7/9 Montana State vs. 16/13 UT Martin

December 4, 2021 ♦ Bobcat Stadium ♦ Bozeman, Montana

## THE STORYLINE

Montana State begins its third consecutive playoff appearance looking to defy the basic holiday tenet that giving is better than taking when UT Martin invades Bobcat Stadium for an FCS Playoffs second round contest on Saturday. Kickoff is 2 pm MT. The Skyhawks rode the strength of six takeaways to a 32-31 first round win at Missouri State last week. UTM stands 18th in the FCS with 26 turnovers gained in 2021, and face a Bobcat team that leads the FCS in fewest turnovers lost (7, tied with James Madison).

## UTM-MSU SERIES

- ▶ Montana State and the Skyhawks have never met on the gridiron, marking the third straight season MSU's playoff opener is against a first-time foe.
- ▶ The Bobcats topped Austin Peay, like UTM an Ohio Valley member, in the 2019 FCS quarterfinals.

## TEAM NOTES

- ▶ Seven of MSU's 16 eight-win seasons in history have occurred in this century, as have four of the eight nine-win seasons.
- ▶ After qualifying for the NCAA Playoffs twice previously, the Bobcats have earned 10 bids since 2002.
- ▶ Brent Vigen's nine wins is the most in MSU history by a first-year Bobcat coach.

## ON THE OFFENSE

- ▶ Montana State's Big Sky-best rushing offense (218.5 yards per game) faces the Ohio Valley Conference's top rushing defense (UTM allowed 128.7 per game)
- ▶ MSU's 5.20 yards per rush is 10th in the FCS, while UTM's 5.49 is 7th.
- ▶ Isaiah Ifanse's 114.4 rushing yards per game is 5th in the FCS, and he averages 95.4 yards in his five playoff games

## ON THE DEFENSE

- ▶ MSU is 7th in the FCS with 167.7 passing yards allowed per game.
- ▶ UTM's 29 points (7 came on special teams) in the regular season finale was the most by a 2021 MSU opponent, while no Bobcat foe has topped 355 total yards.

## STADIUM STUFF

- ▶ Montana State has won three straight home playoff games, and stand 10-3 all-time in post-season games played in Bobcat or Reno H. Sales Stadium.
- ▶ Isaiah Ifanse has two playoff games of 100+ rushing yards in Bobcat Stadium.

## BIG SKY BULLET POINTS

- ♦ MSU finished second in the Big Sky in 2021, the fourth straight season improving the team's place in the final standings.
- ♦ The Cats led the Big Sky in total defense and finished second in scoring defense.

## MSU Media Policies

### Practice Policy

Media members are welcome at the first 15 minutes of Monday practices during normal in-season game weeks, and that period is available for photography and videography (no line-of-scrimmage action). After that, practice is closed. Please consider what is seen and heard at practice off the record.

### Player Interviews

MSU players are available by request on Mondays (depending on class schedules) in or near the Hall of Fame. Interview requests must be submitted to Bill Lamberty, MSU Sports Information, by 5 pm on Sundays. Only captains and Coach Vigen are available during Cat-Griz week.

### Brent Vigen Interviews

Bobcat coach Brent Vigen is available during MSU's weekly Media Lunch each Monday at 12 noon, and by special arrangement through MSU Sports Information. After that, Coach Vigen is available only after games. MSU assistants are available by request as schedules allow.

### Injury Updates

Only season-ending or major injuries sidelining a player for multiple weeks will be addressed by Brent Vigen.

### Post-Game Interviews

Up to three requested players and Coach Vigen appear in the conference room on the 2nd floor of the BAC 15 minutes or so after the game. Post-game road interviews depend on the host facility/staff.

### Sideline Photo Policies

Bobcat Stadium photographers are allowed behind the 10-foot limit line, EXCEPT in team areas or when obstructing the view of paying customers. Photographers are allowed inside the blue pads only with a specially-assigned armband in specifically designated areas. Photo passes and armbands are issued on the following priority system: 1) Still photographers and videographers affiliated with commercial media outlets; 2) Photographers officially designated by competing institutions; 3) Web-based media; and 4) Freelance and student photographers may be issued one credential to two games per season, based on available space. A photo credential DOES NOT guarantee access to the limited number of armbands.

### Credential and Seating Priority

1) Daily newspapers, local TV and radio news outlets, and primary coverage web sites; 2) Weekly newspapers and TV and radio news; 3) Periodicals; 4) Blogs (as space allows); 5) Unaffiliated writers and photographers (as space allows).

