THE MATCHUP

Montana State opens the 2024 post-season Saturday with explosive UT Martin, MSU's second FCS Playoff matchup against the Skyhawks in the last four seasons. The 9-4 Skyhawks have won eight of their last nine games.

Montana State capped the first 12-0 regular season in Big Sky history with an outright Big Sky title. **UT Martin** is 9-4 after dominating New Hampshire 41-10.

Montana State is 1-0 against the Skyhawks, a 26-7 FCS Playoffs win in Brent Vigen's first season. That game was memorable as Tommy Mellott's first start at MSU.

BOBCAT TEAM NOTES

- ▶ The Bobcats finish the regular season 12-0 overall and 6-0 on the road, both program firsts. MSU finished 5-0 in regular season road games in 2012.
- ▶ MSU's current 12-game win streak is the second-longest in program history after a 13-game streak in 1976-77.
- ▶ Montana State's FCS-leading rushing offense (317.9) squares off with UTM's 5th-rated rushing defense, which allows just 84.9 yards per game.

ON THE MSU OFFENSE

- ▶ Tommy Mellott has rushed for 11 TDs this year, with 22 TD passes. His 198 points responsible for is 3rd in the FCS. He has accounted for 86 TDs in his career.
- ▶ Adam Jones is 3rd in the FCS in yards per rush (7.42), while Scottre Humphrey is 4th (7.37).
- ▶ MSU is the only FCS team to score 30 points in each regular season game.
- ▶ The Cats average 40.7 points and 496.2 yards per game to lead the FCS.
- ▶ Montana State gained over 400 total yards in 20 of its last 24 games.
- ▶ MSU had scored in 24 straight quarters before being shut out in the fourth quarter at UC Davis, and has scored in 43 of this season's 48 quarters.

ON THE MSU DEFENSE

- ▶ MSU has 8 sacks in the last 2 games, including 6 at UC Davis..
- ▶ Montana State allows 13.2 points per game at home. Of the 79 points MSU has surrendered in Bobcat Stadium only 10 came before halftime.
- ▶ The Cats allow 295.7 total yards per game, 10th nationally.
- ▶ Montana State's defense has allowed two first-quarter TDs this season.
- ▶ Neil Daily has 25 total tackles, 4.5 for a loss, in his 5 games as a starter.

ON THE MSU SPECIAL TEAMS

- ▶ Taco Dowler's 79-yard punt return for a TD at UC Davis was his first of 2024.
- ▶ Brendan Hall has pinned the foe inside the 20 on an FCS-best 66% of his punts.

STADIUM STORY

- ▶ MSU is 33-1 at home since Sac State's 34-21 win in 2019, the last win by a Big Sky foe in Bobcat Stadium, and 28-1 under Brent Vigen.
- ▶ MSU's 511 rushing yards vs. Sac State set a Bobcat Stadium record.

MSU-UTM Series Notebook

- Montana State's only previous meeting with UT Martin provided both drama on the field and intrigue surrounding the game. The Cats grabbed a 10-0 lead with a pair of second quarter scores, but when UTM's Jay Woods returned a fumble 68 yards for a touchdown just before halftime - as the Cats mounted a drive that might have ended the afternoon's drama - the entire affair was turned upside down. The Cats led 13-7 entering the fourth quarter, but on that quarter's third play Tommy Mellott dashed 73 yards for a touchdown. That gave the Cats a 19-7 lead, and MSU would win 26-7.
- When Tommy Mellott caught a crease up the middle then angled toward the UTM sideline for a 73-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter of that 2021 playoff game is arguably the moment when he became Touchdown Tommy. The then-freshman from Butte rushed for 180 yards and a pair of scores that day, energizing Bobcat fans just days after replacing Matt McKay in the starting lineup.
- Forgotten in the frenzy surrounding Mellott's first start was the dominating day from Isaiah Ifanse. The Bobcat star sealed the win with a 17-yard touchdown run, and finished the day with 176 yards. The Cats rushed for 21 first downs and 387 yards that day.

Scouting UT Martin

- The strength of UT Martin's team, the Skyhawks rush defense surrender's just 84.9 yards per game on the ground, the fifth-lowest total in the FCS. That group stands at the nexus of the game's most intriguing matchup, squaring off against a Bobcat ground game that leads the FCS with 317.9 rushing yards per game. Linebacker Jaylon Sharpe, a Charlotte transfer, leads the Skyhawks with 79 tackles, 14.5 for a loss, with a pair of sacks.
- The Skyhawks' starting defensive front features 6-2, 320 lb nose tackle Christian Dowell. The senior has 27 tackles, including three for a loss, with seven quarterback hurries.
- UTM running back Patrick Smith averages 91.8 yards per game, 24th in the FCS, and 5.7 yards per carry, 30th nationally. His 14 touchdowns ranks 11th.
- Six different UT Martin defensive players have intercepted passes this season, with five of them grabbing more than one. Chris Hunter has picked off five passes, while Tevin Shipp, Oshae Baker and JaMichael McGoy each have three.

