UTRGV Picks Up Exhibition Victory Over Concordia

November 2, 2022 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team beat the Concordia University Tornados 136-81 in an exhibition game. Sophomore Will Johnston led eight Vaqueros in double-figures scoring with a double-double of 17 points, 10 assists and four rebounds. Sophomore John Shanu II scored 17 points on 8-of-8 shooting with three rebounds and two blocks. Senior Justin Johnson scored 16 points with six rebounds and four assists. Sophomore Sherman Brashear scored 16 points with five rebounds and three assists. Junior C.J. Jackson scored 15 points with five rebounds, four assists and two steals. Junior Daylen Williams posted a double-double with 14 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and two steals. Sophomore Derrius Ward scored 11 points with four rebounds and seven assists. Graduate student Dima Zdor scored 10 points with eight rebounds, two assists and three blocks. Freshman Alex Horiuk scored eight points. Freshman Isaiah Barganier scored five points with six rebounds, three assists and one steal. Junior Ahren Freeman finished with four points, seven rebounds and three assists. Freshman Noels Slivackis hit a 3-pointer to go with one rebound and one assist. The Vaqueros shot 61.9% (52-84) from the field. DJ Pigford led the Tornados with 14 points. Donovan Stafford and Jaylon Johnson each scored 11 points. A trio of Zdor layups helped the Vaqueros jump out to a 17-8 lead over the first six and a half minutes. After the Tornados scored the next five points, a pair of free throws, shook the basket with a dunk, and hit a 3-pointer as part of a 9-2 run that made the score 32-20. The Tornados got as close as 32-23 with seven minutes remaining in the first half before Williams scored five-straight points with two free throws and a 3-point play, sophomore John Shanu II and Jackson flew to the rim for back-to-back dunks, and Johnston sunk two free throws to fuel an 11-0 run to push the game out of reach.

UTRGV Drops Heartbreaker in WAC Tournament

March 8, 2022 at Michelob ULTRA Arena - #9 The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team dropped an 81-80 heartbreaker to the #8 California Baptist University Lancers in the Western Athletic Conference Tournament. Graduate student Xavier Johnson led the Vaqueros (8-23) with a season-high 27 points. Graduate student Marek Nelson scored 17 points on 7-of-13 shooting with nine rebounds and three steals. Graduate student Mike Adewunmi scored 14 points with eight rebounds and two steals. Taran Armstrong led the Lancers (18-14) with 13 points, six rebounds and five assists. Tre Armstrong scored 13 points. Ty Rowell, Reed Nottage and Chance Hunter all scored 12 points. Juhlawnei Stone finished with 11 points. The Vaqueros trailed 72-62 with 4:39 remaining. That's when sophomore Quinton Johnson II hit a jumper, Marek Nelson knocked down a layup and Adewunmi dunked the ball to bring the Vaqueros within 72-68. Then, after a pair of Taran Armstrong free throws, an Adewunmi layup and a Xavier Johnson 3 made the score 74-73. Tre Armstrong made a 3 of his own before Quinton Johnson knocked down a jumper and Nelson made a layup to tie the game at 77 with 56 seconds left. Taran Armstrong hit a free throw and Nottage made a 3 to put the Lancers up four. Xavier Johnson banked in a 3 to make the score 81-80 with 35 seconds remaining. The Vaqueros got a stop and took the ball down quickly. Adewunmi launched a 3 as time expired but it hit the backboard and the rim before bouncing out. Down 5-0 early, junior Justin Johnson made a pair of free throws and then junior Ricky "Doc" Nelson knocked down a layup, starting a streak of fivestraight made shots as the Vaqueros tied the game at 12 on a Marek Nelson jumper. The Lancers responded with an 8-1 run to go up 20-13. Marek Nelson answered with back-to-back jumpers and then Adewunmi made a layup to bring the Vagueros within 20-19. The Lancers pushed back again, scoring the next seven points to take a 27-19 lead. Xavier Johnson hit a 3 to spark a 6-2 run and bring the Vaqueros within 29-25. The Lancers went up eight with about a minute left, but Quinton Johnson hit a 3 just before time expired to bring the Vaqueros within 37-32. The Lancers pushed their lead to 12 at 50-38 early in the second half. Adewunmi followed with a 3 and then Xavier Johnson made four-straight baskets, including a 3 to cap a 12-3 run and bring the Vaqueros within 53-50. The Lancers pushed their lead back out to eight before a Xavier Johnson 3-point play brought the Vagueros within 62-57.

