UTRGV Comes Up Short in Upset Bid at Houston

Nov. 28, 2018 at H&PE Arena – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team had the lead with 3:47 remaining and was tied with 1:11 to go before falling to the University of Houston (UH), a team receiving votes in the latest top-25 polls, 58-53. Junior Jordan Jackson led UTRGV (5-4) with a season-high tying 12 points and a career-high nine rebounds. Junior Lesley Varner II scored eight points with eight rebounds and three steals. Sophomore Greg Bowie also scored eight points. Corey Davis Jr. led UH (5-0) with 23 points. Brison Gresham scored 12 points with eight rebounds. UH jumped out to a 19-11 lead over the first 11 and a half minutes. That's when a basket by sophomore Javon Levi and senior Terry Winn III sparked a 12-2 run to end the half with UTRGV up 23-21. After UH opened the second half with a pair of baskets, Levi and Jackson made buckets of their own to help UTRGV go up 29-25. Davis responded with a pair of three-pointers to give UH the lead before a Varner three put UTRGV up 32-31. The game remained a back-and-forth affair from there, with neither team going up by more than one possession until the final minute. UTRGV took its last lead with 3:47 remaining on a Jackson layup that made the score 49-48. The score was then tied at 50 after a Levi free throw with 1:11 left before UH scored eight of the final 11 points.

UTRGV Completes Showdown Sweep of Corpus Christi

Nov. 26, 2018 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team completed the season sweep of Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in the South Texas Showdown, presented by Navy Army Community Credit Union, by winning 68-59. UTRGV (5-3) earns three points for the win while Corpus Christi (4-3) earns one point for winning the attendance challenge 1,160-to-695 UTRGV now leads the showdown standings 20.5-to-5.5. Graduate student Solomon Hainna led UTRGV with a career-high 14 points, four rebounds, two assists and one block. Sophomore Greg Bowie scored 10 points. Graduate student Tyson Smith finished with nine points and a career-high tying two blocks. Senior Terry Winn III scored eight points with seven rebounds and four assists. Junior Jordan Jackson also scored eight points. Sophomore Javon Levi scored seven points with six assists, one block and two steals. Myles Smith led Corpus Christi with 20 points. Corpus Christi led 8-7 after five minutes. That's when UTRGV hit three-straight three-pointers, including one by Jackson and two by Bowie, to power an 11-0 run to take an 18-8 lead. Corpus Christi responded with a 12-2 run to tie the game at 20 before another Jackson three sparked an 11-4 run to put UTRGV up 31-24. UTRGV maintained a small lead until the midway point of the second half, when a three and a layup by Jake Babic tied the game at 48. Then, with the score tied at 50, Hainna and Winn made layups, Winn sunk a pair of free throws, and junior Lesley Varner II turned a steal into a layup to restore UTRGV's lead for good.

