.**-10 points) combined to account for 55 of UTEP's 59 points vs. LA Tech. The other four points were courtesy of fellow starters **Caleb Blackwell** (two) and **KJ Thomas** (two). It marked the second time this season that the reserves did not provide any points, with it previously occurring at Delaware (1/15).

TURNED THEM OVER

UTEP harassed LA Tech into committing 16 turnovers, the most by a CUSA opponent this year. The Miners converted those giveaways into 23 points, a season high when facing DI competition this year. UTEP has now won the points off turnover category in three straight and four of the past five contests.

TURNING UP THE HEAT

The Miners have forced back-to-back opponents into making at least 15 turnovers (31 total). It is the first time this year they've done so in league play and the third occasion overall.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

UTEP has committed a total of 21 giveaways in the past two tilts. It had 10 vs. Missouri State (1/24) before making 11 last time out against LA Tech. The last time the Orange and Blue had a stretch of at least three contests with 11 or fewer turnovers was a four-game surge late in league play last season.

DON'T TAKE HIS SCORING CONSISTENCY FOR GRANTED

Elijah Jones has reached double figures in 19 of 21 games this year (eight and nine points in two others), and he only seems to be getting better. Jones is putting up 19.0 ppg the past three games on a combined 25-47 (53.2 percent) shooting. That includes a ridiculous 13-18 (72.2 percent). The surge has vaulted Jones up to within the top 10 of CUSA for scoring (14.6 ppg-ninth).

A GREAT SHOWING AT THE LINE

UTEP nailed 17-19 (89.5 percent) of its shots at the charity stripe against LA Tech. The readout of 89.5 percent was the highest in a contest since the Miners were an identical 17-19 vs. Seattle U last year (12/7/24). The last time the Orange and Blue shot it that well from the stripe in a CUSA game (min. 10 attempts) was a stellar 34-37 effort (91.9 percent) vs. Southern Miss six years ago (1/9/20).

DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE

Jamal West Jr.'s double-double (10 points, 11 rebounds) vs. LA Tech was the 10th of his career, with four (tied second CUSA) of those coming this year as a Miner. **Otis Frazier III** also had four double-doubles in 2024-25. The last UTEP player to have at least five such efforts was **Bryson Williams** (five) in 2020-21.

DON'T LEAVE THEM OPEN

Kaseem Watson has nailed a team-leading 35 triples on a squad-best 91 attempts (38.5 percent) from distance on the year, aided by filling up 5-12 (41.7 percent) the past two tilts. Thanks to his hot streak, **Elijah Jones** is now right on the heels of Watson by making 34-89 (38.2 percent). Watson has drilled at least two treys in four of the past five contests and 10 times total this season. Jones also has 10 tilts of two or more 3-pointers, including doing so the last four games.

GIVE ELIJAH FIVE 20+ POINT GAMES

Elijah Jones went off for a career-high 25 points against LA Tech. It marked his team-leading fifth outburst of at least 20 points this year, with three of those showings coming in league play. It's the most 20+ point games by a Miner since **Tae Hardy** (eight) in 2023-24.

KASEEM IS CLOSING QUICKLY

Not to be outdone, **Kaseem Watson** has piled up four 20+ point efforts this year, with all of them occurring in the past eight contests. He's accounting for 15.5 ppg during the streak, aided by six double-digit showings.

LOTS OF 20+ POINT SCORERS LATELY

The Miners have had a 20+ point scorer in six of the past eight contests. **Kaseem Watson** has led the way with four in the stretch, followed by **Elijah Jones** (three) and one each from **Caleb Blackwell** and **Jamal West Jr.** That is the best such stretch at the school since there was a 20+ point scorer in eight out of nine contests late in the 2021-22 season. That year it was courtesy of both **Souley Boum** (seven) and **Jamal Bieniemy** (two) during that sequence, with both reaching 20+ points in the same game once in stretch.

MOVING PAST 800 CAREER POINTS

With his 20-point outing against LA Tech, **Kaseem Watson** marched past 800 career points at the DI level. Including prior stops with CSUB and Delaware State, Watson enters the matchup with Delaware at 808 points, including 261 this year (12.4 ppg) with the Miners.

