Transportation and Parking Procedures For Spectators

The following information is extremely important and we ask that you **share this information** with parents and other potential spectators who may attend the OVC Cross Country Championship.

On race day, the SIUE Police will shut down University Drive from Poag Road (St. Louis Street) to Governors Parkway (Cougar Lake Road). A police officer will be present at each end of the road closure.

All spectators MUST park in lot P-8 and P-9.

Cars will **NOT** be allowed on N University Drive to drop spectators off or to park. Spectators must go directly to lot P-8 and P-9.

Free buses will be provided to take spectators to the course. Spectators must be able to access the steps to enter the buses and must be able to sit in a seat. Children, including infants, are allowed on the buses at the discretion of the parents. The buses will not be accessible for car seats.

The first bus is expected to depart Lot P-9 at 7:00 am. Please plan to arrive early, as it will take you additional time to reach the course. The buses will pick up and drop off spectators in Lot P-9.

At the conclusion of the races, buses will pick spectators up at the course in the same location spectators are dropped off.

Buses will run continuously from 7:00 am until 12:30 pm.

Handicapped/Disabled Parking: If you or family member happens to be physically disabled, the SIUE Police will allow you to enter University Drive from Poag Road (St. Louis Street) if you have a valid handicapped placard or valid handicapped license plates. We will have a special parking area set up at the first turn in to the course. When leaving the meet, individuals must travel southbound on University Drive.
