### OPENING DRIVE

- Northwestern State makes its fall 2021 Turpin Stadium debut, marking the latest home opener for the Demons since Sept. 19, 2009, against North Dakota.
- The Demons are 1-2 in home openers under head coach Brad Laird, defeating Grambling (2018) and falling to Midwestern State (2019) and Nicholls (spring 2021).
- Northwestern State wraps up its non-conference slate tonight, facing yet another less-than-familiar opponent. Including its first two games of the 2021 fall season, the Demons have faced their non-Southland foes a total of 13 times in program history.
- The Demons are 6-4 all-time against current Ohio Valley Conference members, having faced Tennessee Tech (2-0), Murray State (2-0), UT Martin (1-2) and Eastern Illinois (1-2).

The first three seasons of **Brad Laird's** tenure as the head coach at his alma mater have produced record-setting offenses, turnover-happy defenses and arguably the most challenging set of circumstances faced by a Northwestern State football team.

As Laird enters his fourth season at the helm of the Demon football program, he is ready to build on the promise shown in an abbreviated spring 2021 season.

In each of Laird's first three seasons, the Demon offense has rewritten the school passing record book, including seeing Shelton Eppler overwrite Laird's career passing yardage mark of 6,037 yards which stood since 1995.

Despite playing just six games during the 2021 spring season, the Demons saw quarterback Bryce Rivers become the first Demon to surpass 400 yards passing in a game more than once, doing so in each of the final two games.

Individual honors have found their way to Natchitoches as NSU has produced three All-Americans, a pair of HERO Sports Sophomore All-Americans and two Freshman All-Americans under Laird.

Away from the field, offensive lineman Chris Zirkle, who was a Campbell Trophy semifinalist, a nominee for the American Football Coaches Association Allstate Good Works Team and a semifinalist for the Doris Robinson Award in 2019.

Laird's first Northwestern State team in 2018 posted a one-win improvement from the 2017 season, but the feel around the program was one of effective nostalgia.

There was a record-setting offense that would have made Laird the quarterback smile. Making Laird equally happy were the strides the NSU defense made in his first season as the head coach.

A three-time defensive coordinator for a total of eight seasons at Northwestern State, Laird saw the Purple Swarm regain that moniker in 2018, collecting 32 sacks (its highest total since 2002) and forcing 26 turnovers. The Demons forced another 24 turnovers in 2019. Counting the 2017 season when Laird was the defensive coordinator, the Demons enter 2020 having forced 67 turnovers in their past 34 games.

From 2013-16, Laird was in charge at his high school alma mater, Ruston, where he averaged more than seven wins in four playoff seasons as head coach.

In 2017, Laird restored the "Purple Swarm" brand for the NSU defense, which had struggled in the past two seasons but showed flashes of brilliance, especially down the stretch. In the final month of the season, the Demons twice recorded 13 tackles for loss in wins over Houston Baptist and Abilene Christian, and staged a series of goal-line stands, two in the season-ending victory over Stephen F. Austin.

**NOTABLE**

**Shifted schedule = longer run at home**

A Hurricane Ida-induced schedule change virtually flipped the makeup of Northwestern State's 2021 schedule.

The damage Ida did to Southeastern's Strawberry Stadium forced the Lions and Demons to postpone their originally scheduled Sept. 25 game to Nov. 13.

The change means Northwestern State starts a run of four home dates in five games tonight against UT Martin.

Instead of opening the season with three of four games on the road, the Demons now will finish the season that way, facing Nicholls (Oct. 30) Southeastern (Nov. 13) and McNeese (Nov. 20) on the road around a Nov. 6 home date against Houston Baptist.

**Demons have different look for UT Martin**

It has been barely two years since Northwestern State made the trip to Martin, Tennessee, to open the 2019 season against UT Martin.

Despite the COVID-19 pandemic that awarded an extra year of eligibility to numerous student-athletes, the Demons' roster looks much different than it did on Aug. 29, 2019.

Just five of the Demons' 22 starters from that Thursday night in western Tennessee remain — tight end **David Fitzwater**, linebackers **Jomard Valsin**, **Kyle Moore** and **Adrian Robertson** and cornerback **William Hooper**.

All five Demons were making their first career starts in that game.

**Bartholomew extends lengthy INT streak**

When he has been healthy, junior cornerback **Shemar Bartholomew** has been a magnet for opposing quarterbacks.

That has not always been the best plan of attack, especially dating to the 2019 season.

Starting with a Nov. 16, 2019, matchup at Sam Houston, Bartholomew has appeared in four

games.

