ON DECK CIRCLE

- The University of Tennessee at Martin softball team heads south to the Ohio Valley Conference Softball Championship to be contested at Choccolocco Park in Oxford, Ala. this week beginning on Wednesday, May 11 through Saturday, May 14. Every game will be broadcast on ESPN+.

- The Skyhawks (31-17) will make their 24th appearance in the event since the OVC Softball Championship's conception in 1994 and while entering for the fifth time as the third seed. The Skyhawks have posted a 32-39 all-time mark in the tournament.

- UT Martin earned the third seed after finishing the regular season with a 17-8 record in OVC play. The Skyhawks picked up series sweeps against Eastern Illinois, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech while taking the season series against Austin Peay, Belmont and SIUE. The only series that the Skyhawks dropped were to top-seeded Murray State and Southeast Missouri.

- At the conclusion of the regular season, UT Martin sat atop the OVC leaderboards in three team categories including batting average (.308), slugging percentage (.451) and fielding percentage (.971).

- Five Skyhawks earned postseason awards with junior outfielder Shyanne Sheffield (.379, five doubles, three home runs, 28 RBIs) being named to the All-OVC first team while junior infielder Kallie Pickens (.349, 16 doubles, five home runs, 38 RBIs), sophomore outfielder Kaci Fuller (.386, five doubles, three home runs, 20 RBIs) and graduate outfielder Paige Clark (.321, seven doubles, three home runs, 21 RBIs, 24 steals) were named to the All-OVC second team. Former Bradley transfer Avry Blume (.287, five doubles, four home runs, 28 RBIs) rounded out the honorees after being tabbed to the All-Newcomer squad.

- The pitching duo of Alexis Groet and Erin Gallagher are primed for the postseason stage after strong regular seasons. Groet lead the team with a 13-7 record while posting a 2.27 ERA in 111.0 innings of work and limiting opponents to a .212 batting average. Gallagher was equally impressive with an 11-3 record with a 2.30 ERA in 106.1 innings. The duo combined for five shutouts on the season for a staff which posted the second-lowest team ERA in the league. Coming out of the bullpen is Katie Dreiling who set a UT Martin single season record with four saves while boasting a 2.94 ERA in 37.2 innings of work.



PLAYER TO WATCH

#11 • KALLIE PICKENS

Kallie Pickens posted a huge final weekend of the regular season to cap off a breakout 2022 campaign. On the same weekend that she graduated college, Pickens went 9-for-12 at the plate against Tennessee State with two doubles, a triple and three RBIs.

Pickens enters the OVC Championship as the team leader in extra base hits (23), doubles (16) and RBIs (38).

QUICK HITS



200 HITS AND COUNTING

• Graduate outfielder **Paige Clark** became just the fifth player in program history to tally 200 career hits with a base knock against Murray State earlier this season. With her career total currently sitting at 218, Clark sits in fourth place all-time and just two behind Carly Gonzales (220) for third place.

LEAGUE LEADERS

• At the end of the regular season, UT Martin sat atop the OVC leaderboards in three team categories including batting average (.308), slugging percentage (.451) and fielding percentage (.971).

PICKENS CHASING SCHOOL DOUBLE MARK

• Junior **Kallie Pickens** has been an extra base machine this season, leading the team by tallying 23 extra basehits while her 16 doubles are within striking distance of the program's single-season record of 18 setback back in 2015 by Carly Gonzales.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS

• The Skyhawks currently boast four of the program's top six offensive threats in terms of batting average in program history. **Shyanne Sheffield** narrowly leads the pack by sitting in first place with a .360 (111-300) career batting average while **Kaci Fuller** ranks second boasting a .368 (114-310) mark. Graduate outfielder **Paige Clark** boasts a .345 (218-639) career batting average which ranks fifth while **Kaitlyn Kelley** sits in sixth at a .340 (125-368) career mark.

