### **UTRGV Knocks Off Defending WAC Champs**

January 11, 2018 at Icardo Center – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team knocked off defending Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Champion CSU Bakersfield (CSUB) 87-74. Winners of four in a row, UTRGV (10-8, 2-0 WAC) is off to its best start since 2006-07 (10-8). Senior Nick Dixon led UTRGV with 21 points on 5-of-11 shooting, including 2-of-5 from behind the arc, plus 9-of-9 from the line. Senior McAllen-native Moe McDonald scored a season-high tying 17 points on 5-of-6 shooting, including 3-of-4 from behind the arc, plus 4-of-4 from the line, with four rebounds and three steals. Junior Terry Winn scored a season-high 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting with four rebounds. Sophomore Xavier McDaniel Jr. scored 12 points with four rebounds. UTRGV shot a season-high .528 (28-for-53) from the field, marking the team's highest shooting percentage since Dec. 16, 2016 at Lamar (.587), and UTRGV's highest shooting percentage against a WAC opponent since 19 Jan. 24, 2015 against Grand Canyon (.552). Rickey Holden led CSUB (7-10, 0-2 WAC) with 18 points. Jarkel Joiner scored 12 points. Neither team led by more than two possessions during the first 27 minutes of the game, with UTRGV taking the largest leads during that span at 37-31 on a Dixon three near the end of the first half and 40-34 on a three by junior Lew Stallworth early in the second. CSUB took a 46-45 lead on a Justin McCall three with 15:28 remaining. UTRGV responded with a 10-1 run, capped by a McDonald jumper, to take the first three-possession lead at 55-47. UTRGV's lead was cut to six at 61-55 with 9:13 left on a Justin Davis layup before a Winn jumper sparked an 11-0 run to put UTRGV up 72-55. UTRGV took its largest at 80-60 on a McDonald layup with 4:03 remaining

### UTRGV Uses Hot Three-Point Shooting to Win WAC Opener

January 6, 2018 at Municipal Auditorium – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team shot a season-best .526 from behind the arc to beat UMKC 73-61 in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) opener. UTRGV (9-8, 1-0 WAC) finished 10-for-19 from behind the arc, marking the third time UTRGV has hit 10 or more three-pointers this season. The .526 shooting percentage was UTRGV's highest from behind the arc since Dec. 29, 2016, when UTRGV shot .528 (19-for-36) against Our Lady of the Lake, and UTRGV's highest against a WAC opponent since Jan. 25, 2013, when UTRGV shot .533 (8-for-15) at New Mexico State. Senior Nick Dixon led UTRGV with 24 points on 6-of-12 shooting, including a career-best 5-of-5 from behind the arc plus 7-for-7 from the line with five rebounds and three assists. Senior McAllen-native Moe McDonald scored 12 points on 5-of-12 shooting, including 2-of-5 from behind the arc. Freshman Javon Levi scored a career-high seven points with a career-high nine rebounds and six assists. Broderick Robinson led UMKC (5-12, 0-1 WAC) with 20 points and five rebounds. Jordan Giles and Isaiah Ross each finished with 12 points. The score was tied at 8 after eight minutes when McDonald and sophomore Xavier McDaniel Jr. made back-to-back threes to put UTRGV up six. Then, with UTRGV's lead cut to two late in the half, McDonald hit two jumpers and a three-pointer to fuel a 13-3 run to put UTRGV up 31-19 at intermission. UTRGV's opened the second half on a 7-2 run to go up 17 at 38-21 on a jumper by junior Johnny Crnogorac. UTRGV still led by 17 at 40-23 after a Levi jumper before UMKC went on a 15-3 to pull within five. Dixon responded with back-to-back three-pointers as part of an 8-0 run to put UTRGV up 51-38. UMKC got as close as 57-51 in the final minutes, but Dixon made five free throws and two three-pointers down the stretch to seal the victory.

### Seven Players Reach Double-Figures to Lead UTRGV Past Our Lady of the Lake

January 2, 2018 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – A season-high seven players reached double-figures in scoring to lead The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team past Our Lady of the Lake University (OLLU) 96-75. Sophomore Xavier McDaniel Jr. led UTRGV (8-8) with 17 points, six rebounds and two blocks. Senior Nick Dixon scored 14 points with a season-high seven assists. Junior Terry Winn posted his fifth-career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Sophomore Lesley Varner Jr. scored a season-high tying 14 points with two steals. Senior McAllen-native Moe McDonald scored 12 points with four rebounds and three assists. Senior Dan Kimasa scored 10 points with a season-high tying eight rebounds. Senior Mike Hoffman scored 10 points with four rebounds. Junior Lew Stallworth dished out a career-high tying 10 assists with a career-high tying seven rebounds. UTRGV dished out a season-high 26 assists, the team's highest total since Dec. 29, 2016 against Our Lady of the Lake (28). Courtney Julien led OLLU (9-5) with 19 points, five rebounds and four assists. Simon Shafack Jr. scored 11 points with eight rebounds and three assists. Yephnick Adelphonse scored 10 points with three steals. UTRGV hit 13 of its first 18 shots, including 4-of-8 from behind the arc to jump out to a 33-11 lead over the first 7:37. UTRGV scored the first eight points of the game, and then, with the lead cut to 11-7, UTRGV hit 8-of-10 shots, including 3-of-5 from behind the arc, to fuel a 22-4 run. UTRGV took its largest lead of the half with 9:18 remaining when a pair of Winn free throws made the score 38-14. OLLU followed with a 24-13 run to pull within 51-38 early in the second half, but UTRGV responded with a 19-6 run, capped by a Hoffman layup, to go up 70-44 and push the game out of reach.

