#### **UTRGV Edged at Utah Valley**

Jan. 18, 2020 at UCCU Center – In a game that was separated by no more than two points over the last four minutes, The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team fell to the Utah Valley University Wolverines 72-70. Senior Lesley Varner II led the Vaqueros (6-12, 2-3 WAC) with 23 points, five rebounds, four assists and four steals. Sophomore Sean Rhea scored 14 points with six rebounds. Junior Javon Levi scored 12 points with nine assists, six rebounds and one steal. TJ Washington led the Wolverines (8-12, 2-3 WAC) with 25 points. Jamison Overton scored 16 points with eight rebounds. The Wolverines led 60-56 with 4:08 remaining. That's when three-pointers by freshman Quinton Johnson II and Levi helped the Vaqueros take a 62-61 lead. The Wolverines took the lead on three free throws, but the Vaqueros tied the game at 64 on a Varner jumper, 66 on a Levi layup, 68 on a Varner jumper, and 70 on a Rhea dunk. Isaiah White responded with a layup with 1.3 seconds left to send the Wolverines to victory. The Vaqueros jumped out to a 12-3 lead on thanks in part to a pair of Levi three-pointers. The Vaqueros pushed their lead to 10 three times on Varner jumpers, at 14-4, 16-6 and 18-8. The Wolverines pulled to within 23-18 before a Varner three-point play extended the Vaqueros' lead to 26-18. The Wolverines scored the next six points to make it a two-point game. Then, after Rhea hit two free throws, the Wolverines scored six-straight points to take a 30-28 lead. A Varner jumper tied the game going into halftime and then the Vaqueros scored eight of the first 11 points of the second half to go up 38-33. The Vaqueros still led by five at 41-37 when the Wolverines went on an 8-0 run to take the lead, but the Vaqueros responded with an 11-4 run, capped by a pair of free throws by graduate student Jordan Jackson, to go up 52-49. The Wolverines followed with an 11-4 run of their own to regain the lead.

#### **UTRGV Falls at Seattle U**

Jan. 16, 2020 at Redhawk Center – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team fell to the Seattle U Redhawks 91-74. Senior Lesley Varner II led the Vaqueros (6-11, 2-2 WAC) with 19 points and eight rebounds. Sophomore Sean Rhea scored 13 points with eight rebounds. Freshman Quinton Johnson II scored 11 points and four rebounds. Graduate student Jordan Jackson finished with 11 points and two blocks. Junior Javon Levi scored eight points with eight assists. Morgan Means led the Redhawks (10-9, 3-1 WAC) with 22 points. Myles Carter scored 17 points with 11 rebounds. Riley Grigsby scored 15 points with five rebounds. Delante Jones finished with 12 points. Mattia Da Campo scored 11 points with seven rebounds. Terrell Brown scored eight points with six rebounds, nine assists, three blocks and two steals. Varner hit two three-pointers and a jumper to help the Vaqueros jump out to a 17-5 lead. Two minutes later, Jackson hit a pair of free throws and junior Rob McClain Jr. sunk a jumper to make the score 21-10. The Redhawks responded with a 15-2 run, bookended by Carter layups, to take a 25-23 lead. A Varner jumper tied the game, and then after a Carter free throw, Varner hit two free throws of his own to put the Vaqueros up 27-26. The Redhawks followed with a 12-3 run before a three by junior Chris Freeman brought the Vaqueros within 38-33 at halftime. The Vaqueros got as close as three twice early in the second half when a Rhea layup made the score 40-37 and a Rhea dunk made the score 42-39, but the Redhawks scored the next seven points and led by at least eight the rest of the way.