CASSIUS ON THE VERGE OF 1,000 CAREER POINTS AT THE NCAA LEVEL

Cassius Brooks is six points shy of reaching 1,000 career points at the NCAA level. He sports 994 points, with the majority of those (931) coming during his stellar two-year run with DII program Arkansas Tech.

PILING UP STEALS OF LATE

UTEP has registered 24 total steals the past three games (8.0 spg), as it has started to turn up the heat once again against the opposition. The surged has propelled the Miners up to 7.8 spg (second CUSA/90th NCAA). UTEP has at least seven thefts in each of the past three tilts after doing so once over the first seven CUSA affairs.



WATCH OUT FOR JONES AND WEST JR. AT THE RIM

The duo of **Elijah Jones** (28 blocks, 1.33 bpg-seventh CUSA) and **Jamal West Jr.** (23 blocks, 1.10 bpg-11th CUSA) has accounted for 51 of UTEP's 78 rejections on the season. No one else on the team has more than seven swats. Jones already has his most rejections in his third year with the program (prior best 23, 2024-25). He is two shy of becoming the first UTEP player to record at least 30 blocked shots in a campaign since **Tyodus Verhoeven** (32) in 2021-22.

JONES BLOCKING SHOT IN BUNCHES

Elijah Jones has been a shot-blocking machine of late. He has swatted 16 shots over the past seven games, including multiple blocks in six of those contests. The effort has surpassed his total (13) the first 14 contests of the campaign. Five of those early on were vs. DII WNMU (11/7). He is now sixth in CUSA (1.33 bpg). **Jamal West Jr.** has been more consistent all year, with at least one rejection in 17 contests.

THEY CONNECT OFTEN

Jamal West Jr. (58.21 percent-second CUSA/41st NCAA) and **Elijah Jones** (50.2 percent-fourth CUSA) give the Miners two of the top four players in the league rankings for field-goal percentage.

GOTTA GET TO 70

The Miners are 7-1 on the season when scoring at least 70 points, most recently doing against FIU (W, 83-77) on Jan. 22.

WHAT A LEAP BY ELIJAH

Elijah Jones has stepped things up at both ends of the court this year, topping the team in scoring (14.3 ppg-ninth CUSA) and blocked shots (1.33-seventh CUSA). Jones is also second in rebounding (4.7 rpg), field-goal percentage (117-233, 50.2 percent-fourth CUSA) and 3-pointers made (34). Last year Jones averaged 3.5 ppg, 2.3 rpg in 2024-25 and 3.9 ppg and 1.7 rpg in 2023-24.

THIS TEAM CAN RALLY

UTEP has won three different games this year in contests when it trailed by double figures. The Miners overcame a 10-point deficit (25-15, 5:41, 1H) in the 70-69 win at Delaware (1/15). They previously did so against North Dakota State (trailed 14-2, 15:50, 1H, W, 76-66, 12/22) and vs. St. Thomas of Houston (down, 41-28, 00:36, W, 84-83, OT, 11/19).

WE CAN WIN THEM CLOSE

UTEP is 3-1 on the year in contests decided by three points or less, with two of those triumphs coming by a single point (W, 84-83, OT, vs. St Thomas, 11/19 and W, 70-69, at Delaware, 1/15). It's the first time in six years that the Miners have picked up multiple wins by one point (W, 71-70, vs. Ball State, 12/23/19 and W, 67-66, at Middle Tennessee, 1/30/20).

MR AND-1

Jamal West Jr. has posted a squad-leading 12 And-1s on the season. It shouldn't come as a surprise given that he's leads the team in both free throws made (57) and attempted (90).

KASEEM IS COOKING

Kaseem Watson has reached double figures in scoring in six of the past eight games and 13 of the past 17 contests. Watson is accounting for 13.7 ppg in the stretch, elevating his season scoring average from 6.8 ppg (through four tilts) to 12.4 ppg.