RACE TO 100

• Graduate outfielder **Paige Clark** sits just six stolen bases away from becoming the second player in program history to eclipse 100 career stolen bases as she enters the championship with 94 career steals in 104 opportunities (90.3 percent). Clark only trails the program's all-time leader and Hall of Famer Leah Taylor with a mark of 110.

30 WIN PLATEAU

• With a win over Tennessee State in the series opener, UT Martin recorded its 30th win of the season. This marks the 13th season in the program's 37-year history that the Skyhawks have eclipsed 30 wins and the first time since 2017.

DREILING BREAKS SAVES RECORD

• Newcomer **Katie Dreiling** has filled many roles for the Skyhawks since transferring from Southeast Missouri following an OVC All-Newcomer selection in 2021. In her debut season she has appeared not only led the team with eight home runs but set a new program single-season saves record with four - all coming during league play. In total she has finished 17 games this season which sits just two behind the program single-season record of 19 held by Paj Lintz in 2007.

HOME SWEET HOME

• The Skyhawks enjoyed played in the friendly confines of Bettye Giles Field this season and turned it into a competitive advantage. UT Martin boasted an impressive 14-2 record at home this season - including an 10-2 mark against OVC foes and sweeps against Tennessee Tech and Eastern Illinois.

BACK-TO-BACK WINNING LEAGUE SEASONS

• UT Martin has put itself back in the conversation amongst the league's top programs after posting back-to-back seasons with a winning season following a 16-15 mark in 2021 while finishing 2022 with a 17-8 record. This marks the first time the Skyhawks has posted back-to-back winning seasons in OVC play since the 2016 and 2017 seasons.

OVC CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE

• When the Skyhawks take to the field at Choccolocco Park it will be the first OVC Softball Championship experience for most of the team. With UT Martin's last appearance in the event coming in 2019, the Skyhawks only feature four players who have previously played on the field including **Paige Clark** (three games), **Erin Gallagher** (one game), **Kallie Pickens** (one game) and transfer **Katie Dreiling** who played four games with Southeast Missouri last season before falling in the title game.

ON THE BASEPATHS

• While UT Martin has not put up the outrageous stolen base numbers of years past, the Skyhawks have been highly efficient when choosing to take their chance. This season, the Skyhawks have posted the highest stolen base percentage in program history by converting 95.7 percent (45-of-47) of their attempts. **Paige Clark** leads the team with 24 steals on the season while **Shyanne Sheffield** (seven) and **Kaci Fuller** (five) rank as the other team leaders.

GRADUATION DOUBLEHEADER

• Prior to the final series of the regular season against Tennessee State, the Skyhawk trio of **Emily Gilstrap**, **Kaitlyn Kelley** and **Kallie Pickens** walked across the stage at Saturday morning's UT Martin graduation at 10 a.m. before making the quick drive over to Nashville for a 4 p.m. first pitch. Pickens celebrated by going 9-for-12 for the weekend while tallying three extra base hits and three RBIs while Kelley chipped in five RBIs of her own.



KELLEY SITS AMONGST HR LEADERS

• Junior infielder **Kaitlyn Kelley** has ranked as one of the best power hitters in program history through the first 2+ seasons of her Skyhawk career. After setting a program single-season record with 17 home runs last season, Kelley currently sits seventh in program history with 24 career home runs. She needs just one more to move into a tie for sixth place with Megan Williams (25, 2007-10).

JUMPING OUT EARLY

• The Skyhawks have reaped the rewards of jumping out to an early lead this season and turning them into run. When UT Martin scores first, they are 22-4 on the season while boasting a 16-3 mark when putting a run on the board in the first inning.

GROET FIGHTING FOR PROGRAM MARKS

• Junior pitcher **Alexis Groet** has been impressive in her two seasons in a Skyhawk uniform and already ranks amongst some of the all-time leaders in program history. Entering the tournament, Groet possesses a career ERA of 1.79 which sits second in program history for the lowest ERA behind Nikki Stoddard's benchmark of 1.77.