#### **UTRGV Blows Out Chicago State**

Jan. 11, 2020 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team blew out the Chicago State University Cougars 87-63. Senior Lesley Varner II led the Vaqueros (6-10, 2-1 WAC) with 21 points and eight rebounds. Graduate student Jordan Jackson scored 18 points with a season-high tying four steals. Junior Chris Freeman hit three three-pointers en route to nine points. Junior Javon Levi dished out 10 assists with six points and two steals. The Vaqueros forced 23 turnovers, scoring 22 points off those turnovers. Xavier Johnson led the Cougars (4-15, 0-4 WAC) with 12 points and five assists. Andrew Lewis also had 12 points. The game was tied at four after four minutes. That's when a Jackson three sparked a 17-4 run, capped by back-to-back baskets by junior Rob McClain Jr. to put the Vaqueros up 21-8. Two baskets later, Varner converted a three-point play and added a jumper to give the Vaqueros a 26-12 lead. The Vaqueros led by as much as 17 in the first half, going up 35-18 on a Levi layup and 43-26 on a pair of free throws by sophomore Sean Rhea. The Vaqueros led 45-30 early in the second half when a Rhea dunk and a Jackson jumper kicked off a 17-3 run to put the Vaqueros up 62-33. The Vaqueros extended their lead to 69-38 on a Jackson three at the 12:02 mark and cruised to victory from there. Freshman Weslaco alum Isaiah Garcia played the final minute and a half, knocking down a three-pointer on his lone shot.

Series Notes: UTRGV rallied from down 19 to pull within three in a WAC Tournament Semifinal loss (3/15/19) ... UTRGV became the first team to score at least 101 points against New Mexico State in nine years on a six-point home loss (2/18/17) ... Janari Joesaar scored 23 points as UTRGV rallied from down 16 to pull within two before falling on the road 53-48 (1/31/15) ... UTRGV shot a season-best 15-16 (.938) from the foul line in a home loss (2/20/14) ... UTRGV shot a season-high .533 (8-15) from behind the arc in a road loss (1/25/14) ... Ray Castillo hit his 116th and final three-pointer to pass Mire Chatman for sixth place in program history in a 78-61 road loss (3/1/05) ... Chatman scored 44 points, tied for the ninth-highest singlegame total in program history, while grabbing eight steals, tied for the fourth-highest single-game total in program history, in a 100-86 home win (2/11/02) ... PAU scored 65 points in the second half, the fourthhighest total in program history, and the highest against an NCAA Division I team, in a 120-97 home win (12/17/77) ... John Wilbanks dished out 17 assists, the sixth highest single-game total in program history, in a 107-105 road loss (2/10/77).

March 15, 2019 at Orleans Arena - Down 19 with 14:03 remaining, fourth-seeded The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team rallied to pull within three before falling to topseed New Mexico State, a team receiving votes in the AP Top 25 poll, 79-72 in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament Semifinals. Graduate student Tyson Smith led UTRGV (19-16) with a career-high 23 points on 7-of-16 shooting, including 4-of-10 from behind the arc, plus 5-of-5 from the line. Junior Lesley Varner II scored 15 points with six rebounds. Sophomore Javon Levi scored 12 points with four rebounds. Terrell Brown led New Mexico State (29-4) with 19 points. AJ Harris scored 15 points. Clayton Henry scored 12 points. NM State led 59-40 after a 17-6 run near the start of the second half. That's when Smith lit on fire, hitting three three-pointers to help UTRGV score 13-straight points to pull within six. Then, after Harris bookended a Smith three-point play with three-pointers of his own, Levi made four free throws and sophomore Greg Bowie II sunk a layup to bring UTRGV within 65-62 with 7:13 remaining. NM State scored the next eight points before Varner made a three and converted a three-point play to fuel an 8-1 run to make the score 74-70 with 1:44 left. UTRGV was still within four at 76-72 with 46 seconds left after a Varner layup, but that's as close as they got. The game was tight for most of the first half, with UTRGV taking the lead three times, including at 10-9 on a jumper by senior Terry Winn III. NM State followed with a 10-2 run to take a 22-14 lead, but UTRGV pulled to within 25-21 on a Varner layup. UTRGV was still within four at 29-25 with 4:08 remaining before NM State went on an 8-2 run to take its first double-digit lead at 37-27.