THE TRIO BRINGS IT EVERY NIGHT

UTEP's top three scorers (**Elijah Jones**, 14.3 ppg-ninth CUSA, **Jamal West Jr.**, 13.5 ppg-15th CUSA and **Kaseem Watson**, 12.4 ppg-22nd CUSA) bring it offensively every single night. Jones has recorded double figures in scoring 19 times followed by West Jr. (15) and Watson (14). Incredibly, in the two games Jones failed to hit double figures this year he had eight in one and nine in the other. Furthermore, Jones reached double figures the first 13 contests, which was the longest streak out of the gates by a Miner since the legendary **Randy Culpepper** (14, 2009-10).

TURNED THE CORNER AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

UTEP has connected on 74.3 percent (124-167) from the free-throw line in CUSA play. It is a notable improved from nonconference action when the Miners were just 64.5 percent (147-228).

STREAKING AT THE LINE

Kaseem Watson has made 23 consecutive free throws and 28-29 (96.6 percent) in CUSA action. The last Miner previously to sink 23 straight free throws was **Souley Boum** (first four games in 2020-21). Boum ripped off 24 in a row in 2019-20 while **Bryson Williams** knocked down 28 straight (also in '19-20). The most-recent UTEP player to have a stretch of at least 30 straight was Miner Hall of Famer **Brandon Wolfram** ('99-00).

WEST JR. SURGING ON THE BOARDS

Jamal West Jr. has piled up 114 rebounds (8.1 rpg) over the past 14 games, a marked improvement from his first seven contests (4.4 rpg). The surge has elevated him to 6.9 rpg (11th CUSA), aided by 2.57 orpg (seventh CUSA). His overall average would be the highest by a Miner since **Bryson Williams's** readout of 7.4 rpg in 2020-21.

LOOKING AT THE STARTING FIVE

UTEP has deployed eight different starting lineups this year. The Miners' most common unit is also their most successful one. The quintet of **Caleb Blackwell, KJ Thomas, Kaseem Watson, Elijah Jones** and **Jamal West Jr.** stands 5-4 in the situation.

SCORING FROM LOTS OF PLAYERS

Ten times this year, at least four UTEP players have reached double figures in scoring. **Elijah Jones** has been the most consistent with 19 such efforts. That included the first 13 games, which was the longest such stretch to start a season by a Miner in 16 years (**Randy Culpepper**, 16, 2009-10). **Jamal West Jr.** (15) and **Kaseem Watson** (14) have buoyed his efforts. **Caleb Blackwell** (six in 15 GP), **KJ Thomas** (three), **LA Hayes** (three) **Tyreese Watson** (three in seven GP) also have multiple games with 10+ points.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

Elijah Jones (14.3 ppg-ninth CUSA), **Jamal West Jr.** (13.3 ppg-15th CUSA) and **Kaseem Watson** (12.4 ppg-22nd) all average better than 12.0 ppg. The last time UTEP had at least three players produce 12.0 ppg or more in a season was during **Joe Golding's** first year (2021-22) on the sidelines thanks to **Souley Boum** (19.9 ppg), **Jamal Bieniemy** (14.7 ppg) and **Keonte Kennedy** (14.1 ppg).

TALKING DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Jamal West Jr. (four) and **LA Hayes** (one) are the lone Miners on the year to have produced double-doubles. Hayes came off the bench to register his first career double-double with 10 points and a career-high 10 rebounds (four offensive) in the 83-80 OT win vs. Middle Tennessee (1/8). West Jr. has two in league play (10 pts, 11 rbs, LA Tech, 1/28 and 16 pts, 10 rbs, at Delaware, 1/15) and two in nonconference (16 pts, 13 rbs, Norfolk State, 12/21 and 21 pts, 14 rbs, at Seattle U, 12/7).

STEALS HAVE BEEN SECONDARY IN NATURE TO US

The Miners enter the game vs. Delaware averaging 7.8 spg (second CUSA/90th NCAA), aided by a total of 24 the past three tilts. UTEP has been among the very best in the nation for the category the past few years under **Joe Golding**. The Orange and Blue were second nationally for steals per game in 2024-25 (10.2), led the country in 2023-24 (11.4) and were 12th in the NCAA in 2022-23 (9.0). They topped CUSA in each of those campaigns.

