## UT MARTIN

The no. 16 Holy Cross women's basketball team will face no. 16 seed UT Martin on Thursday, March 21 in the 2024 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament First Four at 9 p.m. at the Carver-Hawkeye Arena in Iowa City, Iowa. The contest will be broadcast nationally on ESPN2 with Beth Mowins (play-by-play) and Stephanie White (analyst) on the call.

### HOLY CROSS NOTES:

- The surging Crusaders have won four straight games and six of their last eight including the 2024 Patriot League Tournament Championship, their league best 13th conference title defeating Boston University 61-55 Sunday afternoon in the Hart Center Arena. Senior Bronagh Power-Cassidy scored a game-high 21 points to go with eight rebounds in the win.
- Power-Cassidy, the Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year and All-Patriot League first team selection was voted Championship MVP for the second straight year. She averaged 18.3 points, 6.7 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.3 steals per game on 46.5 percent (20-of-43) shooting and 8-of-16 (50%) from range.
- The four game winning streak (March 6-present) is the second longest of the season for the Crusaders as they won nine games (Dec. 17-Jan. 24). During the four game winning streak, Power-Cassidy is averaging a team-high 21.3 points 6.5 rebounds and 2.3 assists, and 1.8 steals per game on 51.7% (31-of-60) shooting and 57.7% (15-of-27) from long distance.
- The conference championship was the 13th in program history for the Crusaders they became the first Patriot League team to win back-to-back titles since Navy's three-peat (2011, 2012, 2013). The victory was their 53rd in the Patriot League Tournament (53-20, .726). Both are league high marks.
- The Crusaders are the lone men's or women's basketball team to represent the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in the NCAA Division I Tournament.
- Head coach Maureen Magarity is 71-40 (.640) as head coach of the Crusaders and has the second-highest winning percentage in team annals (Togo Palazzi, 103-28, .786).
- Holy Cross senior Janelle Allen's brother, Brian Allen Jr., is a defensive end on the Iowa football team. Iowa is the host for the First Four/First and Second Rounds in the Albany 2 region.

### HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT:

- This will be the 14th appearance in the NCAA Tournament for the Crusaders. Holy Cross is 1-13 (.071) in the NCAA Tournament.
- The lone victory came on March 13, 1991 when the no. 11 Crusaders defeated no. 6 Maryland 81-74 in the Hart Center Arena. It is the only NCAA women's basketball tournament win in Patriot League history (1-31, .031).
- The last time Holy Cross played in the tournament was on March 17, 2023 and suffered a 93-61 loss to no. 2 Maryland as the no. 15 seed.

### DE-FENSE, DE-FENSE, DE-FENSE:

- Under head coach Maureen Magarity, the Crusaders take pride on the defensive side of the ball. Magarity has coached two Patriot League All-Defensive team selections, Addisyn Cross '23, the only two-time All-Defensive selection in program history and Avery LaBarbera '22.
- In 2023-24, the Crusaders rank 18th in the nation in three-point percentage defense (27.0), 20th in scoring defense (56.2), and 20th in field goal percentage defense (36.4).
- Per SportsReference, Holy Cross has 3 of the top-10 defenders in the Patriot League via defensive rating, Simone Foreman (1st, 80.0), Lindsay Berger (2nd, 82.9) and Bronagh Power-Cassidy (10th, 87.5). Defensive rating or defensive efficiency is a statistic used in basketball to measure an individual player's efficiency at preventing the other team from scoring points.
- During the 2022-23 campaign, Holy Cross ranked second in the Patriot League in scoring defense (55.9) and second in FG% defense (37.5%) which ranked 19th and 49th in the NCAA respectively.
- In 2021-22, the Crusaders ranked second in the Patriot League in scoring defense (56.5), 3PT FG% defense (27.8%), FG% defense (37.0%), and turnovers forced (15.52). Those marks rank 19th, 42nd and 30th in the NCAA respectively.
- Since Magarity arrived on The Hill, Holy Cross is 63-6 (.913) when holding opponents under 60 points in a game. When leading at halftime, Magarity's teams are 58-7 (.892).

