## Last Game

### Vaqueros Drop Regular Season Finale to New Mexico State

**March 5, 2016 at UTRGV Fieldhouse** – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Vaqueros men's basketball team closed out the season with an 83-44 loss to the New Mexico State University Aggies. Senior **Shaquille Hines** led the Vaqueros (8-21, 4-10 WAC) with 12 points to increase his career total to 1,316 and pass **Melvin Thomas** (1,306, 1987-90) and **Anthony Eatmon** (1,309, 1963-67) for seventh place in program history. Sophomore **Dan Kimasa** also reached double-figures, scoring 10 points with seven rebounds. **Pascal Siakam** led the Aggies (22-9, 13-1 WAC) with 24 points on 10-of-17 shooting and 10 rebounds. **Ian Baker** scored 11 points with five rebounds and six assists. **Tanveer Bhullar** scored 10 points with seven rebounds. The Vaqueros kept the game tight early, pulling within 8-5 on Kimasa's first-career three-pointer and 9-8 on a three by Hines. A Bhullar three-point play, however, sparked a 9-0 run as the Aggies pushed their lead out to 18-8 with 8:53 to play in the first half. A jumper by graduate student **Dakota Slaughter** and a one-hand jam by junior **Christopher Ikuenobe** kept the game within eight points, but Bhullar hit a pair of free throws at the 6:27 mark to kick off a 36-9 run that saw the Aggies go up 56-21 on a Siakam layup with 14:19 remaining in the second half. Hines and senior **Everett Osborne** hit back-to-back threes and graduate student **J.J. Thompson** made a layup to bring the Vaqueros within 58-31, but that's as close as they got.

## Previous Games

### Vaqueros Pick Up Win at Chicago State

**February 28, 2016 at Jones Convocation Center** – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Vaqueros men's basketball team beat the Chicago State University Cougars 89-79. Freshman **Antonio Green** led five Vaqueros (8-20, 4-9 WAC) in double-figures scoring with 22 points on 7-of-17 shooting, including 4-of-10 from behind the arc, with seven rebounds and four assists. Graduate student **Dakota Slaughter** scored 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including 4-of-7 from behind the arc, with five rebounds and four assists. Senior **Shaquille Hines** scored 19 points on 8-of-14 shooting, including 3-of-7 from behind the arc, with five rebounds and four assists. Junior **Christopher Ikuenobe** scored a career-high 14 points on 3-of-3 shooting from the field and 8-of-10 shooting from the line. Graduate student **J.J. Thompson** scored 12 points with six assists and three steals. The Vaqueros finished 11-for-32 from behind the arc. **Anthony Eaves** led three Cougars (4-26, 0-13 WAC) in double-figures scoring with 18 points, seven rebounds and five assists. **Trayvon Palmer** scored 17 points with eight rebounds. **Fred Sims Jr.** scored 12 points with five rebounds. The game was tight early, but with the lead at 9-7, the Vaqueros went on a 12-4 run to push their lead out to 10. The run was punctuated by a Hines dunk. The Cougars responded by scoring the next 12 points to take a 23-21 lead on a **Jawad Adekoya** layup at the 8:39 mark. The Vaqueros regained the lead at 27-26 on a Slaughter three, but the Cougars used a 7-0 run to jump back on top. The game stayed tight until the start of the second half, when a Slaughter three tied the game at 46 and sparked a 29-8 run that saw the Vaqueros go up 72-54. The Vaqueros scored the last 11 points of the run, capped by a Hines dunk. The Vaqueros went 11-for-15 from the field during the run, including 5-of-9 from behind the arc while holding the Cougars to 4-of-17 shooting, including 0-of-6 from behind the arc.

