SETTING THE SCENE

The Toledo men's basketball team (6-2) looks to rebound from Saturday's 81-68 loss at No. 22 Michigan State when it hosts Bradley (4-5, 1-0 MVC) on Tuesday, Dec. 7 in Savage Arena. Tip-off time is set for 7:00 p.m. with streaming on ESPN+.

The Rockets will be looking to avenge defeats at the hands of the Braves the last two years, including a 61-59 setback at the buzzer last year in their season opener at the Xavier Invitational.

Sophomore **Ryan Rollins** paced the Rockets with a game-high 21 points against the Spartans. Junior **Setric Millner Jr.** scored 17, and junior RayJ Dennis registered his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Rollins leads Toledo and ranks 26th nationally with a MAC-best 20.1 ppg. He has scored 15 or more points against each of the Rockets' Division I opponents, including a career-high 35 points against Coastal Carolina (Nov. 24).

Joining Rollins in double digits are Millner (15.1), junior **JT Shumate** (13.9) and Dennis (11.8). Shumate (7.1 rpg) and Millner (6.6 rpg) are pacing the Rockets in rebounding, while Dennis is dishing out a team-high 3.8 apg.

The Rockets are outrebounding their opposition by 7.9 rpg this season, a figure that ranks 33rd in the nation. Toledo also ranked 32nd nationally with 29.1 defensive rpg.

Bradley has won three straight games with an average margin of victory of 19.7 ppg following Saturday's 80-55 win over SIU Edwardsville. Junior guard Terry Roberts is leading the Braves with 14.8 ppg, 3.9 apg and 1.7 spg. Junior forward Ja'Shon Henry is also scoring in double digits at 10.6 ppg.

- **Ryan Rollins** scored a career-high 35 points en route to earning Tournament MVP honors at the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship. He was 12-of-20 from the field, a career-best 4-of-5 from three-point range and 7-of-9 from the free-throw line.
- Rollins topped MAC freshmen with 13.5 ppg last year and was named MAC Freshman of the Year as well as being named a finalist for the Kyle Macy National Freshman of the Year. He ranked second on the team with 2.6 apg, third with 5.3 rpg.
- Rollins has scored in double digits in 33 of 38 career games and his 410 points last year ranked fourth all-time for points by a Rocket freshman. He trailed only **Julius Brown** (427, 2011-12), **Ken Epperson** (420, 1981-82) and **Jake Barnett** (414, 2009-10).
- **Setric Millner Jr.** scored a career-high 27 points on 9-of-13 shooting vs. Charlotte (Nov. 22) and followed that up with an 18-point, 12-rebound effort vs. Tulane (Nov. 23).
- Millner is averaging 18.8 ppg with a 52.3 FG%, 47.4 three-point FG% (9-of-19) and 85.0 FT% (17-of-20) in his last five games.
- **Ryan Rollins** is the only Rocket to score in double digits in every game and has scored 15 or more points vs. every Division I opponent this season.
- **JT Shumate** ranks in the MAC's Top 15 in six categories. He is fifth with a 46.7 three-point FG%, fifth with a 57.6 FG%, tied for eighth with 4.8 defensive rpg and 2.4 offensive rpg, ninth with 7.1 rpg, and 11th with 13.9 ppg.
- Shumate tallied a career-high 33 points and set a school record by making 11-of-11 shots (5-of-5 3PTFG) at Miami last year.
- Shumate transferred to Toledo from NCAA Division II Walsh University in April 2020 and received immediate eligibility in mid-December. He has two sisters playing college basketball — Katie is a junior at Kent State and Emma is a freshman at Ohio State.
- **RayJ Dennis** scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed nine boards vs. Charlotte (Nov. 22). He is tied for fifth in the MAC with a team-high 3.8 apg and tied for sixth with a team-best 4.9 defensive rpg.
- Head Coach **Tod Kowalczyk** is in his 12th season at the Rockets' helm and has guided Toledo to five 20-win campaigns in the last eight years, marking the first time for this accomplishment since Bob Nichols recorded five straight 20-win seasons from 1976-81.
- Toledo has now won four in-season tournaments during Coach Kowalczyk's tenure. The Rockets won the Texas-Pan American Tournament in 2012, 2K Sports Classic Sub Regional in 2013, the Gulfcoast Showcase in 2018 and the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship last week.