### Bobcat Stadium Container and Bag Policy

Credentialed media members may enter Bobcat Stadium through Gate 12 with equipment and camera bags, which are not allowed at any other entrance. Bags will be searched and tagged.

# Bobcat Playoff Notebook

- The University of Tennessee at Martin is Montana State's fourth first-time opponent in its last six playoff games (joining Albany, Austin Peay and Incarnate Word, but excluding North Dakota State, who the Cats played in both 2018 and 2019).

- Bobcat running back Isaiah Ifanse has the longest run from scrimmage (60 yards vs. Austin Peay, 2019), the top two rushing games (196 yards against Austin Peay, 2019, and 139 vs. Incarnate Word, 2018), and the most career rushing yards (477 in five games) in Bobcat playoff history.

- Matthew McKay is slated to make his first career playoff start against UT Martin on Saturday. Bobcat quarterbacks are 4-4 all-time making their initial playoff start, which includes current 2021 reserve signal caller Tucker Rovig, who won his playoff starting debut against Albany in 2019 and current starting linebacker, who as a sophomore quarterback in 2018 led the Cats to a win over Incarnate Word.

- Montana State's only playoff matchup with an Ohio Valley Conference member was the 2019 win against Austin Peay, 24-10 in the quarterfinals at Bobcat Stadium. Earlier in that 2019 season the Cats played their first-ever game against against the OVC, a 38-17 Gold Rush win against nationally-ranked Southeast Missouri.

- The Bobcats stand 9-3 in playoff home games all-time, with an overall playoff record of 12-9.

- Montana State's two previous games against schools from the Volunteer State resulted in Bobcat victories - 2019 over Austin Peay in the FCS Playoffs, and 2015 against East Tennessee State.

- UT Martin's previous game in the Mountain Time Zone was in 2013 (Boise State).

# Bobcat Team Notebook

- Brent Vigen became Montana State's 33rd head football coach when he led MSU onto the field at Laramie, the first to debut against a school he once coached. Six other Bobcat head coaches faced former employers during their careers at MSU:

- Montana State's nine regular season wins against Division I foes in 2019 was the school's most ever, and the team matched that this season. The 2019 squad won 11+ wins for the first time since 2012 (11-2).

- One dozen current Bobcats play as college grads in 2021, and each take graduate classes this season: David Alston (graduated from Nebraska), Troy Andersen, Chase Benson, Blake Hehl (Tarleton State), Jarrett Kessler, Lewis Kidd, Matthew McKay (NC State), Ty Okada, Willie Patterson, Tucker Rovig, Taylor Tuiasosopo, Amandre Williams.

- MSU has previously played each of its 2021 regular season opponents, but for the third straight season opens the playoffs with a first-time foe.

- Montana State's seven Big Sky wins is tied as the second-most in program history.

- Montana State's 30-17 win at Portland State extended the program's string to three straight wins when the Big Sky opener is on the road. MSU is 15-13 when opening Big Sky play on the road all-time.

- Montana State's offensive (Taylor Housewright) and defensive (Freddie Banks) coordinators are in their initial seasons with the Bobcat program, the program's second straight season that's been the case. Matt Miller entered 2019 in his first full season as OC (he was promoted late in 2018) and Kane Ioane transitioned into the DC role. Previously, as in 2021, dual coordinator changes came with new head coaches: 2016 (Courtney Messingham and Ty Gregorak arrived with Jeff Choate), 2007 (Dale Ploessl, Jamie Marshall), and 2000 (Mike Kramer called the offense, Pete Kwiatkowski was DC).

- Montana State has now qualified for the NCAA Playoffs 12 times in school history (in Division II once, the rest in I-AA or FCS). The Bobcats improved their record the following season only three times (8-5 to 11-4 in 2018-19; 9-3 to 10-3 in 2010-11, 10-3 to 11-2 in 2011-12). MSU is 9-9 in the FCS/I-AA Playoffs, 12-9 all-time in NCAA Playoff games (including 3-0 in the Division II Playoffs), and 13-10-2 in the post-season (which includes 1-1-2 in bowl games).

- MSU remains the only college football program to win national titles at three competition levels - NAIA (1956), NCAA Division II (1976), and NCAA I-AA/FCS (1984).

