The scoring got started in the bottom of the first when senior **Cole Loncar** hit an RBI triple to left center field that allowed **Jose Garcia** to come in and score giving the Vaqueros (5-8) the 1-0 lead. Garcia hit a one-out triple in the bottom of the third and then came in to score on a sacrifice fly by **Victor Garcia Jr.** that pushed UTRGV's lead to 2-0. Vaqueros Drop Series Finale at Lamar

March 6, 2016 at Vincent-Beck Stadium – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Vaqueros baseball dropped the finale of a three-game series against the Lamar University Cardinals 4-1. The Vaqueros (4-8) piled up 12 hits, including 11 in 5.1 innings against Cardinals (9-4) starter **Billy Love**, but the only hit that resulted in a run came in the fourth, when junior **Victor Garcia Jr.** singled to right to bring home senior **Cole Loncar** and make it 1-0. Garcia finished 3-for-4. Juniors **Joseph Collazo** and **Jose Garcia** and freshman **Anthony Gomez** had two hits each. The Vaqueros threatened again in the sixth, loading the bases with one out, but **Brett Brown** (1-0) came in and got a double play to escape the threat. Sophomore Nikki Rowe alum **Ryan Jackson** (0-3) only allowed one hit over the first three innings, but the Cardinals put runners on the corners with one out in the fourth to set-up a game-tying single by **Robin Adames**. The Cardinals scored the rest of their runs in the sixth, as with two on and nobody out, Adames hit an RBI-double, **Jacoby Middleton** hit an RBI-single, and then, one out later, **Ryan Erickson** hit an RBI-single to complete the scoring. Junior **Eddie Delgado** silenced the Cardinals after that, pitching 1.2 innings of one-hit relief. Junior Nikki Rowe alum **Andrew Padron** finished up with a scoreless inning, striking out one.

Vaqueros Even Series at Lamar

March 5, 2016 at Vincent-Beck Stadium – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Vaqueros baseball team won the middle game of a three-game series with the Lamar University Cardinals 7-3. Junior **Jose Garcia** led the Vaqueros (4-7) offensively by going 3-for-4 with two doubles, an RBI and two runs scored. Junior **Austin Oakes** went 2-for-5 with a double, a career-high three RBI and a run scored. All three RBI came in the eighth when, with the game tied at 2, Oakes hit a bases-clearing double to put the Vaqueros on top. One batter later, Oakes scored on a sacrifice fly by senior **Correy Davis** to make it 6-2. That made a winner of junior **Andrew Garcia** (1-1), who pitched a complete game, allowing three runs (two earned) on 11 hits (eight singles) while striking out four. He threw 82 of his 121 (67.8 percent) pitches for strikes. The Vaqueros took their first lead right away, as after junior **Joseph Collazo** was plunked to start the first, Garcia doubled and senior **Cole Loncar** came up with an RBI-single to make it 1-0. The Cardinals (8-4) responded in the second when **Robin Adames** reached on a two-out error, leading to a single by **Reid Russell** and an RBI-single by **Ryan Erickson** to tie the game. The Cardinals took the lead in the third on a one-out double by **Bryndan Arrendondo** that made it 2-1. In the mean time, **Jayson McKinley** retired 13-straight Vaqueros and 14 of 15, but Collazo led off the sixth by reaching on an error and Garcia doubled to left-center to tie the game at 2. McKinley lasted six innings, scattering four hits while striking out four. **Fernando Martinez** (1-2) took over and pitched a scoreless seventh, but walked Collazo to lead off the eighth. **Enrique Oquenedo** came in and plunked Garcia and walked Loncar, setting up Oakes' double. The Vaqueros added a run in the ninth when Loncar grounded into a double play with runners on the corners and nobody out. The Cardinals got the run back with two outs in the ninth on a **Chaneng Valera** double.

