PLAYER TO WATCH

#15 Cameron Holden
Junior Forward
Forsyth, Ga.

Holden dazzled on Thursday against Eastern Kentucky, coming away with 13 points, a career-best 18 rebounds, a game-high six assists and four steals. It marked his sixth double-double of the 2020-21 campaign - all of which have occurred in Ohio Valley Conference action.

The 6-5, 200-pound junior is making a push for All-OVC honors in his debut season. He ranks in the top-10 in the league in scoring (14.5 points per game), rebounding (9.0 per game) and steals (1.9 per game) in OVC play.



SETTING THE STAGE

Fans can catch their final glimpse of the 2020-21 version of the University of Tennessee at Martin men's basketball squad in the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center as the Skyhawks host Morehead State in its home finale.

The Ohio Valley Conference matchup also serves as Senior Day for UT Martin as the Skyhawks will honor center Hannes Polla for his career contributions. Hailing from Lahti, Finland, Polla is a two-year member of the UT Martin program, seeing playing time in 34 games after transferring in from the University of Oklahoma. He has made 17 starts as a Skyhawk, including all but three of his games played during the 2020-21 season.

UT Martin is coming off an 89-72 setback to Eastern Kentucky on Thursday. In that game, the Skyhawks fell for the first time all season when leading or tied at the halftime break (40-37, was previously 6-0). Cameron Holden (13 points, career-best 18 rebounds, game-highs of six assists and four steals) led UT Martin while Anthony Thomas secured a team-high 16 points.

The Skyhawks will look to avenge a 76-44 loss at Morehead State on Jan. 23. UT Martin led for 7:34 during the first half but could not overcome a season-low .298 field goal percentage (17-of-57).

Defense has been the calling card for the Eagles all season as they rank atop the OVC in scoring defense (61.1 points per game), field goal percentage defense (.395), three-point field goal percentage defense (.290), blocked shots (4.9 per contest) and rebounding margin (+7.8) in league play.

Morehead State saw its 12-game winning streak snapped last Saturday at Belmont in a matchup of the league's top two teams in the standings. Seven-time OVC Freshman of the Week Johni Broome (11 points and 13 rebounds) recorded his eighth double-double of the year while Ta'lon Cooper added a team-best 16 points.

HOLDEN WINS OVC NEWCOMER AWARD

On Feb. 15, Cameron Holden nabbed the OVC Newcomer of the Week award for the first time this season. The 6-5 junior forward averaged 12.3 points, 9.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists over three contests, including a 19-point, 14-rebound effort against Murray State on Feb. 13.

CLOSE CALLS? NO PROBLEM

UT Martin is a perfect 5-0 this season in games that are decided by single digits, four of which have come in OVC play (at Southeast Missouri, home games against Southeast Missouri, Tennessee Tech and Austin Peay).

SAME OPPONENT BACK-TO-BACK

Because of a scheduling quirk caused by the postponement of an originally scheduled Jan. 14 game, the Skyhawks played Austin Peay on back-to-back games in the span of four days (at UT Martin on Feb. 9, in Clarksville on Feb. 11).

That marked just the fourth time in school history that the Skyhawks faced the same OVC rival in two straight games. In each instance, the first game took place in the regular season finale while the second contest was in the OVC Tournament.

The other instances were against Murray State (won 83-76 on Feb. 25, 2017; won 73-67 on March 3, 2017), Murray State (lost 81-63 on Feb. 25, 2006; lost 65-52 on Feb. 28, 2006) and Tennessee Tech (lost 66-59 on Feb. 24, 2001; lost 69-58 on Feb. 27, 2001).

KENNEDY THE HERO AGAINST APSU

Ajani Kennedy helped carry the Skyhawks to a 76-75 triumph over Austin Peay on Feb. 8. The redshirt junior went off for a career-best 22 points while hauling in a team-high six rebounds.

Kennedy's spectacular performance was capped off with a step-back three-pointer just before time expired. With 2.3 seconds remaining in regulation and UT Martin trailing by two points, Kenton Eskridge lobbed an inbound pass to Cameron Holden, who spun and flung a pass in mid-air to Kennedy at the top of the key. Kennedy calmly knocked down the three-pointer just moments before the final horn sounded as the Elam Center crowd erupted in a frenzy.

