## **GRME NOTES**

### **Historic Win**

Western Illinois picked up a historic 81-75 win over the SIUE Cougars. The six-point win marked the first-ever win for WIU in the Ohio Valley Conference.

#### Off To a Hot Start

Western Illinois is off to a hot start to begin the 2023-24 campaign. The Leathernecks are posting a 11-3 record for the second time in the last three years. WIU has had a 11-3 or better record through the first ten games of play just three times under Coach JD Gravina. WIU started the 2021-22 season with an 11-2 record.

## **Chasing History**

Head Coach JD Gravina is one win away from tying Leslie Crane as the winningest coach in Western Illinois Women's Basketball history. He will need two wins to become the winningest coach.

## **Home Court Advantage**

Western Illinois has taken full advantage of playing their first seven out of ten games at home. The Leathernecks sit with a perfect 9-1 record at home, defeating teams by an average of 30.75 points a game.

## Chasing 1K

Senior Anna Deets has been a dominate scorer her entire career. Deets now sits just 98 points away from reaching the 1,000 point mark in her Leatherneck career.

## Freshman Rising

Raegan McCowan has been leading the Leathernecks all season long. Named the OVC Freshmen of the Week six times this season, McCowan is averaging 17.9 and 7.4 rebounds for WIU.

## **Crashing the Glass**

The Western Illinois squad has outrebounded its opponents by 597-465. The Leathernecks hold a 9.2 rebound differential. Western Illinois is cleaning up the offensive glass, outrebounding opponents 171-132 on that side of the ball.

## Starting Strong, Finishing Stronger

Western Illinois has started the first quarter on fire as they have outscored their opponents 273-209. The Leathernecks have outscored their opponents in all the other three quarters but have dominated the 3rd quarter, outscoring opponents 311-205.

## Raining Three's.

Western Illinois has knocked down 112 three-pointers, averaging 8 a game this season.

## **NCAA Rankings**

Western Illinois currently has the highest NET ranking of any OVC school at 213. The Leathernecks are also ranked 20th in the nation in three-point field goal percentage.

## **OVC Rankings**

Western Illinois ranks number one in the OVC in points scored at 80.6 and points allowed at 62.4. The Leathernecks are also number one in team field goal percentage (46.0%), Opponent field goal percentage (37.2%), 3-point field goal percentage (37.5), 3-point field goals made (8.0), Opponent 3-point field goal percentage (27.2), Rebounds (42.6), Team defensive rebounds (30.4), Rebound Margin (9.4), Assist-turnover ratio (1.06), and Assists (16.2 Avg/G).

On the player side, Raegan McCowan ranks first in points (17.9), fifth in rebounds (7.4), and second in field goal percentage (50.5%). Mallory McDermott is fourth with 2.3 threes a game, and Addi Brownfield is fourth in steals at 1.9 per game.

## HEAD COACH JD GRAVINA



JD Gravina was named as the seventh head coach in program history on April 15, 2011, after a highly successful four-year stint at Quincy University. A six-year head coaching veteran prior to Western, Gravina built a powerhouse during his time at Quincy by posting an overall record of 93-28 and taking the Hawks to the NCAA Division II National Tournament three times, and has brought that same level of success to Macomb.

Gravina enters the 2022-23 season with a 170-161 record at Western Illinois, having posted double-digit victories in 10 of the last 11 seasons - a stretch that was highlighted by back-to-back 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2017-18, and an upset victory in the first round of the 2021 Summit League Tournament.

During the 2021-22 season, his Leatherneck team went 14-15 and had three players earn All-Summit recognition, with Danni Nichols (Second Team), Evan Zars (Honorable Mention) and Elizabeth Lutz (All Defensive, All Academic) each having career seasons. The 2021-22 Leathernecks also ranked fifth in the nation in the WBCA Academic Top-25.

The team also hosted and won the 2021 Compass Challenge, overcoming Southern Illinois 85-80 on Dec. 4 to win the tournament. Despite struggling during conference play Western Illinois still had several big

moments, especially on the road, as shown by their mid-February sweep of the weekend series at North Dakota and North Dakota State. Western fell in the first round of the Summit League Tournament to eventual champions South Dakota State.

In an unprecedented 2020-21 year, Gravina's Leathernecks went 8-16 overall, making the conference tournament. Once in Sioux Falls, Western Illinois made some noise, as Elizabeth Lutz made two free throws with one second remaining to secure a 60-59 victory over the fourth-seeded Kansas City Roos. The victory marked the first time in program history that a fifth-seeded Leatherneck team won a game in the Summit League Tournament.

Gravina led his team to a 22-10 record in 2017-18, marking the first time since 2002-04 that the team posted back-to-back 20-win seasons. On Nov. 18, 2018, Gravina and his Leathernecks completed one of the most monumental win in program history: a victory over then-No. 18 Stanford. This marked the first-ever win over a nationally-ranked opponent in Western Illinois Women's Basketball history.

Gravina also helped guide his team to its third-straight postseason appearance, going on to play in the 2018 WNIT, with his Leathernecks ranking in the top-10 nationally in multiple categories: steals, steals per game, three-point field goals made, three-point field goals made per game and turnover margin. The team also set a new program record with an 81.1 scoring average that ranked 12th nationally.

The year prior, in 2016-17, Gravina's team recorded an unprecedented 26-7 record, the best in program history while also winning program's first Summit League Regular Season Championship in 11 years. Western Illinois went on to win its first Summit League Tournament Championship that season and make its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1995. That season saw WIU make one of the biggest shots in program history, as Taylor Hanneman made a 3-pointer with 2.2 seconds in the championship game against IUPUI to send the game into overtime; Western Illinois would win 77-69 to secure a place in the NCAA Tournament while Hanneman's shot was featured at no. 2 on ESPN SportsCenter's "Top-10 Plays."

Along with the league championship and tournament appearance, Gravina also garnered The Summit League 'Coach of the Year' honor and was a recipient of his fourth-career Illinois Basketball Coaches' Association (IBCA) 'Coach of the Year' award. His team also broke a combined 15 individual and team records, including wins (26), home wins (13), home game attendance (1,596 vs. South Dakota, Feb. 25, 2017), scoring (2,640) and 3-pointers made (314). In all, his team led The Summit League in points (80.0), assists (18.0), steals (11.3), blocks (4.3) and 3-pointers made per game (9.5) for the 2016-17 season. Western Illinois also finished the season ranked in the top-10 nationally for steals, 3-pointers made, 3-pointers made per game, turnover margin, assist to turnover ratio and assists per game.

A two-time Great Lakes Valley Conference 'Coach of the Year' at Quincy, Gravina led the Hawks to national tournament appearances during the 2007-08 and 2008-09 campaigns and was also selected as the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Division II 'Coach of the Year' three times.

Prior to his tenure at Quincy, Gravina spent two seasons at McPherson College where, during the 2006-07 campaign, he helped the Bulldogs record their third winning season in 25 years.

Gravina graduate from William Jewell College in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in Mathematics and Computer Science. He competed in basketball, tennis and track and field as a student-athlete. He received his first master's degree from UMKC in Economics in 2002 and another in Health, Physical Education and Recreation from Emporia State in 2007.

He and his wife Meredith, welcomed their first child, Maryn Elizabeth, on September 3, 2014, their second child, Dominic James, on May 7, 2016, and their third child, Miller Lucille Gravina, on September 5, 2018. They are also joined by their dogs Annie and Mollie.