With the Broncs' lead cut to 6-3 in the eighth, senior **Logan Landon** grounded into a fielder's choice to bring home senior Edinburg alum **Lee Rios** and complete the scoring. Freshman **George Lamb** (1-0) earned his first-career win by pitching the first 2.2 innings, allowing one run on two hits. He was one of four Broncs to pitch at least two innings, as freshman Nikki Rowe alum **Ryan Jackson** struck out three while allowing one hit in 2.1 innings, sophomore Nikki Rowe alum **Andrew Padron** allowed two unearned runs on three hits in two innings, and freshman Harlingen South alum **Zach Martinez** finished up with two innings of one-hit ball.

- The Vaqueros play six games against teams that reached the 2015 NCAA Tournament, including at home against Houston Baptist on Feb. 27. The Vaqueros then visit TCU on March 1 and Texas on April 19 before hosting defending WAC Tournament Champion CSU Bakersfield May 6-8.

2015 Team Notes

- The team had five freshman pitchers, **Johnny Gonzalez**, **Ryan Jackson**, **George Lamb**, **Zach Martinez**, and **Robert Quinonez**, combine for 196.2 innings (43.8 percent of the team total) across 71 appearances (17 starts), going 7-12 with four saves and a 4.53 ERA. The freshmen combined to strikeout 149 while walking 78 and allowing 224 hits. Jackson, who earned WAC Pitcher of the Week honors after his first start, led the team with 58 strikeouts while Quinonez ranked second with 57.
- Ryan Jackson** had a streak of 12.1 scoreless innings, including six-straight scoreless outings snapped at New Mexico State (5/8). From April 7, when Jackson became a full-time member of the bullpen, through May 3, Jackson made nine appearances, eight of which were scoreless, compiling a 1.37 ERA and 1.22 WHIP while striking out 21 in 19.2 innings.

- Andrew Padron** finished the season with seven saves, tied for the third-highest single-season total in program history. Padron now has nine-career saves, tied for the fifth-highest total.
- Jaocb Huckabay** went 13-for-38 (.342) dating back to his third at-bat against Chicago State (4/18) through his first at-bat against Utah Valley (5/14). During those 12, Huckabay has raised his average from .168 to .210.
- The team used the same lineup four times in a row and four times in the same season from March 15-20 for the first time since prior to 2012. The team has since repeated one other lineup four times. The team used 41 different unique lineups in 52 games, including 12 in each of their first 12 games. From April 5, 2014, March 10, 2015, the team used 36 different unique lineups in 36 games. That was the end of a stretch that saw the team use the same lineup three times in a season for the first time since 2012. Before that, the team had used 61 different unique lineups in a row dating back to 2013. The team has only repeated 14 lineups, not necessarily consecutively, in 215 games since 2012, using 196 unique lineups in that time.