UTRGV Pulls Off Historic Comeback to Beat Lamar

Nov. 23, 2018 at UTRGV Fieldhouse - The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team became just the 28th team in NCAA history to come back from a deficit of 24 or more points to beat Lamar 77-75. While setting a new program record for largest comeback, UTRGV (4-3) became the first team to come back from a 24 or more-point deficit since Feb. 22, when Drexel came back from down 34 to beat Delaware. UTRGV is the second WAC institution to pull off such a large comeback, as Utah Valley rallied back from down 27 to win at Denver on Nov. 23, 2016. Junior Lesley Varner II led UTRGV with a career-high tying 21 points, eight rebounds, a season-high four assists, one block and three steals. Sophomore Javon Levi scored a career-high 19 points with four assists. Junior Jordan Jackson scored a season-high 12 points with a career-high tying six rebounds, a career-high five assists and a season-high three steals. Graduate student Tyson Smith hit three three-pointers for 11 points, three rebounds and a season-high three assists, Nick Garth led Lamar (3-3) with 17 points, Jordan Hunter scored 16 points with seven assists and three steals. Josh Nzeakor scored 15 points with 12 rebounds. T.J. Atwood finished with 13 points. Lamar jumped out to a 28-4 lead over the first nine minutes. Smith responded with a three-pointer as UTRGV started to chip away. UTRGV still trailed by 20 at 36-16 with 4:17 remaining in the first half when two three-pointers and a layup by Smith helped UTRGV score nine-straight points as part of an 18-6 run to close out the half with UTRGV down 42-34. Lamar pushed its lead to 13 twice in the second half, including 52-39 with 17:02 remaining. Lamar led by 12 at 60-48 at the 11:44 mark when three-point plays by Levi and Jackson helped UTRGV scored eight-straight points to pull within four. UTRGV closed to within two with 6:36 left when a Varner layup made the score 66-64. UTRGV tied the game for the first time on a Varner layup at the 4:55 mark that made the score 68-68. Then, with Lamar up 70-68, Levi hit back-to-back layups to give UTRGV a 72-70 lead with 3:02 to go. Lamar took the lead once more, going up 73-72 31 seconds later, but Levi, Varner and senior Terry Winn III combined to make five free throws to give UTRGV the lead for good.

December 16, 2017 at UTRGV Fieldhouse - The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team fell to UT Arlington (UTA) 86-65. In his first-career start, freshman Greg Bowie led UTRGV (6-7) with a career-high 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting, including 2-of-3 from behind the arc, and four assists. Senior Nick Dixon scored 15 points with nine rebounds and three assists. Kevin Hervey led UTA (8-3) with 30 points, 16 rebounds, four assists and two blocks. Kaelon Wilson scored 21 points with six rebounds and five assists. Nathan Hawkins scored 16 points with three rebounds, four assists and two steals. UTA scored the first 10 points of the game before Kimasa made a layup, senior Mike Hoffman nailed a three and Dixon sunk a free throw to bring UTRGV within 10-6. UTRGV got as close as four twice, including 14-10 on a Kimasa layup at the 9:07 mark, but UTA responded with a 12-5 run to go up 26-15. UTA took its largest lead of the half at 37-24 on a Hawkins layup with 2:02 remaining. UTRGV trailed 43-33 early in the second half when a Bowie three sparked a 9-2 run to bring UTRGV within 45-42 at the 15:42 mark. UTA responded with a 16-5 run to go up 61-47 and push the game out of reach.

- Oklahoma's head coach is former Pan American University head coach Lon Kruger, who coached the program from 1982-86. Hill worked as an assistant coach with Kruger at UNLV from 2004-11 and Oklahoma from 2011-16. Kruger was inducted into the Hall of Fame the night before the game while he and his wife, Barbara, were inducted into the Hall of Honor.
- This was the <u>second time Kruger has returned to the Rio Grande Valley to face his former program</u>, as he <u>brought Illinois to what was then known as the UTPA Fieldhouse on Nov. 28, 1998</u>.
- This was the 10th time this program has hosted an institution currently in a Power 5 Conference and the first time since 2010.
- This was the <u>first time UTRGV had hosted an institution in the Big</u>
 12 at the time of the contest, the <u>third time this program had hosted an institution currently in the Big</u> 12, and the <u>first time since 1991</u>.
- This was the <u>first time UTRGV has played at a facility in the Rio Grande Valley other than the fieldhouse since Nov. 27 and 28, 2009</u>, when UTRGV took part in the South Padre Island Invitational.
- Junior Lesley Varner II scored a <u>career-high tying 16 points for</u> the second-straight game, this time on 7-of-8 shooting.
- Graduate student Tyson Smith finished with 14 points on a career-high tying 4-of-6 shooting from behind the arc.
- Senior Terry Winn III scored 13 points with six rebounds, a career-high five assists and two steals.
- Sophomore Javon Levi scored 12 points with four rebounds, six assists and a <u>career-high tying four steals</u>.