Bobcat Legacy Number

Former Bobcat coach Jeff Choate introduced 41 as Montana State's legacy number in the summer of 2016, a tribute to the Treasure State's status as the 41st state in the Union and to Montana State's iconic 1941 football team, the last group of Bobcats to play football before World War II. By the end of the 1944 season 10 Bobcat football players had perished in the war effort, a fact observed by famed sportscaster Bill Stern. Stern's 1944 All-America football was comprised only of those 10 men, and in the next year their names had been memorialized nationally and read into the Congressional record. By the time the 1945 academic year dawned, four teammates had joined those 10. Bozeman's Grant Collins wore no. 41 when Choate decided to designate it as MSU's legacy number, and Belgrade's Brayden Konkol was the first Bobcat selected specifically for the honor.

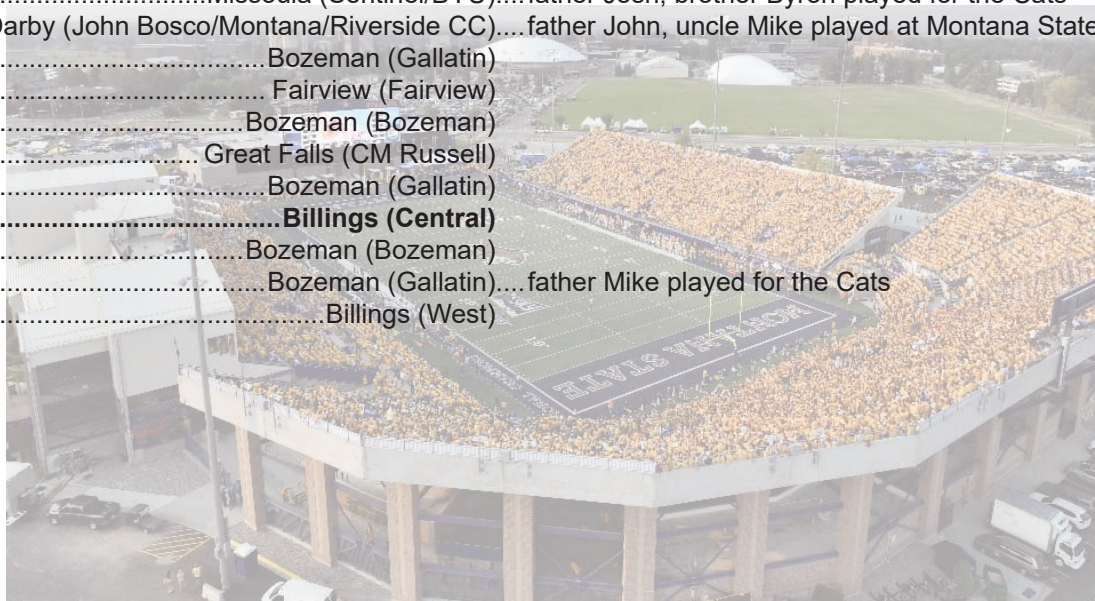

Bobcat Team Notebook

- Montana State's 12th straight win Saturday marked the program's longest winning streak since the 1976-77 Bobcats won 13 in a row. This is MSU's second-longest streak ever. This is Montana State's second unbeaten regular season of more than five games (the 1956 squad was 9-0 before the Aluminum Bowl tie).

- The UC Davis win gave MSU its first-ever 6-0 single-season road record.

- In Sac State's 34-21 win at Bobcat Stadium in 2019, MSU's most recent home loss to a league foe, the Hornets piled up 403 yards (5.8 per play) to MSU's 378 (5.6). Saturday, This season in Bobcat Stadium, Sac State gained 255 (4.1 per play) to MSU's 604 (9.4).

- The 2024 Bobcats have scored at least 30 points in the first 12 games, eclipsing the school record of eight (2015).

- Montana State has scored at least 30 points in 40 of Brent Vigen's 53 games as head coach. The Bobcats currently lead the FCS with 40.7 points per game. Vigen's MSU offenses:

- With his 106 yards against UNC, Taco Dowler became MSU's first 100-yard receiver since Ty McCullough vs. EWU last year. Of Dowler's yardage, 34 came on a TD pass from McCullough.