• Groet also currently ranks as the program leader in lowest opponent batting average (.207) and most strikeouts per seven innings (6.54).

INJURIES TAKE THEIR TOLL

• UT Martin's depth has been stretched thin all season long. Before the season began, the Skyhawks found out that three players - Emily Alexander (outfielder), Kenna Garst (catcher) and Gracie Lusk (outfielder) would miss the 2022 campaign due to injuries. Then in the first OVC series of the year, Anna Hazlewood suffered a season-ending injury after starting starting the first 23 games and hitting .271 with five extra base hits.

SKYHAWK TRIO EARNS OVC MEDAL OF HONORS

• The trio of **Emily Brown** (nursing), **Paige Clark** (graduate school) and **Gracie Lusk** (political science) were three of 23 Skyhawk student-athletes to be recognized as an OVC Medal of Honor recipient for achieving a perfect 4.0 Grade Point Average in the 2020-21 academic year. Clark achieved her second Medal of Honor honor of her career after earning her bachelor's degree in health and human performance and while actively pursuing a master's degree in education.

OVC COMMISSIONER'S HONOR ROLL

• UT Martin saw 181 student-athletes achieve at least a 3.25 Grade Point Average during the 2020-21 academic year, earning a spot on the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll. Overall, 1,730 student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll. UT MARTIN GARNERS 14 EASTON/NFCA

ALL-AMERICA SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARDS

• UT Martin was rewarded for its academic excellence off the field as 12 returning players were named Easton/National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-America Scholar-Athletes. To be selected as an Easton/NFCA Scholar-Athlete, student-athletes must achieve a 3.5-or-better overall grade point average on a 4.0 scale for the school year.

Leading the way for the Skyhawks were standouts Emily Brown, Paige Clark and Gracie Lusk with perfect 4.0 GPAs. Also earning selections were Alexis Groet (3.66), Anna Blanton (3.59), Emily Alexander (3.76), Emily Gilstrap (3.73), Erin Gallagher (3.72), Kaci Fuller (3.65), Kaitlyn Kelley (3.525), Kallie Pickens (3.71) and Shyanne Sheffield (3.71).

SKYHAWK STUDENT-ATHLETES SET NEW RECORD WITH 3.31 GPA FOR FALL SEMESTER

• For the fourth straight semester, UT Martin student-athletes have shattered a record for Grade Point Average as the Skyhawks combined for a 3.31 GPA this past fall.

• Overall, 261 UT Martin student-athletes garnered Athletic Director's Honor Roll status for the Fall 2021 semester, recognizing those who compile at least a 3.0 GPA.

BRIAN DUNN

HEAD COACH • 3RD YEAR

Brian Dunn enters his third season at the helm of the UT Martin softball history after being named the fourth head coach in program history on June 11, 2019.

Dunn brings over 28 years of championship experience at both the high school and collegiate level including two state championships and four national titles. For his career, he has posted a 488-137 record in his collegiate career - including a 39-29 record at UT Martin.

In his second season overall and first full campaign in 2021, Dunn led the team to a 27-19 mark while going 16-15 for the program's first winning record in Ohio Valley Conference action since 2017. The Skyhawks posted several statistical highlights including a school record 8.65 hits per game while ranking in the top-five in single-season history in six other categories of slugging percentage (.462, second), batting average (.309, third), runs per game (5.13, third), team hits (398, fifth) and fielding percentage (.965, fifth).

Under his direction, the tandem of Alexis Groet and Kaci Fuller each earned NFCA All-Region honors while a total of five individuals garnered postseason OVC accolades. The Skyhawks had a pair of All-OVC first team selections in Groet and Kaitlyn Kelley while Fuller and Paige Clark earned a spot on the All-OVC second team. Four players were recognized on the OVC All-Newcomer squad as Fuller, Groet and Kelley were joined on the list by Shyanne Sheffield.

