Men's Basketball Drops Season Opener at No. 19 Texas

November 25, 2020 at Frank Erwin Center – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team fell to the No. 19 Texas Longhorns 91-55 in the season opener. Sophomore **Quinton Johnson II** led the Vaqueros (0-1) with 13 points, seven rebounds and two steals. Junior **LaQuan Butler** scored 10 points while hitting a pair of three-pointers and grabbing two steals. Senior **Chris Freeman** finished with 10 points and five rebounds. **Courtney Ramey** led the Longhorns (1-0) with 20 points, five rebounds and six assists. **Matt Coleman III** scored 17 points with five assists. **Kai Jones** scored 14 points with eight rebounds. **Gerald Liddell** finished with 10 points, six rebounds and three assists. **Greg Brown III** posted a double-double with 11 points with 10 rebounds. The Vaqueros were within 5-4 on a Freeman dunk and a pair of free throws by senior **Javon Levi** in the opening four minutes. The Longhorns scored the next 12 points as part of a 24-7 run over a span of nine minutes to go up 29-11. The Longhorns took their largest lead of the half at 36-17 with 4:46 remaining. That's when Johnson and Butler used three-pointers to power a 10-0 run to bring the Vaqueros to within 36-27. The Vaqueros were still within nine at 38-29 with 1:50 left on a layup by senior **Anthony Bratton**, but the Longhorns scored the final seven points of the half to take a 45-29 lead. Johnson opened the second half with a jumper, but the Longhorns answered with a 13-6 run to push the game out of reach.

Men's Basketball Beats California Baptist in Overtime to Clinch No. 2 Seed WAC Tournament

March 7, 2020 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team clinched the No. 2 seed in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Tournament, the highest seed in program history, by closing out the regular season with a 79-76 overtime victory over the California Baptist University Lancers in front of a raucous crowd of 1,523. Graduate student **Jordan Jackson** led the Vaqueros with 24 points, three assists and two blocks. Senior **Lesley Varner II** scored 22 points with a career-high seven steals, tied for the 10th-highest single-game total in program history. Junior **Javon Levi** scored eight points with a career-high tying 13 assists, a season-high tying five steals and five rebounds. Senior **Isaiah Fontaine** finished with five points with four rebounds. **Milan Acquaaah** led the Lancers (21-10, 10-6 WAC) with 18 points, 10 rebounds and eight assists. **Dejon Davis** scored 15 points with 11 rebounds. **Ferron Flavors Jr.** finished with 15 points. The Vaqueros trailed 52-46 with 8:34 remaining in the second half. Junior **Rob McClain Jr.** responded with a layup and Varner came up with a dunk to spark an 8-2 run to tie the game at 54. Flavors and Kuol answered with threes to put the Lancers up 60-56. Then, with the score 62-58, Jackson made a layup and Varner hit two free throws to tie the game. The Vaqueros trailed 67-64 in the final minute before Levi hit a game-tying three with 21 seconds left to force overtime. The Lancers jumped out to a 74-70 lead with 1:51 left in the extra session, but four Varner free throws sandwiched a Jackson layup to give the Vaqueros the lead. A Davis layup tied the game with seven seconds left before Varner came down the court and hit a game-winning three. Jackson opened the game with a jumper and a dunk and then freshman **Quinton Johnson II** nailed a three as the Vaqueros jumped out to a 7-2 lead. The Lancers responded with a 16-6 run to go up 18-13. The Lancers extended their lead to 28-22 late in the half, but a jumper and a free throw by Fontaine and a three at the buzzer by Johnson allowed the Vaqueros to go into halftime down just 30-28. The Vaqueros scored the first four points of the second half to take the lead before an Acquaaah three sparked a 14-6 run to put the Lancers up 44-38.