In all four of those games, the New Orleans native has recorded at least one interception, snaring a total of five picks in that time.

Bartholomew extended his run with a diving interception on the first play of the second half of the season opener at North Texas on Sept. 4.

For his career, Bartholomew has eight interceptions, which ranks him in a tie for 10th among all active FCS players in career picks.

Bartholomew missed the Demons' Sept. 11 loss against Alcorn with an injury, so his streak remains intact entering tonight's game.

**Price is right for big-play TD grabs**

Senior wide receiver **Kendrick Price's** 65-yard touchdown reception against North Texas in the season opener continued a trend for the big-bodied receiver.

The catch-and-run score, which included a broken tackle at the point of the reception, was Price's second career score that covered at least 65 yards.

In 2019, Price had a 67-yard score that jump-started the Demons' 31-28 win at Sam Houston.

Price's eight career touchdown catches have covered an average of 26.6 yards. A Lindale, Texas, product, Price needs two touchdown catches to move into a ninth-place tie on the Demon career list.

**Demons' eye explosive return**

The Northwestern State offense lived up to its billing as a big-play machine in Week 1 against North Texas, posting nine explosive plays (rushes of 12 or more yards, passes of 18 or more).

However, the Demons suffered a dropoff against Alcorn in Week 2, notching just three such plays.

The three explosive plays were Northwestern State's fewest in a game since posting one against Midwestern State on Sept. 7, 2019.

**Valsin at home in opponents' backfield**

A key factor in junior linebacker **Jomard Valsin** earning second-team All-American honors from the American Football Coaches Association this past spring was his ability to make plays behind the line of scrimmage.

Valsin led Northwestern State with eight tackles for loss in the six-game spring season, collecting at least a half-tackle for loss in all six games.

Valsin has picked up a half-tackle for loss in each of Northwestern State's first two games this fall, running his streak of games with a tackle for loss to 15.

The last time Valsin did not post a TFL came Sept. 21, 2019, at Houston Baptist.

**Landry productive no matter the number**

Senior wide receiver **Gavin Landry's** journey from walk-on to team captain has been well documented in words.

It could just have easily been done by the number on his back.

In the 2017 and 2018 seasons, Landry wore No. 42 while playing primarily special teams.

As a junior in 2019, Landry entered the wide receiver rotation wearing No. 84.

For his sixth and final season at Northwestern State, Landry made the decision to change his number to 0. However, Northwestern State's new jerseys did not arrive in time for either of the Demons' first two games, forcing Landry to wear yet another number in road games at North Texas and Alcorn.

Donning No. 11, Landry had two catches against the Mean Green and added another at Alcorn.

Landry should finally wear his newest number (0) against UT Martin tonight.

**Adams tops 100 (total) yards again**

Junior running back **Scooter Adams** did not post a 100-yard rushing game in the season opener at North Texas, but he eclipsed the centry mark in total yards for the fourth time in seven career games as a Demon.

Adams rushed for 88 yards and added 32 more on six catches, producing 120 yards and a touchdown.

It marked the fourth time in his seven games in an NSU uniform that Adams topped 100 total yards, but it was the first time Adams did so without rushing for at least 100 yards.

**NSU run game flashes depth in opener**

Preseason first-team All-Southland Conference running back **Scooter Adams** garners most of the headlines centered around Northwestern State's run game.

While Adams led NSU with 88 rushing yards in the season opener at North Texas, he was far from the only productive Demon to carry the ball against North Texas.

Playing without **Aubrey Scott**, Northwestern State had seven different players credited with a rush against the Mean Green.

Of those, five produced at least one carry of double-figure yardage. **Bryce Dealey** (22), **Zachary Clement** (14), **Trevor Morgan** (12) and **Curtis Williams** (12) all had the longest rush of their Demon careers.

Adams added a 36-yard touchdown run for good measure.

Williams established career highs in carries (8) and yards (39) while Dealey ran for 29 yards in his NSU debut.

Also debuting and picking up 24 yards on nine carries was Southern Miss grad transfer **Kevin Perkins**.

From the coaching staff to the roster, the 2021 Northwestern State football team has deep ties to Trinity Valley Community College.

### King, Griffin next in WR transfer line

Since **Jazz Ferguson's** breakout 2018 All-American season in which he was named Southland Conference and All-Louisiana Offensive Player of the Year, Northwestern State has become an epicenter of successful transfer receivers.

Ferguson, an LSU transfer, was joined in 2018 by Texas Tech transfer **Quan Shorts**, who established the school single-season reception record in 2019 with 100 catches en route to earning third-team All-American honors.