Feb. 7, 2019 at GCU Arena - Down 11 with 14 minutes remaining, The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) men's basketball team rallied back to stun Grand Canyon University (GCU), which entered the night tied for first in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC), 72-69. This was UTRGV's (13-12, 5-4 WAC) first win at GCU (14-8, 7-2 WAC) in six tries. UTRGV is the first team to beat GCU at GCU Arena this season. snapping a 16-game winning streak dating back to Jan. 11, 2018. Graduate student Tyson Smith led UTRGV with a career-high tying 21 points. Senior Terry Winn III scored 15 points. Sophomore Javon Levi scored 12 points with five rebounds, three assists and four steals. Junior Jordan Jackson scored nine points with five rebounds. Junior Lesley Varner II scored eight points with 10 rebounds. Damari Milstead led GCU with 14 points. Carlos Johnson scored 13 points. Michael Finke finished with 10 points. GCU led by as much as 11 twice, including 50-39 with 13:28 to go. Then, with the score 54-44, Smith used a three, a jumper and a three-point play to power an 18-6 run to give UTRGV a 62-60 lead with 4:15 remaining. Milstead tied the game with a layup, but Smith hit four free throws restore UTRGV's lead. GCU tied the game at 67 with 45 seconds remaining on a Johnson three-point play. Winn made a layup 15 seconds later to give UTRGV the lead. After a GCU travel, Smith hit two free throws. Milstead responded with a jumper. Jackson hit a free throw to make it a three-point game and then Milstead missed a desperation three to end the game. GCU led 15-8 on an early Milstead three before four Levi layups and a pair of Varner baskets allowed UTRGV to score 12-straight points to take a 20-15 lead. GCU scored the next seven points as part of an 11-3 run to regain the lead, but Winn made two layups and a free throw to put UTRGV up 28-26. Winn also used free throws to tie the game at 30 before GCU took a 32-30 lead into the break.

- Junior Javon Levi earned <u>Preseason All-WAC First Team</u> honors from the coaches and media.
- UTRGV's schedule features at least 19 games, including seven at home, against teams that competed in the postseason last year. UTRGV faces four opponents that competed in the NCAA Tournament, including national runner-up Texas Tech (Dec. 21), Oklahoma, which advanced to the third round (Dec. 30), North Dakota State, which advanced to the second round (Nov. 15), and reigning WAC Tournament Champion New Mexico State (Jan. 25 at home and Feb. 22 on the road). UTRGV plays three opponents that competed in the NIT, including Sam Houston State (Dec. 3 at home), South Dakota State, and quarterfinalist Creighton (Dec. 13). UTRGV competes against two other CIT participants, Seattle U (Jan. 16 on the road and Feb. 15 at home) and CSU Bakersfield (Feb. 1 at home and Feb. 27 on the road). UTRGV also takes on four College Basketball Invitational (CBI) opponents, including Stony Brook (Nov. 16), California Baptist (Jan. 2 on the road and March 7 at home), Utah Valley (Jan. 18 on the road and Feb. 13 at home), and Grand Canyon (Jan. 30 at home and Feb. 29 on the road).

#### 2018-19 Notes

- UTRGV made its 10<sup>th</sup> postseason appearance, third at the NCAA
   <u>Division I level</u> and <u>second in a row</u> by participating in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT).
- UTRGV won a postseason game at the NCAA Division I level for the first time by beating Grambling State in the opening round. It was the program's first postseason victory since 1968.