Feb. 9, 2017 at GCU Arena – UTRGV fell to GCU 76-57. Nick Dixon led UTRGV with 23 points on 9-of-13 shooting. Antonio Green scored 10 points. Keonte Vernon led GCU with 18 points and 12 rebounds. Joshua Braun scored 17 points. DeWayne Russell finished with 14 points and eight assists. Kenzo Nudo scored 10 points. GCU scored the first five points of the game en route to an 8-4 lead. Mike Hoffman answered with a three and then Gage Loy made a layup to give UTRGV a 9-8 lead. Then, after a Russell jumper, Walter Jones made a layup to again put UTRGV on top at 11-10 with 11:27 remaining in the first half. GCU responded with an 11-0 run to go up 26-14 on a Vernon dunk, but Dixon bookended a 10-2 run with layups to bring UTRGV within 28-24. UTRGV was still within four at 30-26 after a Green jumper with 4:05 to go, and it was a five-point game at 33-28 after a Jones jumper at the 2:27 mark, but GCU closed the half on a 13-2 run to push its lead into double-figures for the rest of the game.

Feb. 25, 2017 at UTRGV Fieldhouse - UTRGV fell to UVU 88-68. Antonio Green led UTRGV with 19 points while hitting a trio of threepointers. Moe McDonald scored a career-high 18 points on a caeerbest 7-of-9 shooting, including a career-high tying 3-of-5 from behind the arc, with three assists. Jordan Poydras led UVU with 17 points. Zach Nelson finished with 14 points and seven rebounds. Ivory Young scored 13 points with five rebounds and four assists. Conner Toolson scored 11 points with five rebounds. Kenneth Ogbe also scored 11 points. UTRGV and UVU traded baskets over the first four minutes, with Lesley Varner Jr. hitting three jumpers and McDonald adding one to keep the game tied at eight. That's when Poydras went off, hitting a three, three free throws and a layup to power a 15-0 run to put UVU up 23-8. UTRGV responded with an 11-2 run on the power of two McDonald three-pointers to pull within 25-19, but UVU scored the next nine points as part of a 12-2 run to push its lead into doublefigures for the rest of the game.

UTRGV Athletics hired Lew Hill, who spent the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, as the new UTRGV men's basketball head coach on March 31, 2016.

**2016-17:** In first season at the helm, coached UTRGV to the Emerald Coast Classic Pool B Championship, and a stretch that saw UTRGV win seven out of eight, starting with wins over Texas State, North Florida and Lamar, and ending with a WAC-opening win over Chicago State ... Coached defensive unit that ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA and second in the WAC in turnovers forced per game (16.38) and 34<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA and second in the WAC in steals per game (7.7) ... Helped Nick Dixon earn All-WAC Second All-Newcomer Team honors ... Dixon and Antonio Green were one of only six duos in the NCAA to average at least 16.7 points per game, ranking fifth with a combined average of 17.8 points per game.

**Career:** Oklahoma went 29-8 (.784) in 2015-16 and compiled a 111-57 (.661) record during Hill's five-year tenure, including four-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament.

The 2015-16 season was Hill's 12<sup>th</sup> working with former Pan American University head coach Lon Kruger, after spending seven seasons as an

assistant coach at UNLV from 2004-11. During that time, UNLV went 161-71 (.694) while making six postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Prior to his time at UNLV, Hill was an assistant coach at Texas A&M for five seasons (1998-2003) and associate head coach (2003-04) for one. He previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at East Carolina (1994-98) and two years as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1992-94).

Hill began his coaching career at Wichita East High School as the head coach of the JV boys' basketball team and an assistant coach with the varsity team in 1989-90. He followed that up by moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at South Alabama (1990-92).

Hill was an All-American point guard for San Jacinto Junior College in 1983-84, helping the Ravens to the national championship. He went on to earn All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades in 1987-88 as a senior at Wichita State while helped the Shockers to a 20-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

The Mount Vernon, N.Y., native was an all-state performer at Mount Vernon High School. After graduating from Wichita State in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, he played professionally in Germany for one season before beginning his coaching career.

Hill and his wife, Renee, have two children: a son, Lewis Jr., and a daughter, Elle. Hill also has three other daughters, Sierra, Erica and Asya.