- UTRGV plays at least 12 games against 2018 postseason participants, including Texas Tech, which reached the Elite Eight, Houston, which advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament, NCAA Tournament participant Oklahoma, defending WAC Champion and NCAA Tournament participant New Mexico State twice, CBI participants Grand Canyon, Seattle U and Utah Valley twice each, and CIT participant Lamar.

2017-18 Notes

- UTRGV made its <u>first postseason appearance since the 1981</u>
 <u>NIT</u>, second at the NCAA Division I level and ninth ever by advancing to the CBI for the first time.
- UTRGV experienced a <u>50 percent increase in wins</u>, going from 10 to 15 in head coach Lew Hill's second season.
- UTRGV won a program record six WAC games, its highest total of conference wins since 1995-96 in the Sun Belt (six).
- UTRGV swept the defending WAC Champions, CSU Bakersfield, for the first time since joining the WAC in 2013-14.
- UTRGV (12-11) <u>finished regular season non-conference play with a winning record</u> (9-8) for the <u>first time since 2007-08</u> (18-13). This was the <u>first time UTRGV finished regular season non-conference play with a winning record while part of a conference since 1993-94</u> (6-2).



- UTRGV had an <u>NCAA-high seven players reach double-figures in scoring in a 96-75 win over Our Lady of the Lake</u> (1/2), a feat the program hadn't accomplished since Dec. 4, 1993.
- Nick Dixon earned NABC All-District Second Team honors as voted on by member coaches of the NABC in NCAA Division I. Dixon led the WAC in scoring (20.6), and ranked second in steals per game (1.4) and seventh in free throw shooting (.793). Nationally, Dixon ranked third in the NCAA in free throw makes (219) and attempts (276), 31st in total points (659), 34th in scoring (20.6), 106th in field goal attempts (432), 127th in field goals made (193), 174th in total steals (46), 228th in free throw shooting (.793), and 241st in field goal shooting (.447). He also earned All-WAC First Team honors as voted on by the head coaches based on statistics compiled during WAC play. Dixon averaged 20.9 points on .419 shooting, including .343 from behind the arc, plus .784 from the foul line, 4.5 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.3 steals in 14 WAC games. During WAC play, Dixon lead the WAC in scoring (20.9) and ranked tied for seventh in steals per game (1.3), tied for ninth in three-pointers made (23), tied for 10th in offensive rebounding (1.6), and tied for 15th in rebounding (4.5).

UTRGV Athletics hired Lew Hill, who spent the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, as the new UTRGV men's basketball head coach on March 31, 2016.

2017-18: In second season at the helm, coached UTRGV to a 50 percent increase in victories (10-to-15) and a 200 percent increase in WAC victories (2-to-6) ... The six WAC wins are the most the program has ever had and the highest total number of conference victories since 1995-96 (Sun Belt) ... UTRGV finished fifth in the WAC, its best finish in five years of WAC play ... UTRGV went on to earn its first postseason appearance since 1981, taking part in the College Basketball Invitational ... Prior to his time at UNLV, Hill was an assistant coach at Texas A&M for five seasons (1998-2003) and associate head coach (2003-04) for one. He previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at East Carolina (1994-98) and two years as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1992-94).

Hill began his coaching career at Wichita East High School as the head coach of the JV boys' basketball team and an assistant coach with the varsity team in 1989-90. He followed that up by moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at South Alabama (1990-92).

Hill was an All-American point guard for San Jacinto Junior College in 1983-84, helping the Ravens to the national championship. He went on to earn All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades in 1987-88 as a senior at Wichita State while helped the Shockers to a 20-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

The Mount Vernon, N.Y., native was an all-state performer at Mount Vernon High School. After graduating from Wichita State in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, he played professionally in Germany for one season before beginning his coaching career.

Hill and his wife, Renee, have two children: a son, Lewis Jr., and a daughter, Elle. Hill also has three other daughters, Sierra, Erica and Asya.