## Bobcat Legacy Number

Former Bobcat coach Jeff Choate introduced 41 as Montana State's legacy number in the summer of 2016, a tribute to the Treasure State's status as the 41st state in the Union and to Montana State's iconic 1941 football team, the last group of Bobcats to play football before World War II. By the end of the 1944 season 10 Bobcat football players had perished in the war effort, a fact observed by famed sportscaster Bill Stern. Stern's 1944 All-America football was comprised only of those 10 men, and in the next year their names had been memorialized nationally and read into the Congressional record. By the time the 1945 academic year dawned, four teammates had joined those 10. Bozeman's Grant Collins wore no. 41 when Choate decided to designate it as MSU's legacy number, and Belgrade's Brayden Konkol was the first Bobcat selected specifically for the honor.

# Bobcat Offensive Notebook

## Offensive Notes

- Montana State's offense has rushed the ball 62.5% of the time in its last 25 games, including the post-season (1,056 rushes out of 1,675 plays). In that time, the Cats have lost just 10 fumbles (which includes one on special teams).

- The volume of MSU's ground game is accentuated by its quality. In 2021:

- Matthew McKay's longest pass (67) and run (56) this season were at EWU.

- Troy Andersen's career rushing total of 2,263 is 10th in MSU history. He was passed by Isaiah Ifanse at Portland St.

- Isaiah Ifanse's 1,258 rushing yards in 2021 raise his career total to 3,096 yards, 3rd in Bobcat history (34 games). He is the fourth Bobcat to surpass 2,000 rushing yards in the last five seasons, recently passing current (Troy Andersen) and former (Chris Murray) teammates, and is the third Bobcat to hit the 3,000-yard mark (the first since 2013).

- In his 481 career carries as a Bobcat Isaiah Ifanse has three of more than 70 yards, and eight of at least 40 yards.

- Montana State's 0.93 sacks allowed per game in 2019 was 7th in the FCS and led Big Sky. This year's squad has surrendered 1.4 sacks per game, first in the Big Sky and 26th in the FCS.

- Matthew McKay threw his first interception as a Bobcat on his 81st pass, which came early in the second quarter at Portland State. His second came 115 passes after the first, against EWU. McKay is sixth in the FCS in passing efficiency (157.7) and 18th in completion percentage (.638).

- Lance McCutcheon has 47 of MSU's 149 catches in 2021, while Willie Patterson is next with 23. McCutcheon's three 100-yard games this year is tied for ninth-most in Bobcat history, and 16 of his 47 catches are for 20+ yards.

- Montana State's 2,404 rushing yards is 213 from crashing into the school's top 10 rushing seasons, while the team's 5.2 yards per rush is sixth-best in Bobcat history. MSU rushed for 5.8 yards per carry and 245 per game during the 2017-18 seasons, a school-record 3,871 yards in 15 games in 2019 (258.1 per game, 5.7 per carry).

- In 2019 the Cats ran the ball 45.4 times a game, 64% of its plays, throwing 25.3 passes per contest. This year's team runs 40.4 times a game, 61%, throwing it 23.6. MSU has more runs than passes in 53 of the last 58 games.

- MSU rushed for 121 yards, averaging 4.0 yards per carry, against a Wyoming team that allowed 125.3 yards a game and 3.4 yards per carry in 2020.

# Bobcat Defensive Notebook

- Montana State held Eastern Washington to 20 points, its lowest scoring output of the season by 14 points, and 314 total yards, 190 below its season average entering the game.

- Portland State gained 351 yards against the Cats, one of only three opponents in MSU's most recent 19 games to eclipse 350 total yards.

- Idaho State's 23 first downs against the Bobcats was the most by an MSU opponent since Texas Tech's 35 in the 2019 season opener (22 games earlier). In that span the Cats allowed 20 once and more than that just four times (including ISU). MSU's 157 first downs allowed in 2021 is fewest in the Big Sky and 14th in the FCS.

- Jeffrey Manning Jr.'s interception at Wyoming marked only the third time in the 21st century a Bobcat intercepted a pass in his MSU debut. The list:

- Montana State posted a string of at least one interception in six straight games late in 2019, snagging a pick in 12 of 16 contests that season. MSU has intercepted a pass in six of this year's 11 games, surviving four straight games without a pick after snagging four Cal Poly passes.

- MSU's 13 interceptions is 19th in the FCS, although the team's two picks at Montana snapped a four-game string without snagging an interception.

- Before doing so vs. Cal Poly this season, the last time MSU intercepted four passes in a game was in a 54-13 win vs. Idaho State in 2011 (112 games earlier).

- MSU's string of 31 games with a takeaway ended at Eastern Washington. The Cats now have forced a turnover in four straight games.