### HOME IS WHERE THE HART IS:

- During the 2023-24 season, Holy Cross went 15-2 at home setting a new program single-season record for wins in the Hart Center Arena.
- The Crusaders have won 69 of their last 91 games at the Hart Center (69-22, .758).
- From Feb. 22, 2023 to Feb. 3, 2024 the Crusaders won 14 straight games in the Hart Center which is tied for the third longest winning streak since becoming a Division 1 program.

### GOT THE POWER:

- Senior Bronagh Power-Cassidy, a two-time Patriot League Tournament Championship MVP (2023, 2024), a two-time Patriot League Championship All-Tournament Team selection (2023, 2024), the 2023-24 Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year, a two-time Academic All-Patriot League choice (2022-23, 2-23-24), a 2023-24 All-League First Team athlete, a 2023-24 Preseason All-Patriot League choice, a 2022-23 Patriot League Second Team honoree, 2020-21 Patriot League Rookie of the Year and All-Rookie Team selection returns to carry the load on offense for the Crusaders.
- Power-Cassidy ranks first in the Patriot League in three-pointers per game (2.4) and three-pointers (73), is 3rd in scoring (16.8), 4th in field goal percentage (45.3), 6th in minutes per game (33.3), and tied for 19th in rebounding (5.0).
- On Dec. 17 at home against Northeastern, Power-Cassidy became the 36th member of the program's 1,000 point club draining a three-pointer with 7:07 left in the fourth quarter. She has 1,391 points over her four year Crusader career which is 15th all-time.
- During her time at Holy Cross, she has knocked down 189 three-pointers which ranks 4th all-time in program history.
- On the defensive side, she has tallied 75 blocks and is 4 away from 79 which would rank within the program's top-10.
- In 2023-24, Power-Cassidy has converted 73 threes which is sixth most during a season in team history.
- Power-Cassidy has scored 20 or more points 18 times in her career. The Crusaders are 14-4 (.778) in those games and 9-2 (.818) during the 2023-24 season.
- Power-Cassidy claimed her second straight Patriot League Championship MVP award after averaging 18.3 points, 6.7 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.3 steals per game on 46.5% (20-of-43) shooting and 8-of-16 (50%) from three-point land.
- In the Patriot League title game against Boston University (3/17), she scored a game-high 21 points on 8-of-15 (53.3%) shooting going 4-of-6 (66.7%) from deep to go with eight rebounds and a three steals in the Crusader victory.
- Power-Cassidy was one of four players in double figures during the Patriot League semifinal round win against Loyola (Md.) (3/14) scoring a game-high 20 points on 60% (6-of-10) shooting to go with a game-high eight rebounds.
- In the Patriot League quarterfinal round against Bucknell (3/11) Power-Cassidy handed out a career-high seven assists with a personal-best matching four blocks to go with 14 points in the Crusader win.
- The team captain tallied a game-best 30 points with a career-high seven three-pointers (7-of-10, 70%), which was tied for the second most during a single-game in program history as the Crusaders clinched their 13th Patriot League Regular Season title against Lafayette (3/6).
- She scored a career-high 33 points on 52.4% (11-

of-21) shooting with three triples at Colgate (2/28).

- At Bucknell (2/21), Power-Cassidy scored 26 points with 16 coming in the fourth quarter (7) and overtime (9) during the Crusaders 58-47 victory.
- Power-Cassidy chipped in 24 points knocking down six three-pointers at American (2/12).
- Power-Cassidy willed the Crusaders back from a 10-point third quarter deficit at home against American (1/24) scoring a game-high 22 points with 10 rebounds en route to her second career double-double.
- During the Patriot League opener against Bucknell (1/3), Power-Cassidy scored a game-high 21 points on 53.3% shooting.
- Against Northeastern, Power-Cassidy scored a game-high 24 points in 32 minutes of action going 10-of-19 (52.6%) from the field with six boards in the Crusader win.
- In the season opener at BC on Nov. 6, Power-Cassidy tallied her first career double-double with 16 points (4/9 3PT), and a personal-high 12 rebounds.
- The Dublin, Ireland native was the team's leading scorer in 2022-23 averaging 13.6 points per game which was tied for 7th in the Patriot League.
- In 2022-23, Power-Cassidy knocked down 63 three-pointers which is tied for 7th in a single-season in program history.
- Power-Cassidy was named the 2023 Patriot League Championship MVP and to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 20.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.7 assists and 1.0 steals per game shooting 58.3% (21-of-36) and 50% (9-of-18) from downtown in all three wins en route to the conference title.

