Myah Taylor has recorded 53 assists on the year and is averaging 6.6 assister per game which ranks fourth in the NCAA . She leads the SEC in both categories and is the only player averaging over 6.0 per game in the conference and the only player with at least 50 assists.

Despite being undersized, State has blocked 62 shots in eight games, fourth most in the country. MSU also ranks second nationally in blocked shots per game (7.8)

DOUG NOVAK ELEVATED TO INTERIM HEAD COACH

- Doug Novak earned his first career win at Mississippi State on Nov. 9, 2021 with a 91-62 victory over Alabama State
- Doug Novak was hired on Sept. 7 as the Associate Head Coach
- On Tuesday, Oct. 12, 2021, Doug Novak was named interim head coach of the Mississippi State women's basketball program. Novak becomes the ninth women's basketball head coach at Mississippi State.
- Novak came to Starkville following eight seasons as the head coach of the men's program at Bethel University near Minneapolis, Minnesota.
- While at Bethel University, he posted a record of 131-68 with two MIAC Titles and an NCAA Tournament appearance
- He guided 19 players to All-MIAC honors including an MIAC Player of the Year and First Team All-American

STATE AMONG WINNINGEST PROGRAMS IN DIVISION I SINCE 2016-17

- Since the start of the 2016-17 campaign, Mississippi State owns 147 wins, which is tied for the sixth-most victories in all of Division I.
- During the stretch, State has appeared in two national title games, made three-consecutive Elite Eights and won three SEC championships.
- After posting 34 wins in 2016-17, the Bulldogs recorded a program-record 37 victories during the 2017-18 campaign. State followed that season up with 33 wins in 2018-19 and 27 in 2019-20.
- Mississippi State has won eight matchups against teams on the list during the last five seasons.

MYAH TAYLOR, THE NATIONS BEST PASSER

- Redshirt senior Myah Taylor, already known as one of the top point guards in the country, has elevated her game at the start of the 2021-22 season.
- The Olive Branch, Miss. native ranks 11th in the NCAA in assists with 53.

- She has earned 53 assists in just 8 games so far this season.
- She is averaging 6.6 assister per game which ranks 4th in the NCAA .
- Myah leads the SEC in both categories and is the only player averaging over 6.0 per game and the only player with at least 50 assists.
- She has posted an assist/turnover rartio of 4.4 on the year and has only turned it over 12 times all season. Her A/T ratio is the 2nd best ratio in the NCAA and the 2nd best in the SEC.
- After recording 10 assists against McNeese State, Myah has recorded two double-digit assist games this season. Before the 2021-22 season, Myah had only reach double-digit assists once in three seasons, back in 2019-20.
- Last season, Taylor recorded 78 total assists in 19 games (4.1 per game). Taylor is on pace to well exceed last seasons total
- Taylor's career-high for assists in a season was 151 during her sophomore season in 2019-20. That year she averaged 4.6 assists per game.
- Taylor has earned 7+ assists in all but two games this season. Her previous long streak with 7+ assists in a game was back in 2019-20 when she did in three straight games from Feb. 27 through March 6. During that same season (2/9/20 through 3/6/20) she had at least 6 assists in seven straight games.
- When Taylor reached at least 7 assists in a game, State is nearly perfect with a record of 14-2.

MYAH TAYLOR CAREER MSU MILESTONS TO WATCH

- Myah Taylor has 339 career assists in 94 games. She just passed Julian Harris (1977-80) for 10th on the all-time career assists list.
- Currently, Myah's career assists per game average of 3.6 ranks 6th all-time at MSU.
- Her 11 assists against Alabama State is

tied for the 9th most in a single-game in program history.

- Taylor owns three of the top 14 single-game highs with two other 10 assist per game performance.

RICKEA JACKSON, 40 BURGER

- Junior Rickea Jackson had a game to remember against McNeese State on Dec. 1.
- The Detroit native scored a career-high 40-points on 18-of-26 shooting (69%). Rickea became the first Bulldog reach the 40-point mark since Teaira McCowan back in Dec. of 2017 when she scored 41.
- Rickea is just the 13th player all-time to score 40-points in a game and her point total ranks as the 10th most points scored in a single-game in program history.
- Against McNeese State, Jackson also added nine rebounds, two steals and two assists.
- Her 40 points scored is the 3rd-most points scored by any player in the country this season

RICKEA JACKSON IS JUST TOO TALENTED

- Junior Rickea Jackson continues to move up the career list for the most games with at least 20-points scored.
- In 58 career games, Jackson has reached the 20-point mark 15 different times, with 10 of those games coming against SEC teams.
- In those 15 games, Mississippi State is 14-1. The lone loss came against Kentucky on Jan. 3, 2021 (86-92).