- A week after Cal Poly's impromptu triple-option gained 216 rushing yards against MSU, the most by a Bobcat opponent in 2021, the Cats held Weber State to 54. MSU's 112.9 yards allowed per game is 19th in the FCS. In 2019, the Cats allowed 121.2 yards a game, 18th in the FCS and 2nd in the Big Sky.

- MSU's +0.91 turnover margin is 8th in the FCS and 2nd in the Big Sky. The Cats finished 2019 +13 in turnovers, third in the Big Sky with a turnover margin of +0.87, 13th in the FCS, and led the league (+0.77) in 2018.

- The 2021 Bobcats have scored 69 (of the team's 311) points off of turnovers, allowing 13. MSU out-scored its 2019 opponents 73-14 after turnovers

- Amandre Williams, the other Bobcat moving from outside linebacker to end this season, had a sack against Idaho State and now claims 8.0 tackles-for-loss and 5.5 sacks in 2021. One of his five tackles at Wyoming - where his father starred at defensive end - was a tackle-for-loss.

- Daniel Hardy foreshadowed his spectacular senior season by logging a sack in his first game as a defensive end at Wyoming, and has never slowed down. He finishes the regular season with 17.5 tackles-for-loss and 11.0 sacks. His 1.0 sacks per game is 9th in the FCS and 2nd in the Big Sky. His 1.6 tackles-for-loss per game is 10th in the FCS and fourth in the Big Sky.

- In Troy Andersen's 22-game stretch as a full-time linebacker (spanning 2019 and 2021), he has logged 158 tackles (103 in 2021), 21 for a loss (9.5 this season), with 9.5 sacks (3.0 in '21). He has a fumble recovery, two interceptions and 10 pass breakups.

- Troy Andersen didn't let Ty Okada enjoy the distinction of being the first Bobcat to return an interception for a touchdown since 2017 very long. About 10 minutes of game time after Okada found the end zone against San Diego, Andersen did the same. The last Bobcat duo to accomplish that was Michael Beach and Case Gazerro in 2007.

- Replicating the productivity that end Bryce Sterk and OLB Amandre Williams provided in 2019 seemed unlikely entering 2021, but here's how the three-pronged attack of Williams, Daniel Hardy and Brody Grebe have produced in the team's new 4-3 scheme:

# Bobcat Special Teams Notebook

## Kick Team Notes

- Blake Glessner has kicked off eight times in the last three games (at UM and EWU, vs. Idaho). Six were touchbacks, three were stopped inside the 25, and of the three returned beyond the 25 the furthest was the 32. He helped hold UM's fourth-ranked return unit (27.35 yards per return) to 19.0 on two returns. His 66 kickoffs this season have resulted in 16 tackles inside the 25 and 38 TBs.

- MSU's place-kicking battery of snapper Tommy Sullivan, holder Bryce Leighton, and kicker Blake Glessner each debut as freshmen this season. The only other years MSU debuted kickers in the same season this century was 2016 (P Jered Padmos, K Gabe Pempenger), 2007 (P Eric Fisher, K Michael Sweeney), and 2000 (Nate Cook handled both jobs, although frosh Ryan Wilcox also did some of the kicking).

- Blake Glessner's 54-yard field goal vs. Idaho State is the sixth-longest in MSU history, and made him the school's third kicker to boot two of more than 50 yards in a season. His 53-yard field goal at Wyoming is now tied as seventh-longest in MSU history and is the longest ever by a Bobcat making his career debut and by a freshman (although when Jan Stenerud kicked his 59-yarder against UM in 1965 he was a first-year kicker playing in his eighth game).

- Montana State's 25 special teams tackles this season have resulted in 11 opponent drives beginning inside the 25 (on kickoffs) or 20 (on punts) yard line.

- Daniel Hardy has registered three kickoff coverage tackles this season. All three were big hits that resulted in opponent drives beginning inside the 25.

- Blake Glessner's eight straight mid-season field goals is tied for the second-longest streak in school history. The school record of 14 is held by Jason Cunningham (2010).

- MSU foes blocked a kick in each of the first two games, with Wyoming tipping a field goal and Drake an extra point. UNC got a hand on an extra point

that made it through the uprights. The Cats didn't suffer another blocked kick until Idaho blocked a PAT in game 10.

- Montana State's longest kick return of the season, Coy Steel's 45-yard return of a Portland State punt that set up a Bobcat touchdown and resulted in an injury to Steel.

- Blake Glessner, a member of Stats Perform's Jerry Rice Award Watch List, has connected on 16 field goals this season, tied for fourth in a season at MSU.