### LIVING IN ALLENTOWN:

- Senior Janelle Allen, a 2024 Patriot League Championship All-Tournament Team selection and a back-to-back All-Patriot League Third Team choice (2022-23, 2023-24), is the main post threat for the Crusaders. Allen set a career-best averaging 10.4 points per game as the team's second leading scorer in 2022-23.
- Allen ranks third on the Crusaders in scoring averaging 10.2 points per game.
- She scored her 750th career point at Navy (1/10) and has scored 949 points in her career and needs 51 more for 1,000.
- A Patriot League Championship All-Tournament Team selection, Allen averaged 10.0 points and 4.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists on 50% (11-of-22) shooting.
- In the Patriot League Championship game, Allen scored six points with three rebounds and two assists but played a key role in limiting Patriot League Player and Defensive Player of the Year Caitlin Weimar of Boston University (3/17) to seven points, her second lowest total of the year on 2-of-7 (28.5%) shooting.
- During the Patriot League semifinal round victory against Loyola (Md.) (3/14), Allen was one of four players in double figures scoring 11 points while dishing out four assists.
- In the Patriot League quarterfinal round against Bucknell (3/11), Allen scored 13 points on 6-of-9 (66.7%) shooting with five rebounds, two assists and two blocks.
- Allen matched a season and career-best 20 points going a perfect 6-of-6 at the line in the Senior Day win against Navy (2/24).
- She scored a game-high 18 points on 61.5% shooting with five boards and two blocks against Colgate (2/14).
- Allen recorded her first double-double of the season and third of her career matching a ca-

reer-high with 20 points and a personal-best matching 10 rebounds all while shooting 57.1% in the win against UMass-Lowell (11/13).

- At the 2023 Patriot League Championship game (3/12/23), Allen produced 16 points and five rebounds with a block and an assist on 7-of-11 (63.6%) shooting.

## MICROWAVE MCCORMACK:

- Senior Cara McCormack, a2024 Patriot League Championship All-Tournament Team selection, a 2023-24 All-Patriot League Third Team choice and a 2020-21 Patriot League All-Rookie Team honoree looks to be one of the main downtown threats for the Crusaders.

- She has knocked down 147 three-pointers in her career which ranks 9th all-time in program history.
- In 2023-24, McCormack has made three or more three-pointers 12 times.

- During 2023-24, McCormack has recorded three or more assists 18 times and the Crusaders are 13-5 (.722) in those contests.

- McCormack ranks 2nd in the Patriot League in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.3), is 4th in assists (100), and is 5th in assists per game (3.1).

- McCormack who stands at 5 foot, 3 inches, as of Feb. 26 became only the third player in the NCAA this season to record 10 or more rebounds in a game. Buffalo's Rana Elhousseini (5-3) (10 reb, at Miami (OH) - 2/7/24, 11 pts, 10 reb, 10 ast, vs. Southern Miss. - 2/10/24) and Colorado State's McKenna Hofschild (5-2) (36 pts, 10 reb, at Montana - 12/9/23) are the only players in the NCAA 5-3 or shorter with double-digit rebounds in a game this season.

- A Patriot League Championship All-Tournament Team selection, McCormack averaged 13.3 points, 3.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.0 steals with a team-high nine three pointers during the championship run.

- In the Patriot League Championship Game, McCormack scored 13 of her 15 points in the second half hitting three triples with four rebounds and three assists in the Crusader victory against Boston University (3/19).

- Against Loyola (Md.) (3/14) in the Patriot League semifinal win, McCormack scored 16 points to go with four three-pointers (4-of-6).

- In the Patriot League quarterfinal win against Bucknell (3/11), McCormack scored all of her points in the fourth quarter hitting a crucial three-pointer with two minutes to go.

- During the overtime win at Bucknell (2/21), McCormack secured a career-high nine rebounds.