FIRST WIN WHILE TRAILING AT HALF

The Skyhawks' 66-64 triumph over Tennessee Tech on Feb. 6 was the first time this season that UT Martin scored a victory while trailing at halftime (41-40, was previously 0-11).

HISTORICAL DEFENSE AGAINST EIU

UT Martin's 41 points allowed against Eastern Illinois on Jan. 28 are the fewest by any Skyhawk team against a NCAA Division I opponent in school history. The Skyhawks held Eastern Illinois to 28.1 percent shooting (16-of-57), including a 3-for-24 effort (12.5 percent) from three-point range.

The 28.1 percent defensive field goal percentage was the best for a UT Martin team against a Division I squad since holding Southeast Missouri to 27.5 percent shooting (14-of-51) in a 66-55 road win on Feb. 4, 2006 - a span of 465 games.

LONGEST HOMESTAND IN 34 YEARS

Due to COVID-19 postponements and rescheduled contests, the schedule aligned for the Skyhawks to play six straight games inside the Elam Center in the span of 14 days (Jan. 26 through Feb. 8).

That lengthy stretch marked the longest homestand in the school's Division I Era

(since 1992) and is the longest since six straight home games from Dec. 10, 1987 through Jan. 4, 1988.

UT Martin found success during its homestand, snapping a nine-game losing streak with four victories in six tries in front of the home crowd.

BRINGING OUT THE BROOMS

By virtue of a 69-66 home victory over Southeast Missouri on Jan. 26, UT Martin swept the season series against the Redhawks for the first time since the 2008-09 season. The Skyhawks had previously defeated Southeast Missouri by a 69-67 margin in Cape Girardeau on Dec. 18.

PLAYING SHORTHANDED

In what has become the "new normal" in the world of COVID-19 testing protocols and contact tracing, only three players (Jaron Williams, Ajani Kennedy, Kenton Eskridge) have played in all 21 games so far in 2020-21.

HOLDEN'S HISTORICAL FEATS

Cameron Holden became the first player in UT Martin history to pile up a double-double in his first two Ohio Valley Conference games. He tallied 24 points and 10 rebounds at Southeast Missouri on

REMEMBERING ANTHONY STEWART

The college basketball world was stunned to hear of the passing of Skyhawk head coach Anthony Stewart on Nov. 15. He was just 50 years old and was set for his fifth season as head coach at UT Martin.

Stewart joined the Skyhawks in 2014 as the associate head coach under Heath Schroyer before being promoted as the program's 10th head coach.

Stewart guided the Skyhawks to 22 victories in his debut season (2016-17), equaling the school record for most wins in a single season. As a result, he was named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

In memory of Coach Stewart, UT Martin will leave an empty suit jacket on the first seat of the bench at all games and will have a decal on the floor at home games this season.





UT MARTIN SKYHAWKS QUICK HITS

Dec. 18 before hauling in 23 points and 11 rebounds at Jacksonville State on Dec. 30.

Nearly a month later, Holden went off for 20 points and a career-best 16 rebounds against Murray State. His 11 offensive rebounds are the third-most in an NCAA Division I game this season.

Holden's six double-doubles in OVC play rank second to only Terry Taylor (14) from Austin Peay.

THOMAS JOINING RARE COMPANY

By earning a start in the Dec. 2 triumph against Evansville, Anthony Thomas became the first UT Martin true freshman to start in a season opener since future All-OVC honoree Javier Martinez accomplished that feat on Nov. 8, 2013 at Wyoming.

Thomas made more history on Dec. 22 as he tied a team-high with 7 points at Ole Miss. He became the first freshman to lead UT Martin in scoring since Parrish Hewitt (16 points) accomplished the feat at Eastern Illinois on Jan. 18, 2018.

Once again, Thomas joined elite company on Jan. 9 after he tossed in 21 points at Belmont. It marked the first time a Skyhawk freshman scored at least 20 points against an OVC opponent since UT Martin's all-time leading scorer Myles Taylor scored 24 points against Eastern Illinois on Feb. 11, 2012 (a span of 269 games).

Three weeks later against SIUE, Thomas collected a career-high 24 points on 9-of-14

shooting (including a trio of three-pointers).