UTRGV Drops Regular Season Finale to Stephen F. Austin

March 5, 2022 at UTRGV Fieldhouse – The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) Vaqueros men's basketball team closed out the regular season with a 93-63 loss to the Stephen F. Austin Lumberjacks. Junior Justin Johnson led the Vaqueros (8-22, 3-15 WAC) with 20 points, eight rebounds and four assists. Sophomore Quinton Johnson II scored eight points. Freshman Donte Houston Jr. finished with seven points. Gavin Kensmill led the Lumberjacks (22-8, 14-4 WAC) with 33 points and nine rebounds. Calvin Solomon scored 13 points with seven rebounds and four assists. Latrell Jossell scored 11 points with four assists and two steals. Sadaidriene Hall scored 10 points with four rebounds. Junior Ricky "Doc" Nelson opened the game with a jumper to put the Vaqueros up 2-0 and then hit a pair of free throws to make the score 4-2. The Lumberjacks scored the next six points before Nelson found graduate student Marek Nelson for an alley-oop to make the score 8-6. The Lumberjacks hit their next four shots to go on an 11-0 run and take a 19-6 lead. Quinton Johnson knocked down a 3-pointer before the Lumberjacks scored the next five points. The Vaqueros pulled within 12 twice, first at 26-14 on a floater by graduate student Xavier Johnson and then at 28-16 on a layup by graduate student Mike Adewunmi, but the Lumberjacks responded with a 9-2 run to take their largest lead of the half at 37-18 with 1:43 remaining. The Lumberjacks were up 57-32 early in the second half when Marek Nelson hit a floater to spark a 17-6 run that brought the Vaqueros within 63-49 at the 10:39 mark. The Vaqueros hit all six of their shots during the run. The Lumberjacks responded by scoring seven-straight points as part of a 13-2 run to push the game out of reach.

Game Notes

Kansas State (11/7)

- This is the fourth-ever matchup between UTRGV and Kansas State, with the UTRGV dropping the first three on the road while scoring exactly 68 points each time (75-68 on 12/27/84, 69-68 on 1/2/01, 102-68 on 12/11/02).
- UTRGV is looking to win the season opener for the second year in a row after opening 2021-22 with a 74-59 home victory over Texas A&M International.
- UTRGV is looking to win the season opener on the road for the first time since Nov. 30, 1979, a 77-75 victory at UNLV. Since then, UTRGV has opened the season with a true road game 13 times.
- UTRGV <u>last opened the season on the road in 2020-21</u> at #19 Texas.
- UTRGV has two wins in 33 tries against teams in the Big 12 at the time of the game. Both wins were against Baylor Jan. 6, 2004, 55-54 in Waco, and Dec. 22, 2001, 72-66 in Carolina, Puerto Rico.

Concordia (11/2)

- UTRGV <u>beat Concordia 136-81 in an exhibition</u> game.
- Had this been a regular season game, UTRGV would have broken or tied the following program records:

Previous: 126 vs. Concordia Lutheran (now Concordia) (12/4/93) and Texas A&I (now Texas A&M-Kingsville) (1/23/76)

- UTRGV had 41 assists on 52 baskets (78.85%). The only time an NCAA DI team has had 41 or more assists on 52 or fewer baskets in a regular season game since 2010 was Dec. 5, 2021, when Cornell had 41 assists on 49 baskets (83.67%) vs. Keuka.
- UTRGV shot 61.9% (52-84) from the field.
- UTRGV recorded 10 blocks, which would have tied for the fifthhighest total in program history and been the most since Nov. 17, 2014, a 12-block performance vs. UTSA.
- UTRGV had eight players reach double-figures in scoring. Only twice in the regular season over the last 30 years has the team had seven players in double-figures scoring, Jan. 2, 2018 vs. Our Lady of the Lake and Dec. 4, 1993 vs. Concordia.
- Sophomore **Will Johnston** posted a <u>double-double</u> with a <u>game-high tying 17 points</u>, <u>game-high 10 assists</u>, and four rebounds.
- Sophomore John Shanu II scored a game-high tying 17 points on 8-of-8 shooting with three rebounds and two blocks.
- Senior Justin Johnson scored <u>16 points</u> with six rebounds and four assists.
- Sophomore Sherman Brashear scored <u>16 points</u> with five rebounds and three assists.