His debut season at UT Martin proved to be far from normal as the team played just 22 games before seeing the season come to an abrupt halt due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the shortened season, the Skyhawks posted a 12-10 record prior to the cancellation.

Heralded as the winningest softball coach in west Tennessee history, Dunn has compiled record of 1,155 wins and 313 losses in 34 varsity seasons at the high school and college level. He has posted 869 career victories in 26 seasons as a head softball coach while also adding 286 wins as a volleyball coach at both Union University and the University School of Jackson. As a whole, he has overseen 63 team championships.

Dunn's most recent coaching stop saw him turn USJ into a perennial state tournament threat since 2005 by accumulating a 344-102 record. During his tenure with the Bruins, the program won TSSAA state titles in 2010 and 2012, finished runner-up twice and claimed numerous district and region titles. His path to success was quick as he led the program to its first district championship in his fourth year before a state championship in his fifth season at the helm.

Prior to Dunn's illustrious career at USJ, he transformed Union University's softball program into a legitimate national title contender. He led the Lady Bulldogs softball program to a 449-108 record (.803 winning percentage) over a nine-year period. During his tenure, Union posted seven straight top-10 national rankings while earning six TranSouth Conference championships, four conference tournament championships and four NAIA Region XI championships. The Lady Bulldogs reached the pinnacle with three NCCAA National Championships and six NAIA World Series appearances, including a third-place finish in 2001 with a school record 63 wins.

In addition to coaching a top-ranked softball program, Dunn guided the Union volleyball program to a 243-62 record over its first seven seasons, including the inaugural season in 1998. Dunn led Union to three TranSouth regular season championships, two conference tournament championships and six straight NCCAA MidEast Region Titles while capturing the 2003 NCCAA National Volleyball Championship and finishing runner-up in 2001. In his final season, he led the team to the NAIA National Tournament with a top-10 NAIA finish.

During Dunn's eight-year tenure as a coach at Union, he coached 73 all-conference, 49 all-region, 28 All-American and 35 scholar-athlete award winners. Included in that list are 14 conference Players of the Year, nine region Players of the Year and two national Players of the Year. Individually, he claimed five NCCAA National Coach of the Year honors.

Dunn began his coaching career at Riverside High School where he led the Lady Panther softball team to their first-ever appearance in the TSSAA AA state tournament and a 64-25 record in three seasons.

Along with his numerous coaching achievements, Dunn has garnered 32 various Coach of the Year honors while being inducted into the Tennessee Softball Coaches Association Hall of Fame (2014), USJ Softball Hall of Fame (2016), Jackson Madison Country Sports Hall of Fame (2018) and Union University Sports Hall of Fame (2018).

Dunn is a 1989 graduate of San Diego State University, where he helped lead the baseball team to a Western Athletic Conference Championship and a top-25 national ranking. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in history before completing his master's in education in 1998 from Union.

Dunn is married to the former Emily Garrett, as the couple resides in Jackson. They have two daughters, Addison and Ashlee.

FIVE SKYHAWKS GARNER POSTSEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SOFTBALL HONORS



BRENTWOOD, Tenn. – Five University of Tennessee at Martin softball players were recognized for their impressive campaigns by garnering postseason recognitions from the Ohio Valley Conference. Junior outfielder Shyanne Sheffield was the lone Skyhawk named to the All-OVC first team while junior infielder Kallie Pickens was joined by the outfield duo of sophomore Kaci Fuller and graduate Paige Clark on the All-OVC second team. Meanwhile, redshirt-sophomore Avry Blume was tabbed to the All-Newcomer squad.

The Skyhawks four All-OVC selections ranked as the second-most all-conference selections by a team this season – trailing only league champion Murray State – as voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

A native of Tullahoma, Tenn., Sheffield improved upon her All-Newcomer selection in 2021 and elevated to the All-OVC first team after a dominant league campaign in which she posted the second-highest batting average (.486) and on base percentage (.531) in OVC-play. Overall, she posted a .379 batting average with 37 runs scored, 47 hits, five doubles, one triple, three home runs and 28 RBIs in a stellar year. In addition to drawing 15 walks and swiping all seven of her stolen base attempts, she posted a .447 on-base percentage while slugging .508. Additionally, she is currently riding both a 19-game on-base streak and a 15-game hitting streak into the OVC Softball Championship while tallying 14 multi-hit outings on the season.