This offseason, the Demons welcomed a pair of FBS transfer wideouts who look to extend that streak of production.

Senior **Jay Griffin IV** came to NSU from New Mexico and will double as a track sprinter for the Demons in the spring.

Griffin caught a pass for 43 yards and returned a kickoff for 25 yards against North Texas in his NSU debut.

King was active for the opener but did not play after exiting COVID-19 quarantine late in the week of the season opener. King snared a pair of passes for 14 yards in his Demon debut at Alcorn on Sept. 11.

Northwestern State has produced eight NFL Pro Bowlers: WR Charlie Hennigan (5x, Oilers); TE Jackie Smith (5x, Cardinals); WR Mark Duper (3x, Dolphins); FB Charlie Tolar (2x, Oilers); RB Joe Delaney (1981, Chiefs); RB John Stephens (1988, Patriots); QB Bobby Hebert (1993, Falcons); KR Terrence McGee (2004, Bills).

Thirty-four Demons have been drafted, including seven since 2000. RB John Stephens (1988, Patriots) is the Demons' lone first-round pick while six former Demons have been second-round selections: RB Sidney Thornton (1976, Steelers); OL Petey Perot (1979, Eagles); RB Joe Delaney (1981, Chiefs); WR Mark Duper (1982, Dolphins); CB Adrian Hardy (1993, 49ers); OT Marcus Spears (1994, Bears).

### Ireland adds to NSU's Hall of Fame legacy

Longtime Northwestern State sports information director Doug Ireland joined the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame in August as one of three Louisiana Sports Writers Association's Distinguished Service Award in Journalism honorees.

Ireland, who also serves as the chairman of the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame, was inducted into the state's sports shrine on Aug. 28, a few blocks from Northwestern State's campus.

He was joined in the induction class by fellow NSU graduate Villis "Bo" Dowden, the 1980 Bassmaster Classic champion.

Ireland was honored ahead of the 2019 season by Northwestern State, which renamed the fifth floor of the Turpin Stadium press box the "Doug Ireland Media Level."

**Lucas stays in professor mode on sideline**

At one end of the team area of the Northwestern State sideline is a smattering of chairs arranged like a small classroom.

That's where professor **Mike Lucas** holds class for his defense between series. It is a Lucas tradition that dates to 1985 when he began doing so as a defensive coordinator at Eastern New Mexico.

Lucas said he likes to utilize the classroom setting to discuss adjustments in a learning environment.

**Turnovers tell tale of Lucas' tenure**

In four seasons under defensive coordinator **Mike Lucas**, the Purple Swarm has created 89 turnovers in 42 games.

The Demons have produced 44 turnovers in their 15 wins with Lucas as defensive coordinator while forcing 47 turnovers in their 28 losses.

The Demons had a pair of interceptions in a season-opening loss at North Texas on Sept. 4.

**Demons deep at scholar athlete**

According to the National Football Foundation, 3,284 college football players enter the 2021 season having already earned their undergraduate degrees.

Northwestern State contributed to that list as **David Fitzwater, Gavin Landry, Kendrick Price, Mark Salazar, Donovan Duvernay, Ja'Quay Pough, Brandon Floyd, Khalil Corbett-Canada** and **Darius Whitfield** already have earned their degrees.

**NSU nickname stands alone**

Northwestern State may share a piece of its name with the Big Ten's Northwestern University, but another part of NSU's identity is its alone.

Northwestern State's use of Demons is unique among NCAA Division I football teams.

**Landry, Price hoping for super 6th (year)**

Senior wide receivers **Kendrick Price** and **Gavin Landry** appear dissimilar to the naked eye, but the pair share plenty of similarities.

In addition to both being in their sixth year with the NSU program, Price and Landry both have overcome torn ACLs suffered within a few months of each other.

Landry suffered his injury Oct. 19, 2019, while Price was hurt during spring practice in 2020.

Both worked their way back and played in all

**Coaching staff has new look**

For the first three seasons of the Brad Laird era in Natchitoches, the Demon coaching staff remained largely unchanged.

That is not the case entering the fall 2021 season.

Today's game against North Texas marks the Northwestern State debut for a quartet of assistant coaches — **Rashad Jackson** (special teams coordinator/wide receivers), **Joey Fitzgerald** (quarterbacks), **Josh Jones** (safeties) and **Kevon Beckwith** (defensive line).

**Senior LB Pough goes "Hollywood"**

Senior linebacker **Ja'Quay Pough** has a simple request for radio and television announcers — to call him Hollywood.

Pough's reasoning? "This season is going to be

a movie."