3-0 FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1989-90

UT Martin was 3-0 to start a season for the first time since the 1989-90 campaign, three years before it joined the NCAA Division I ranks. The Skyhawks were one of the final 33 Division I teams to stay unbeaten before a Dec. 20 loss to Western Illinois.

BASKETBALL ACTIVITIES PAUSED

On Dec. 4, UT Martin's men's basketball activities were paused due to NCAA and OVC COVID-19 testing protocols.

As a result, four Skyhawk games were altered. UT Martin cancelled its Dec. 5 game at No. 5 Illinois and its Dec. 9 contest at No. 13 Tennessee. The Skyhawks postponed a matchup against Bethel (originally scheduled for Dec. 7, rescheduled for Dec. 15) and their original OVC opener against Southeast Missouri (originally scheduled for Dec. 12, makeup date was Jan. 26).

HOLDEN GETS TO THE STRIPE VS. BU

Cameron Holden pumped in a game-high 21 points in only 21 minutes off the bench against Bethel, including a 15-of-17 performance from the free throw line.

Holden's 15 makes were just two shy of the school record set by Mitch Stentiford against Southeast Missouri on Jan. 3, 1984 and were the most for any Skyhawk since Benzor Simmons converted 16 free throws

at SIUE on Jan. 24, 2011.

SKYHAWKS OUTLAST EVANSVILLE

The thrilling 93-87 triumph over Evansville in the Dec. 2 season opener marked the first double overtime game for the Skyhawks since Jan. 19, 2017, an 82-71 victory against Eastern Illinois.

SKYHAWKS FROM EVERYWHERE

The Skyhawk coaching staff searched far and wide to compile the 2020-21 roster, which includes four returners (including a redshirt transfer) and 11 newcomers.

UT Martin's 15-man roster includes players from 14 different states/countries: Alabama, Arizona, Bosnia and Herzegovina, California, Finland, Georgia, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, New Jersey, South Carolina and Virginia.

RETURNING DIVISION I EXPERIENCE

UT Martin's four returners (Ajani Kennedy, Hannes Polla, Eric Rustin, Eman Sertovic) combined for only three playing seasons in a Skyhawk uniform.

However, Kennedy (two seasons at UC Riverside) and Polla (two seasons at Oklahoma) boasted additional years of Division I experience outside of UT Martin.

Also, newcomer Kenton Eskridge played his freshman season at Southern Utah, a Division I member of the Big Sky Conference.

INTERIM HEAD COACH MONTEZ ROBINSON



Montez Robinson, who won Southwestern Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors in 2016-17, was named the University of Tennessee at Martin's interim head coach on Nov. 17. He was originally hired as an assistant coach in September before being elevated to interim head coach two days after the sudden passing of Anthony Stewart.

Robinson comes to the Skyhawks as an assistant after a successful five-year stint as head coach at Alcorn State University. Taking over a program that was under NCAA sanctions for low Academic Progress Rate scores, the Fairfield, Ala. native improved the Braves program by nine victories in both overall and conference play in his debut season. Alcorn State finished second in the SWAC standings in 2015-16 after the team he inherited finished ninth during the previous season. Robinson additionally improved the program's academic standards as his recruiting classes averaged a 2.97 Grade Point Average during his tenure.

All in all, Robinson compiled a .556 winning percentage in league games with the Braves, including back-to-back second-place finishes (13-5 in 2015-16 and 2016-17). His first two seasons marked the first time that Alcorn State dialed up consecutive winning seasons in league play in 15 years. Last season, the Braves were predicted to finish ninth in the SWAC preseason standings but placed fourth with an 11-7 mark. Alcorn State received an invitation to play in the 2020

CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) and shattered the school record for single-season free throw percentage (.744) and three-point field goals made (268) in the process.

Robinson's best season occurred in 2016-17, when he guided the Braves to the SWAC Tournament championship game. He became the first Alcorn State representative to win SWAC Coach of the Year accolades since 2002 and was also crowned as the NABC All-District 23 Co-Coach of the Year. The Braves boasted an 11-game winning streak down the stretch, which was the fifth-longest streak in the nation and fourth-longest in school history. Robinson mentored HBCU All-Americans Marquis Vance and Reginal Johnson on their way to All-SWAC honors, marking the first time that Alcorn State garnered a pair of all-conference selections since 1998-99.