A LOOK AT THE ROCKETS

Toledo captured its ninth Mid-American Conference title in program history and registered its fifth 20-win season in the last eight years in the 2020-21 campaign.

Toledo won a school-record 27 games under Coach Kowalczyk in the 2013-14 campaign. The Rockets' 25 victories in 2018-19 ranked second in program history.

The Rockets have produced a strong run of success in recent years and possess a 92-45 (.672) win-loss mark since the start of the 2017-18 season.

TOLEDO RANKING AMONG TOP 50 IN WINS & WIN PERCENTAGE

Entering this season, Toledo's **86 wins** over the last **FOUR** years ranked **41st** in the country. In addition, the Rockets' **.667** winning percentage during that same period ranked **49th**.

Over the last **EIGHT** years, Toledo's **167 wins** ranked **45th** in the country. The Rockets' **.637** winning percentage during that same period ranked **48th** as well.

ROCKETS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

Toledo is picked to finish third in the 2021-22 season, according to voting from the league's 12 head coaches. In addition, **Ryan Rollins** was named to the Preseason All-MAC First Team squad. The Rockets received 107 points in the poll, trailing only Buffalo (143 pts.) and Ohio (126 pts.).

TRIPLE-DOUBLE HISTORY UNDER COACH KOWALCZYK

Toledo's program went 100 years without having a triple-double and now has five in the last six seasons under Coach Kowalczyk. **Marreon Jackson** tallied two of those in the 2020-21 campaign with 18 pts., 11 asst. and 10 reb. vs. Miami and 22 pts., 13 reb. and 10 asst. vs. Ball State.

Nathan Boothe registered the first triple-double with 12 pts., 13 reb. and 10 asst. vs. San Jose State at the Great Alaska Shooout in 2015. He was followed by 2018 MAC Player of the Year **Tre'Shaun Fletcher** with 20 pts., 11 reb., and 11 asst. at NIU in 2018 and **Luke Knapke** with 12 pts, 12 reb. and a school-record 10 blocks at Cleveland State.

A RARE TRIPLE CROWN

Toledo became just the second program in Mid-American Conference history to receive Player of Year, Coach of Year and Freshman of Year last season.

Marreon Jackson, Ryan Rollins and **Tod Kowalczyk** were named Player of Year, Freshman of Year and Coach of Year, respectively.

Eastern Michigan was the first school to be honored with all three awards when Grant Long, Lorenzo Neely and Ben Braun were the recipients in 1988.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE

Toledo appeared on national television on eight occasions last season. The Rockets played on the CBS Sports Network on four occasions with two appearances each on ESPN2 and FS1.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Rockets were 12-1 at home last season and their .923 winning percentage was their best since going 15-0 in the 2013-14 season. UT's only defeat in Savage Arena last year was an 88-81 loss to Bowling Green (Feb. 13).

Toledo is 38-9 (.809) at home since the start of the 2018-19 campaign.

Toledo posted a 10-6 record on its home court in 2019-20, a 14-2 mark in 2018-19, a 12-4 record in 2016-17 and 2017-18, a 9-6 mark in 2015-16, a 10-5 ledger in 2014-15 and a perfect 15-0 mark in 2013-14.

The Rockets' unbeaten record (15-0) at home in 2013-14 was their first since 1966-67 and just the fourth time in school history UT has accomplished the feat.

ROAD WARRIORS

The Rockets have posted a 32-27 (.542) win-loss mark in road games over the last three-plus seasons and are 32-24 (.571) in their last 55 road tilts. Over the last seven-plus years, Toledo possesses a 60-58 (.508) win-loss mark on enemy courts.

Sophomore guard **Ryan Rollins** earned MAC Freshman of the Year and All-MAC Honorable Mention honors last year after leading all league freshmen with 13.5 ppg. He ranked second on the team with 2.6 apg and third with 5.3 rpg. Rollins was also named a finalist for the Kyle Macy National Freshman of the Year.

A Macomb, Mich. native, Rollins scored in double digits in 25 of 30 contests, including three 20-point contests. He scored a season-high 25 points vs. CMU (Jan. 19) and tallied 20 points at Xavier (Nov. 27) and WMU (Jan. 2).

Rollins tallied two double-doubles with 15 points and a season-high 13 rebounds at Marshall (Dec. 16) and 16 points and 11 boards vs. Northern Illinois (Dec. 22).

ROLLINS RECEIVES PRESEASON ACCOLADES

Sophomore guard **Ryan Rollins** was named to the Preseason All-MAC First Team and was the only true sophomore to be named to either the first or second team.

Rollins also has been named to the 2021-22 Lou Henson Award Preseason Watch List. The award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I mid-major player and Rollins is one of six sophomores and three MAC players to be included on the list.

Former Rockets **Marreon Jackson** (2021), **Tre'Shaun Fletcher** (2018), **Nathan Boothe** (2016) and **Julius Brown** (2014, 2015) have been previously selected to the Lou Henson All-America Team.

MILLNER A MAINSTAY

Junior **Setric Millner, Jr.** provided consistency for Toledo's frontcourt last year in his first season as a Rocket and has improved on that this season.

Millner ranks third on the team in scoring with 15.1 ppg and second with 6.6 rpg and a 40.0 three-point FG%. He is coming off an all-tournament team performance in the Baha Mar Hoops Nassau Championship and is averaging 18.8 ppg with a 52.3 FG%, 47.4 three-point FG% (9-of-19) and 85.0 FT% (17-of-20) in his last five games.

Millner averaged 12.9 ppg, grabbed a team-high 6.8 rpg and averaged 33.6 mpg while starting all 30 contests last year. He scored in double digits in 25 games, including a career-high 26-point, nine-rebound outing vs. Ohio in the MAC semifinals.

The Little Rock, Ark. native started all 27 games and averaged 7.1 ppg and 4.7 rpg as a freshman at Cleveland State in 2018-19 before playing for Northwest Florida State College last year where he averaged 14.6 ppg, 5.5 rpg and 1.1 spg.

SHUMATE STEPPING UP HIS GAME

Junior **JT Shumate** has continued his stellar play after making an immediate impact as a transfer from NCAA Division II Walsh University last season. Shumate ranks third in the MAC with a 46.7 3PTFG% (14-of-30) and is fifth with a 57.6 FG%. He also is leading the team with 7.1 rpg and has scored in double digits in seven of eight contests.

Shumate ranked third in the MAC with a 1.4 bpg and a team-best .593 field goal percentage, a mark that is tied for eighth in program history. Shumate also shot 62.9 percent (**5th in school history**) from the field in league play and ranked third on team with a 39.1 three-point FG%.

DENNIS DELIVERING FOR ROCKETS

Junior guard **RayJ Dennis** has made an immediate impact after transferring to Toledo from Boise State last spring. Dennis is tied for fifth in the MAC with a team-high 3.8 apg and second with an 86.4 FT% (19-of-22). He also ranks third on the team with 6.0 rpg and fourth with 11.8 ppg. Dennis registered his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds at No. 22 Michigan State (Dec. 4). He also scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed nine boards in the Rockets' 98-86 win over Charlotte (Nov. 22).

A 6-2, 180-pound guard, Dennis started 25 of 28 contests and averaged 8.6 ppg, 3.0 rpg, a team-best 2.9 apg and 1.2 spg in 27.2 mpg this past season for a Boise State squad that posted a 19-9 overall record and a 14-6 Mountain West Conference mark. The Oswego, Ill. native, tied his career high with 19 points at NCAA Tournament participant BYU (Dec. 9) and also led the Broncos with 18 points in their season opener at NCAA Final Four squad Houston (Nov. 27).

EDU OUT AFTER KNEE SURGERY

Junior center **AJ Edu** was scheduled to return to the court this fall after suffering a season-ending knee injury in the Rockets' second game last season. The Colchester, England native will now have to wait until February after suffering another knee injury this past summer.

Edu ranked second in the MAC with 1.7 bpg in 2018-19 and finished first in league play with 1.9 bpg. He blocked a season-high six shots vs. Western Michigan, the most by a Rocket at the time since Allen Pinson swatted away seven shots at Duke on Dec. 12, 2004. Edu's six blocks were the second most by a Rocket in a conference game and tied for fourth most in overall contests.

He finished third on Toledo's single-season blocked shot list with 57, three behind Luke Knapke's (2017-18) and J.C. Harris' (1990-91) school record of 60. Edu's 57 blocked shots are the most by a freshman in program history.

SHARPSHOOTERS

Toledo has ranked in the Top 3 of the MAC in free-throw shooting and posted a 72.5 FT% or higher in nine of the last 10 seasons. The Rockets were first last year with a 78.0 FT% and are second this season with a 76.0 FT%. The lone exception was Toledo's 69.5 mark in 2016-17 that placed it sixth in the conference.

Toledo was first in the MAC in 2018-19 (and 12th nationally) with its 77.2 FT%. The Rockets were second in 2015-16 with a 74.7 FT% after topping the MAC with a 74.2 FT% in the 2014-15 campaign. The Rockets were also second in 2013-14 with their 72.5 free-throw percentage (behind Miami's 75.4%).

Toledo paced the MAC at the charity stripe in the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, posting a 72.6 mark in 2011-12 and ranking eighth nationally in 2012-13 with a school-record 76.1 clip.

- Toledo ranked in the Top 25 nationally in eight categories** - 1st in 3PTFGs made (314), 5th with 10.5 3PTFGs/game, 15th with a 1.45 A/TO ratio, 15th with 81.1 ppg, 18th with a 29.8 three-point FG% defense and 18th with a 78.0 FT%.
- Toledo won a school-record 15 league games and is the only MAC school to win 13 or more league games in three of last four years.
- The Rockets won 13 of their 15 MAC games by nine points or more and led the league with a plus-12.0 scoring margin in conference games.
- Five or more Rockets scored in double digits on 10 occasions.
- Toledo allowed an opponent to register a 40.0 3PTFG% or higher only five times.
- Toledo connected for 10 or more treys in a game in 20 of 30 contests.

ROCKETS SIT ATOP MAC IN GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

Toledo received a Graduation Success Rate (GSR) of 100 percent in the latest figures released by the NCAA. The Rockets are joined at 100 percent by Akron and Kent State and followed by Ball State (91), Miami (91), Ohio (90), Western Michigan (90), Eastern Michigan (85), Buffalo (82), Central Michigan (79), Northern Illinois (75) and Bowling Green (62).

GSR is a gauge of every team's graduation rate within a six-year period of a student-athlete's enrollment. The latest GSR figures examined the student-athlete cohort that originally enrolled in 2013 and would need to have graduated by August of 2019 to count as a graduate. The GSR formula, intended to be a more complete and accurate look at student-athlete success, removes from the rate student-athletes who leave school while academically eligible and includes student-athletes who transfer to a school after initially enrolling elsewhere. The GSR also allows for a deeper understanding of graduation success in individual sports than the federal metric, which has broader groupings.

MORE ACADEMIC ACCOLADES

Toledo received the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Team Academic Excellence Award for the sixth time in last eight years in the 2020-21 campaign.

Toledo is one of 14 schools to receive the honor in five of the last six years. They are joined by Belmont, Bradley, Eastern Washington, Gonzaga, Harvard, North Dakota State, Northwestern, Rice, Seton Hall, Stanford, Utah Valley, Villanova and Yale.

Toledo's six NABC Team Academic Excellence Awards leads all MAC schools.

The Rockets posted a 3.15 GPA during the 2020-21 academic year with five Rockets — **AJ Edu**, **Spencer Littleson**, **Setric Millner Jr.**, **JT Shumate** and **Blake Williams** — earning spots in the NABC's Honors Court.