TALKING DOUBLE-DIGIT STEALS UNDER GOLING

UTEP has produced 60 games with at least 10 steals under head coach **Joe Golding**, including doing so six times this year. To put that overall figure under Golding into perspective, consider that it matches the total such efforts (60) in the prior 15 seasons combined prior to Golding's arrival (started for 2021-22 season).

TURNING TEAMS OVER IS WHAT WE'VE DONE

UTEP enters the game vs. Delaware with the opposition committing 13.4 giveaways per game (second CUSA/83rd NCAA), helped by forcing a total of 31 the past two tilts. The Miners have led CUSA and been among the best, if not the best in the country, in that area the past three years (2024-25, 16.0-sixth, 2023-24, 18.7-first and 2022-23, 16.8-10th).

WAS A DAUNTING NON D1 SCHEDULE

UTEP endured a challenging nonconference DI foes. Through Jan. 26, those eight opponents have combined to go 112-62.

HEALTH CHECK

With two Miners (**David Tubek** and **Tyreese Watson**), sidelined to injuries vs. LA Tech, UTEP has now lost 25 man-games to injury after having only three such contests a year ago. It's the most such man-games lost to injury since the 2022-23 season (34).

QUICK RUNDOWN

- Lost all five starters and 11 letter winners overall from last year.
- Lost 89.0 percent of scoring, 77.7 percent of the rebounding, 90.3 percent of its assists, 90.8 percent of the steals and 74.7 percent of its blocks.
- Returned four players from last year, including two who started the opener (**Elijah Jones & KJ Thomas**), and another (**Jordan Hernandez**) who made his UTEP debut.
- Ten newcomers joined the squad, including DI transfers **C.J. Smith** (Oklahoma State), **David Tubek** (Seton Hall), **Tyreese Watson** (ULM), third-team All-MEAC member **Kaseem Watson** (Delaware State) and back-to-back All-Southland Conference second-team honoree **Jamal West Jr.** (Nicholls State). Second-team NJCAA All-American and the No. 12 JUCO player nationally **Caleb Blackwell** (South Plains), first-team all-conference and NJCAA All-Tourney team **LA Hayes** (Frank Phillips College) and 2025 NJCAA National Champion **Mouhamed Mbaye** (Trinity Valley CC) venture from the JUCO ranks. Three-star recruit **Bobby Montgomery Jr.** (Mt. Zion Prep) is a true freshman. DII transfer and second-team All-GAC recipient **Cassius Brooks** (Arkansas Tech), who scored more than 900 points in two years, rounds out the list of newcomers.



WINNING WAYS WITH GOLING

UTEP head coach **Joe Golding** has led his squad to three winning seasons in four years, securing 18+ wins in each of them. That hadn't happened since the Miners claimed 18+ games in four straight seasons from 2012-16. UTEP has also posted consecutive campaigns with 18 wins for the first time since that stretch.

HOME COOKING

The Miners are 6-5 thus far at home (2-3 CUSA), but they need to get hot to secure 10+ wins in the Sun City for a sixth straight year (five home games left). UTEP was 11-5 at the Bear's Den last year, including winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight year.

THE BEST FANS IN CONFERENCE USA

UTEP has led Conference USA in attendance for either total number of fans or average attendance for all four years of head coach **Joe Golding's** tenure. In 2024-25 the Orange and Blue topped the league in both categories. UTEP averaged a CUSA-best 5,247 fans and had a league-most 83,954 pass through the turnstiles.

PRESEASON PREMONITIONS

UTEP was predicted to finish eighth in Conference USA for the 2025-26 season, as voted upon by the league's head coaches. Defending regular-season and tournament champion Liberty (143) led the way, followed by Kennesaw State (113), NM State (113), Middle Tennessee (103), LA Tech (82), WKU (79), Jax State (67), the Miners (66), Sam Houston (56), FIU (36) and league newcomers Delaware (35) and Missouri State (30). UTEP did not land anyone on the league's All-CUSA Preseason Team.