- In the nationally-televised home victory against BU (1/29) McCormack scored a game-high 18 points with a contest-best six assists and three triples and seven free throw conversions.

- On the road at Navy (1/10), McCormack recorded her third block of the season, setting a single season career-high mark.

- At home Army (1/6), McCormack scored a career-high 22 points on 53.3 percent (8-of-15) shooting with four rebounds, and two assists in a Crusader win. McCormack scored 18 of her 22 markers in the first half.

- In the win against Merrimack (12/20), McCormack filled the box score with a team-high 14 points, a career-best eight rebounds, four assists, three three-pointers and a steal.

## (F)LANAGAN'S BALL:

- Sophomore Kaitlyn Flanagan, a 2022-23 Patriot League All-Rookie Team choice returns to conduct the Crusaders offense for the second straight season.

- Flanagan has started and played in every game since freshman year. The Crusaders are 44-21 (.677) and 24-12 (.667) PL in those games.

- In 2023-24, Flanagan paces the Patriot League in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.8), which is 12th in the nation, assists (142), assists per game (4.4) and is tied for 14th in steals per game (1.2) all which leads the team.

- Dating back to her freshman year, Flanagan has totaled four or more assists 31 times and the Crusaders are 23-8 (.742) in those games.

- Flanagan also has tallied nine games of zero turnovers in her career, the Crusaders are 9-0 (1.000) in those contests.

- She was one of four Crusaders in double figures during the Patriot League semifinal win against Loyola (Md.) (3/14) chipping in 12 points on 50% (4-of-8) shootin to go with a game-best five assists.

- Flanagan matched a career-high with four steals in the victory at Stonehill (11/29).

- Flanagan started and played in every game for the Crusaders in 2022-23. She averaged 2.9 assists per contest which was tied for 8th in the league.

- Versus Colgate on Feb. 18, 2023, Flanagan established a new career-high with nine assists.

- At Army on Feb. 25, 2023, Flanagan scored a career-high 16 points shooting 66.7% (4-of-6) from the floor and 85.7% (6-of-7) from the line.

## CHEESEBERGER IN PARADISE:

- Junior Lindsay Berger had a breakout campaign for the Crusaders in 2022-23 leading the team in rebounding (6.6) which was tied for seventh in the Patriot League.

- Berger is the team leader and ranks 5th in the Patriot League in blocks per game (0.9) she also is tied for 9th in rebounds per game in the conference at 5.8 which is second on the squad.

- At Lafayette (1/17) Berger scored a game-high 16 points in 19 minutes off the bench shooting 70% (7-of-10) from the field in the win.

- Coming off the bench early in 2023-24, Berger recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career against Brown (11/9) scoring 13 points and grabbing a game-best 12 rebounds in only 17 minutes of action.

- In her first start of the season, Berger matched a game-best with 17 points shooting 70% (7-of-10) with three blocks and three steals against Conn. College (12/7).

- Her best performance in 2022-23 was a career-high 22 point effort shooting 62.5% (10-of-16) from the field as the Crusaders broke BU's 17-game winning streak.

- From Jan. 18, 2023 to Jan. 25, 2023 Berger recorded three consecutive double-doubles at Colgate (13p, 10r), vs. Bucknell (11p, 10r) and at Lehigh (17p, 12r).

## FOREMAN THE MEAN REBOUNDING MACHINE:

- Sophomore Simone Foreman has taken on a key role in 2023-24 entering the starting lineup in the season opener.

- Foreman matched a career-high with 14 rebounds - seven offensive to go with eight points and a stea in the Patriot League quarterfinal win against Bucknell (3/11).

- She scored a career-high 18 points and secured a personal-best 14 rebounds while shooting 61.5% and committing zero turnovers in a home win against Lehigh (1/13).

- Foreman is the team's leading rebounder at 8.6 boards per game which ranks third in the Patriot League.

- Foreman has 12 double-digit rebound games this season. Holy Cross is 9-3 (.750) in those games.

## LOOKING BACK:

In the semi-finals, the Crusaders dispatched no. 3 Lehigh in the Hart Center 71-54 on Mar. 9, 2023 to advance to the championship game on the road in which they defeated no. 1 BU 66-61 on Mar. 12, 2023.