### Hines Moves into Top 10 in Scoring as Vaqueros Fall to CSU Bakersfield

**February 20, 2016 at UTRGV Fieldhouse** – Senior **Shaquille Hines** scored 13 points to move into the top 10 in scoring in program history, but the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley Vaqueros men's basketball team fell to the CSU Bakersfield Roadrunners 70-57. The effort propelled Hines past **Jim McGurk** (1,281 points, 1960-64) and **Mire Chatman** (1,282 points, 2000-02) into ninth place on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,285 points. Next on the list are **Melvin Thomas** (1987-90, 1,306 points) and **Anthony Eatmon** (1963-67, 1,309 points). Hines also recorded two blocks to up his career total to 72 and break a tie with **Matt Palmquist** (1996-00, 70 blocks) for third place in program history. Graduate student **J.J. Thompson** was one of two other Vaqueros (7-20, 3-9 WAC) in double-figures, scoring 12 points with six assists. Graduate student **Dakota Slaughter** scored 11 points with seven rebounds. **Kevin Mays** led the Roadrunners (19-8, 9-3 WAC) with 18 points and 13 rebounds. **Damiyne Durham** and **Jaylin Airington** each scored 12 points. The Roadrunners scored the first five points of the game, but a layup by senior **Everett Osborne** sparked a 7-0 run to give the Vaqueros the lead. The game stayed within one possession until late in the first half. The Vaqueros led 20-17, but a deep three by Durham sparked a 14-2 run that gave the Roadrunners a 31-22 lead. After Hines hit a pair of free throws, though, sophomore **Ot Elmore** nailed a three at the halftime buzzer to make it 31-27. Thompson hit a pair of early threes in the second to cap what became a 13-0 run and give the Vaqueros a 35-31 lead. The Roadrunners, however, responded by scoring 12-straight points as part of a 27-7 run to take a 58-42 lead with 6:12 remaining.

**February 18, 2016 at UTRGV Fieldhouse** – UTRGV hit a season-high tying 11 three-pointers to beat Seattle U 67-57. **Shaquille Hines** led three Vaqueros in double-figures scoring with 22 points on 8-of-17 shooting, including a career-high tying 5-of-7 from behind the arc, with six rebounds. **Dan Kimasa** posted his team-leading fourth double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds. **Ot Elmore** scored a career-high 11 points while hitting a career-high three three-pointers and dishing out a career-high six assists. **Jack Crook** led the Redhawks with 22 points on 10-of-15 shooting and 10 rebounds. **Brendan Westendorf** scored 14 points with a game-high four steals. **William Powell** scored 10 points with 13 rebounds. The Redhawks jumped out to an 11-2 lead over the first five minutes, holding the Vaqueros 1-of-7 from the field, including 0-for-4 from behind the arc. The Redhawks pushed their lead out to 15-5 with 13:01 remaining in the first half, but the Vaqueros scored eight-straight points as part of a 30-9 run to go up 32-22 on a Hines three late in the half. Hines scored 13 of his 18 first half points during the run as the Vaqueros went 11-for-14 from the field, including 6-for-8 from behind the arc, while forcing seven turnovers and assisting the Redhawks to 3-of-12 shooting, including 0-of-5 from behind the arc. The Vaqueros pushed their lead out to 14 early in the second half on a Hines layup that made it 46-32. Crook responded with nine points as the Redhawks went on a 15-4 run to pull within 50-47 with 5:00 remaining. The Redhawks were still within three at 53-50 with 2:22 to go, but Elmore hit back-to-back threes to push the game out of reach.

The game stayed within one possession until late in the first half. The Vaqueros led 20-17, but a deep three by Durham sparked a 14-2 run that gave the Roadrunners a 31-22 lead. After Hines hit a pair of free throws, though, **Ot Elmore** nailed a three at the halftime buzzer to make it 31-27. Thompson hit a pair of early threes in the second to cap what became a 13-0 run and give the Vaqueros a 35-31 lead. The Roadrunners, however, responded by scoring 12-straight points as part of a 27-7 run to take a 58-42 lead with 6:12 remaining.

- Rozanski and her husband, first year assistant coach **Marc Rozanski**, make up the only husband-wife duo on an NCAA Division I men's basketball coaching staff.

## WAC Freshman of the Year

- Freshman **Antonio Green** earned WAC Freshman of the Year honors after scoring in double figures in eight of the 12 WAC games in which he played, with 20 or more points twice. In conference games only, he led the WAC in minutes per game (35.17), ranked fifth in three-pointers per game (2.17), seventh in assist-turnover ratio (1.61), ninth in assists (3.08), 10<sup>th</sup> in defensive rebounds (4.08) and 16<sup>th</sup> in scoring (11.3).

UTRGV Athletics hired Dan Hipsher, who had been the associate head coach at Alabama for the previous four seasons, as the head coach of the men's basketball team on April 4, 2013.

**2014-15:** In second season with the team, played eight games against teams that went on to play in postseason tournaments, including two each against New Mexico State (NCAA), Seattle U (CBI) and Grand Canyon (CIT), and on each against Utah (NCAA), Sam Houston State (CIT) ... Led team to 3-0 start for the first time since 2006-07 ... Earned wins over the teams that finished second (Grand Canyon), third (Kansas City) and fourth (Seattle U) in the WAC ... Increase win total from previous season ... Won eight home games ... Brought in team's leading scorer and All-WAC Second Team honoree **Janari Joesaar**, who ranked second in the WAC in scoring (16.9 points per game) ... Coached freshman **Dan Kimasa** to All-WAC Defensive Team honors.