- Junior C.J. Jackson scored <u>15 points</u> with five rebounds, <u>four</u> assists and two steals.
- Junior Daylen Williams posted a <u>double-double</u> with <u>14 points</u>, a <u>game-high 10 rebounds</u>, <u>three assists</u> and two steals.
- Sophomore Derrius Ward scored <u>11 points</u> with four rebounds and seven assists.
- Graduate student Dima Zdor scored 10 points with eight rebounds, two assists and a game-high three blocks.

- Justin Johnson earned <u>Preseason All-WAC First Team</u> honors.
- UTRGV has <u>outperformed the preseason polls in three of the last five years</u>, including finishing a program best third in 2019-20 by going 9-7 in WAC play. UTRGV outperformed the 2018-19 poll by two spots, finishing fourth, after outperforming the 2017-18 poll by one spot, finishing fifth.



2021-22 Game Notes

- Justin Johnson earned <u>Second Team All-WAC</u> and <u>All-Newcomer Team</u> honors as voted on by the conference head coaches based on his play during WAC competition.
- During WAC play, Johnson averaged <u>18.8 points</u>, <u>7.3 rebounds</u> and 2.4 assists while shooting <u>48.9% from the field</u> in 18 games (16 starts).
- Johnson ranked <u>second in the WAC in scoring</u>, <u>third in defensive rebounding</u> (6.5), <u>fourth in rebounding</u> and <u>minutes per game</u> (34.8), and <u>seventh in field goal percentage</u>.
- Johnson reached double-figures in scoring in 17 out of 18 WAC games, including a career-high 38 points on 14-of-23 shooting (60.9%) at California Baptist on Feb. 12. This was the highest-scoring output by a Vaquero since Nov. 15, 2017, when Nick Dixon dropped 39 points at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Johnson had three 30+ point games, the most of any UTRGV player since 2001-02 (Mire Chatman).
- Johnson <u>played all 40 minutes seven times</u>, tied for the <u>21st-highest</u> total in the NCAA.
- UTRGV had 17 instances of players playing every second of a game, going the full 40 minutes each time. Since joining the WAC in 2013-14, UTRGV has had 39 instances of players playing at least 40 minutes. Of the 22 occurences prior to 2021-22, 14 featured players playing every second of the game, while the other eight were either overtime or double overtime games in which the players played 40 or more minutes but not the full 45 or 50. This was the first time UTRGV has had any player play every second of a game since 2015-16 (four times). It also happened six times in 2014-15 and four times among eight 40+ minute games in 2013-14. UTRGV also had players play at least 40 minutes in overtime contests twice in 2019-20 and once each in 2018-19 and 2016-17.
- UTRGV made <u>717 appearances at the foul line, the 20th highest total in the NCAA, making 498 free throws, which ranked 36th.

- UTRGV ranked second in the WAC in free throw attempts and makes.
- UTRGV <u>hit the same number of free throws as opponents four times in its first 16 games after doing so just four times in its previous 99 games</u>. Since 2008-09, UTRGV has had two season in which the feat occurred three times (2013-14 and 2012-13, each in 32 games), two seasons in which it occurred twice, two seasons in which it occurred once, and five in which it didn't happen.
- UTRGV <u>dressed between seven and nine players for 20 out of 30 games</u>, including each of the first 16 games.
- UTRGV <u>dressed just seven players during a three-game road trip Nov. 22-26, going 2-1, including road and neutral site wins over Northern Arizona and Cal State Fullerton, respectively, on consecutive days, and a near upset of #14 Illinois on the road.</u>
- For the second year in a row, UTRGV recorded its <u>largest-ever</u> margin of victory over <u>UTSA</u>, winning 68-50 (+18) on the road (12/17) one year after beating UTSA 81-64 (+17) at home.
- UTRGV <u>held UTSA to 25.7% shooting</u> from the field, the <u>lowest shooting percentage for an opponent since prior to the 2008-09 season.

Matt Figger Head Coach

Date Named: 3/29/21 • Collegiate Head Coaching Experience: Sixth Season • Alma Mater: Eastern Kentucky

UTRGV Athletics hired 2017-18 Ohio Valley Conference (OVC) Coach of the Year **Matt Figger**, who had been the head coach at Austin Peay for the previous four seasons, as the men's basketball head coach on March 29, 2021.