- Jackson has gotten off to a fast start in 2021-22. The junior from Detroit has scored at least 20-points in four of the six games she has played in.
- Jackson opened the season with 26 points against Alabama State. It was the first 20-point season-opener since Teaira McCowan scored 24 on Nov. 6, 2018 against SE Missouri State.
- Her 26 points was the most on opening night since 2011 when Diamber Johnson scored 30 against Jacksonville State on Nov. 11.

- Jackson is averaging 21.9 points per game through 7 games this season.
- Her 21.9 ppg leads the SEC and ranks 7th nationally

STARS IN THE MAKING

- **Sophomore Jerkaila Jordan** and **freshman Denae Carter** have been two of State's top players this season, despite both being in their first seasons wearing Maroon & White.
- Jordan currently ranks second on the team in scoring (16.1 ppg) and third in rebounding (5.6 rpg) while also ranking second in steals (17) and third blocked shots (12).
- Carter, who is coming off the bench and averaging just 19 minutes per game, is currently leading the team in rebounds per game (7.0 rpg), total rebounds (56, only player with at least 50 boards) and blocked shots (15) while averaging 6.4 ppg (5th best team average).
- Through eight games this season the duo has accounted for 30% of the teams scoring, 31% of the teams rebounds and 44% of the teams blocked shots.
- Carter is ranked 50th in the NCAA in blocked shots (15) and 51st in blocks per game (1.8).

UNDERSIZED, BUT BLOCKING EVERYTHING

- Mississippi State, despite having just four players 6-2 or taller, is ranked second in the country in blocked shots.
- In eight games this season, State has blocked 62 shots
- MSU also ranks second nationally in blocked shots per game.
- Denae Carter currently leads the team in blocks (15) while Rickea Jackson has 13 and Jerkaila Jordan has 12 each. Raven Farley also has double-digit blocks on the year with 11.
- Mississippi State has already had three games this season with at least 11 blocked shots. The season-high is 12 against Bethune-Cookman.
- Last season State had zero games with double-digit blocks and they had only one such game during the 2019-20 season.
- Despite having only played seven games this season, MSU is just 22 blocked shots away from tying the mark if 81 set in 19 games last season.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Lead by the SEC's best point guard, Myah Taylor, Mississippi State has been one of

the best teams in America at protecting the basketball.

- State leads the SEC, and is ranked 25th nationally, in fewest turnovers at just 73.
- MSU's 10.4 turnovers per game is ranked 3rd nationally while leading the SEC for fewest per contest.

I'LL TAKE THAT

- While the team is forcing an averaging of 18.7 turnovers per game, Myah Taylor and her elite level defense has been a big reason why.
- Taylor is ranked 6th in the nation in steals (25) and 2nd in the SEC.
- She is also ranked 11th nationally, 1st in the SEC, in steals per game at 3.6 per contest.

Doug Novak was named the interim head coach of the Mississippi State Women's Basketball team on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 after Nikki McCray-Penson stepped down due to health concerns. Novak was hired at Mississippi State on Tuesday, Sept. 7 as the associate head coach.

Novak possesses nearly three decades of coaching experience, most recently as the head coach at Bethel University in Minnesota for the past eight seasons and as the top assistant coach at The Citadel and Tulane for seven seasons on the men's side.

Novak's Bethel teams won 65.8 percent of their games (131-68), highlighted by seven consecutive MIAC playoff appearances. The Royals made six trips to the semifinals and three runs to the championship game. Bethel captured a share of the program's first-ever MIAC regular season championship, second-ever MIAC playoff championship and second-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 2016-17.

A point of pride for Novak is player development. He had 17 MIAC All-Conference honorees during his Bethel tenure. Kyle Zimmerman secured the MIAC's Most Valuable Player, coupled with an NABC All-America First-Team and D3Hoops.com All-America Third-Team selection in 2014-15.

Novak graduated from the University of Tennessee in 1990 with a degree in Psychology. He then earned his Masters degree in Counseling in 1992 from Clemson University.