- Holy Cross won their 50th Patriot League Tournament game, the most in the conference.
- The Crusaders became only the second no. 2 seed to beat a no. 1 seed in the conference championship game.
- Holy Cross traveled to Maryland for the NCAA Tournament First Round and were defeated by a 93-61 score on March 17, 2023.
- The Crusaders owned the second best field goal percentage (42.3), free throw percentage (74.6) and third best three-point percentage (31.7) as a team in the league. Additionally, the Crusaders ranked second in blocked shots per game (3.1) and third in assists per game (13.52).
- Bronagh Power-Cassidy earned Championship MVP Honors, was selected to the All-Tournament Team, was named Patriot League Second Team and Academic All-Patriot League.
- Janelle Allen and Kaitlyn Flanagan also earned conference accolades. Allen was an All-League Third Team honoree and Flanagan was named to the All-Rookie Team.
- Addisyn Cross was awarded Patriot League All-Defensive team honors for the second straight year for her defensive prowess.

### ALL FOR ONE AND ONE FOR ALL:

- Holy Cross welcomes three newcomers in 2023-24: guard Janie Bachmann, forward Simone Lewis and guard Hannah Griffin.
- Bachmann, an athletic combo guard played four seasons of varsity basketball at Saint John Vianney under head coach Dawn Karpell. Bachmann helped lead Saint John Vianney to their fourth straight conference championship and a state championship and tournament of champions in 2021-22.
- Lewis is a physical forward with length. A two-time team captain, Lewis played four seasons of varsity at Georgetown Visitation Prep under head coach Mike McCarthy. Lewis captured the Independent School League (ISL AA) Championship in 2019-20, earned All-League ISL First Team, All-State (D.C.) First Team honors in 2021-22 and was a Washington Post All-Met Honorable Mention honoree in 2021-22.
- Griffin is a facilitator and played four seasons of varsity at Gwynedd Mercy Academy under head coach Tom Lonnergan. A two-time team captain (2022, 2023), Griffin was the conference MVP as a senior and First Team All-conference as a junior. Griffin is a three-time district champion. She is the daughter of Cindy Griffin, the women's basketball head coach at Saint Joseph's.

### MAGARITY:

- Maureen Magarity enters her fourth season at the helm in 2023-24. Magarity brings a combined 22 years of Division I playing and coaching experience to The Hill, and served as the head coach of the University of New Hampshire from 2010-2020.
- Magarity recorded her 200th career win on Nov. 29, 2023, a 59-32 win at Stonehill. She posted her 50th win as Crusader head coach on Mar. 9, 2023 in the Patriot League Semifinals against no. 3 Lehigh winning 71-54.
- On November 3, 2022 Associate Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics, Kit Hughes announced that Coach Magarity and Holy Cross agreed on a new three-year contract extension to keep Magarity as head coach of the program through the 2027-28 season.
- In year four with the Crusaders, Magarity led the program to back-to-back Patriot League Tournament Championships, their 13th overall and 13th Patriot League Regular Season Championship which was their second over the last three years. Holy Cross also led the conference with three All-League selections (Bronagh Power-Cassidy, Janelle Allen, Cara McCormack).
- In her third season as bench boss Magarity's Crusaders captured their 12th overall Patriot League Championship defeating Boston University 66-61 on Mar. 12, 2023. The team also earned the 23rd 20+ win season in program history and back-to-back 20 win seasons for the first time since the 2001-02 and 2002-03 seasons.
- In 2023-24, the Crusaders won nine straight games from Dec. 17 to Jan. 24 (vs. Northeastern, vs. Merrimack, vs. Bucknell, vs. Army, at Navy, vs. Lehigh, at Lafayette, at Loyola, vs. American) making it the longest win streak under Magarity's leadership.
- The 13 point comeback victory against Lehigh on Jan. 11, 2023 was the biggest come from behind win in the Maureen Magarity era and it was matched in 2023-24 in the Crusaders home opener against Brown.