Robinson's impressive turnaround of the Braves program received national attention. He was a two-time finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award (following the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons) and was also a finalist for the 2016 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award.

Before his first head coaching gig at Alcorn State, Robinson was an assistant coach at Bethune-Cookman University for four seasons (2011-15) under Gravelle Craig. During Robinson's time in Daytona Beach, Fla., Robinson helped the Wildcats advance to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Tournament championship contest in 2012 and quarterfinal appearances on two other occasions. He worked closely with Bethune-Cookman's post players, including All-MEAC Tournament honoree Anthony Breeze.

Robinson was also a major factor in Kennesaw State University's transition from Division II to Division I. As an assistant for head coach Tony Ingle from 2005-11, Robinson aided the Owls in becoming one of the fastest-growing Division I men's basketball programs in the nation. Kennesaw State advanced to the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament semifinals in their first season of



reclassification and won more games than any other NCAA reclassifying institution during a four-year period, eventually ranking in the top-5 in the mid-major polls. As the lead recruiting liaison, Robinson coached one conference Freshman of the Year, five all-conference players and seven players who went on to play professionally.

Robinson began his coaching career at Truett-McConnell College in Cleveland, Ga., where he was associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for three seasons (2002-05) under head coach Allen Sharpe. Robinson was part of yet another impressive turnaround with the Bears, as the program improved from an eight-win season to 24 victories (with just three scholarship student-athletes) during Robinson's first year. Robinson was part of a TMC squad who set the single-season school record for wins while mentoring eight All-Georgia Athletic Conference honorees and four players who played professionally following graduation.

A proud member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches, Robinson is married to the former Leah Hornbuckle. The couple has two children: a daughter, Tezlyn; and a son, Montez, Jr. After playing two seasons at Kemper Military Junior College in Boonville, Mo., Robinson finished out his playing career as co-captain of the men's basketball squad at North Georgia College and State University. He graduated in 2002 with a degree in criminal justice and later obtained his Master's degree in transformative leadership from Bethune-Cookman in 2014.

UT MARTIN OUTLASTS EVANSVILLE IN EMOTIONAL 93-87 DOUBLE OVERTIME SEASON-OPENING WIN

UT Martin's season opener took 50 minutes to decide a victor as the Skyhawks made all the right plays down the stretch during a 93-87 double overtime triumph over Evansville at the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center.

UT Martin led for 43:47 of game time – opening up a lead as large as 14 points in the first half – before a late surge by the Purple Aces at the end of regulation. Eden Holt – who tossed in a game-high 24 points in his Skyhawk debut – knocked down a three-pointer from the right wing with one second remaining in the second half to force overtime.

In the two overtime periods, UT Martin shot 57.1 percent (4-of-7) while doing most of its damage at the charity stripe – sinking 15 of its 19 free throw attempts down the stretch.

Holt's 24 points came on 6-of-9 shooting (including 3-of-4 from beyond the three-point arc) and a 9-for-10 performance from the free throw line. Cameron Holden registered 16 points, a team-best eight rebounds and two blocks off the bench while Jaron Williams (11 points, five rebounds, three assists, three steals) and Eman Sertovic (10 points) also scored in double figures for the Skyhawks.

Evansville was led by Noah Frederking's 22 points while Jax Levitch compiled a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Shamar Givance and Thomasi Gilgeous-Alexander added 17 and 11 points, respectively.

Murray State took the win after Tevin Brown collected a game-high 25 points. KJ Williams (15 points, 16 rebounds), Chico Carter, Jr. (17 points) and Demond Robinson (10 points) also led the way for the Racers.

Reigning Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week Cameron Holden generated 13 points, a career-best 18 rebounds, six assists and four steals for the Skyhawks, who saw seven players score at least seven points. Anthony Thomas scored a team-high 16 points while Ajani Kennedy's 11 points rounded out UT Martin's double-digit scorers. Eman Sertovic (nine points), Vinnie Viana (eight), Jaron Williams (seven) and Kenton Eskridge (seven) also provided scoring punch for UT Martin.

Eastern Kentucky placed four scorers in double digits in the scoring column, topped by Tre King's 24 points. Wendell Green, Jr. tossed in 17 points while Curt Lewis (13) and Cooper Robb (10) additionally chipped in significant scoring performances for the Colonels.