A YEAR IN REVIEW

- Compiled a record of 18-15 in 2024-25, marking the third season of at least 18 triumphs in four years under head coach **Joe Golding**.
- Outlasted I-10 rival NM State, 66-63, on the road, for its first victory against the Aggies in the Pan-American Center in 14 years.
- Won the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight season.
- Surged out to the best record through 20 games (15-5) in 15 years.
- Won at least one contest at the CUSA Championships for the second consecutive campaign. That hadn't happened since an eight-season run (2010-17).
- Nailed 241 triples, the second-most in a single season in program history.

THE BASIC FACTS ON UTEP'S PROGRAM

- This is the 105th season of UTEP men's basketball. The Miners made history by starting five African-Americans to defeat Kentucky, 72-65, and win the 1966 NCAA Championship on the way to inspiring the Disney hit movie Glory Road.
- UTEP has 17 NCAA Tournament appearances (last in 2010), 11 NIT bids (last in 2015), 12 conference championships (last in 2010) and 26 seasons with at least 20+ victories (last in 2015). The Miners have won five league tournaments (last in 2005).
- The Miners have a strong presence in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame with **Don Haskins**, **Nate Archibald**, **Nolan Richardson**, the **1966 team** and **Tim Hardaway** all representing UTEP.

GET TO KNOW COACH GOLING

Joe Golding is in his fifth year at UTEP, and he is the 20th head coach in program history. He is the eighth head coach for the Miners since legendary Hall of Fame Coach **Don Haskins** retired following the 1998-99 season. Golding is 235-221 in his 15th season as a collegiate head coach, including 77-77 at UTEP. He has enjoyed three winning seasons in four years, piling up at least 18 triumphs in those campaigns above .500. He is tied for fourth all time with **George McCarty** (77-58, 1954-59). If the Miners can get hot, he could tie or surpass **Tony Barbee** (82-52, 2006-10, third place) by year's end. Golding set the tone for his tenure in his first year on the sidelines in the Sun City in 2021-22. He became the fourth head coach in program history to have a winning season in their initial season. **Don Haskins** was the first to do so when he directed the Miners to a mark of 18-6 in 1961-62. **Doc Sadler** (27-8, 2004-05) and **Tim Floyd** (25-10, 2010-11) also achieved the feat. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP. Previously Golding spent 10 years at Abilene Christian (158-144), helping it transition from a Division II to a Division I program. Golding led the Wildcats to the 2019 and 2021 NCAA Tournaments, including a stunning upset as a 14-seed of third-seeded Texas in the first round of the 2021 Big Dance.

UP NEXT

UTEP has a split week, with one road game and one home contest. The Miners open things up by playing at Sam Houston (5:30 p.m. MT/6:30 p.m. CT) on Wednesday before locking up with I-10 rival NM State (at 7 p.m. MT on Feb. 7). Fans who buy a ticket for UTEP's matchup with the Aggies will be able to get in free to the women's contest at 2 p.m. vs. Sam Houston. Fifth Season at UTEP

27th Season as a Coach

Joe Golding was appointed the 20th head coach in UTEP men's basketball history on April 13, 2021. He will carry a career record of 228-207 (14 years) into the 2025-26 season, including a mark of 70-63 (four years) with UTEP. The 70 victories place him fifth all-time on the school's career coach win list.

Golding has directed the Miners to three winning seasons in four years, with UTEP picking up at least 18 victories in each of those campaigns. That hadn't occurred since the Orange and Blue claimed 18+ games in four straight seasons from 2012-16. UTEP has also posted consecutive campaigns with 18 wins for the first time since that stretch. Under his tutelage, nine Miners have combined to secure 12 Conference USA postseason honors.

UTEP compiled a record of 18-15 in 2024-25, including its first road vanquishing of I-10 rival NM State in 14 years. Other notable achievements were winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the second straight season, surging out to the best record through 20 games in 15 years and winning at least one contest at the CUSA Championships for the second consecutive campaign. That hadn't happened since an eight-season run (2010-17).

