NOTES

- Union is coming off an 82-68 loss at West Georgia to close out the first semester. Union trailed just four at the half, 41-37. Union was led by Marterrace Brock with 27 points and Serigne Mboup with 10.
- After starting the season 9-0, Union men find themselves on a three game losing streak. Union's slow starts in recent games has hurt the Bulldogs. In each of the last four games, Union has trailed by double figures at some point in the first 10 minutes of play.
- After being ranked in the top-25 in both the NABC Coaches Poll and the D2SIDA Media Poll, the three game skid has dropped Union from both polls.
- Union is now sitting tied for seventh in the GSC men's standings through six games. The top eight teams make the conference tournament at the end of the season. However, in a tightly grouped top eight teams, No. 1 and No. 8 are separated by just two games. Alabama Huntsville leads the way at 5-1, with five teams tied for second at 4-2.
- West Florida is 1-5 in league play with their win coming 96-85 at home versus North Alabama, one of the teams tied for second. The Argos have lost four straight coming into today's game at Union.

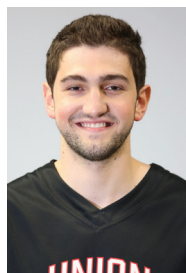

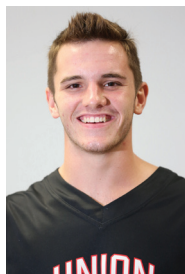