Men's Basketball Wins to Break Tie with Grand Canyon

Feb. 29, 2020 at GCU Arena – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team moved into position for the No. 2 seed in the Western Athletic Conference Tournament by beating the Grand Canyon University Lopes 88-80. Senior **Lesley Varner II** led the Vaqueros with 32 points on 9-of-16 shooting, including 5-of-6 from behind the arc, with seven rebounds. Junior **Javon Levi** scored a career-high 25 points with four assists and three steals. Junior **Chris Freeman** scored a career-high 18 points. Freshman **Quinton Johnson II** finished with seven points, five rebounds and two assists. **Alessandro Lever** led the Lopes with 18 points and six rebounds. **Isiah Brown** scored 17 points. **Jovan Blacksher Jr.** scored 15 points, with five rebounds and five assists. **Carlos Johnson** scored 11 points with five rebounds. **Lorenzo Jenkins** finished with 10 points and six rebounds. The Lopes led briefly in the second half, going up 68-65 after trailing for the majority of the game. That's when Freeman drilled a three from the right corner, drew the foul and hit the free throw to spark the Vaqueros. Varner followed with a three and Levi hit a jumper to put the Vaqueros up 74-68. The Lopes got as close as four at 76-72, but Varner responded with a three-point play and Johnson made a backdoor layup as the Vaqueros put the game on ice. The Vaqueros came out on fire in the first half, going up 9-2 on a Freeman three. Then, with the score 14-9, Varner and Johnson made back-to-back threes and Varner hit a jumper to put the Vaqueros up 22-9. The Vaqueros extended their lead to 14 at 34-20 on a Freeman three midway through the half. The Vaqueros took their largest lead with 7:23 remaining in the first half when a Levi layup made the score 40-24. The Lopes closed to within five early in the second half before a Varner three punctuated a 7-2 run to give the Vaqueros a 56-46 lead. The Lopes followed with a 16-5 run to tie the game to take their first lead at 62-61.

January 12, 2015 at UTPA Fieldhouse – UTPA completed the non-conference portion of its schedule with a 68-43 loss to UTSA. **Dan Kimasa** led UTPA with his third double-double, recording 10 points and 10 rebounds. **Jeromie Hill** led UTSA with 18 points, seven rebounds and three steals. **Ryan Bowie** scored 15 points on 5-of-6 shooting from behind the arc. **Kaj-Björn Sherman** scored 14 points with nine rebounds. **Keon Lewis** scored 12 points with five steals. Kimasa hit a layup and **Janari Joesaar** made a three as UTPA jumped out to a 5-2 lead. UTSA scored the next seven points, but the Broncs responded with five of their own, going up 10-9 on a Joesaar jumper. UTPA still led by one at 14-13 after a Kimasa layup, but Bowie nailed three-straight three-pointers to put the Roadrunners up 22-14. UTPA pulled within 25-23 on a pair of free throws by **Shaquille Hines**, but UTSA hit nine of their next 15 shots to power a 23-5 run and go up 48-28 with 13:54 remaining.

Nov. 30, 2019 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team fell to the Texas A&M-Corpus Christi Islanders 55-52 as part of the South Texas Showdown, presented by Navy Army Community Credit Union. The Vaqueros (2-5) win the attendance point 1,093-to-978, but the Islanders (3-4) now hold a 15-14 lead in the showdown standings. Graduate student **Jordan Jackson** led the Vaqueros with 16 points. Senior **Lesley Varner II** scored 15 points on 7-of-13 shooting, eight rebounds and three steals. Freshman **Connor Raines** scored a career-high 15 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including 3-of-4 from behind the arc. **Myles Smith** led the Islanders with 23 points and six rebounds. **Elijah Schmidt** finished with 10 points and nine rebounds. Raines scored the Vaqueros' first nine points to help the Vaqueros go up 9-5. Then, with the score 12-9, Varner made three baskets, including a three, and Jackson added a three-point play, to put the Vaqueros up 22-9. The Islanders pulled to within seven late in the first half before a three by sophomore **Uche Dibiamaka** and a jumper and a layup by Varner gave the Vaqueros a 36-22 lead at the start of the second half. The Islanders hit four-straight baskets to pull within 36-31. Then, after a Jackson jumper and a free throw by junior **Chris Freeman**, The Islanders went on a 12-0 run to take a 43-39 lead. The Islanders still led at 48-45 with five minutes remaining when a Varner layup and a Jackson dunk gave the Vaqueros the lead. A Jackson jumper tied the game at 51 with 2:38 left, but a **Jordan Hairston** free throw and a Smith three gave the Islanders the lead for good.