- In her second year as leader of the Crusaders, Magarity was named the Patriot League Coach of the Year after guiding Holy Cross to a 20-9 overall record, the 22nd 20-plus win season and program history and a 14-4 mark in conference play with the 14 victory a new program conference win record.
- The 2017 Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, she recorded 146 wins during her tenure in Durham – the second most by a head coach in program history.

### COACHING STAFF:

- Joining the Crusaders for the 2023-24 season is assistant coaches, Candice Green and Paige Corkins and director of basketball operations Ryan Weise.
- Green comes to Worcester following four seasons at Fordham including a year as the interim head coach in 2022-23 where she amassed a 19-13 overall mark and a 10-6 record in Atlantic-10 action. Fordham qualified for the WNIT in 2023 and defeated Drexel 73-63 in the opening round before falling to Columbia 78-73. No stranger to the Patriot League Green played in 111 career games at Colgate before spending three years as an assistant coach and one as the director of operations.
- Magarity's former player at New Hampshire, Kat Fogarty, an All-America East selection in 2017 enters her fourth season on the Crusader coaching staff.
- Corkins comes from Fordham after spending her first season as a video analyst in 2021-22 and adding director of player development to her responsibilities for the 202-23 season.
- Weise arrived at Holy Cross for her first season following a spring internship with Division II East Stroudsburg women's basketball.

### THE SEASON BEFORE THE SEASON:

- Holy Cross was selected to finish first in the Patriot League in a preseason coaches' poll.
- The 2022-23 tournament champion Crusaders earned 160 points and 16 out of a possible 18 first place votes for the top slot in the rankings. Boston University (141 points, two first place votes) and Colgate (121) are projected for a second and third place finish.
- The remaining teams in the Patriot League were ranked as follows: Lehigh (111), American (90, two first place votes), Bucknell (79), Army West Point (69), Lafayette (60), Loyola (Md.) (40) and Navy (29).
- Caitlin Weimar of Boston University was named the Patriot League Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Weimar on the Preseason All-Patriot League team were American's Emily Johns, Colgate's Taylor Golembiewski, Holy Cross' Bronagh Power-Cassidy and Loyola (Md.)'s Lex Therien.
- Weimar was also selected as the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

# MAUREEN MAGARITY

## Head Coach • 4th Season

Maureen Magarity enters her fourth season as the head women's basketball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in 2023-24. Magarity is the seventh coach in program history and arrived on Mount St. James after spending 10 years as head coach at the University of New Hampshire. While at Holy Cross, Magarity has coached the Crusaders to a 71-40 (.640) record and a 45-23 (.662) mark in Patriot League play through four campaigns.

In just four seasons, Magarity has restored the storied tradition of the Holy Cross women's basketball program. She has guided the Crusaders to back-to-back Patriot League Tournament Championships (2023, 2024) and appearances in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2023, 2024). Holy Cross also has recorded three consecutive 20 win seasons under Magarity's tenure while in 2022-23, the Crusaders recorded the second most wins (24) in a single season in program history and in 2023-24, the Crusaders set the program record for wins at home in the Hart Center Arena (15).

Year four of the Magarity era in 2023-24 yielded the 13th Patriot League Tournament Championship in program history and the 13th Patriot League Regular Season Championship which their second over the last three seasons (2021-22). On Nov. 29, 2023, Magarity recorded her 200th career victory, a 59-32 decision at Stonehill.

With Magarity at the helm, the Crusaders take pride on the defensive side of the ball. Magarity has coached two Patriot League All-Defensive team selections (Avery LaBarbera) and the first two-time selection in program history (Addisyn Cross). Holy Cross finished the 2021-22 season ranked second in the Patriot League in scoring defense (56.5) which ranked 19th in the NCAA.

During 2022-23, Magarity recorded her 50th victory at Holy Cross defeating Lehigh 71-54 in the Patriot League Tournament Semifinals en route to the conference championship. Holy Cross also recorded an eight game win streak, the longest in Magarity's tenure and the Crusaders tallied seven multiple possession comeback victories (seven or more points) including a 13-point third quarter comeback against Lehigh (Jan. 11, 2023).

In her second season on The Hill, Magarity was named the 2021-22 Patriot League Coach of the Year guiding the Crusaders to the 22nd 20-win season in program history and the first Patriot League regular-season championship since 2004-05. The Crusaders set the team record with 14 conference wins and made the WNIT Tournament for the first time since 2002.

