UTRGV Knocks Off North Florida

Dec. 12, 2016 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team knocked off two-time defending Atlantic Sun Conference Champion University of North Florida (UNF) 98-84. Sophomore **Antonio Green** led UTRGV (4-8) with 24 points while going 8-for-12 from behind the arc, tying for the third-highest single-game three-pointer output in program history. Green now has 52 three-pointers this season, the most in the NCAA. He is also averaging 4.33 three-pointers per game, which also leads the NCAA. Junior **Nick Dixon** scored 22 points on 8-of-11 shooting, including 5-of-5 from the line, with seven assists and three steals. Sophomore **Lew Stallworth** scored 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting with four assists and two steals. **Dallas Moore** led UNF (3-9) with 24 points on 10-of-23 shooting. **Garrett Sams** scored 17 point. **Karlos Odum** finished with 11 points, nine rebounds, three assists and two steals. UNF led 4-3 at the outset on an **Aaron Bodager** layup, but junior **Mike Hoffman** and Green hit three-pointers as part of a 10-2 run to put UTRGV up 13-6. Then, with the lead cut to 17-14, freshman **Xavier McDaniel Jr.** hit a jumper to help UTRGV score seven in a row to go up 24-14. After Odum, Moore and **Wajid Aminu** all made layups to bring UNF within 24-20, Dixon converted a three-point play and then hit three more free throws as UTRGV scored 14-straight points to go up 38-20. UTRGV then extended the run to 24-7, capped by a Green three that made it 48-27 late in the first half. UTRGV took its largest lead of the game with 14:38 remaining when a Green three made it 71-42. UNF scored the next 13 points to pull within 71-55 on a Moore layup, but freshman **Lesley Varner Jr.** and junior McAllen-native **Moe McDonald** answered with baskets to put the game away.

UTRGV Uses Three-Point Barrage to Beat Texas State

Dec. 7, 2016 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team shot a season-high .481 from behind the arc to beat Texas State 72-61. UTRGV (3-8) finished 13-for-27 from behind the arc, marking the second-most three-pointers UTRGV has hit in a game and the most in a regulation game this season. Sophomore **Antonio Green** led UTRGV (2-8) with 20 points on 7-of-17 shooting, including 5-of-12 from behind the arc, with six rebounds and two assists. Junior **Nick Dixon** scored 14 points with three rebounds, five assists, one block and one steal. Junior **Mike Hoffman** finished with 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting. **Kavin Gildur-Tilbury** led Texas State (4-4) with 20 points on 8-of-16 shooting and seven rebounds. **Bobby Conley** scored 13 points with five rebounds. UTRGV jumped out to a 7-1 lead on a pair of Dixon baskets and a Green three-pointer. Then, after Texas State scored the next seven points to take its only lead, UTRGV scored 14-straight points as part of a 19-3 run to take a 26-11 lead at the 9:03 mark of the first half. During the run, UTRGV went 7-for-9 from the field while forcing six turnovers and holding Texas State 1-for-3. Texas State rebounded to score 11 in a row to pull within 26-22, but Green, junior **Dan Kimasa**, sophomore **Lew Stallworth** and Dixon all hit threes to power a 14-5 run that put UTRGV up 40-27 at the start of the second half. Then, with the score 42-29, Gilder-Tilbury scored seven points to power a 13-6 run that brought Texas State within 48-42. Texas State was still within six at 55-49 with 9:06 remaining, but Dixon and Green hit threes as part of a 10-1 run to push the game out of reach.

UTRGV Closes Road Trip with Double Overtime Loss at Portland

Dec. 5, 2016 at Chiles Center – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team closed out a seven-game road trip with a 90-89 double overtime loss to the University of Portland. It was UTRGV's first double overtime contest since Jan. 9, 2013. Sophomore **Antonio Green** led UTRGV (2-8) with 28 points on 10-of-26 shooting, including 5-of-14 from behind the arc, with seven rebounds. Junior **Nick Dixon** scored 22 points on 9-of-16 shooting with nine rebounds and five assists. Junior **Gage Loy** scored a career-high 14 points on 6-of-11 shooting, including 2-of-6 from behind the arc, with four rebounds. **Alex Wintering** led Portland (5-3) with 24 points, nine rebounds and seven assists. **De'Marques Tyson** hit seven three-pointers en route to 21 points. **Jazz Johnson** scored 19 points with six rebounds and five assists. **Gabe Taylor** scored 16 points with seven rebounds. UTRGV jumped out to a 6-2 lead on baskets by Dixon, junior **Dan Kimasa** and Green, but Portland scored the next nine points as part of a 13-3 run to go up 15-9. Portland still led by six at 22-16 on a Wintering three-point play with 7:21 remaining in the first half. Green followed with a three and a layup to bring UTRGV within one and then hit another layup to bring UTRGV within 24-23. UTRGV tied the game at 28 on a Dixon jumper with 4:02 left in the half before taking a 31-30 lead on a Dixon three-point play two and a half minutes later. Green and Loy made baskets in the first minute of the second half to push UTRGV's lead to 35-30. Portland pulled within on at 39-38 on a Tyson three, but UTRGV responded with an 11-3 run to take a 50-41 lead. Portland followed with an 11-5 run to climb within 55-52 before Green hit back-to-back three-pointers to push UTRGV's lead back to nine. UTRGV extended its lead to 13 at 67-54 on a dunk by junior **Adonis Rwabigwi** with 6:53 remaining, but Portland went on a 19-6 run to tie the game at 73 on a **Joseph Smoyer** dunk with 0.8 seconds left in regulation. UTRGV led late in the first overtime, going up 82-80 on a Loy layup, but Johnson hit a driving layup with 6.5 seconds remaining to tie the game. UTRGV went up 87-86 late in the second overtime before a Tyson three gave Portland the lead with 49.6 seconds left. After a timeout, Green missed a three from the top of the key, but Dixon grabbed the rebound in the lane and went to the basket for the layup to put UTRGV ahead 89-88 with 22.1 seconds to go. Then, with time winding down, Wintering drove to the basket and missed the layup, but Taylor grabbed the rebound underneath the basket and came up with the game-winning putback with two seconds left.

