DRESSING ROOM COMMENT -- NEW MEXICO

QUARTERBACK BUDDY FUNCK

"I definitely think we've got a better team than what we showed tonight. In the third quarter, the roof just caved in on us. Especially in the first half, we were moving the ball real well. But in the first quarter, we only got the ball once, and when you only have the ball once, you've gotta score points. We came up empty for the first half, and I think that kinda frustrated us. And then in the third quarter, everything just went Tennessee's way. (Regarding botched FG attempt) It was ~~kinda~~ kind of a bad snap and I didn't handle it well. I just didn't get it on the tee. The field goal would have helped, but I can't really say whether or not it would have changed the game...Tennessee's got a great team; we knew they'd be tough. But I still think we can play with them. We just didn't execute in the third quarter and we let things get away from us. I don't think it will be that tough getting ready for Arkansas."

FREE SAFETY RAY HORN~~E~~FECK

"I think we just got outmuscled. They were blowing us back off the line pretty much at will. I found myself running into a lot of linemen back in my area. The way we played tonight, I think we probably are 25 points worse than Tennessee. ~~A~~ Day in and day out, I don't think it would be that bad, but I think they would probably get the better of us most of the time. Tennessee's real physical, and they're real smart, too. They knew exactly what to do to beat us. We had watched them before. They didn't do a lot of passing tonight. They just ran at us, and that's exactly what they needed to do. They handled the blitzed really well. I was impressed ~~x~~ with that. We usually take the quarterback down a lot more."

TENNESSEE DRESSING ROOM COMMENT:

Quarterback Alan Cockrell:

"We came into this game feeling we were better and physically bigger than they were and could run on them. Because they blitz and move around a lot, our game plan was to run the ball right at them and pass only if we had to. I tried to avoid the mistakes I made agnst Pittsburgh. It was another fantastic defensive effort, and I thought we had- much better execution this time. On my touchdown pass to Clyde Duncan (wide receiver), it was a man coverage. We knew before the game that crossing routes would work against New Mexico.

Running Back Randall Morris:

"Coach Majors' theme in practice this past week was x 'resiliency'. And we bounced back like we thought we could. We'll have to ~~XXXXX~~ bounce back much harder against Auburn. On my two-yard run for the score in the third quarter, it was a straight up the middle ice play. Chuhck Coleman and Sam Henderson did a great job blocking for me, and I just took ~~a~~ it on in. I should have broken a couple of plays tonight for long yardage, especially when there was just one man I_ had to get away from. Maybe I can do it the next time."

Wide Receiver Clyde Duncan (Regarding 53-yard TD pass from Cockrell in first quarter)

"It was man coverage and I went in from the right and ~~XXXX~~ and beat the corner man across. Our offensive line did a fine job picking up the stunts, and of course, Alan ~~did~~ did a great job of throwing to me. Once I cut across the cornerback, I was wide open. Our offensive coaches prepared us well for this game. The win helps a lot. Our offense showed a lot of resiliency this time out-just as Coach Majors said it could."

Running Back Sam Henderson:
