SOCCER AND TRACK & FIELD COMPLEX



Built in 2014, the UTRGV Soccer and Track & Field Complex is located on the west end of campus.

The complex had a seating capacity of 555 in 2014 and has grown to 1,250 in 2015 to meet ticket demands. Additionally, UTRGV Athletics has installed lights to allow for night matches in 2015.

Once all phases of construction are complete, the complex will include not only the main field, but two practice fields as well. The main area will have permanent concession stands, offices, training rooms, locker rooms, team rooms, and a press box.

The initial soccer field is of exceptional quality. As such, care is being taken to protect the high quality of the playing surface from adverse effects of extreme weather and wear-and-tear. Despite these precautions, the complex hosts and will host numerous outside events, including professional matches, exhibitions, camps, clinics, and high school competitions.

The complex opened with the women's soccer team beating Chicago State 3-0 on Oct. 10, 2014.

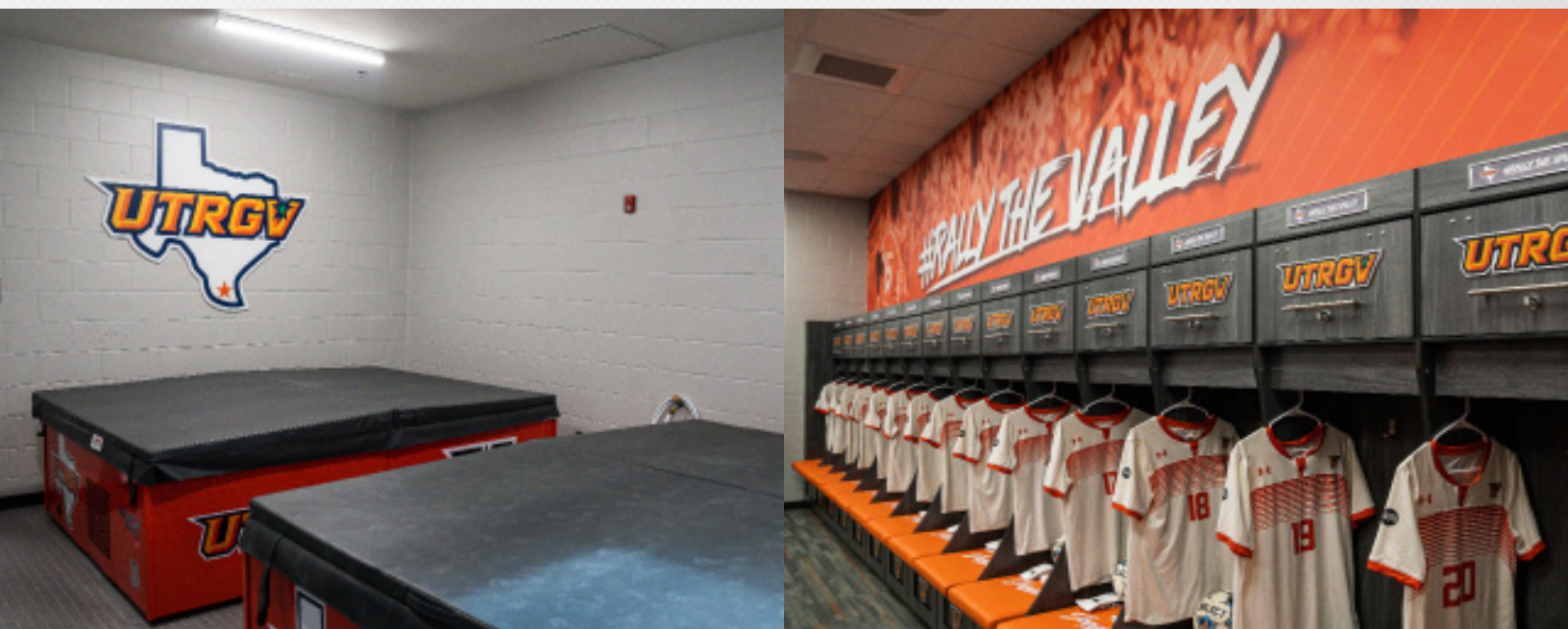

Renovations to the UTRGV Soccer and Track & Field Complex are underway, as a new press box has been installed and should be ready to use to the start of the 2022 soccer seasons. UTRGV is also installing a new sound system to upgrade the student-athlete and fan experience.

The renovations to the UTRGV Soccer and Track & Field Complex are part of a \$30 million investment in department facilities that was announced in April 2022.

Construction on an operations center for the soccer programs will begin soon, with new locker rooms and coaches' offices as well as a new sports medicine facility for those programs. The completion of the renovations is scheduled for 2023.

VICTORY CENTER



For today's student-athletes, training and conditioning is a year-round commitment. Balancing the rigors of competing at the collegiate level with the demands of the classroom is one of the greatest challenges our student-athletes face. That is why it is so essential that the department of intercollegiate athletics provides our student-athletes with access to hands-on academic support.

Located in the Academic Services Building, the Victory Center is an integral part of the life of our student-athletes and has a vast amount of services and assistance available.



The Victory Center is structured after the principles of the NCAA CHAMPS/Life Skills Program, which is created to provide student-athletes with five basic components: Academic Excellence, Athletic Excellence, Community Service, Career Development and Personal Development.

UTRGV has approximately 275 student-athletes, including approximately 150 freshmen and transfers, who are required to attend study hall and specially designed workshops that assist them in acclimating to college life and living away from home. Student-athletes must dedicate anywhere from six to 10 hours each week to study hall as they work toward their ultimate goal, graduation.

The Victory Center provides student-athletes access to computers, tutors and other resources. The Victory Center, which is open six days a week (Sunday-Friday), houses a computer lab, a learning lab, areas for both individual and group study, and offices for the Academic Advisement Center staff.

Each student-athlete works with their college advisor to make sure that they are enrolled in the correct classes to graduate. The Victory Center staff verifies the classes to ensure that the student-athlete is working towards their degree, making yearly satisfactory progress and meeting grade point average requirements.

History

UTRGV was created by the Texas Legislature in 2013 as the first major public university of the 21st century in Texas. This transformative initiative provided the opportunity to expand educational opportunities in the Rio Grande Valley, including a new School of Medicine, and made it possible for residents of the region to benefit from the Permanent University Fund – a public endowment contributing support to the University of Texas System and other institutions.

UTRGV has campuses and off-campus research & teaching sites throughout the Valley including Boca Chica Beach, Brownsville (formerly The University of Texas at Brownsville campus), Edinburg (formerly The University of Texas-Pan American campus), Harlingen, McAllen, Port Isabel, Rio Grande City, and South Padre Island. UTRGV, a comprehensive academic institution, enrolled its first class in the fall of 2015, and the School of Medicine welcomed its first class in the summer of 2016.

UT Brownsville and UT Pan American

The shared history of The University of Texas-Pan American and The University of Texas at Brownsville goes back to 1973, when Pan American opened a second campus in Brownsville, which later became an independent institution of The University of Texas System in 1991. Over the years, the missions and the identities of these great institutions have continually evolved to serve the communities of the Rio Grande Valley.

SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

At the UTRGV School of Medicine, students have access to high-quality, innovative medical education programs that are designed to train the next generation of physician leaders in medical education, scientific research, and patient care.

Our mission is to educate a diverse group of dedicated students who will become physicians who serve across all the disciplines of medicine; to bring hope to patients by advancing medical knowledge through research; to integrate education and research to advance the quality and accessibility of patient care in an integrated manner, and to engage with the Rio Grande Valley communities to benefit Texas and the world.

MD Program

The UTRGV School of Medicine is committed to providing a forward-thinking medical education experience that graduates physicians dedicated to practicing scientific, evidence-based, and patient-centered medicine in any setting, but particularly in under-served communities. The curriculum provides a unique educational experience that integrates basic science disciplines, clinical skills, and professional development throughout the four-year program by incorporating and promoting:

- Principles of evidence-based practice & scientific research;
- Community and population-based health care;
- Patient advocacy and cultural awareness;
- Inter-professional collaboration and communication;
- Ethical and professional behavior;
- Life-long learning and problem-solving.

The school's distinctive geographic location at the border of the US and Mexico offers a rich bicultural experience

that will afford students with the opportunity to experience and to learn about border medicine and the interplay between the cross-cultural, socio-economic and environmental determinants of health.

The Four-Year Curriculum

The general four-year curriculum is divided into two pre-clerkship years comprised of sequential and longitudinal learning modules and two clerkship years comprised of clerkships, selective clerkships and sub-internships and electives. Woven throughout this four-year integrated curriculum are:

- Interprofessional Education: Students are given the opportunity to experience interprofessional education and team-based care by working and learning alongside an array of disciplines that include nursing, pharmacy, physician assistants, public health, social work, behavioral health and occupational therapy.
- Early Clinical Exposure: Students are given the opportunity to participate in direct patient interactions during the pre-clerkship years through venues such as the UTRGV Student-Run Free Clinic, Colonia UniMovil clinics, Operation Lone Stars, health fairs, and more.
- Underserved Medicine: Student are given the opportunity to work in under-served communities, Colonias, and at the student-run free clinic, to learn about healthcare disparities and population health.

Graduate Medical Education (GME)

The GME process, which includes residencies and fellowships, is intended to prepare the physician for the independent practice of medicine and to assist in the development of a commitment to the life-long learning process that is critical for maintaining professional growth and competency.



SCHOOL OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE



The UTRGV School of Podiatric Medicine, located in Harlingen, Texas, is a four-year, professional graduate level education, granting the degree of Doctor of Podiatric Medicine. As the only school of podiatric medicine in Texas and one of only 10 across the country, our podiatry program offers students a superior medical education taught by distinguished faculty who are at the forefront of the podiatric profession.

Through our innovative curriculum, we will train and prepare students to be highly competent physicians who will excel in residency training and become global leaders in the field of podiatric medicine, surgery, and research.

Accreditation

The UTRGV School of Podiatric Medicine (SOPM) has received approval from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). The Council on Podiatric Medical Education has approved the UTRGV SOPM eligibility application.

Our candidate status site visit was January 24-25, 2022, and we anticipate approval during the Council's April 23, 2022, meeting allowing UTRGV SOPM to recruit its inaugural class.

didactic, laboratory, and clinical/patient care experiences to prepare its students for post-graduate podiatric medical and surgical residency training.

The UTRGV SOPM's goal is to provide a podiatric medical education that graduates podiatric physicians dedicated to practicing evidence-based and patient-centered medicine in South Texas and beyond.

Third and Fourth-Year Curriculum

Third-year curriculum: In the third year, students will spend the majority of their time in four-week block clinical rotations offered at different private clinics, out-patient clinics, and hospital sites throughout the Rio Grande Valley. The third-year clerkship rotations will provide students with complete clinical and hands-on experience to augment the foundational medical knowledge and clinical skills gained during Years 1 and 2. The clinical rotations are designed to set the foundation for clinical skills the student will use in their professional career. Students will participate in core podiatric and general medicine and surgery clerkship rotations, selective and electives in various specialties at various healthcare settings. As part of their didactic education, students will attend and participate in mandatory grand round sessions twice a week throughout the third year.

Fourth-year curriculum: The fourth year is the final preparatory phase for entry into a podiatric residency program. Students will spend the first five months in elective podiatric medicine and surgical externship rotations at different sites nationwide. This offers students the opportunity to tailor their educational experience to their own interests and gain exposure to the residency program they are interested in pursuing. Two months are devoted to residency readiness and board review for APMLE Step 2. The student will spend the final three months of their fourth year participating in additional rotations in Podiatric Medicine and Surgery, General Medicine, or Surgery.