UTSA (11/25)

- This is the first matchup between Lew Hill and Steve Henson, who worked together as assistant coaches under former Pan American head coach **Lon Kruger** from 2004-11 at UNLV and 2011-16 at Oklahoma before accepting their jobs at UTRGV and UTSA on the same day in 2016, right before competing in the Final Four.

No. 19 Texas (11/25)

- UTRGV dropped the season opener 91-55.
- Sophomore **Quinton Johnson II**, who made 16 starts in 30 games last season, and senior **Chris Freeman**, who started 10 times, started together for just the third time, combining for 23 points and

12 rebounds. Johnson scored 13 points on a career-high 8-of-14 shooting from the foul line.

- Junior **LaQuan Butler**, who gained immediately eligibility after transferring from Southeastern Louisiana, scored 10 points with two assists, his first-career block, and two steals.
- In his collegiate debut, freshman **Malik Lawrence-Anderson** grabbed a team-high tying seven rebounds and a steal while scoring four points with an assist.

- This is the highest UTRGV has ever been picked in the preseason polls after previously getting picked fourth in both polls last year. UTRGV has outperformed the preseason polls three years in a row, including finishing a program best third last year by going 9-7 in WAC play. UTRGV outperformed the 2018-19 poll by two spots, finishing fourth, after outperforming the 2017-18 poll by one spot, finishing fifth. UTRGV has improved its final standing by one spot each of the last two years after making a two-spot jump in 2017-18.

- Junior **Javon Levi** earned Preseason All-WAC First Team honors from the coaches and media.

- Levi and graduate student **Jeff Otchere**, a Stony Brook transfer, are both former conference defensive players of the year. Levi earned the honor from the WAC in 2018-19 and 2019-20 while Otchere earned the honor from America East in 2018-19. UTRGV is the only team in the nation to have two players that have won conference defensive player of the year awards and the only one with a total of three such awards among its players.

- UTRGV is the only team in the nation without any freshmen on its roster.

2019-20 Notes

- UTRGV won eight of its final 10 games and earned the No. 2 seed in the WAC Tournament, the best in program history, after finishing third in the WAC, also the best in program history.
- UTRGV ranked sixth in the NCAA in turnover margin (4.9), eighth in turnovers forced (17.50), 20th in steals per game (8.4), 31st in assists per game (15.0), 37th in total steals (251), 48th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.20) and 80th in total assists (451), leading the WAC in each category.
- UTRGV had a six-game winning streak from Feb. 1-18, marking its longest winning streak since winning seven-straight from Dec. 31, 2007 through Jan. 28, 2008. The first five games during the streak were WAC games, marking the second year in a row in which UTRGV won a program-record five-straight WAC contests.
- UTRGV went 11-3 at home, marking the second-straight season in which UTRGV has won 11 home games. The feat hadn't previously happened since 2012-13.
- After becoming the first road team to win at GCU Arena in 2018-19, snapping Grand Canyon's 16-game winning streak, UTRGV won at Grand Canyon again in 2019-20.
- For the second year in a row, Javon Levi was the WAC Defensive Player of the Year, a Left Driesell Defensive All-American and part of the WAC All-Defensive Team. He also added All-WAC Second Team honors for the first time. During WAC play, Levi averaged 12.4 points, 2.8 rebounds, 7.9 assists and 1.9 steals in 15 games. He ranked 14th in the conference in scoring, first in assists and second in steals. He also had a WAC-best 2.7 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Levi ranked second in the NCAA in assists per game:

- Despite missing five games, Levi ranked 11th in the NCAA in steals per game (2.4) 12th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.93) 13th in total assists (199), and 34th in total steals (60), leading the WAC in each category.
- **Lesley Varner II** was part of the All-WAC First Team for the first time in his career. The only player to start all 16 WAC contests for UTRGV, Varner averaged 17.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.6 steals while shooting 44.3 percent from the field, 44.6 percent from behind the arc and 89.0 percent from the foul line. He ranked third in the WAC in scoring, second in free throw shooting, third in three-point shooting, fourth in steals, fifth in defensive rebounding (4.9), seventh in rebounding, tied for ninth in three-pointers made (25), and 14th in field goal percentage.
- **Jordan Jackson** was featured on Sportscenter's top plays twice for epic dunks. The first was dubbed the "best dunk" after posterizing a defender against Kansas City (1/9). The second was as part of an alley-oop rom Levi against Chicago State (1/11).

UTRGV Athletics hired Lew Hill, who spent the previous five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, as the new UTRGV men's basketball head coach on March 31, 2016.

2019-20: Led team to wins in eight of final 10 games, culminating in No. 2 seed at WAC Tournament, the highest in program history ... Won career-high six WAC home games ... Tied career highs with 11 home wins and nine WAC wins ... UTRGV ranked sixth in the NCAA in turnover margin (4.9), eighth in turnovers forced (17.50), 20th in steals per game (8.4), 31st in assists per game (15.0), 37th in total steals (251), 48th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.20) and 80th in total assists (451), leading the WAC in each category ... Coached **Javon Levi** to WAC Defensive Player of the Year and All-Defensive Team honors for second-straight year while adding All-WAC Second Team recognition ... Coached **Lesley Varner II** to All-WAC First Team honors.

2018-19: Named finalist for Ben Jobe Award, presented annually to the top minority coach in division I men's basketball ... Led team to second-straight postseason berth for first time since marking six-straight appearances from 1960-66 as the team not only appeared in the CollegelInsider.com Tournament (CIT), but hosted two games, marking the first postseason home games in the history of the fieldhouse and the first since 1966 ... Coached team to first postseason victory since 1968 and first as an NCAA Division I program ... Guided team to 20-17 record, tied for the eighth-winning season in program history and the winningest since 2000-01 ... Won a program record six conference road games ... Finished with eight total road wins, the team's highest total since 1975-76 ... Recorded a winning record on the road (8-7) for the first time since 1989-90 ... Levi was also a finalist for the Lefty Driessell award, given to the nation's top defensive player ... Coached **Terry Winn III** to All-WAC Second Team honors.

2017-18: In second season at the helm, coached UTRGV to a 50 percent increase in victories (10-to-15) and a 200 percent increase in WAC victories (2-to-6) ... The six WAC wins are the most the program has ever had and the highest total number of conference victories since 1995-96 (Sun Belt) ... UTRGV finished fifth in the WAC, its best finish in five years

of WAC play ... UTRGV went on to earn its first postseason appearance since 1981, taking part in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) ... UTRGV finished regular season non-conference play with a winning record (9-8) for the first time since 2007-08 (18-13). Hill began his coaching career at Wichita East High School as the head coach of the JV boys' basketball team and an assistant coach with the varsity team in 1989-90. He followed that up by moving into the collegiate ranks as an assistant coach at South Alabama (1990-92).

Hill was an All-American point guard for San Jacinto Junior College in 1983-84, helping the Ravens to the national championship. He went on to earn All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades in 1987-88 as a senior at Wichita State while helped the Shockers to a 20-10 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.

The Mount Vernon, N.Y., native was an all-state performer at Mount Vernon High School. After graduating from Wichita State in 1988 with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, he played professionally in Germany for one season before beginning his coaching career.

Hill and his wife, Renee, have two children: a son, Lewis Jr., and a daughter, Elle. Hill also has three other daughters, Sierra, Erica and Asya.