- MSU's 5.17 penalties per game is 29th-fewest in the FCS. The Cats average 6.3 penalties on the road, 3.6 at home.

- The Cats have begun only three seasons - 2024, 1957 and 1899 - by winning two true road games. In four other years (1968, 1968, 1962, 1956), MSU opened the seasons with two wins away from home which included one neutral site game.

- MSU has sold out 26 straight home regular season games.

- The Bobcats' only first-quarter deficit to an FCS foe this season came when UC Davis scored on its first drive to lead 8-0. New Mexico (FBS) led 10-0 in the season opener.

- MSU outscored its opponents 299-63 in the first half this season. By quarter: 1st - 117-25, 2nd - 182-38, 3rd - 96-55, 4th - 03-86.

- MSU is in its sixth straight post-season, the longest stretch in program history.

- Before the season-opening win at New Mexico, MSU's most recent fourth-quarter comeback win was Nov. 5, 2022, when Blake Glessner's walk-off field goal beat NAU. At UNM, Tommy Mellott led an 11-play, 89-yard drive capped by a four-yard Scottre Humphrey TD with four seconds left.

- MSU finished 8-0 at home in both 2021 and 2022, the third and fourth unblemished home campaigns in the Sales/Bobcat Stadium era (1976, 2005). The stadium opened in 1973.

- MSU's 2024 senior class owns a four-year career record of 44-9 (.830). The 2023 group finished 43-13 (.768). The Class of '22 compiled 44 wins and a .772 win percentage. The 1956-59 group finished with an .816 win percentage.

- Adam Jones' 93-yard run at New Mexico was the second-longest rush in Bobcat history. His 928 rushing yards is 2nd on MSU's all-time freshman list, he has five runs of at least 50 yards. Jones finished as the Stats Perform's Jerry Rice Award finalist.

- The Cats have 67 explosive runs (12+ yards) this season, including 17 of at least 50 yards and 7 of 70 or more.

- MSU's quest for offensive balance combined with a cumulative halftime score of 279-60 has suppressed Tommy Mellott's ground work this season. His combined 2022/2023 totals vs. 2024:

- Six Bobcats have combined for 27 runs of at least 20 yards this season: Scottre Humphrey (9), Tommy Mellott (8), Adam Jones (6), Jared White (2), Ty McCullough (1), Colson Coon (1).

- After making it through the 2023 regular season without an offensive line starting lineup change, the Cats have used two this year. The second version debuted against Mercyhurst when Burke Mastel made his first career start at guard, moving Connor Moore to LT.

- When redshirt freshman Cedric Jefferson and third-year sophomore Titan Fleischmann took the field against New Mexico as MSU's starting tackles it was the first time since at least 1990 that MSU began the season without starting experience at either tackle position.

- Scottre Humphrey certainly has the 'first impressions' thing nailed. In 2023, he became the first Bobcat to gain at least 100 yards in his first game as a true freshman, getting 114 vs. Utah Tech. He topped with 140 yards against New Mexico in this year's opener scoring the game-winning TD with 10 seconds left.

- Montana State has topped the 30-point mark in all 10 games this season, and in 37 of Brent Vigen's 51 games at MSU. MSU is 36-1 in those.

- The Cats have seven scrimmage plays longer than 70 yards (four of them rushes) and 17 of at least 50 yards (11 rushes).

- The Cats average 6.94 yards per rush and 317.9 per game to lead the FCS. In 2023, Montana State's 7.13 yards per rush led the FCS and the team's 291.0 rushing yards was 2nd.

- Montana State's offensive line has resumed its status among the elite units in the FCS. The Bobcats lead the FCS in rushing yards per game and yards per rush, and are tied for 10th in fewest sacks allowed. South Dakota, South Dakota State, Jackson State and Butler are also among the top 10 in both.

- The Cats have 40 rushing touchdowns in 2024, 1st in the FCS. Last season's total of 41 was 2nd.

- After losing seven fumbles in the previous 26 games, MSU has lost seven fumbles in 2024. Last season, the Cats fumbled 10 times but lost only three. This season the team's 10 fumbles have resulted in seven lost.

- On his 76-yard TD run at EWU Tommy Mellott passed the 3,000 yard rushing mark in his career, one of four Bobcats to surpass that milestone. He is 9th among active FCS players (3,059) in yards, 6th in rushing TDs (38).