While Pough has not done any acting, he has performed admirably on the field. In 16 career games as a Demon, the Texas Tech transfer has collected 136 tackles (six for loss), three sacks, three forced fumbles and a pass breakup.

Pough posted the fifth double-figure tackle game of his career at Alcorn on Sept. 11, finishing with 12 stops and a sack.

Pough's Hollywood nickname is among the list of Demon monikers found on Page 10.

**Demons go 3-for-3 in POY hunt**

When linebacker **Adrion Robertson** signed with Northwestern State after earning Defensive Player of the Year honors in the Southwest Junior College Football Conference, he likely had no idea the pipeline he had started.

Following Robertson, who won the award at Kilgore College in 2018, the Demons landed a pair of Trinity Valley Community College linebackers who also picked up the award in **Race Moser** (2019) and **Jaeden Ward** (2020).

**Two Cowboys morph into Demons**

Northwestern State and McNeese are heated Southland Conference rivals, but that did not stop a pair of Cowboys from transferring to Demonland.

Tight end **Jacob Logan** is in his second season with the Demons after transferring from McNeese in the summer of 2020. He was joined on the roster this fall by defensive tackle **Steven Conerly**, who transferred to Natchitoches in the summer of 2021.

**Fletcher extends two-year QB streak**

By taking the opening snap at North Texas on Sept. 4, **Kaleb Fletcher** became a two-time opening-day starting quarterback for the Demons — something that has become somewhat normal at NSU.

With his start against the Mean Green, Fletcher joined **Zach Adkins** (2013-14) and **Shelton Eppler** (2018-19) as Demon QBs who have started multiple season openers in the past decade.

**NSU well represented on preseason All-SLC**

Although Northwestern State was predicted to finish fifth in the new-look, six-team Southland Conference, the Demons produced more than their share of preseason All-Southland Conference selections.

Running back **Scooter Adams** and second-team All-American linebacker **Jomard Valsin** earned first-team acclaim.

A pair of linemen — tackle **Khalil Corbett-Canada** and center **Jakob Sell** — were second-team selections as was punter **Scotty Roblow**.

The Demons flooded the preseason second-team defense, placing linebacker **Ja'Quay Pough**, safety **PJ Herrington**, cornerback **William Hooper** and kick returner **Donovan Duvernay** on that squad.

**Duvernay, Sell back in same locker room**

Offensive lineman **Jakob Sell** is one of the eight Demons who played junior college football at Trinity Valley Community College in Athens, Texas.

While connected to the numerous former Cardinals on the NSU roster, Sell is tied to another Demon from a past school.

Sell and safety/return specialist **Donovan Duvernay** were teammates at the University of Texas in 2018 where their lockers sat next to one another.

DENTON, Texas – There were plenty of big plays and turnovers in Northwestern State’s season-opening football game at North Texas on Saturday night.

Unfortunately for the Demons, they had too many of one and not enough of the other.

Mean Green running back DeAndre Torrey rushed for a career-high 244 yards and three touchdowns and the Demons turned the ball over four times, allowing North Texas to pull away for a 44-14 victory at Apogee Stadium.

“It’s frustrating when you look at the scoreboard at the end of the game,” fourth-year head coach Brad Laird said. “The thing I told the guys, you look at the second half, coming out of the half, we get the interception, and we have the touchdown to Jay (Griffin) that gets called back. Those are things, when you’re playing games like this, you can’t have.”

The Demons (0-1) matched the Mean Green punch for punch for most of the first half, thanks to a pair of big plays on offense and an opportunistic defense.

Down 7-0 after Torrey’s first touchdown – a 24-yard run – Northwestern State answered with its first big play. Kaleb Fletcher hit Kendrick Price on a slant route, and Price broke through a one-on-one tackle, turning it into a 65-yard touchdown.

“That definitely put a spark in the team,” said running back Scooter Adams, who ran for 92 yards on 12 carries and added 36 yards on a team-high seven catches. “That gave us some momentum. We’ve got to keep getting more explosive plays like that.”

Adams had the Demons’ other big offensive play in the first half.

Trailing 17-7, Adams took a second-down carry through a gaping hole 36 yards for his first touchdown of the season, cutting the NSU deficit to a field goal.

Adams’ score was set up by a Cedric Anderson interception of Jace Ruder.

“That came off a free safety blitz,” said Anderson, who also broke up a pass in the end zone in the second half. “I have to give credit to (PJ) Herrington. He came in on the blitz and hit the quarterback.”

LORMAN, Mississippi – Time and again Northwestern State’s Purple Swarm defense bent but did not break Saturday night.