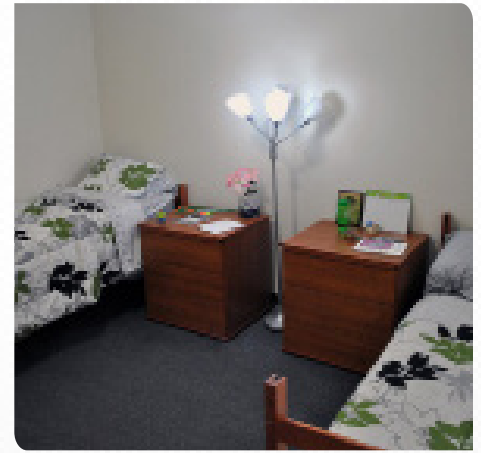

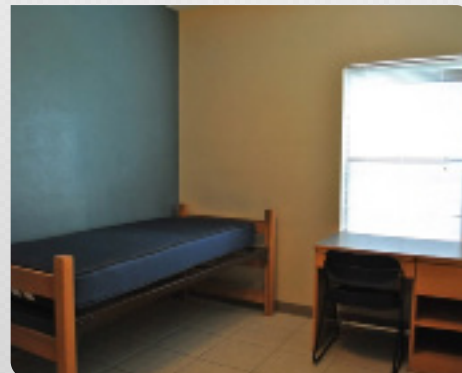
- Designed in suite style, with two rooms sharing a bathroom.

- Services provided include: central heat and air, 24-hour emergency maintenance, mail delivery, garbage collection, on-site student parking, ethernet connections, and cable.

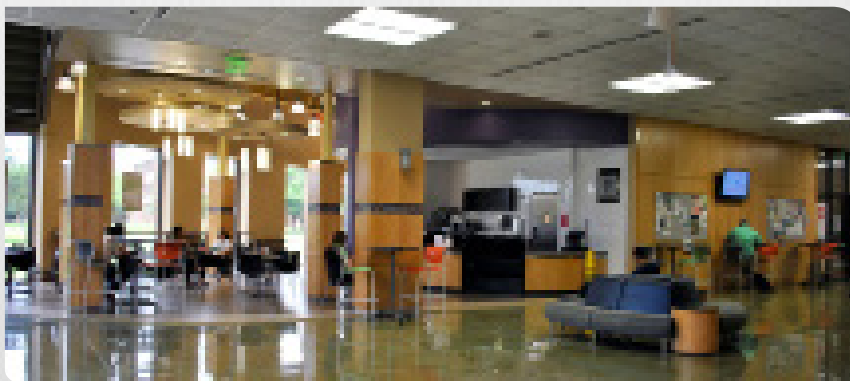
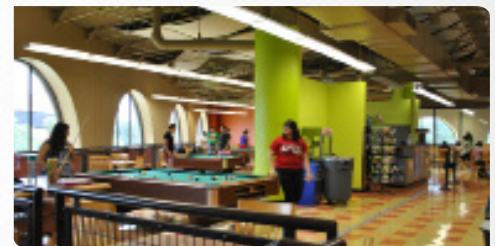


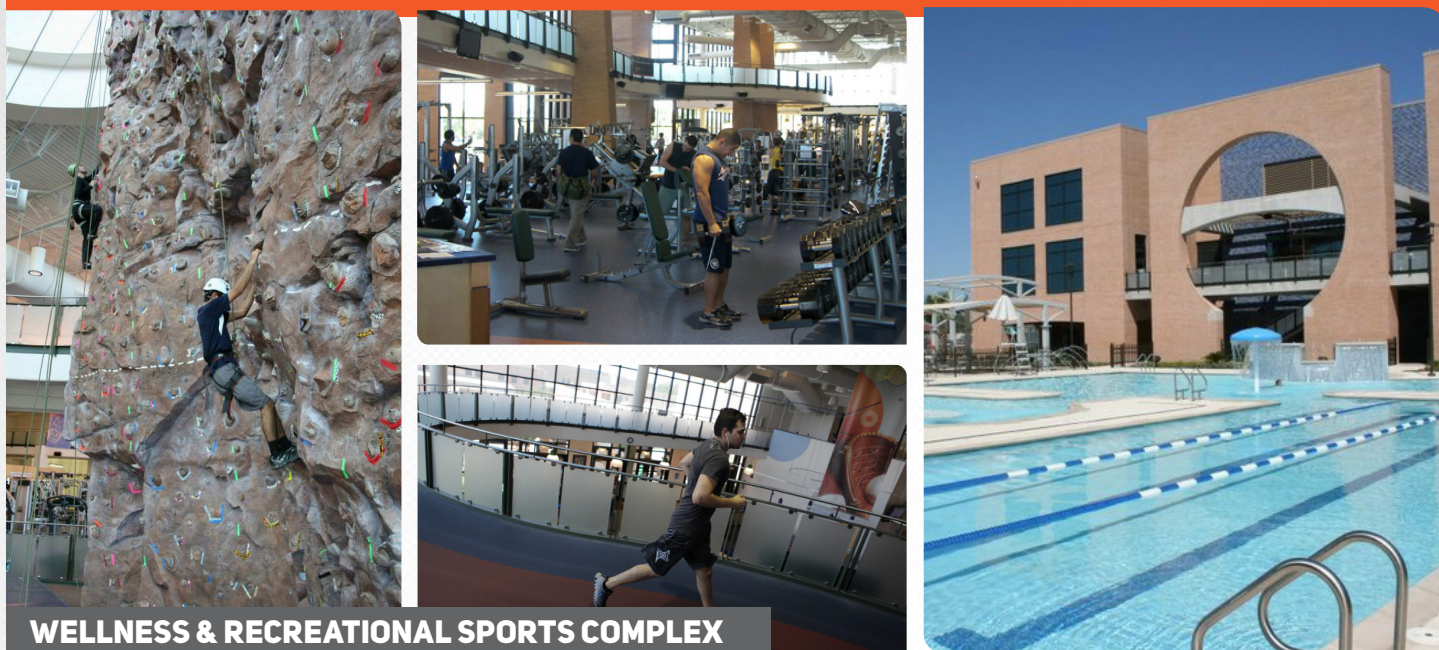
Student Union

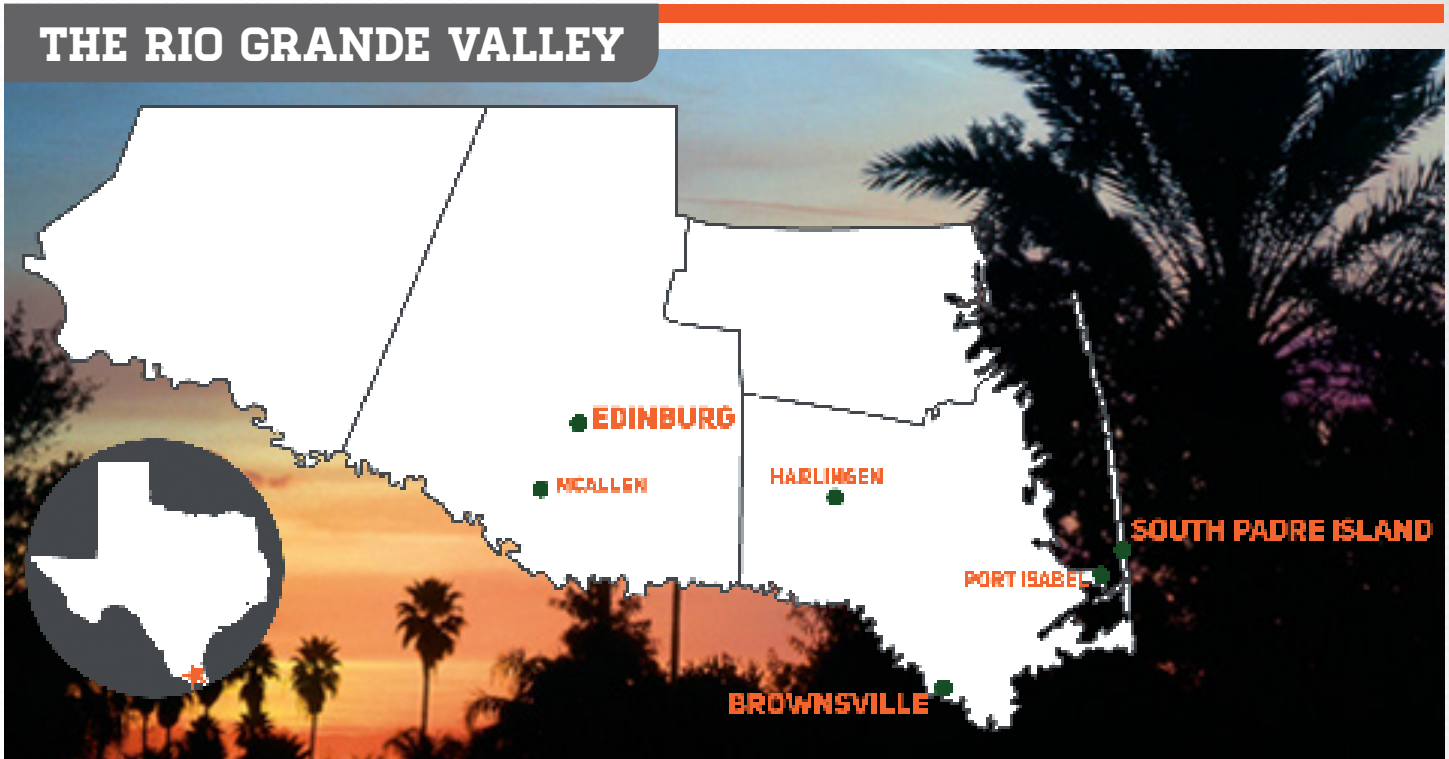


WELLNESS & RECREATIONAL SPORTS COMPLEX



- Weight area includes both free weights and exercise machines, including dumbbells, strength training equipment, cardiovascular machines, and multiple televisions for entertainment.
- Walking/running track, approximately 1/10 mile, with area for stretching. There are also stability balls and mats as well as three racquetball courts.
- Two dance/activity rooms for group exercise and specialty programs.
- The main gymnasium space can be divided into two basketball, two volleyball or multiple badminton courts. One indoor soccer court with rounded corners, dasher boards and Plexiglas can also be utilized as a basketball, volleyball or badminton court. Used for open recreation and intramurals.
- Indoor Climbing Facility (35' high) combines integral rock and moveable hand and foot holds. Also features three routes and hosts instructional courses from beginner to advanced. Group facility and private party rentals are available. Aquatics facilities feature a lap swimming pool, leisure pool, lazy river, and a jacuzzi. It is a perfect place for a private party or group rental.
- Outdoor Activity Area features two sand volleyball courts, two outdoor basketball courts, two tennis courts, and an outdoor pavilion with tables and chairs. A BBQ grill is available for group rentals.
- Men's and women's locker rooms with over 400 lockers, private shower areas, and vanity areas.
- Member Services Desk assists guests with membership sales, locker rentals, retail sales, and general guest services.
- Energy Zone serves up sandwiches, smoothies, specialty items, salads, fruits, soft drinks, sports drinks and bottled water.
- Lounge/Eating Area with tables and chairs, lounge furniture, couches, televisions, vending machines and great observational area for many activities.

- The Vipers play at Bert Ogden Arena, which has also hosted UTRGV basketball events on a semi-regular basis including, women's basketball's matchup vs #7 Texas in front of a record-breaking 6,591 fans in the 2023-24 season and men's basketball's doubleheader featuring UTRGV vs Western Illinois and Texas vs Northern Arizona in the 2022-23 season.