Series Notes: Janari Joesaar scored a career-high 29 points in a home win (12/13/14) ... **Shaquille Hines** posted his first double-double (18p, 11r) to help snap a seven-game road losing streak against Lamar (11/27/13) ... **Lauri Toivonen** scored a career-high 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting in a home win (12/15/12) ... Played against each other in the American South Conference from 1987-88 through 1990-91, meaning a home and home every year plus the potential to meet in the conference tournament. PAU and UTPA were 4-4 against Lamar in conference play and 1-0 in conference tournaments ... Completed a three-game sweep of Lamar in 1989-90 ... Played against each other in the Sun Belt from 1991-92 through 1997-98. UTPA was 3-8 against Lamar in conference play and 0-1 in conference tournaments ... UTRGV is 28-41 against the Cardinals since becoming an NCAA Division I program in 1968-69.

December 2, 2015 at Montagne Center – UTRGV fell to Lamar 83-60. **J.J. Thompson** led UTRGV with a career-high 21 points on 7-of-10 shooting, including 3-of-5 from behind the arc, with four assists. with **Shaquille Hines** scored 16 points with four assists. **Nick Garth** led Lamar with 21 points while going 5-for-7 from behind the arc. **Dorian Chatman** scored 14 points with five rebounds. **Marcus Owens** scored 12 points with five rebounds. **Dontavious Sears** scored 11 points with 10 rebounds. Down 2-0 in the opening seconds, UTRGV took the lead on a Hines jumper and a three-point play by **Dakota Slaughter**. Then, with the game tied at 5, a layup by **Adonis Rwabigwi** gave UTRGV the lead again, but Lamar outscored UTRGV 45-15 over the next 19:21 to pull away with a 50-22 lead. During the run, Lamar went 12-for-26 from the field, 5-for-11 from behind the arc, and 16-for-23 from the line with seven steals, while UTRGV went 4-for-21 from the field, 1-for-6 from behind the arc, and 6-for-13 from the line with one steal. Lamar built its largest lead at 69-32 on a Sears dunk. Thompson responded with a free throw and then a three as UTRGV scored eight-straight as part of a 19-7 run to pull within 76-51 with four minutes left, but that's as close as they got.

November 30, 2015 at Hofheinz Pavilion – **Shaquille Hines** became the 24th student-athlete in program history to score at least 1,000-career points as UTRGV fell to Houston 78-65. In his 100th career game, Hines finished with 22 points on 8-of-13 shooting, including 2-of-5 from behind the arc, to increase his career total to 1,013, eight behind **Steve Heard** (1957-61) for 23rd place in program history. Hines also grabbed four rebounds to move within eight of 500 for his career. **Antonio Green** also reached double-figures, scoring 15 points on 5-of-11 shooting, including 3-of-8 from behind the arc, with five rebounds. **Devonta Pollard** led Houston with 24 points and 12 rebounds. **Rob Gray Jr.** scored 15 points. **Damyean Dotson** scored 11 points with 10 rebounds. **Ronnie Johnson** scored 11 points with four rebounds and three assists. Johnson hit a layup and a three as Houston jumped out to a 5-0 lead. UTRGV came back to tie the game at 9 on a Hines layup before taking their first lead at 14-13 on a Hines three-pointer. Houston responded with a 12-2 run to go up 25-16, but a Green three brought UTRGV within two possessions, and a three-point play by **Dan Kimasa** brought UTRGV within 27-25. Houston scored the next five points, but a layup and a three-pointer by Hines helped UTRGV tie the game at 34. Early in the second half, UTRGV was down 41-39, but a jumper and a three by Green powered a 6-0 run to give UTRGV the lead. A Johnson three, a Pollard layup and a Gray three, however, put Houston back on top 49-45. UTRGV regained the lead midway through the half when a Hines layup made it 54-53, but Houston scored the next eight points as part of a 16-2 run to push the game out of reach.

UTRGV Athletics hired Lew Hill, who spent the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, as the new UTRGV men's basketball head coach on March 31, 2016.

Oklahoma is currently 29-7 (.806) and has compiled a 111-56 (.665) record during Hill's tenure, including four-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament.

The 2015-16 season was Hill's 12th working with former Pan American University head coach Lon Kruger, after spending seven seasons as an assistant coach at UNLV from 2004-11. During that time, UNLV went 161-71 (.694) while making six postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Prior to his time at UNLV, Hill was an assistant coach at Texas A&M for five seasons (1998-2003) and associate head coach (2003-04) for one. He previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at East

Carolina (1994-98) and two years as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1992-94).

Hill began his coaching career at Wichita East High School as the head coach of the JV boys' basketball team and an assistant coach with the varsity team in 1989-90. He followed that up by moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at South Alabama (1990-92).

Hill was an All-American point guard for San Jacinto Junior College in 1983-84, helping the Ravens to the national championship. He went on to earn All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades in 1987-88 as a senior at Wichita State while helped the Shockers to a 20-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

The Mount Vernon, N.Y., native was an all-state performer at Mount Vernon High School. After graduating from Wichita State in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, he played professionally in Germany for one season before beginning his coaching career.

Hill and his wife, Renee, have two children: a son, Lewis Jr., and a daughter, Elle. Hill also has three other daughters, Sierra, Erica and Asya.