Then the north end of Spinks-Casem Stadium struck again.

Alcorn’s Felix Harper spun into that end zone on a 1-yard touchdown run with 4:11 to play, capping a Braves’ fourth-quarter rally that dropped Northwestern State, 13-10, in non-conference action.

“In that type of ball game – as well as we played defensively for four quarters – the opportunity they had – the one big play – puts you in a tough situation,” fourth-year head coach Brad Laird said. “Defensively, we played well. We played hard. We were able to get off the field. When you’re in those tight games, it’s often that one play.”

While Harper’s touchdown regained the lead for Alcorn (1-1), the one play the Demons (0-2) would like to have back came on third and 10 from the Braves 46.

Harper found Manny Jones for a field-flipping, 50-yard completion that gave Alcorn a first-and-goal at the NSU 4.

Even then, it took the Braves three cracks from the 4 before Harper twisted in for the go-ahead score.

“Last week, it’s on film – we had 28 missed tackles,” said senior linebacker Ja’Quay Pough, who finished with 12 tackles and a sack. “This game, we weren’t letting it happen again.”

The Purple Swarm limited Alcorn to 122 yards on 41 carries, an average of 3 yards per rush in a game where neither team found much running room.

NSU managed just 71 yards on 36 carries as Alcorn outgained the Demons, 326-293.

Still, Northwestern State made Kendrick Price’s early 18-yard touchdown catch from Kaleb Fletcher stand up.

Fletcher’s grab put the Demons up 7-3 with 49 seconds to play in the first quarter, but the Demons barely were able to put any additional distance between them and the Braves.

MARTIN, Tennessee – The Northwestern State football team got the fast start it was looking for in its season opener Thursday night.

The second half for the Demons did not play out the same.

UT Martin used a pair of non-offensive, second-half touchdowns to spoil a record-setting night for Northwestern State quarterback Shelton Eppler as the Skyhawks pulled away for a 42-20 victory at Hardy Graham Stadium.

“Give them credit, first and foremost,” second-year head coach Brad Laird said. “They came out and made plays in all three phases in the second half. We had some special teams miscues in the third quarter that gave them the momentum. We came back and had a chance to tie the score, and we had a fourth-down situation where they ended up with a defensive touchdown. You could see the momentum of the game change at that moment.”

That moment came with the Demons (0-1) trailing 28-20 with just more than 5 minutes to play.

Kaleb Fletcher rolled out on fourth and 2 and threw a pass that Wanya Moton jumped and returned 78 yards for a touchdown that put the Skyhawks (1-0) up 15 with 5:06 left.

The interception return for a score was one of four second-half touchdowns for UT Martin, all of which came from 21 or more yards. The final three scores, which came in the final 17:13 of the game, covered 55, 78 and 53 yards and occurred in all three phases of the game.

The chunk plays stood in contrast to a Northwestern State attack that ran 91 plays and outgained the Skyhawks, 483-309.

Eppler enjoyed a scintillating first half, setting in motion a night that saw him shatter school single-game records for completions (43) and attempts (62) while posting the second-highest single-game yardage total (387).

In the first half alone, Eppler was 28-for-36 for 285 yards and three touchdowns, two of which went to Quan Shorts, who established career highs in catches (12), yards (111) and touchdown receptions (2).

“The only thing that matters is we didn’t come away with the win,” Eppler said. “We’ll get back at it (Friday), fix what we need to fix and get ready for Week 2.”

The Demons’ passing game had to replace three of its top four receivers from a season ago but was efficient early. Eppler completed 23 of his first 27 passes, including a span of 10 straight in the second quarter, as the Demons built a 20-14 lead.

Special teams issues arose though as the Demons had an extra point bounce off the right upright after Eppler’s 26-yard touchdown pass to Corey Smallwood, who hauled in his first career score despite a Skyhawks defender being draped over him.

The missed extra point and a missed 35-yard field goal at the end of the first half – along with a 97-yard kickoff return touchdown that was

Northwestern State maintained that lead for much of the third quarter before a pair of Terry Williams’ punt returns swung the momentum to the Skyhawks.

Williams’ 41-yard punt return set up Peyton Logan’s 21-yard scoring run with 4:22 to play in the third that gave UT Martin a 21-20 lead.

Just more than two minutes later, Williams gathered a one-hop punt on the run and brought it back 55 yards for a touchdown.

Logan (13 carries, 149 yards) capped the scoring with a 53-yard run with 2:53 to play in the game.

“Our guys kept fighting,” Laird said. “We just couldn’t put things together in the fourth quarter.”