- Average starting field position for Bobcat opponents after kickoffs is their own 25-yard line.

# 2021 BOBCAT HIGH- LIGHT REEL

## September 4 at Wyoming

⇒ Isaiah Ifanse's 103 yards at Wyoming (his ninth) was the first by a Bobcat against an FBS foe since Chad Newell at Idaho in 2016  
⇒ Wyoming's 19 points marked the best effort by MSU's defense vs. an FBS opponent since MSU's 19-10 win at Colorado in 2006  
⇒ Blake Glessner's 53-yard field goal is tied as the sixth-longest in program history and is the school's longest-ever by a freshman or a player making his MSU debut

## September 11 vs. Drake

⇒ Brent Vigen became the third straight Bobcat coach to win his home opener. MSU coaches stand 25-7-1 in home openers.

## September 18 vs. San Diego

⇒ Isaiah Ifanse rushed for 109 yards, and his 74-yard run was his third of at least 70 yards.  
⇒ MSU's 540 total yards was the team's fourth-highest total in the last 53 games, and was the 10th 500-yard day in that span.  
⇒ Ty Okada and Troy Andersen became the first Bobcat duo with pick-6s in one game since Michael Beach & Chase Gazerro (Weber, 2007).

## September 25 at Portland State

⇒ Isaiah Ifanse's 217 rushing yards was the second-most by an FCS player through September, and his second 200-yard rushing day as a Bobcat  
⇒ Lance McCutcheon's eight catches and 161 yards marked career highs  
⇒ Matthew McKay's first interception of 2021 (and at MSU) came on his 81st pass

## October 2 vs. Northern Colo.

⇒ Isaiah Ifanse became the 16th Bobcat with three straight 100-yard games with 114 vs. UNC  
⇒ MSU's 40-7 win marked the fifth straight game the Bobcat defense held its foe to under 20 points  
⇒ Lance McCutcheon's 107 receiving yards gave him back-to-back 100-yarders

## October 9 vs. Cal Poly

⇒ MSU scored 30+ points for the fifth straight game, tied for the program's fifth-longest streak  
⇒ Lance McCutcheon has caught a pass of at least 30 yards in all six 2021 games  
⇒ MSU has now finished 15 straight games at least even in turnover margin

## October 15 at Weber State

⇒ MSU's 13-7 win at No. 19 Weber State marked the team's fewest points in a win since a 7-3 victory over Southern Utah in 2007 (159 games ago), and its nine first downs stand as the fewest in a win since getting that many in a 21-18 win against Stephen F. Austin in 1994 (306 games ago).  
⇒ MSU scored more points in a single quarter eight times in its first 24 quarters of 2021.  
⇒ Five of freshman Bryce Leighton's eight punts forced Weber State's superstar returner Rasheed Shaheed into fair catches.  
⇒ Freshman kicker Blake Glessner scored seven of MSU's 13 points and nailed 10th straight FG.

## October 23 vs. Idaho State

⇒ With his fellow starter at LB injured, Troy Andersen logged a career-high 16 tackles vs. ISU  
⇒ Do-it-all Tommy Mellott rushed four times for 21 yards and completed his first pass as a Bobcat  
⇒ MSU held an opponent out of the end zone for the first time in 2021

## November 6 at Eastern Wash.

⇒ MSU held Eastern Washington to 30 points and 290 yards below its season averages  
⇒ Isaiah Ifanse's 217 rushing yards last week stand as the most ever by a Bobcat against EWU  
⇒ MSU posted its third game of at least 500 total yards this season

⇒ Punter Bryce Leighton pinned EWU inside its own 20 four times, including once at the 3, to earn Big Sky Special Teams Player of the Week honors

But the game played in blustery conditions on hard AstroTurf – "It was carpet, just like what we're standing on now," says one of that day's standouts Tom Kostrba, now a middle school teacher in Bozeman – resonates with many of its participants as more than a football game. It stands as a symbol of how football used to be.

Karnop, who witnessed many of the 33 meetings between NDSU and the Bobcats, said by the time those teams met for the 28th time that December day in 1976 the game had become legendary for many involved in the series. "I think it kind of got so it symbolized that it was going to be football, almost (old-time) Butte type of football. Our guys would start getting ready three weeks ahead of time just to go in there whacking."