2021-22: In Figger's first season at the helm, he helped UTRGV get off to a hot start, with a 4-2 record that was a bucket away from behind 5-1 entering a matchup at #14 Illinois that UTRGV almost won despite dressing only seven players, as the game was tied at 82 with 3:03 remaining and was still a one possession game with 1:57 to go ... Figger led UTRGV to their largest-ever margin of victory over UTSA, winning by 18 on the road, as well as a WAC sweep of Lamar ... Figger coached **Justin Johnson** to All-WAC Second Team and All-Newcomer Team honors. As of March 9, Figger's squad led the NCAA in free throw attempts (717) while ranking eighth in makes (498) ... The Vaqueros were also 94th in three-point defense (32.1%).

Austin Peay (2017-21): Figger compiled a 76-51 (.598) record, including a 49-25 (.662) mark in OVC play.

When Figger arrived at Austin Peay in 2017-18, he took a team that had gone 11-19 (7-9 OVC) the previous year and guided them to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) Quarterfinals, ending the season with a 19-15 record (12-6 OVC). Figger's teams went on to go 22-11 (13-5 OVC) in 2018-19 and 21-12 (14-4 OVC) in 2019-20 before finishing this past season 14-13 (10-10 OVC).

Under Figger's tutelage, the Governors made one of the NCAA's largest defensive turnarounds in 2017-18, going from allowing 83.8 points per game (ppg) to 71.2 ppg, with the 12.6 drop in points allowed the second-largest in the nation.

In his second season, the Governors reached 20 victories for the first time since 2010-11. Figger also became the first Austin Peay coach with double-digit conference wins in his first two seasons.

Among the student-athletes to play under Figger was two-time OVC Player of the Year **Terry Taylor**, who recorded an NCAA-best 20 double-doubles in 27 games this past season while also leading the NCAA in offensive rebounding at 5.15 per game.

Off the court, Figger's teams displayed impressive academic prowess, recording a team grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 in each of his last three semesters. This includes a 3.538 GPA in the fall of 2020 and a 3.542 in the spring of 2020.

Figger's teams were also active in the community. In 2019, for example, student-athlete **Zach Glotta** was one of 46 Division I basketball players nominated to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Give Back Team, recognizing men's basketball student-athletes for outstanding community service.

South Carolina (2012-17): Figger went to Austin Peay on the heels of a whirlwind Final Four run as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at South Carolina. The Gamecocks were the East Region champion, taking down Marquette, Duke, Baylor and Florida. Figger, who was at South Carolina from 2012-17, assisted in the revival of a program that hadn't enjoyed a 20-win season since 2008-09, had not advanced to an NCAA Tournament since 2003-04, and had not won an NCAA Tournament game since 1973.

Kansas State (2007-12): Figger arrived in South Carolina after serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Kansas State from 2007-12. There, Figger was part of a staff that secured at least 21 wins and finished fifth or better in the Big 12 each season. In his first season, Kansas State won its first NCAA Tournament game since 1988 while posting a 20-win season – just its fourth since 1990. The 2008-09 squad posted 22 wins and earned an at-large bid to the NIT, which set the stage for a record-setting season in 2009-10, when the team posted a school-record 29 wins en route to the program's first NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance in over two decades. The Wildcats defeated six ranked opponents that season, finishing the year ranked seventh in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches Top 25 polls.

Figger signed two McDonald's All-Americans at Kansas State, including 2008 National Freshman and Player of the Year **Michael Beasley**, a first-round pick in the NBA Draft. Beasley was one of five All-Americans tutored by Figger.

South Alabama (2003-07): Prior to his time at Kansas State, Figger served a brief stint as the director of operations at Arkansas (April-June 2007), which followed five seasons as an assistant coach at South Alabama (2003-07). South Alabama enjoyed some of its greatest success during Figger's time on staff, especially the final two seasons when the team reached the NCAA Tournament and NIT, respectively.

Junior College (1993-02): Prior to his time at South Alabama, Figger spent 10 years as an assistant coach in the junior college ranks, including stints at Wabash Valley (1993-94), Vincennes (1994-99) and Odessa College (2000-02). His teams won 20 or more games eight times, captured six region and four district titles and advanced to the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) national tournament four times.

Personal: Originally from Jenkins, Ky., Figger earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Eastern Kentucky in 1995. He played baseball at Pikeville College from 1990-91 before completing his education at Eastern Kentucky.

Figger and his wife, Katrina, have one son, Vince.