Alumni in Affiliated Minor League Baseball

- Outfielder **Logan Landon** (2014-15), a 10th round pick of the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2015 MLB Draft, split his rookie season between three teams, including the Great Lakes Loons (Midwest, Class A), Ogden Raptors (Pioneer, Class R+), and Arizona League Dodgers (Arizona League, Class R). Overall, Landon hit .273 (35-for-128)/.354/.391 with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 RBI and 23 runs scored in 35 games. He drew almost as many walks (15) as strikeouts (19) and was successful in all five of his stolen base attempts.
- Left-handed pitcher **Alex Henson** (2014-15), who signed with the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim as an undrafted free agent, spent the 2015 season with the Arizona League Angels, going 2-1 with a 2.76 ERA. In 13 relief appearances, Henson pitched 32.2 innings striking out 26 while walking nine and allowing 32 hits. He posted a 1.26 WHIP and held opponents to a .256 batting average.
- Right-handed pitcher **Sam Street** (2013-14), a 16th round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 2014 MLB Draft, played for the Western Virginia Power (South Atlantic League, Class A) last season, going 3-1 with six saves and a 2.10 ERA. In 34 relief appearances Street pitched 85.2 innings, striking out 72 while walking 13 and allowing 83 hits for a WHIP of 1.12 and opponents average of .252. Street played for the Jamestown Jammers (New York-Penn League, Class A-) in 2014, earning NYPL All-Star honors after going 1-1 with five saves and 0.98 ERA. In 27.2 innings, he struck out 21 while allowing just 13 hits and four walks for a 0.61 WHIP. He held opponents to a .135 batting average. Shortly after the season ended, Street was invited to take part in the Pirates' instructional league in Bradenton, Fla. Street went on to pitch for Team Australia in the inaugural U21 Baseball World Cup, pitching a perfect inning for a hold against Japan.
- Right-handed pitcher **Dusten Knight** (2012-13), a 28th round pick of the San Francisco Giants in the 2013 MLB Draft, played for the Augusta GreenJackets (South Atlantic League, Class A) last season, going 7-3 with three saves and a 2.69 ERA. In 38 games (one start), Knight pitched 73.2 innings, striking out 86 while walking 24 and allowing 58 hits for a 1.11 WHIP and .212 opponents batting average. Knight played for the Salem-Keizer Volcanoes of the Northwest League in 2014, going 1-3 with one save and a 3.65 ERA. Manny Mantrana

Head Coach

Manny Mantrana has been the head baseball coach of the program for seven seasons. He spent the previous 12 seasons at Saint Thomas University, earning induction into their Hall of Fame and having his jersey retired in 2013-14.

2015: Led team to 8-3 start ... Helped convert senior All-WAC Second Team selection **Logan Landon** from a pitcher back into an outfielder, where he hadn't played regularly since college. Landon hit .382, third best in the WAC and 21st in the NCAA, with an on-base percentage of .476, second best in the WAC and 29th in the NCAA, and a slugging percentage of .623, second best in the WAC and 45th in the NCAA. He ranked among the WAC leaders in every other offensive category as well ... Utilized five freshman pitchers, had five freshmen pitchers, **Johnny Gonzalez**, **Ryan Jackson**, **George Lamb**, **Zach Martinez**, and **Robert Quinonez**, who combine for 196.2 innings (43.8 percent of the team total) across 71 appearances (17 starts), going 7-12 with four saves and a 4.53 ERA. The freshmen combined to strikeout 149 while walking 78 and allowing 224 hits. Jackson, who earned WAC Pitcher of the Week honors after his first start, led the Team with 58 strikeouts while Quinonez ranked second with 57.

2014: Led team to third-straight No. 2 seed in a conference tournament, as the Team went 17-10 in their first season in the Western Athletic Conference ... The Team won each of their final seven WAC series, including taking two out of three from eventual WAC Champion Sacramento State, while completing two sweeps ... Coached team to 3-1 win at No. 15 Oklahoma State (3/14) ... Helped develop **Sam Street** into the WAC Pitcher of the Year and one of the final 18 candidates for the National Pitcher of the Year award. Street led the NCAA in complete games and ranked second in wins. He also led the WAC in every major pitching category, becoming the first triple crown winner since 2011 ... Coached right fielder/catcher **Alex Howe**, an All-WAC First Team selection who led the Team in almost every offensive category and was among the WAC and NCAA leaders as well.

2013: Led the Team to their best-ever finish in Great West Conference (GWC) play, going 17-10 to finish in second place ... Included a program record seven road wins in GWC play ... The Team won 10 total road games, their highest total since 2008 (11) ... The Team also won their first 10 home GWC games ... Overall, the Team won 28 games and finished with their highest RPI (211) since 2007 (198) ... Coached pitcher **Dusten Knight**, who was drafted by the San Francisco Giants in the 28th round of that year's MLB Draft.