- UTRGV hosted the <u>first two postseason home games in the history</u> of the fieldhouse.
- UTRGV won a WAC Tournament game for the first time in program history by defeating fifth-seeded CSU Bakersfield. It was UTRGV's first conference tournament victory since the 2010 Great West Quarterfinals, snapping a nine-game skid. UTRGV entered the tournament as the No. 4 seed, its best-ever seed.
- UTRGV has increased its win total by five games in each of Lew Hill's first three seasons as head coach, with 10 in 2016-17, 15 in 2017-18 and 20 in 2018-19.
- The <u>20 wins are UTRGV's most since 2000-01</u>, marking the eighth time UTRGV has won at least 20 games at the NCAA Division I level and the 12<sup>th</sup> time overall.
- UTRGV won a program record nine WAC games, one short of the program record for conference wins of 10 set in the Sun Belt in 1994-95.
- UTRGV went <u>8-7 on the road</u>, the <u>team's highest road win total</u> since 1975-76 (8-3).
- UTRGV finished with a winning record on the road for the first time since 1989-90 (7-6).

Over the final 20:08, UTRGV outscored CSUB 38-16.
- UTRGV went <u>11-7 at home, its highest home win total since 2012-13</u> (11-2).
- UTRGV won five games in a row from Jan. 31 through Feb. 14, marking its longest WAC winning streak ever and its longest winning streak in 11 years after previously winning seven-straight from Dec. 31, 2007 through Jan. 28, 2008.

- UTRGV became the <u>28<sup>th</sup> team in NCAA history and second in WAC history to come back from a 24+ point deficit</u> by beating Lamar
- In UTRGV's other 13 wins, they did not trail by more than seven points at any time.



- UTRGV ranked third in NCAA in 10+ point comebacks, behind only Duquesne (eight) and Bucknell (eight). UTRGV finished tied with Duquesne and Bucknell for the NCAA lead in 10+ point conference comebacks (five). UTRGV led the NCAA in both 10+ point road comebacks and conference road comebacks (five).
- UTRGV ranked fourth in the NCAA and first in the WAC with a program record 345 steals.

 UTRGV clinched in inaugural WAC/Summit League Challenge Championships for the WAC by beating North Dakota at home. UTRGV grabbed 21 steals in that game, the third-highest singlegame total in program history and most since Jan. 5, 1981. UTRGV grabbed 18 steals in the first half, more than any WAC institution had had in a full game to that point in the season. UTRGV forced

- 29 turnovers, the team's highest total since forcing 30 at Texas State on Dec. 5, 2009.
- UTRGV hosted Oklahoma on Nov. 9, marking the 10<sup>th</sup> time this program had hosted an institution currently in a Power 5 Conference and the first time since 2010. This was the first time UTRGV had hosted an institution in the Big 12 at the time of the contest, the third time this program had hosted an institution currently in the Big 12, and the first time since 1991.
- Javon Levi was the WAC Defensive Player of the Year and a member of the All-Defensive Team after breaking the all-time WAC records for steals in a season in WAC play (54) and steals per game (3.4) in WAC play. He averaged 2.0 more steals per game than any other player in conference games. In WAC play Levi also averaging 10.4 points, 4.2 rebounds and 6.2 assists per game.
- Overall, Levi <u>ranked second in the NCAA and first in the WAC in total steals</u> with a program record 109, which is also the second-highest total in WAC history. Junior **Lesley Varner II** was <u>133<sup>rd</sup> in the NCAA and second in the WAC</u> with 51. Junior **Jordan Jackson** was 149<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA and third in the WAC with 49.
- Levi ranked third in the NCAA and first in the WAC with 2.95 steals per game, the third-highest total in WAC history. Varner ranked 242<sup>nd</sup> in the NCAA and eighth in the WAC with 1.38.
- Levi was a <u>finalist for the Lefty Driesell award</u>, presented annually to the top defensive player in men's basketball. He was the <u>only player in the NCAA averaging at least 5.5 assists (5.7), 2.5 steals (2.95) and 2.1 turnovers or less (2.03) per game</u>. Levi was also the <u>only player averaging at least 9.9 points (9.9), 3.9 rebounds (3.9), 5.5 assists (5.7), and 2.5 steals (2.95) per game</u>.
- Terry Winn III was an <u>All-WAC Second Team</u> selection after averaging 14.1 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.4 assists while shooting 46.6 percent (75-for-161) from the field and 72.4 percent (76-for-105) from the foul line. During conference play, Winn <u>ranked eighth</u> in the WAC in scoring and 10<sup>th</sup> in field goal shooting percentage.