- Brothers Brody Grebe and Bryce Grebe each forced a fumble against Mercyhurst.
- Third down defense was the story of MSU's first two 2024 games. The Cats allowed just one third down conversion against both New Mexico and Utah Tech (2-for-19 total). The Bobcats have held opponents to .323 on third down through 12 games, 15th in the FCS.
- Kenneth Eiden IV's sack against Sacramento State snapped a two-game drought by MSU defensive linemen, then he added two more at UC Davis. As a team MSU logged six sacks at UC Davis and two vs. UM, and its 2.17 sacks per game is 3rd in the Big Sky.
- The Cats have held opposing offenses without a first down in four quarters this season - the first three vs. Utah Tech, and the first against Mercyhurst..
- Brent Vigen's Bobcats have held two opponents to less than 10 first downs - Utah Tech (six) in 2024, and William & Mary (nine) in the 2022 FCS Playoffs.
- On possessions after its 14 takeaways this season, Montana State has scored 34 points. A year ago the Bobcats took the ball away 14 times, but cashed those into 59 points.
- In Brent Vigen's four seasons, MSU is +44 in turnover margin in the 44 wins, +6 in the nine losses.
- Brody Grebe is 47th nationally with 0.55 sacks per game. Grebe's 12.5 tackles-for-loss in 2023 (1.1 per game) was 4th in the Big Sky, and his 0.82 sacks per game 5th. Grebe's 24.5 career sacks is 10th in Bobcat history.
- Montana State allows just 17.0 points per game, 6th in the FCS. New Mexico scored 31 points against MSU in the season opener, but two of those scores came courtesy of the Lobos' defense. The Cats have allowed just 23 offensive touchdowns this season.

- The Cats have allowed just 25 points in the first quarter this season - including just two offensive touchdowns - and 63 points before halftime. UC Davis' early 8-0 lead marked MSU's first first-quarter deficit since the opener.
- Danny Uluilakepa's last play as a Bobcat was his fourth career interception, and his second in consecutive games this season. On the return, Danny U. suffered a season-ending knee injury. Jackson Harmon's first career interception late in the Maine contest also snapped a string of four straight games (dating to 2023) without an interception. Rylan Ortt doubled that total with his pick at Idaho State.
- Montana State's first two takeaways this season - the interception against Maine and fumble recovery at New Mexico - each came on the opponents' last offensive play.
- Montana State's 14 takeaways have resulted in 34 Bobcat points. Last year, MSU took the ball away 14 times and turned that into 79 points.
- MSU allows 113.9 rushing yards a game, 17th in the FCS, and 3.88 yards per rush, 37th nationally.
- Nine Bobcats have interceptions in their careers - Takhari Carr, Zac Crews, Caden Dowler, Jon Johnson, Rylan Ortt, Dru Polidore, Blake Stillwell, Danny Uluilakepa, Simeon Woodard and Jackson Harmon.
- Montana State has posted a +6 turnover margin this season (28th in the FCS), but after a slow start in that category are +9 in the most recent seven games. The team's 2023 +0.53 turnover margin was 20th in the FCS and 2nd in the Big Sky. MSU was even or positive in turnover margin in nine of last season's first 10 games, but finished -1 at UM and NDSU. Two of MSU's seven 2023 turnovers came on kick teams.

Kick Team Notes

- Tommy Sullivan's first snap against UT Martin marks his 53rd game played as a Bobcat.
- Brendan Hall is PFF's 9th-ranked punter in Division I, and is 2nd among FCS punters. He leads all of college football in kickoff touchbacks, and is 2nd in Division I in kickoff rating (PFF).
- Brendan Hall pinned UC Davis inside the 20 on all five of his punts, and inside the 25 on two of his kickoffs. UC Davis' average starting field position was the 21, largely due to Hall's work in the kicking game.
- Brendan Hall has allowed seven punt and 10 kickoff returns through 12 games. The punt that Mercyhurst returned was muffed for zero return yards, and EWU's Efton Chism III returned one for -2 yards. Six of the kickoffs returned resulted in possessions beginning inside the 25, with one resulting in a forced and recovered fumble. His last kickoff against the Grizzlies resulted in a tackle of Junior Bergen inside the 25, and 13 of his 22 punts pinned the opponent inside its own 20 yard line.
- Max Murphy's 3 special teams tackles include 1 FF and 2 pins inside 20/25.
- MSU has blocked an opponent punt in two 2024 games - Taki Uluilakepa vs. Maine and Rylan Ortt vs. Mercyhurst. Zac Crews' touchdown off Ortt's block was MSU's first blocked punt score since 2018.
- Redshirt freshman Myles Sansted became MSU's primary place kicker in the days before the New Mexico game due to an injury, and has responded by making 58 of his 60 PATs. He is 10-for-14 on field goals. He is 19th in the FCS in scoring (8.2 points per game).
- MSU is 5th in the FCS in net punting at 41.67 yards per punt. The Cats led the FCS in net punting in 2023 (43.7). Brendan Hall's average of 46.1 yards per punt didn't qualify for NCAA rankings because he had 10 too few punts, but would have slotted in at third nationally.