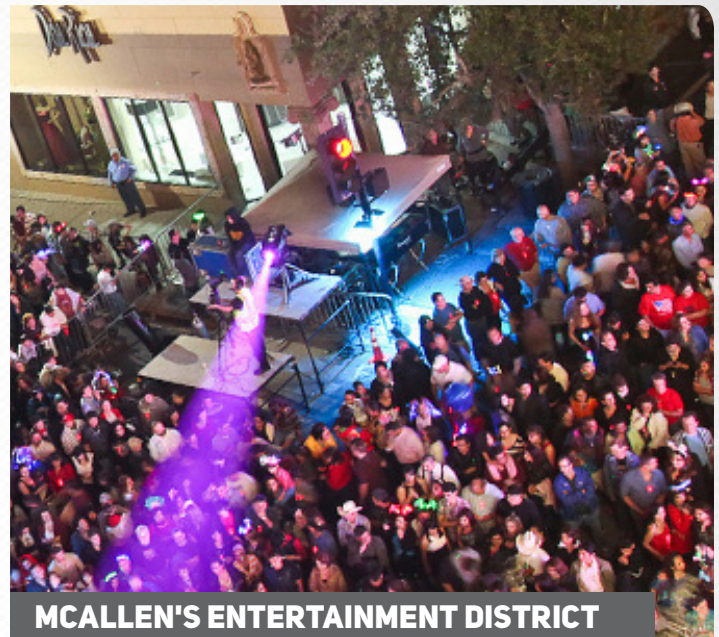

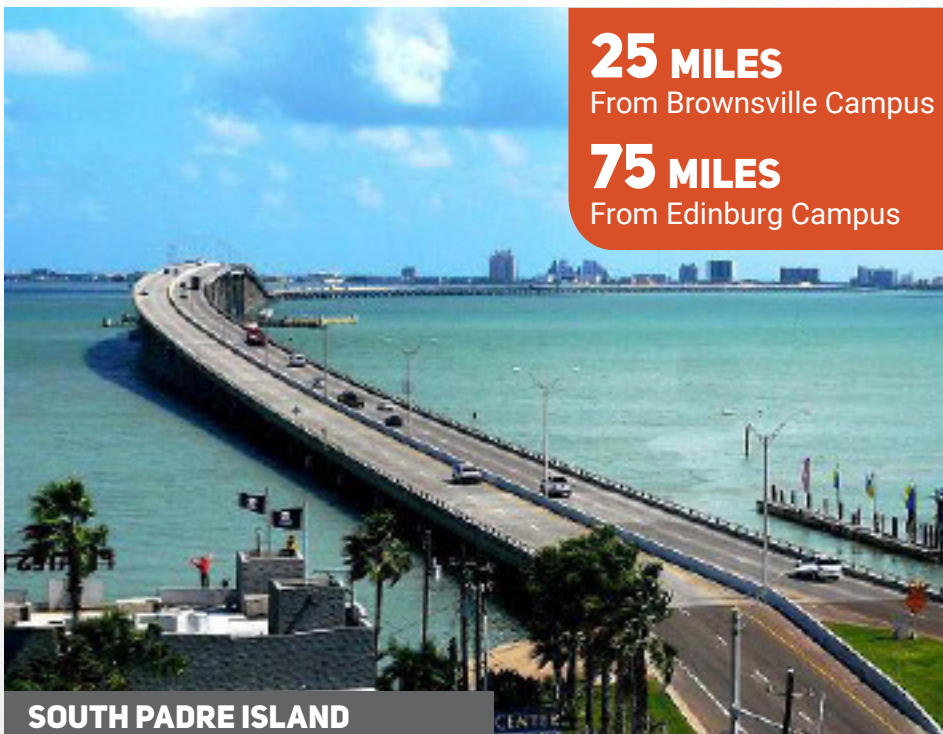

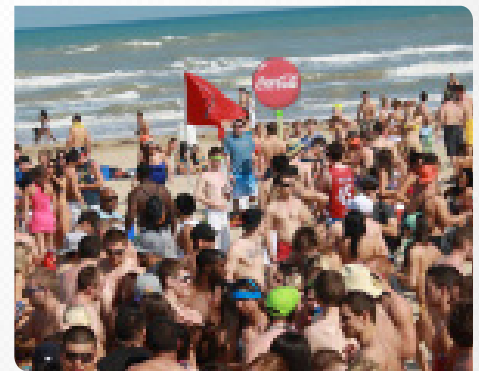