UTRGV Athletics hired Lew Hill, who spent the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, as the new UTRGV men's basketball head coach on March 31, 2016.

2018-19: Named finalist for Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority coach in division I men's basketball ... Led team to secondstraight postseason berth for first time since marking six-straight appearances from 1960-66 as the team not only appeared in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT), but hosted two games, marking the first postseason home games in the history of the fieldhouse and the first since 1966 ... Coached team to first postseason victory since 1968 and first as an NCAA Division I program ... Guided team to 20-17 record, tied for the eighth-winning season in program history and the winningest since 2000-01 ... Won a program record six conference road games ... Finished with eight total road wins, the team's highest total since 1975-76 ... Recorded a winning record on the road (8-7) for the first time since 1989-90 ... Led team to seven double-digit comebacks, the third most in the NCAA, including an NCAA-best five in conference, all of which were on the road. The first of the comebacks was against Lamar, against who UTRGV trailed 28-4 after nine minutes before becoming the 28th team to ever comeback from a 24+ point deficit ... Levi was also a finalist for the Lefty Driesell award, given to the nation's top defensive player ... Coached Terry Winn III to All-WAC Second Team honors.

2017-18: In second season at the helm, coached UTRGV to a 50 percent increase in victories (10-to-15) and a 200 percent increase in WAC victories (2-to-6) ... The six WAC wins are the most the program has ever had and the highest total number of conference victories since 1995-96 (Sun Belt) ... UTRGV finished fifth in the WAC, its best finish in five years of WAC play ... UTRGV went on to earn its first postseason appearance since 1981, taking part in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) ... UTRGV finished regular season non-conference play with a winning record (9-8) for the first time since 2007-08 (18-13). **2016-17:** In first season at the helm, coached UTRGV to the Emerald Coast Classic Pool B Championship, and a stretch that saw UTRGV win seven out of eight, starting with wins over Texas State, North Florida and Lamar, and ending with a WAC-opening win over Chicago State ... Coached defensive unit that ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA and second in the WAC in turnovers forced per game (16.38) and 34<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA and second in the WAC in steals per game (7.7) ... Helped Nick Dixon earn All-WAC Second All-Newcomer Team honors ... Dixon and Antonio Green were one of only six duos in the NCAA to average at least 16.7 points per game, ranking fifth with a combined average of 17.8 points per game.

**Career:** Oklahoma went 29-8 (.784) in 2015-16 and reached the Final Four. Oklahoma compiled a 111-57 (.661) record during Hill's five-year tenure, including four-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament.

The 2015-16 season was Hill's 12<sup>th</sup> working with former Pan American University head coach Lon Kruger, after spending seven seasons as an assistant coach at UNLV from 2004-11. During that time, UNLV went 161-71 (.694) while making six postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournament appearances.

Prior to his time at UNLV, Hill was an assistant coach at Texas A&M for five seasons (1998-2003) and associate head coach (2003-04) for one. He previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at East Carolina (1994-98) and two years as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1992-94).

Hill began his coaching career at Wichita East High School as the head coach of the JV boys' basketball team and an assistant coach with the varsity team in 1989-90. He followed that up by moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at South Alabama (1990-92).

Hill was an All-American point guard for San Jacinto Junior College in 1983-84, helping the Ravens to the national championship. He went on to earn All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades in 1987-88 as a senior at Wichita State while helped the Shockers to a 20-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

The Mount Vernon, N.Y., native was an all-state performer at Mount Vernon High School. After graduating from Wichita State in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, he played professionally in Germany for one season before beginning his coaching career.

Hill and his wife, Renee, have two children: a son, Lewis Jr., and a daughter, Elle. Hill also has three other daughters, Sierra, Erica and Asya.