Kostrba was in on many of that day's big plays, rushing for 106 yards and setting up both Bobcat scores. With the Bobcats trailing 3-0 at halftime, Kostrba gained 34 yards on seven carries on the first drive of the second half to move deep into Bison territory. On third-and-four from the NDSU five yard-line, sophomore quarterback Paul Dennehy found freshman tight end Butch Damberger in the end zone for the day's only TD.

Freshman Jeff Muri's 34-yard fourth-quarter field goal sealed MSU's 10-3 win.

# Bobcat History Lesson

## Butte Beauties

Montana State's first playoff touchdown was scored by Butte's Paul Dennehy, the brilliant quarterback from 1976-78, on a two-yard run in the second quarter of MSU's 17-16 home win over New Hampshire in 1976. Dennehy rushed for 56 yards in the playoffs that season. Another Butte product could take snaps for the Bobcats on Saturday. Freshman Tommy Mellott has carried 36 times for 294 yards this season.

## MSU On December 4

Montana State's most memorable moments on December 4, other than the 10-3 playoff win at Fargo that set the stage for the school's second national title, mostly came in the headlines. On December 4 in 2015 the school named Jeff Choate its 32nd head football coach, in 2012 Big Sky Defensive MVP Jody Owens and quarterback DeNarius McGhee landed All-America honors, and

in 1991 Cliff Hysell was named one of four finalists (with Carroll's Bob Petrino, Bob Cortese of Fort Hays State, and Chuck Shelton). Hysell became the school's head football coach one week later.

## MSU 10, NDSU 3, 12/4/76

It was cold. Ask anyone involved in Montana State's 10-3 playoff win over North Dakota State 45 years ago, and the topic of the frigid conditions comes up early in the conversation.

"It was so cold," laughs Arnie Sgalio, MSU's Sports Information Director in 1976 and later info director for the Big Sky and an executive with ESPN Regional, who spent the week in Fargo advancing the ABC National Game of the Week. "Really cold. And snowy."

"It was a miserable windy day," recalls long-time MSU Athletic Trainer Chuck Karnop. "It started blowing hard (before the game) and blew the same way for three hours."

# Bobcat Coaching Notebook

● By winning his first six home games Brent Vigen joins Herb Agocs (8-0 to begin his career, 1958-59) Fred Bennion (8-0, 1914-15), and Tubby Graves (5-0-1, 1920-21) to navigate that stretch without a loss.

● Brent Vigen, MSU's first-year wins leader among all head coaches, is one of seven Bobcat coaches to win three of his first four games at Montana State, with Rob Ash (3-1 in 2007), Sonny Lubick (4-0, 1978), Herb Agocs (4-0, 1958), Tubby Graves (3-0-1, 1920), Fred Bennion (4-0, 1914), and John E. Flynn (3-0-1, 1902). Each of those coaches also won at least four of their first five. After six games only Agocs, Lubick and Bennion won at least five. Vigen, Agocs, and Lubick each won seven of their first eight.

● The first North Dakota State graduate to lead the Cats, Brent Vigen joins Earle Solomonson as former Bison coaches to assume the head coach role at Montana State. Solomonson became MSU's head coach in 1987, one year after he won a Division II Championship at NDSU and three years after MSU won a national title. He won 15 games in five seasons.

● These coaches left MSU to become head coaches elsewhere: Jim Sweeney after 1967 (Washington State), Ott Romney after 1927 (BYU), and Walter Powell after the 1919 season (Stanford).

● Jeff Choate left Bobcat Football to become an assistant coach at Texas, one of five men who left his role as MSU's head coach to become an assistant coach elsewhere. Doug Graber (after the 1982 season) and Wally Lemm (after 1955) each departed for NFL jobs. Clyde Carpenter went to Tennessee as an assistant coach before returning to the Treasure State as a high school coach and administrator for the remainder of his career. Dorsett Graves left the Bobcats after the 1921 season to become an assistant football coach and head baseball coach at Washington.

● In 1914 Montana State hired Fred Bennion as its head coach and director of athletics. Bennion had coached previously at Utah and BYU, and by all accounts was drawn to Bozeman by the opportunity to study and work in agriculture while coaching. From that point on, only these men coached the Cats without previous head coaching

experience at any level: Schubert Dyche (1928-35, 1938-41), Jack Croft (1936-37), Tom Parac (1968-70), Cliff Hysell (1992-99), and Brent Vigen (2021-).

● Brent Vigen officially became Montana State's 33rd head football coach when he led the Cats onto the field at Laramie. That game marked the first time a Bobcat coach made his debut against a school he once coached. Six other Bobcat head coaches faced former employers during their careers at MSU:
