UTSA at a Glance: UTSA returns its potent offense from one year ago that saw the Roadrunners finish 24-9 for its sixth consecutive 20-plus win season. The Roadrunners ranked 44th in the nation in hitting percentage (.249) and held opponents to a .166 attack percentage, which was best for 25th in the NCAA. UTSA also finished top three in five of seven statistical categories in Conference USA. Head volleyball coach Laura Neugebauer-Groff returns five of her starters from last season, including first team All-Conference USA selection and AVCA All-Region honoree Dajana Boskovic. The senior outside hitter paced the squad with a NCAA 14th-best 4.53 kills per set, while adding 2.79 digs and 0.80 blocks per frame. Boskovic was also recognized for the third consecutive season on the C-USA Preseason Volleyball Team, along with fellow teammate Marijeta Runjic. Runjic was also an all-conference award winner last season and contributed 2.98 kills and 0.60 blocks per set.

Opponents at a Glance: Between the three teams UTSA will face over the weekend, SMU had the most successful run in 2015 as the Mustangs captured the American Athletic Conference regular season title with a 27-9 record, the most wins in program history. SMU advanced to the NCAA Tournament with an automatic bid and fell to Purdue in the first round, 3-1. Little Rock finished even at 14-14 in the Sun Belt Conference and was selected to finish fourth in the West Division in the preseason poll. Montana posted an 8-20 overall record and went 4-12 in the Big Sky and return just two starters and the libero this season.


of the Lone Star State to kick off their campaign.

In the program's 33 years of existence, the Roadrunners have gone **14-19** in **season openers**. In the last five seasons, UTSA is 3-2 and has won the last two season openers. In 2015, the Roadrunners swept at the Bearkats Invitational and defeated Montana State to open the season.

Head coach Laura Neugebauer-Groff enters her 15th season at the helm of the Roadrunners volleyball program and 23rd overall in 2016. Among all coaches at the Division I level, Neugebauer-Groff is the 34th winningest coach (by wins) with 513 and is the 44th winningest coach (by percentage) with a 67 percent winning percentage.

Milestones were reached during the 2015 season when the Roadrunners took down a trio of Power 5 conference programs. UTSA defeated Indiana (Big 10) at the Delta Zeta Classic hosted by Texas State and then went on to roll past No. 12 Oregon (Pac 12) at the Convocation Center and finally Clemson (ACC) a week and a half later at the SMU Doubletree Invitational.

Convocation Center



- Built in 1975, the Convocation Center features a permanent maple hardwood court that measures 17,900 square feet and seating that accommodates 4,080 spectators.
- The "Convo" hosted the 1993 United States Olympic Festival Volleyball Tournament, 1998 NORCECA World Volleyball Championships, 2002 WBCA All-Star Game and 2004 Nike Hoops Summit.
- It has been the home of UTSA's volleyball team since 1989.
- All of the top 10 crowds in program history have come during the 14-year Laura Neugebauer-Groff era.

Neugebauer-Groff has strung along six consecutive seasons of 20-plus wins and in that span, the Roadrunners have combined for a 62-14 record at the Convocation Center.

Conference USA announced its **2016 preseason team** and **Dajana Boskovic** and **Marijeta Runjic** represent UTSA on the 11-member team. Boskovic makes her third straight appearance while this is Runjic's first.

Once again, UTSA was selected to finish second in the league in the 2016 preseason poll with WKU repeating as champions. The Roadrunners finished runners-up last season after falling to the Hilltoppers in the final match of the conference tournament.

UTSA will be taking on three teams mentioned in the 2016 AVCA Top-25 Coaches Preseason Poll. Texas checks in at No. 3 in the poll while Conference USA foe and defending champion WKU comes in at No. 22. Wichita State received votes with 21 and will visit the Alamo City for the Roadrunner Roundup.

Since volleyball play first started in 1983 at the Convocation Center, the Roadrunners have gone a combined 277-145. Of those 277 wins, Neugebauer-Groff owns 128. The famed head coach owns a 128-53 record at the Convo.