Sheffield currently ranks in the top-10 in eight OVC-only statistical categories including batting average (.486, second), on-base percentage (.531, second), OPS (1.166, fourth), hits (36, fourth), RBIs (21, sixth), slugging percentage (.635, sixth), runs scored (21, seventh) and total bases (47, 10th).

Hailing from Jackson, Tenn., Pickens has used 2022 as a breakout campaign en route to All-OVC second team honors. The three-year starter at the hot corner has posted a .349 batting average with 32 runs scored, 53 hits, 16 doubles, two triples and five home runs while driving in a team-high 38 RBIs. Along with drawing nine walks, she has posted a .380 on-base percentage and slugged .579 on the way to a career-best .959 OPS. In addition to leading the team with 23 extra base hits, she has notched 14 multi-hit contests and recorded 11 games with multiple RBIs – including four games with at least three RBIs.

Pickens currently ranks in the top-10 in six OVC-only statistical categories including fielding percentage (1.000, first), triples (two, second), total bases (51, sixth), batting average (.385, sixth), slugging percentage (.630, seventh) and hits (31, 10th). She also ranks third in total doubles (16) and sixth in total RBIs (38).

Garnering her second All-OVC honor in as many years, Fuller hit both near the top of the Skyhawk lineup and the OVC leaderboard all season. She notched a .386 batting average with 32 runs scored, 59 hits, five doubles, two triples, three home runs and 20 RBIs. Along with her 10 walks and five steals, she boasted a .423 on-base percentage while slugging .503 on the year to post a .926 OPS. The Huntingdon, Tenn. native leads the team with 18 multi-hit contests and is currently riding a 10-game on-base streak heading into the OVC Softball Championship.

Fuller currently ranks in the top-10 in the OVC in batting average (.386, sixth), hits (59, seventh) and sacrifice flies (three, ninth) while also ranking amongst league leaders in conference play in fielding percentage (1.000, first), hits (32, seventh) and batting average (.360, eighth).

Earning the third All-OVC accolade of her decorated career, Clark continues to leave her stamp on program history by becoming just the seventh Skyhawk to earn a third all-conference honor. She posted a .321 batting average with 42 runs scored, 53 hits, seven doubles, three triples, three home runs and 20 RBIs. Along with drawing 14 walks and swiping a team-high 24 stolen bases, she only struck out eight times in 165 at bats. The Lafayette, Tenn. native boasts a .401 on-base percentage while slugging .455 for a season OPS of .856. She posted a season-long 16 game hitting streak early in the season while boasting 16 multi-hit efforts.

A five-year starter for the Skyhawks, Clark currently ranks in the career top-10 in nine categories including steals (94, second), hits (218, fourth), runs scored (133, fourth), batting average (.341, fifth), games played (221, sixth), triples (eight, sixth), at bats (639, seventh), on-base percentage (.393, eighth) and total bases (278, 10th). She also ranks amongst the OVC leaders this season in steals (24, third), runs scored (42, fourth), triples (three, fourth), hit by pitch (eight, fifth) and at bats (165, 10th).

Hailing from Belvidere, Ill., Blume earned a spot on the All-Newcomer squad after starting 47 games in her first season in a Skyhawk uniform. The Bradley transfer boasted a .287 batting average with 21 runs scored, 39 hits, five doubles, one triples, four home runs and 28 RBIs. Along with drawing six walks and swiping five stolen bases, she posted a .327 on-base percentage while slugging .426. Starting the majority of her games in the outfield, she tallied eight multi-hit games while her best outing came against Austin Peay when she went 3-for-4 with six RBIs on April 30.