Otis Frazier III (All-CUSA Second Team, All-Defensive Team), Corey Camper Jr. (All-Defensive Team, All-CUSA Honorable Mention) and David Terrell Jr. (All-CUSA Honorable Mention) were all recognized in postseason CUSA accolades. Frazier and Camper Jr. became the second Miner duo to earn all-defensive honors in the same season. Frazier III is also the first UTEP player since Julian Washburn (three times, 2013-15) and third all time (Julian Stone, 2010-11) to do so on multiple occasions.

He guided UTEP to 18 victories and runner-up honors at the 2024 CUSA Championships. It marked the Orange and Blue's first appearance in the championship contest of the league tournament since 2011. The run to the finals was unprecedented for the program for multiple reasons. UTEP's No. 5 seed was the lowest in the 13 appearances that it has now made in a conference tournament championship game. The Miners took out the No. 1 seed, Sam Houston, 65-63, in the semifinals, their first win against a top seed at the league tournament since the 1993 WAC Championships. Furthermore, they became the first squad in school history to come back from double-digit deficits to win consecutive contests at the league tournament.

Some other notables for 2023-24 included helping UTEP lead the country in both steals per game (11.4) and turnovers forced per game (18.7). The Miners shattered the prior standard (280, 2002-03 and 2022-23) with their 389 total thefts, which also rates second all time in CUSA History. That trailed only the 395 by UAB in 2002-03. UTEP also broke the program mark for turnovers forced in a season with 636. The Miners showed grit, winning a game at the league tournament by two points or less for the first time since 1992 after they ousted top seed Sam Houston.

The Orange and Blue posted the biggest margin of victory (74-49, 25 points) against I-10 rival NM State in 20 years. UTEP claimed the 2023 WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational for the first time since 2019 (no event in 2020 due to Covid-19), in addition to knocking off a power conference program (Cal, 75-72, Nov. 20) at a neutral site for the initial occasion since 2014.

Senior guard Tae Hardy earned second-team All-District and All-CUSA Honors. The Miners accounted for three of the five players on the CUSA All-Freshman Team, including the Freshman of the Year Terrell Jr. Frazier III was All-CUSA Honorable Mention and voted to the CUSA All-Defensive Team, the first selection to the squad for UTEP since 2015.

In 2022-23 he had to overhaul the roster after the Miners returned just one starter and three letterwinners total from a 20-win team a year prior. UTEP managed a 14-18 record, including a 67-64 victory against NM State on Nov. 12 for its first win against the Aggies in three years. That was the start of a five-game winning streak, which was aided by back-to-back OT triumphs. UTEP's five straight victories in November were the longest in the month in four years, which was aided by a mark of 3-0 in the inaugural Jim Forbes Classic Presented by Speaking Rock.

The Miners came within a point of winning the WestStar Don Haskins Sun Bowl Invitational, falling 47-46 to eventual NCAAA Tournament participant Kent State on Dec. 22. UTEP experienced a tough 1-4 stretch early in league play, with those four setbacks by a combined 14 points. The Miners remained resilient on the way to forging seven league triumphs, capped by a 77-65 "Senior Day" triumph against Middle Tennessee on March 4.

Shamar Givance was named to the five-member Conference USA men's basketball All-Academic team, becoming the first Miner to secure a spot since Dominic Artis (second team) in 2015-16. Givance also garnered 2022-23 College Sports Communicators' Academic All-District accolades.

Golding experienced immediate success in his first year on the sidelines with the Orange and Blue, directing the Miners to their first 20-win season (20-14) since going 22-11 in 2014-15. UTEP earned a spot in The Basketball Classic for its first postseason appearance since 2015. The Miners defeated Western Illinois, 80-54, on March 19 for their first postseason win since 2009.

UTEP was 11-7 in league play, securing the first winning record in conference action since forging a mark of 12-6 in 2016-17. That was aided by winning 10 of 14 down the stretch, including halting back-to-back CUSA West Division Champion North Texas' 15-game winning streak, 70-68, on "Senior Day" on March 5. The Miners then went on to defeat Old Dominion, 74-64, on March 9 for their first victory at the CUSA Championships in five years.