Magarity earned her first win at Holy Cross against Army West Point against her father, Dave—in what was believed to be the first father-daughter coaching matchup in Division I history. In her first season on The Hill, Magarity led the Crusaders to their first win over Boston University since the 2018-19 season and the No. 5 seed in the Patriot League Tournament.

Under Magarity's tutelage, Bronagh Power-Cassidy was an All-Patriot League second team selection and was joined by classmate Janelle Allen on the All-League third team in 2022-23. Guards Kaitlyn Flanagan (All-Rookie Team) and Addisyn Cross (All-Defensive Team) earned honors in 2022-23 as well. In 2021-22, Avery LaBarbera was named the Patriot League Player of the Year and to the All-First Team while Addisyn Cross was an All-Defensive team selection. LaBarbera also earned 2021-22 ECAC Second Team honors as well. Bronagh Power-Cassidy was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Year and to the All-Rookie Team in 2020-21. Additionally, Avery LaBarbera earned a spot on the All-Patriot League Second Team and All-Defensive Team, while Cara McCormack joined Power-Cassidy as an All-Rookie Team honoree.

Magarity brings a combined 21 years of Division I playing and coaching experience to The Hill, and has served as the head coach of the University of New Hampshire since 2010. The 2017 Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, she recorded 146 wins during her tenure in Durham – the second most by a head coach in program history.

The architect of a program-changing turnaround in Durham, Magarity made an instant impact upon arriving at UNH, posting winning records in three of her first five seasons and leading the Wildcats to the program's first winning season since 2005-06. She would go on to take a program that won just 33 games in the four years prior to her arrival and guide it to a 93-60 record from 2013-18, including a combined 45 wins from 2016-18, the most victories in a two-year span in UNH's history.

In 2016-17, Magarity led UNH to a 26-6 record en route to an America East regular-season title, also marking the program's first 20-win season in more than 33 years and the second-biggest turnaround in Division I that season. The Wildcats recorded a school-record 13 consecutive victories and won 19 of their final 20 regular-season games on their way to the program's first title since 1985. For its efforts, the team was awarded its first WNIT berth since 1999. Magarity, in addition to being named the Kay Yow National Coach of the Year, earned 2017 America East Coach of the Year honors, and was a finalist for the WBCA National Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 season also saw great success, with the team going 19-12 overall. Both the Class of 2017 and the Class of 2018 posted 74-48 career records, marking the winningest senior classes in program history. In total, Magarity saw 18 all-conference selections in her time at the helm in Durham, including the 2017 America East Player of the Year (Carlie Pogue) and 2019 America East Rookie of the Year (Kari Brekke).

Magarity is no stranger to the Patriot League, having spent four seasons on the coaching staff at Army West Point from 2006-10, including the 2009-10 season as associate head coach. In Magarity's four seasons at West Point, the Black Knights posted an overall record of 72-48, including a program-best 24-win campaign during the 2006-07 season. The Black Knights averaged 20 wins in each of her first three seasons on the staff, the best three-year span in program history.

Her coaching career began at Marist, where she was an assistant during the 2004-05 season. That season, the Red Foxes finished with a 22-7 record, the most wins in program history, and earned the regular-season MAAC title. Before joining the Army staff, Magarity also spent one season as an assistant at Fairfield.

Magarity played three seasons at Marist from 2001-04, serving as team captain her junior and senior seasons and leading the Red Foxes to their first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2004. She garnered two All-MAAC Second Team selections and was a 2004 MAAC All-Tournament Team honoree. She earned two MAAC Scholar-Athlete awards (2002, 2004) and received the James Pizzani Award for dedication and loyalty as a senior. Magarity began her collegiate playing career in 1999-00 at Boston College, where the Eagles reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Magarity earned a B.A. in communications and public relations from Marist in 2003 before earning her Master's degree in public administration while at Marist in 2005.

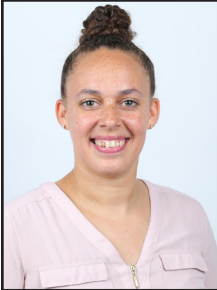