**2013-14:** In first season, took on a schedule that included 12 games against eventual playoff teams, including three against Utah Valley (NIT), two each against New Mexico State (NCAA) and Grand Canyon (CIT), and one each against SMU (NIT), Texas A&M (CBI), Sam Houston State (CIT), Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (CIT) and IPFW (CIT) ... Led team to five road wins, their highest total since 2007-08 ... Coached team to season sweeps of Chicago State and Kansas City, the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds in the WAC Tournament ... Brought in team's top two scorers as transfers over the summer, including **Javorn Farrell**, a fifth-year transfer from Massachusetts who averaged a team-high 16.1 points, ranked second in rebounds at 5.4, and tied for the team lead in assists at 3.3, and junior college transfer **Shaquille Boga**, who ranked second in scoring at 14.0, fourth in rebounds at 3.5, tied for first in assists at 3.3, and led the team in steals at 2.1 per game.

**Career:** Hipsher's knowledge and basketball acumen helped turn Alabama into one of the toughest defensive units in the country, while his eye for talent helped the Tide land a top-five recruiting class.

In 2012-13, Hipsher helped guide the Tide to a 23-13 record (12-7 SEC) and the NIT Quarterfinals.

In 2011-12, Alabama held 31 of its 33 opponents below their scoring average, allowing an average of 58.1 points per game. The Tide reached the 20-win mark for the second straight season, finishing with a 21-12 record, and made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2006.

In his second season at UA, Hipsher helped turn a team with an early 5-5 record into one that amassed a 25-12 record and captured the 2011 Southeastern Conference Western Division title. That same squad made UA's first postseason appearance in four seasons and advanced to the NIT Championship Game.

The veteran coach came to Alabama after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of South Florida (USF). Prior to joining the USF staff, Hipsher was an assistant coach at Arkansas, where he helped the Razorbacks to back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths.

Before serving as an assistant and associate at the high major ranks, Hipsher spent 15 years as a head coach. He started with four seasons at Division III Wittenberg, where he compiled a 97-18 (.843) record, four conference championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances. He led his team to the 1990 Elite 8 in his first season, earning NCAC Coach of the Year and NCAA Division III Great Lakes Region Coach of the Year honors.

He then moved on to Stetson University for two years, where he went 29-27 (.518), including 20-12 (.625) in Trans-America Athletic Conference play. Hipsher earned TAAC Coach of the Year honors in 1994-95 after winning the conference regular season championship.

Hipsher next began a nine-year stint as the head coach at the University of Akron in 1995-96, turning around a struggling program after just two seasons by going 17-10 (13-5 Mid-American Conference) in 1997-98 while earning MAC Coach of the Year honors. He led the Zips to records of 18-9 (12-6 MAC) and 17-11 (11-7 MAC) over the following two seasons.

Overall, Hipsher has a 247-205 (.546) record as a head coach, including 147-118 (.555) in conference contests. He has earned conference Coach of the Year honors three times and regional coach of the year twice.

Hipsher has shown an ability to create both offense and defense. In 1991-92, Wittenberg led the nation in field goal percentage defense, while in 2000-01, Akron led the nation in three-point shooting percentage.

Hipsher began his coaching career in 1977-78 as a graduate assistant at Miami University, where, while earning a master's in education, he helped the RedHawks to a 19-9 record (12-4 MAC), a MAC Championship, a MAC Tournament Championship, and a victory in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Hipsher then spent two seasons at Miami Dade Community College as an assistant coach and health and physical education instructor before returning to the NCAA Division I ranks as an assistant coach at Dayton under legendary head coach Don Donoher from 1980-89. The Flyers made five postseason appearances during that time, advancing as far as the NCAA Tournament Elite 8 in 1983-84.

In 36 seasons as a coach, Hipsher has an overall record of 582-457 (.560), including 226-198 (.533) in conference play. His teams have made 14 postseason appearances, including nine in the NCAA Tournament and five in the NIT.

Hipsher graduated from Bowling Green State University in 1977 with a bachelor's degree in chemistry and biology. He was a two-time captain and academic All-American for the Falcons.

The 61-year old Hipsher and his wife, Sue, are the parents of two sons, Andy (35) and Bryan (33). Both played collegiately for their father at Akron.