Golding's charges achieved notable success on the road, compiling their most road wins (seven) since going 8-2 in 2013-14. UTEP had its first winning record on the road in league play since 2016-17, and the five league road wins surpassed its total (four) of such games from the prior three seasons combined.

The Miners registered their first road sweep of the LA Tech and Southern Miss trip in six years.

UTEP enjoyed a six-game winning streak in conference play (Jan. 15 to Feb. 5), which was the longest since also posting six straight CUSA victories in 2016.

With the Miners finishing at 20-14, Golding joined Don Haskins (18-6, 1961-62), Doc Sadler (27-8, 2004-05) and Tim Floyd (25-10, 2010-11) as the only coaches in program history to have a winning season in their first year on the sidelines. Overall, the prior 19 head coaches combined to forge an average record of 9-13 in their first year with UTEP.

Individually, Souley Boum (second team) and Jamal Bieniemy (third team) both earned All-Conference USA accolades. Boum was also a NABC All-District honoree.

He joined UTEP after leading Abilene Christian to the NCAA Tournament in two of his final three seasons with the program and an upset win over third-seed Texas in the 2021 "Big Dance."

Golding performed a remarkable turnaround at ACU after shepherding the Wildcats' transition from Division II to Division I. He guided the Wildcats to a record of 158-144 in 10 seasons at the helm of the program (2011-2021), including a 71-23 mark over the last three years. ACU chalked up three consecutive 20-win seasons, finishing with a 27-7 mark in 2018-19, the most wins in program history. ACU finished 20-11 overall and 15-5 in league play during the 2019-20 season before the postseason was canceled due to the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic. It marked just the second time in program history that the team put together back-to-back 20-win seasons including the postseason; the first came during coach Golding's playing days.

Golding directed ACU to a 24-5 overall record and a 13-2 Southland Conference mark during the 2020-21 campaign. The Wildcats claimed the Southland Conference tournament title, and the first NCAA Tournament win in program history when #14 seed ACU shocked the heavily favored Longhorns, 53-52, in the first round on March 20. Golding was named the NABC District 22 Co-Coach of the Year, while Kolton Kohl was selected to the All-District 22 first team. Kohl was also named to the 2020-21 All-Southland Conference first team, while Joe Pleasant earned second team All-League honors and Coryon Mason garnered third team recognition. Damien Daniels, Reggie Miller and Mason were also tabbed to the league All-Defensive team.

Golding, who played point guard at ACU from 1994-98, took over as the head coach at his alma mater in 2011. In his first season, the Wildcats were 12-16 overall and 4-14 in the Lone Star Conference. ACU began competing at the Division I level during the 2013-14 season. Four years later, they reached the postseason (College Insider Tournament) and, the year after that, they were in the Big Dance.

Golding's teams have also excelled in the classroom with a perfect 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last four years, and a 3.2 grade point average this season. Every one of his players who exhausted their eligibility graduated from ACU.

Golding's first coaching job was as a varsity assistant at South Garland High School, where he helped the team to back-to-back Class 5A playoff appearances. He spent the 2001-02 season as an assistant coach at Seminole Junior College before taking the head coaching job at Sachse High School. During the program's first years at the 5A level, Golding led the team to a 15-14 record in 2002-03 and an 18-10 mark in 2003-04. Golding spent the 2004-05 season as an assistant coach at Collin County Community College, and the next three seasons (2005-08) as the top assistant to head coach Jason Copeland at ACU before joining head coach Steve Shields' staff at Arkansas Little Rock. His three years at UALR (2008-11) produced a Sun Belt Conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

Golding was a four-year letterwinner at ACU from 1994-98, playing in all 108 games, and was given the Teague Point Guard Award as a senior. He shot 46 percent from the floor over his four-year career, and averaged 4.2 assists per game. He graduated from ACU with a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport science in May of 1999.

Golding and his wife, Amanda, have two sons, Cason and Chase.