2012: Led the Team to the first winning season in 12 years, going 30-22 ... The season included a 21-6 record at home and a 16-12 record in GWC games ... The Team earned the number two seed in the Great West Conference Tournament ... Led team to 5-2 win at No. 8 Texas A&M (3/14) ... Mantrana also coached a .400 hitter for the second time in his tenure at UTPA, as **Roger Bernal** hit .414, the fourth highest average in program history. In 2010, Mantrana coached **Garrett Blvone** to a .428 average, the second highest in program history ... Coached third baseman/outfielder **Angel Ibanez**, who was drafted by the Houston Astros in the 28th round of that year's MLB Draft ... Also coached pitcher **Michael Zouzalik**, who signed with the Texas Rangers organization over the summer.

2008-11: Mantrana signed a contract extension on May 24, 2011 to remain in Edinburg for at least another three years. The program has come a long way since Mantrana's arrival in late September of 2008, when the program had only twenty-one players on the roster and no coaching staff.

1997-2008 (Saint Thomas University): Mantrana came to the Rio Grande

Valley after serving 12 seasons as head baseball coach at Saint Thomas University in Miami Gardens, Florida. During his tenure, Mantrana quadrupled, from one to four, the program's number of trips to the College World Series. He was the winningest coach in STU history with a 451-220-1 (.672) record, including a 1997 season that ended with a program-record 54 victories. In addition to being the head coach, Mantrana served as the hitting and pitching coach for eight of his 12 seasons. Mantrana's squads appeared in three College World Series, and nine total postseasons. He was recognized as Southeast Coach of the Year on three occasions and also received Florida Sun Conference Coach of the Year honors three times. In 1997, Mantrana guided his first squad at STU to a Florida Sun Conference Tournament Championship, Southeast Region appearance and finished with a 44-16 record. Mantrana's second season as head coach of the Bobcats ended in his first trip to the College World Series. He also led STU to the Southeast Region Championship and Florida Sun Conference regular season and tournament championships while going 54-14. In 1999 and 2000, Mantrana led his squad to two more Florida Sun Conference Tournament Championships and Southeast Region Tournaments. The 2000 squad made it to the World Series with a 43-14 record after winning the Super Regional Tournament as well as the regular season and tournament championships for the Florida Sun Conference. His 2007 squad earned a College World Series appearance with a 46-16-1 record and added Florida Sun Conference and Southeast Region Tournament Championships. More than 45 of Mantrana's players have received All-Conference or All-Region accolades with 20 of those players signing professional contracts. He also coached ten All-Americans, including five All-American scholar athletes. Additionally, approximately 95% of players who attended STU for four years earned a degree. Mantrana's players continue to perform extremely well in the classroom. Over half of the players recorded a 3.0 GPA or higher for the second straight year and his annual APR (Academic Progress Report) for student-athletes has been well above what the NCAA considers in good standing.

Early Coaching Career: Mantrana began his coaching career as head coach for his alma mater, Jackson High School in Miami, for four years. Mantrana then accepted an assistant coaching job at Miami-Dade Community College in 1995 under head coach Tony Simone where his responsibilities were coaching infielders and hitters while also serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Playing Career: Mantrana was an accomplished player for Miami-Dade College, Middle Georgia Community College and Louisiana State University. He was at Miami-Dade for one year before transferring to Middle Georgia where he helped lead his team to a second-place finish at the Junior College World Series. Mantrana was named to the JCWS All-Tournament team and was MVP of the region tournament as a second baseman. He spent the last two years of his college career at LSU under Hall of Fame coach Skip Bertman. Mantrana was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 10th round of the 1981 MLB Draft as a shortstop out of Jackson High School. Mantrana was drafted another three times during his collegiate career before signing a free agent contract with the Detroit Tigers. Mantrana also played for the New York Mets and Milwaukee Brewers organizations.

Education: Mantrana earned a bachelor's degree in Sports Administration from STU in 1990 and then earned his master's degree in Guidance and Counseling from STU in 1997. He has also started and is currently working toward a Doctor of Education in Leadership and Management.

Personal: Mantrana is married to the former Marlane Schwartz and has one daughter, Maxine.