- Brendan Hall has pinned the opponent inside the 20 18 times on his 30 punts this season, and did so 14 times in 2023. He has only five touchbacks on 59 punts in his Bobcat career.
- Brendan Hall has kicked off 157 times as a Bobcat, with 136 resulting in touchbacks, including touchbacks on 74 of his 85 kickoffs in 2024. His 72 touchbacks in 2023 led all of DI per PFF.
- The Cats average 2.5 punts per game this year, nearly identical to the past two seasons (2.8 in 2023, 2.7 in 2022).

- During Brendan Hall's 24 games as Montana State's punter opponents have returned only 13 of his 73 punts, with 26 of those resulting in starting field position inside the opponent 20.
- Brendan Hall is suffering from Montana State's prolific and efficient offense. For the second straight season he is in danger of not punting enough to qualify for NCAA punting statistics. He didn't punt against Portland State, the second time in his career he hasn't been called upon (once in 2023). MSU also didn't punt in three 2022 games.

Bobcat Coaching Notebook

● MSU's 2023 loss at Idaho was Brent Vigen's first in the month of October and his second against a Big Sky foe. MSU's only two November losses in that span are in Missoula.

● Brent Vigen's 44 wins is third-most in Bobcat history. His 53 games coached is 16th. His .830 winning percentage is easily the best in school history.

● Bobcat defensive coordinator Bobby Daly coached Atlanta Falcons linebackers Troy Andersen at MSU and Kaden Elliss at Idaho.

● Current Bobcat assistant coaches Bobby Daly (4th, 382) and Jody Owens (8th, 343) rank among MSU's all-time tackles leaders.

● Bobcat assistant coaches Al Johnson (Wisconsin, 2002) and Jordan Walsh (Iowa, 2015) were All-America and all-conference linemen in the Big 10.

● Brent Vigen opened his first season as a head coach (at any level) against Wyoming in 2021, where he worked from 2014-20, and closed it against his alma mater, North Dakota State, where he began his coaching career in 1998.

● Five Bobcat assistants played college ball in the Treasure State. Jody Owens and Bobby Daly starred at linebacker for the Cats, Sam Mix played receiver at MSU Northern, Shawn Howe played defensive line at Rocky Mountain, and Marcus Monaco at UM Western.

● Brent Vigen is one of three Bobcat coaches in the Gold Rush era of home openers (since 2007). Rob Ash won all nine of his Gold Rush Games, Jeff Choate was 3-1, and Vigen is 4-0. Seven of Ash's nine Gold Rush wins came against Division II opponents. Choate's only Gold Rush loss, and one of the wins, came against ranked FCS foes.

● Brent Vigen (2021, 2022) joins Mike Kramer (2005) and Sonny Holland (1976) as MSU's only coaches with perfect home seasons in Sales/Bobcat Stadium. Vigen is 26-1 at home, the best start to any Bobcat coaching career (Herb Agocs, 1958-59, and Fred Ben-

nion, 1914-15, each started 8-0). His 12 wins in 2021 was third-most in Big Sky history for a first-year head coach, second-most for a first-year coach without previous head coaching experience, and the most ever by a Bobcat coach.

● Three coaches left MSU to become head coaches elsewhere: Jim Sweeney after 1967 (Washington State), Ott Romney after 1927 (BYU), and Walter Powell after 1919 (Stanford). Five others left to become assistants: Jeff Choate went to Texas before the 2021 season, Doug Graber went to the Chiefs after 1982, Wally Lemm to the Cardinals after 1955, Clyde Carpenter to Tennessee before returning to Montana as a high school coach, and DV Graves left after 1921 to become baseball and assistant football coach at Washington.

● The first North Dakota State graduate to lead the Cats, Brent Vigen joins Earle Solomonson as former Bison coaches to assume the head coach role at MSU. Solomonson won 15 games from 1987-91 after three seasons as NDSU's coach, including an NCAA Division II title.

● In 1914 Montana State hired Fred Bennion as head coach after he'd attained success at Utah and BYU. , and by all accounts was drawn to Bozeman by the opportunity to study and work in agriculture while coaching. Since then, only Schubert Dyche (1928-35, 1938-41), Jack Croft (1936-37), Tom Parac (1968-70), Cliff Hysell (1992-99), and Brent Vigen (2021-) led MSU without prior head coaching experience.
